DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of my design for a  
catheter deflector assembly for endoscopic instruments  
and the like showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear view.



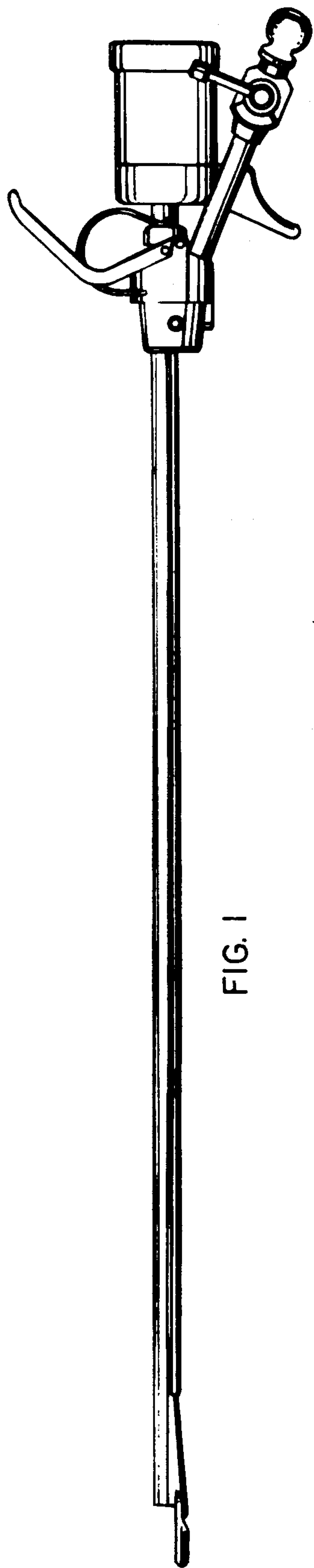

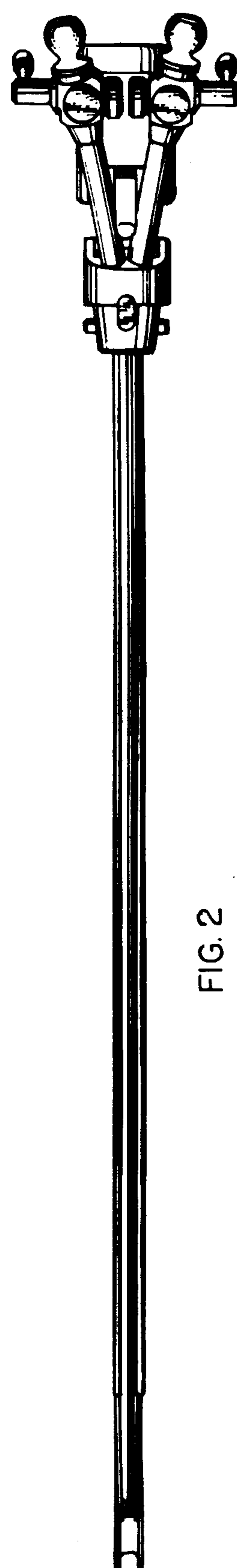

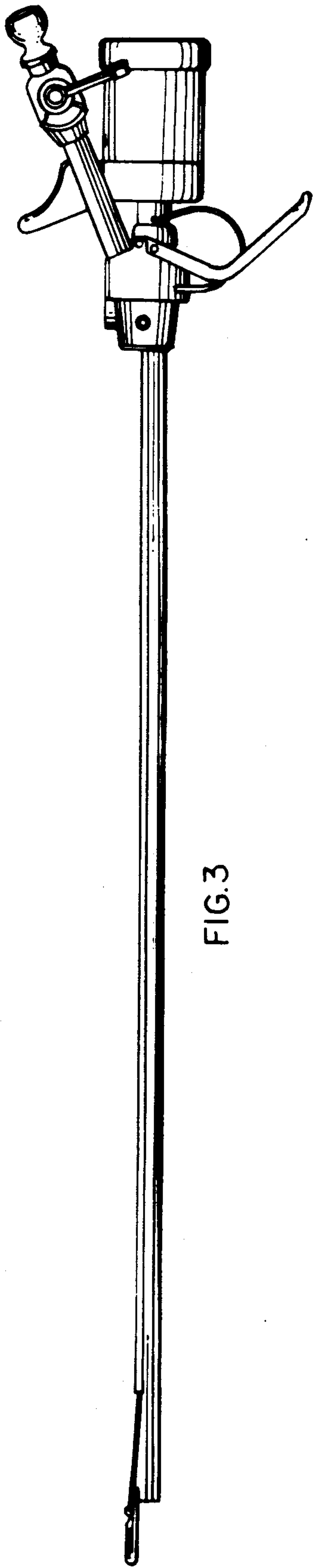

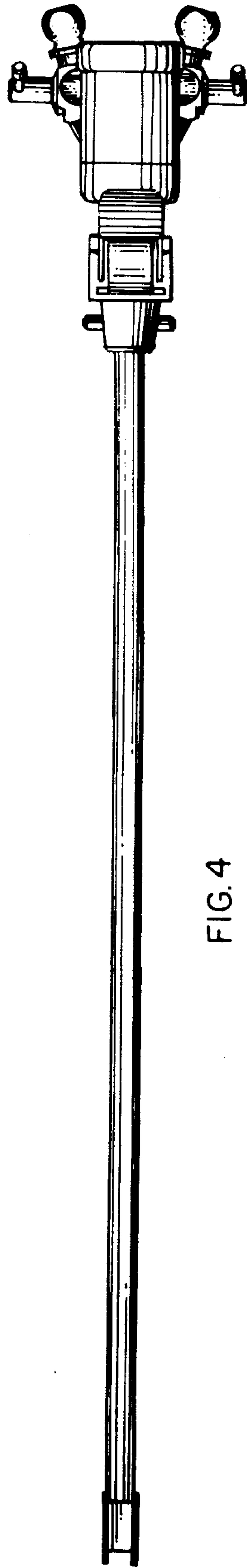

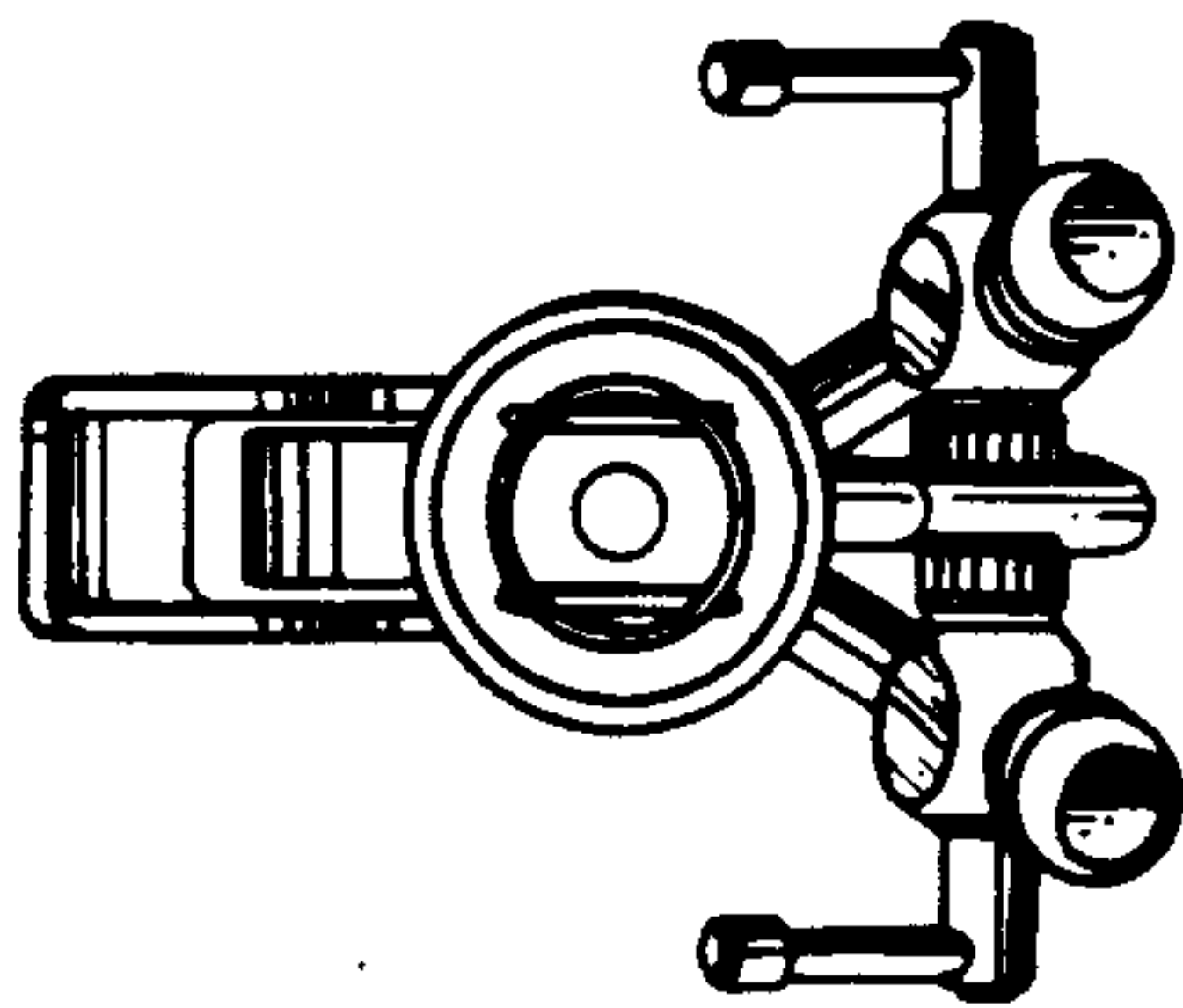

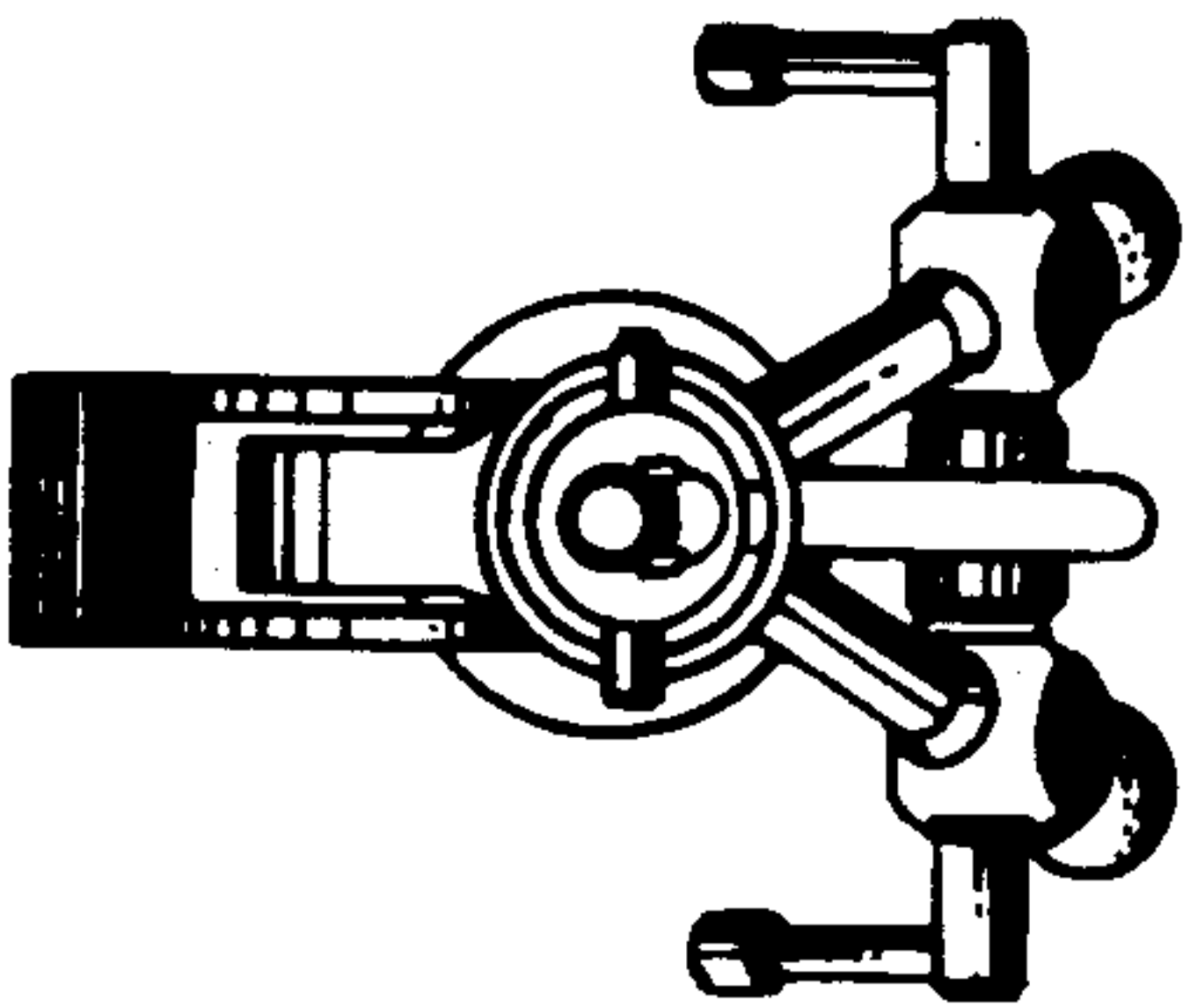
