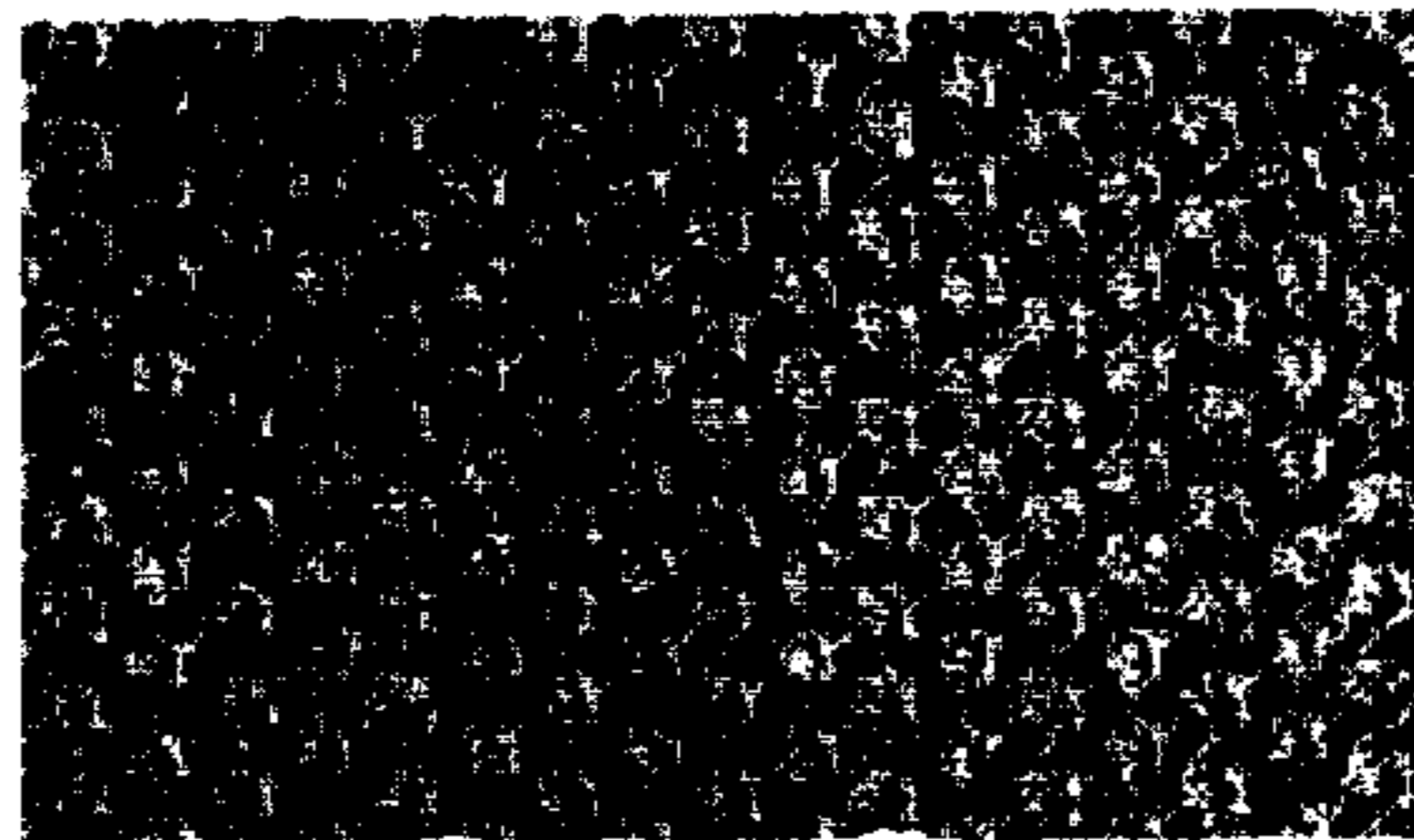

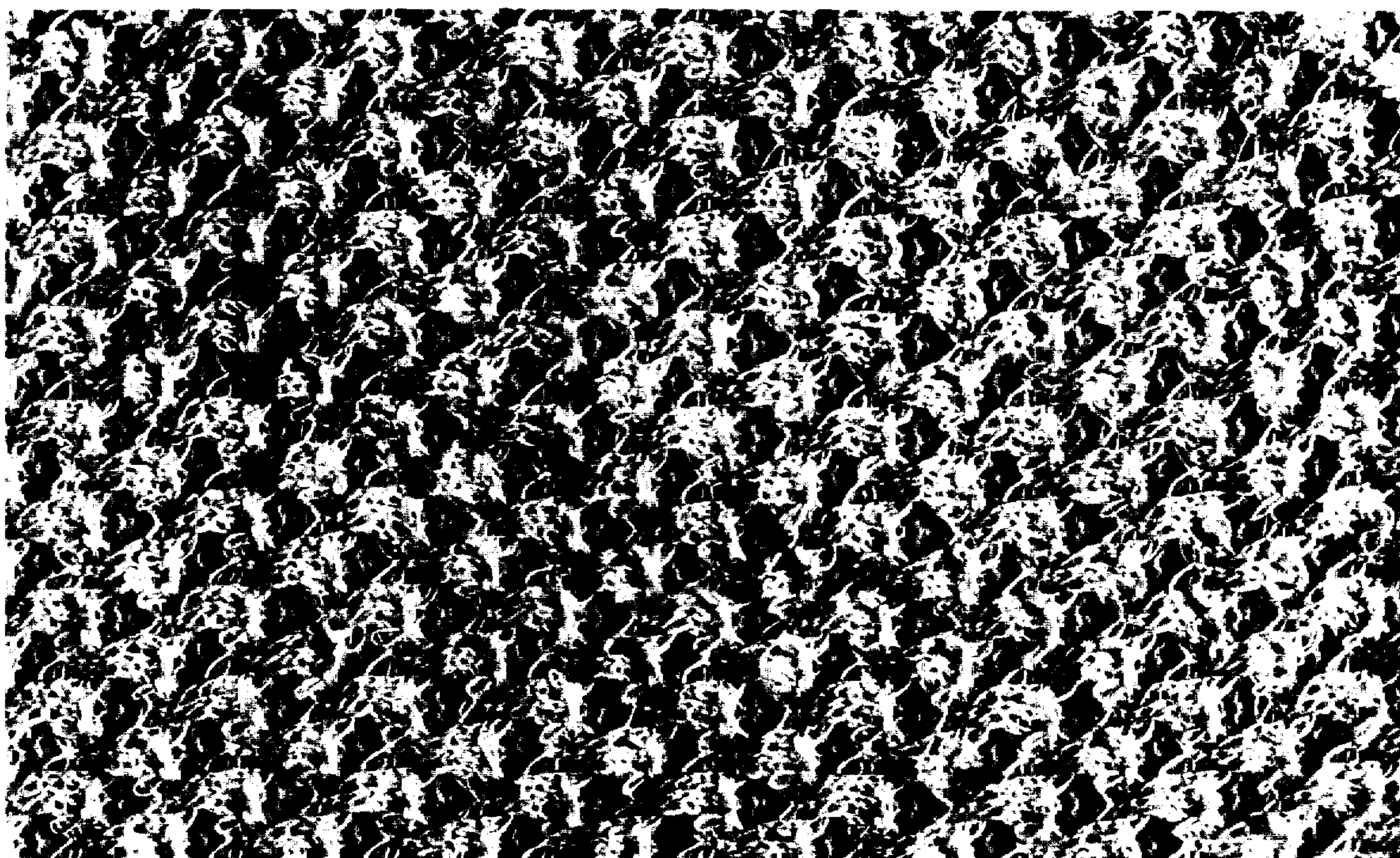
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a double knit fabric, as shown and described.

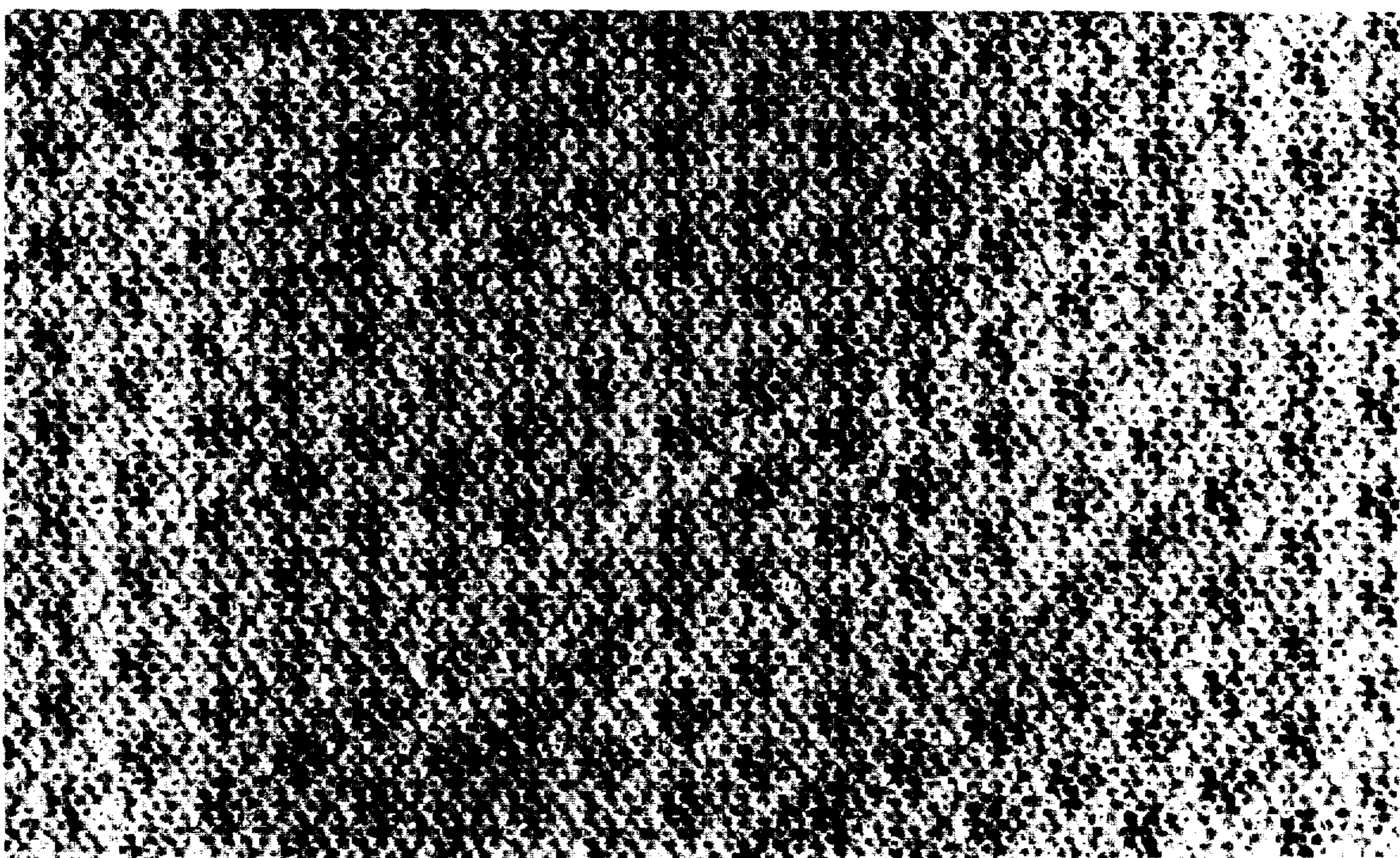
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of one surface of a double knit fabric showing my new design; and  
FIG. 2 is a plan view of the side of the fabric opposite that shown in FIG. 1.  
The portions of the fabric shown in the two Figures are not precisely in alignment with each other.
