FIG. 4 is a top plan view;

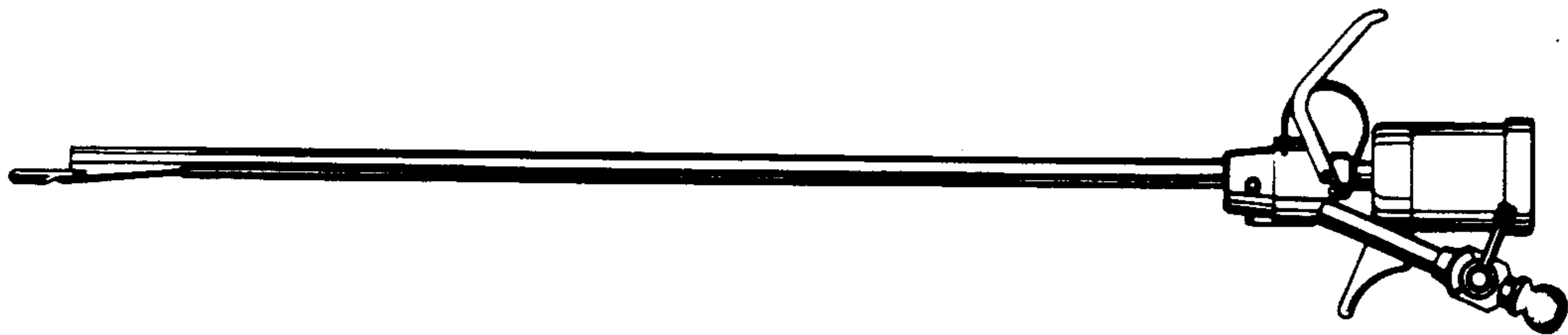
FIG. 5 is a front view; and

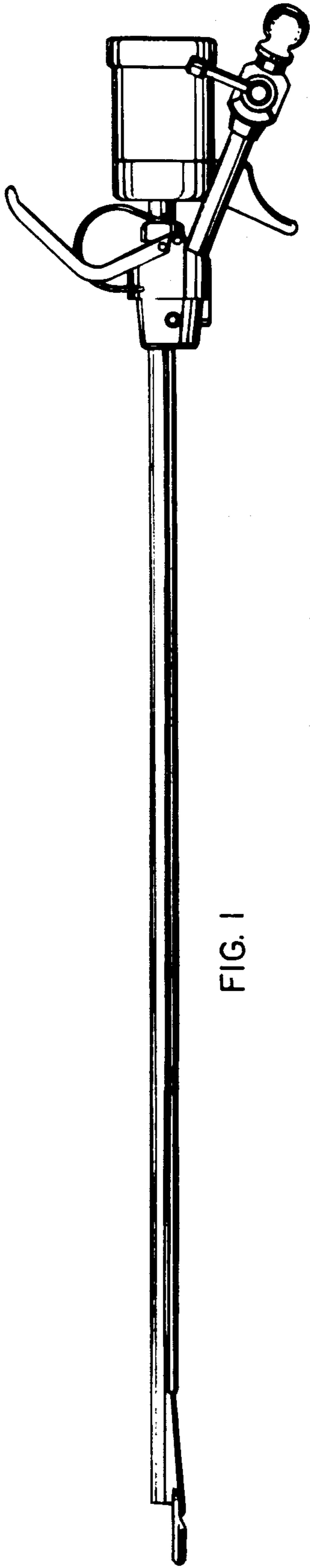

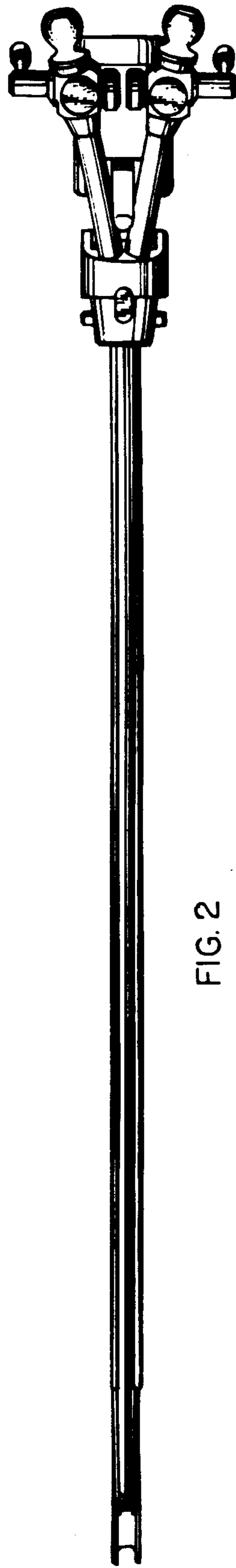

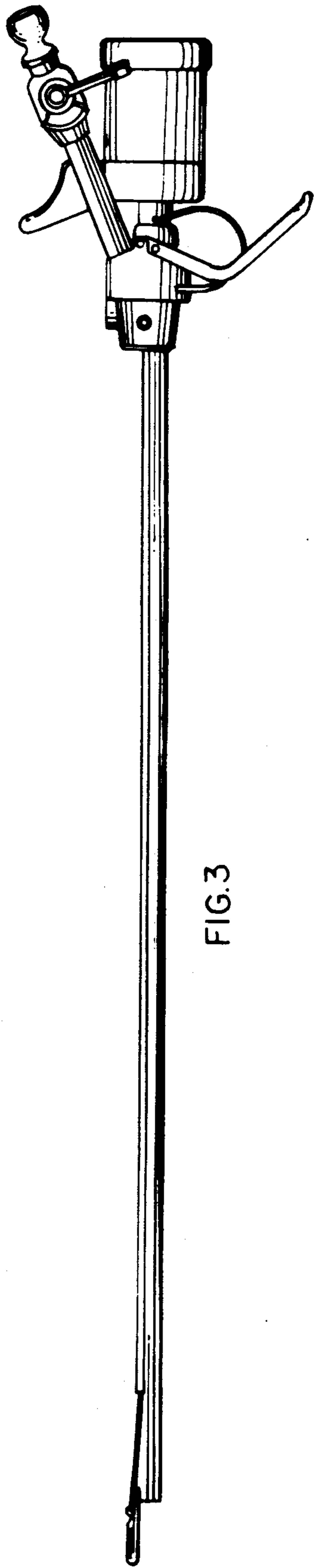

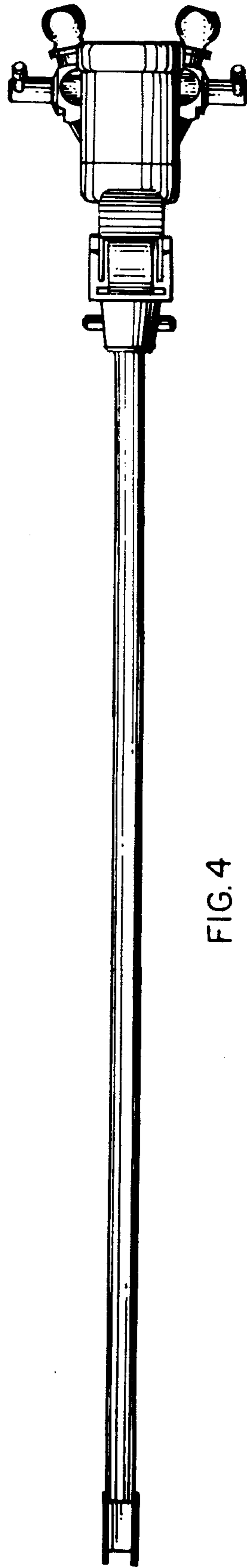

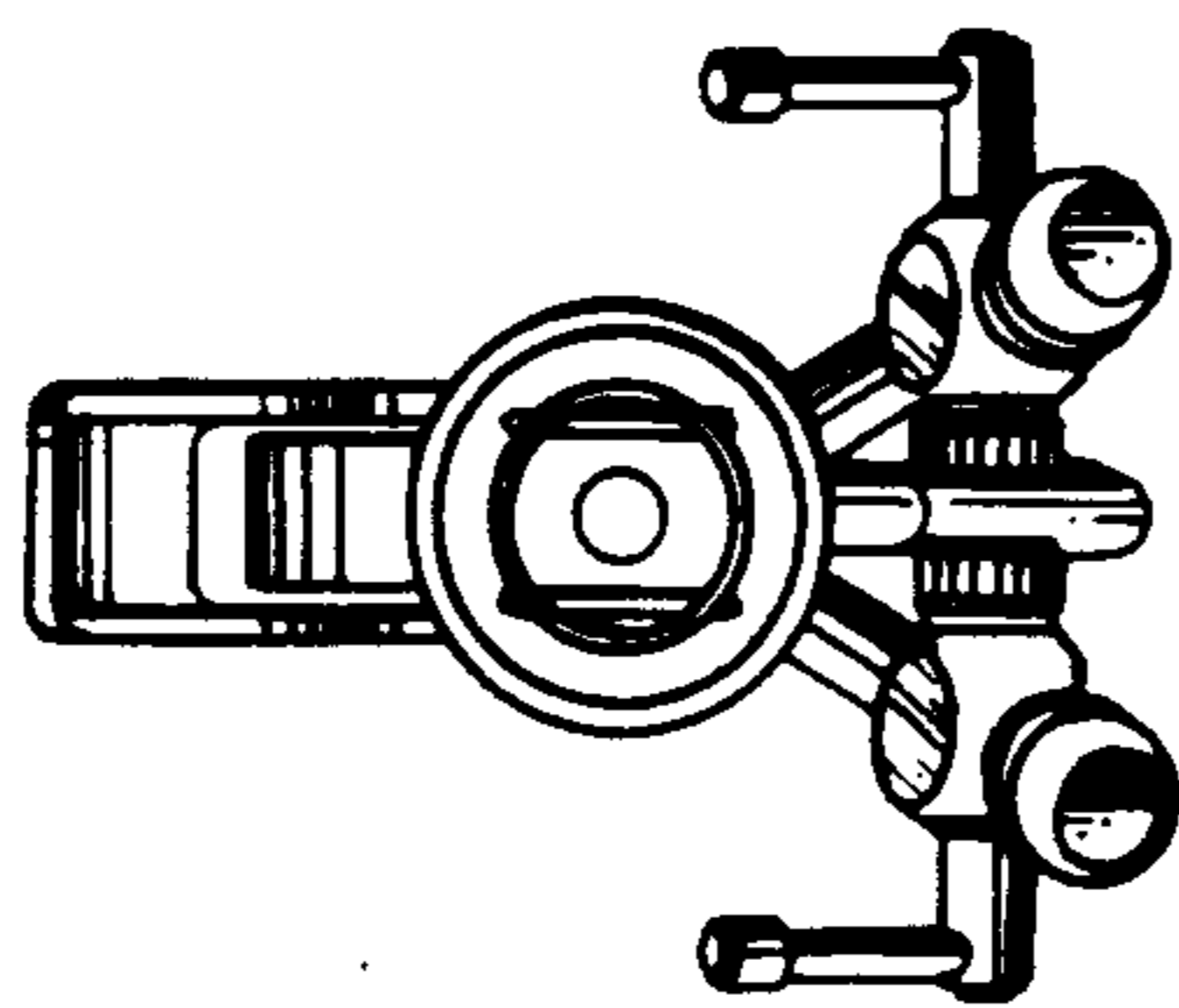

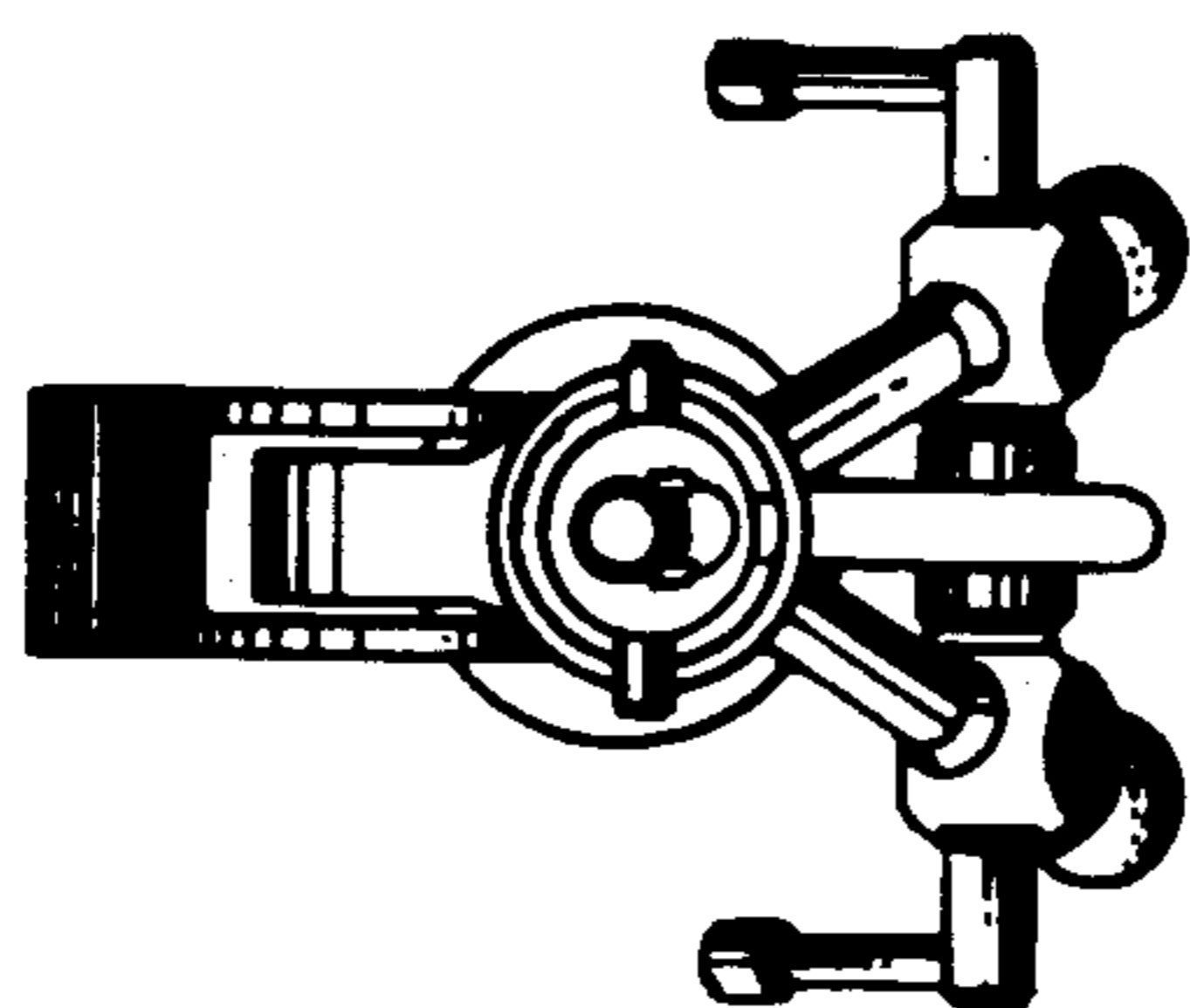
