FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

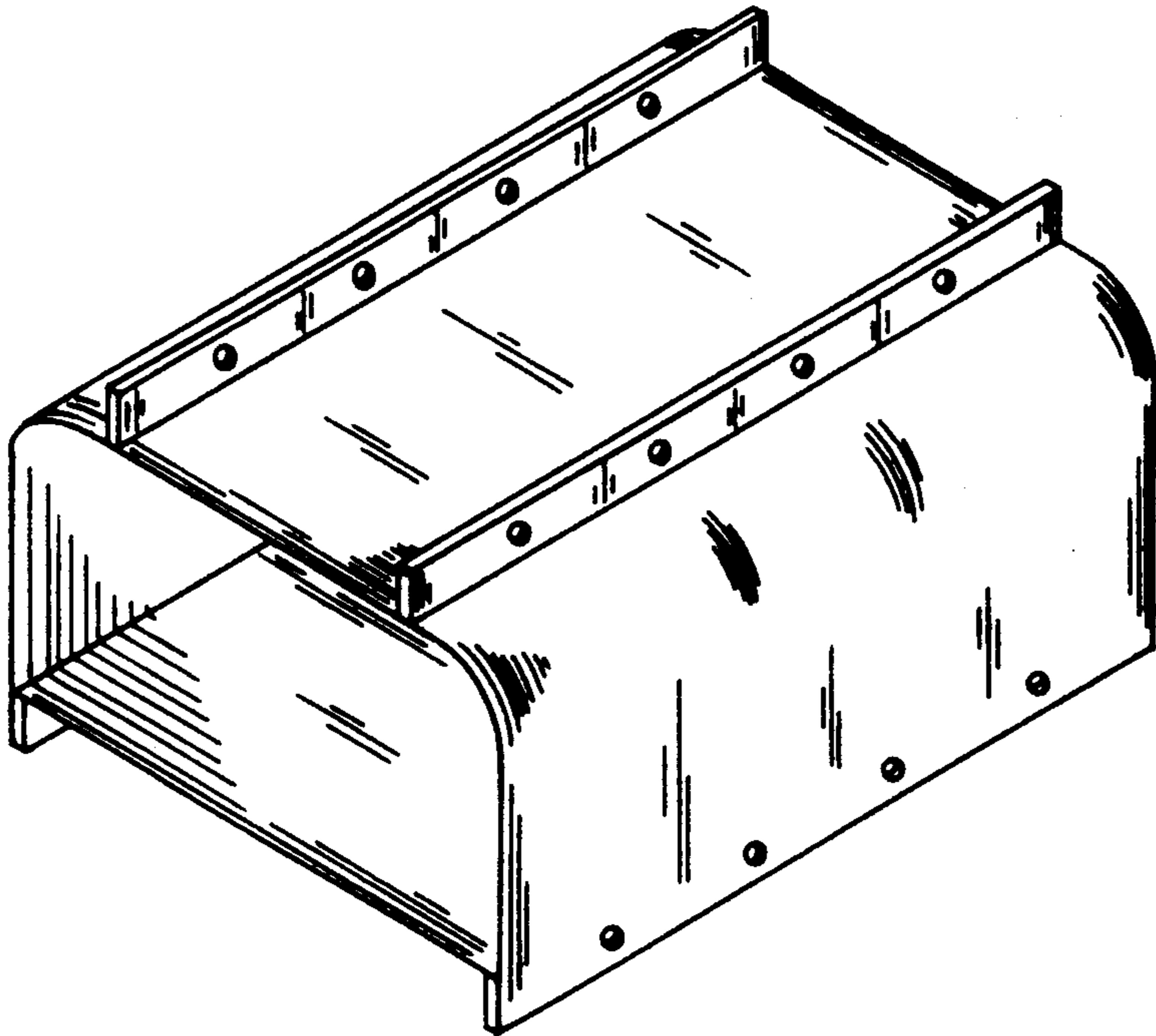
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof.

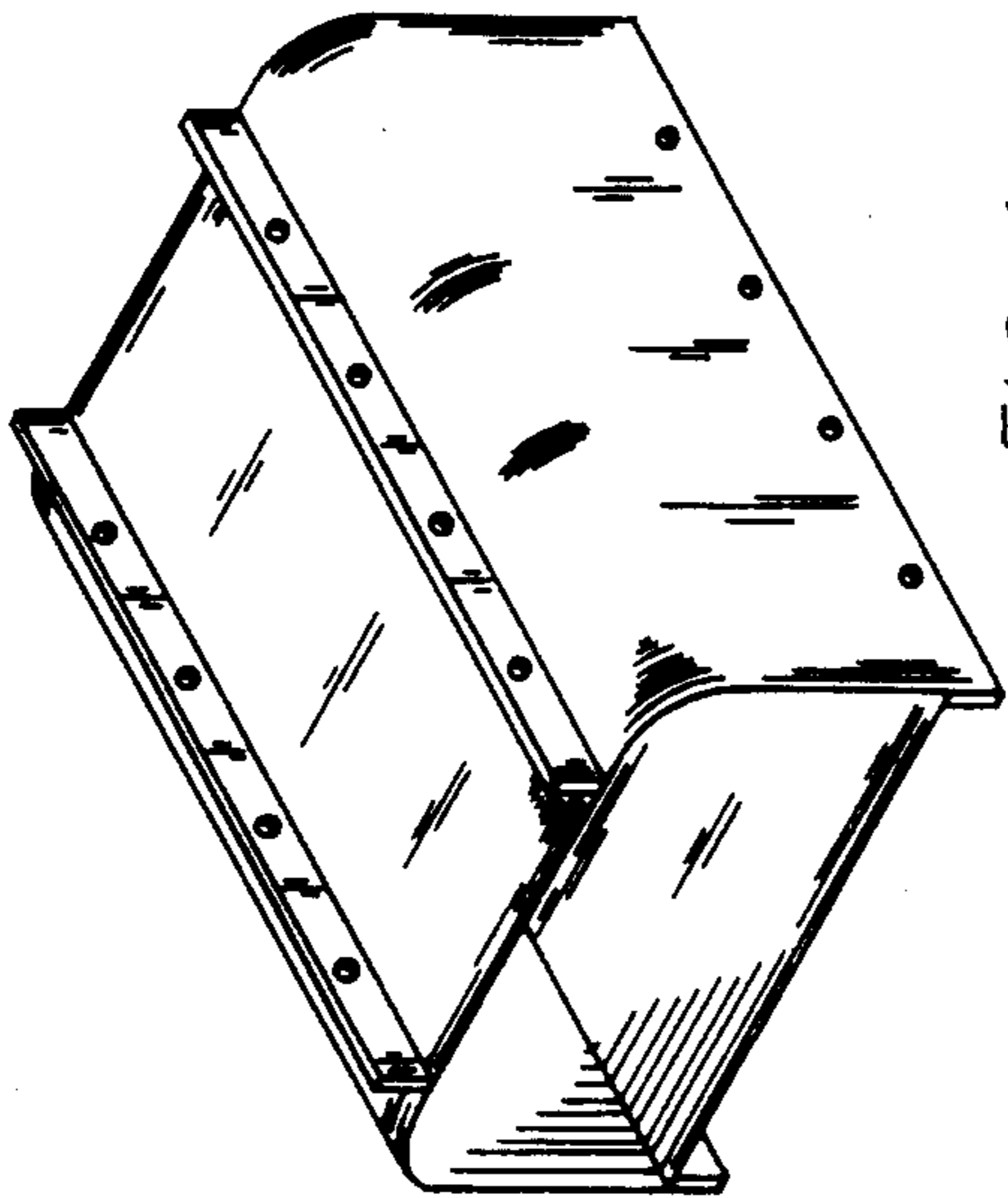

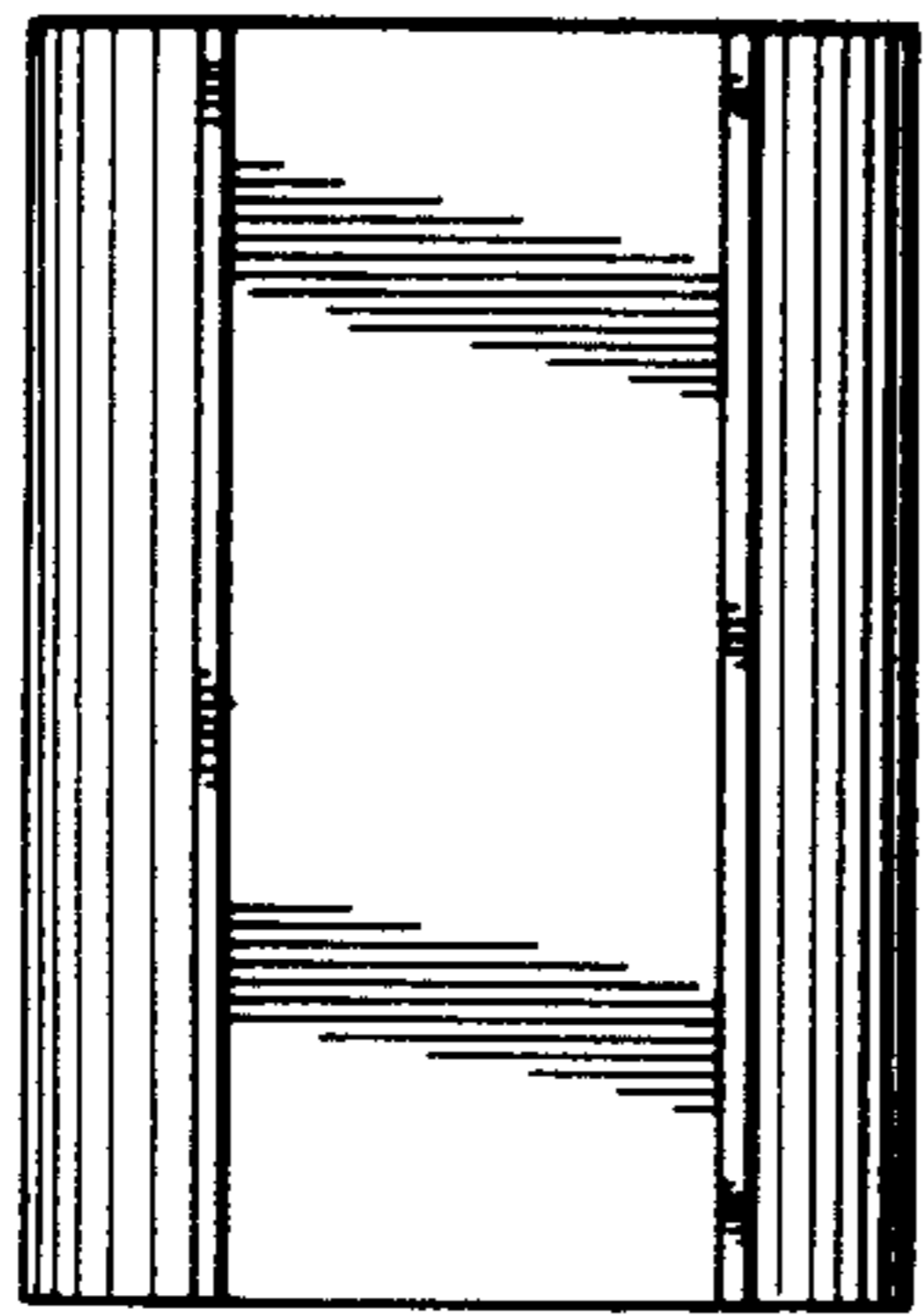

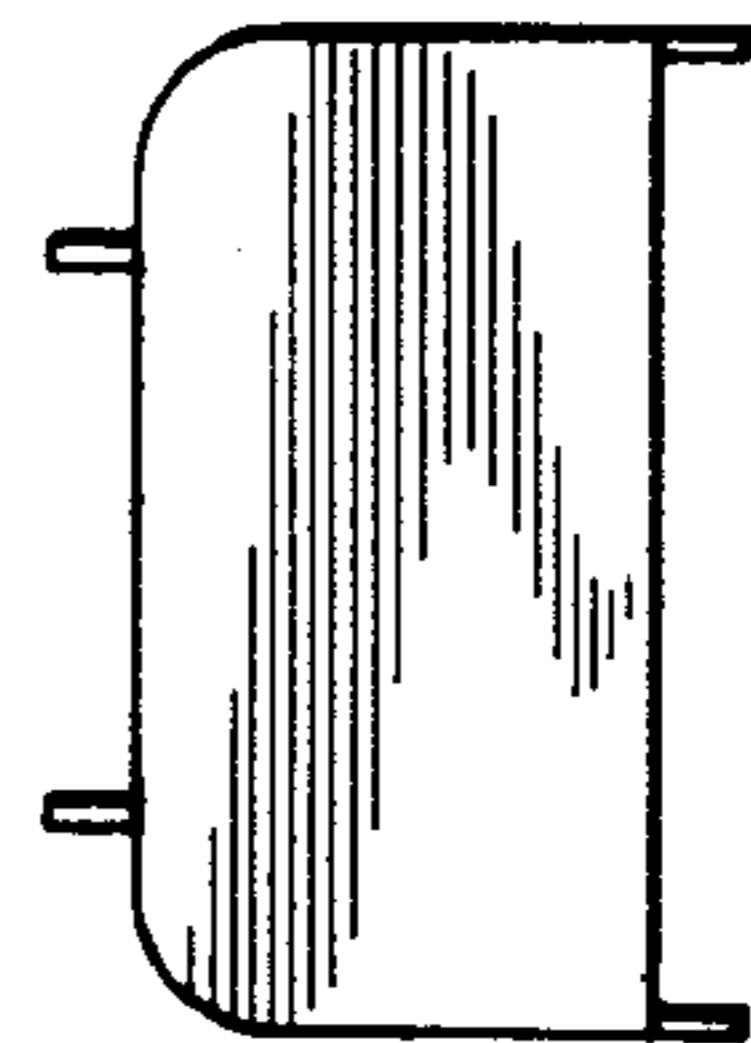

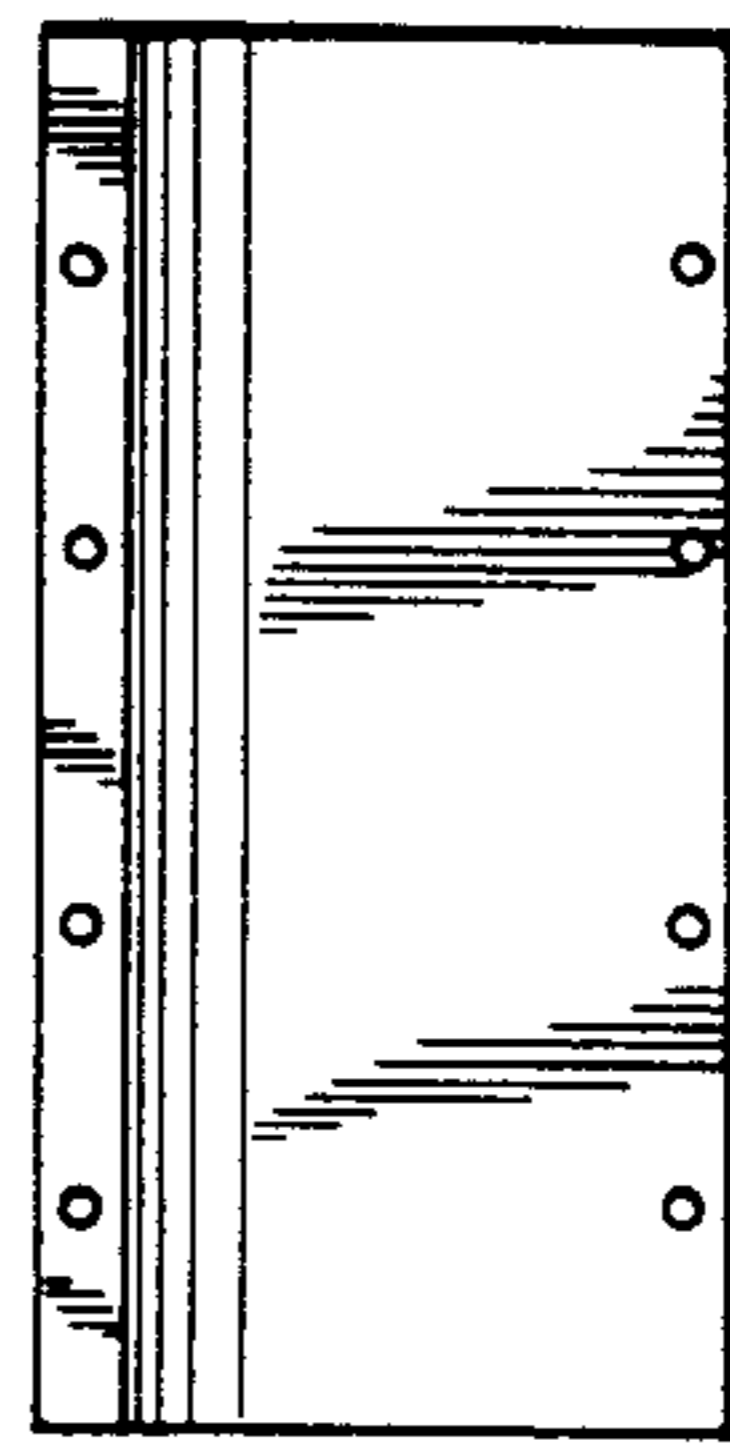
