The ornamental design for an animal food product, substantially as shown and described.

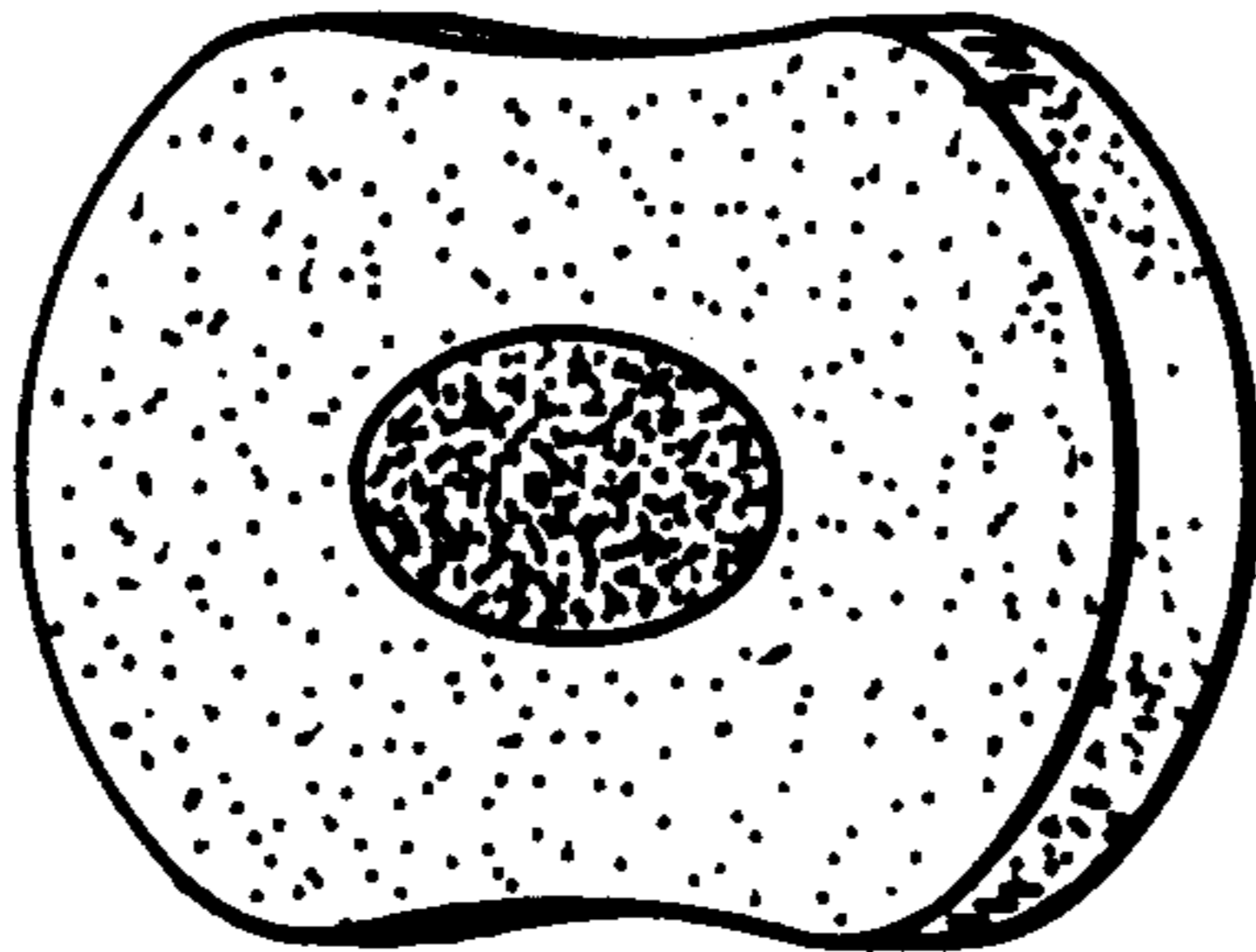
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.



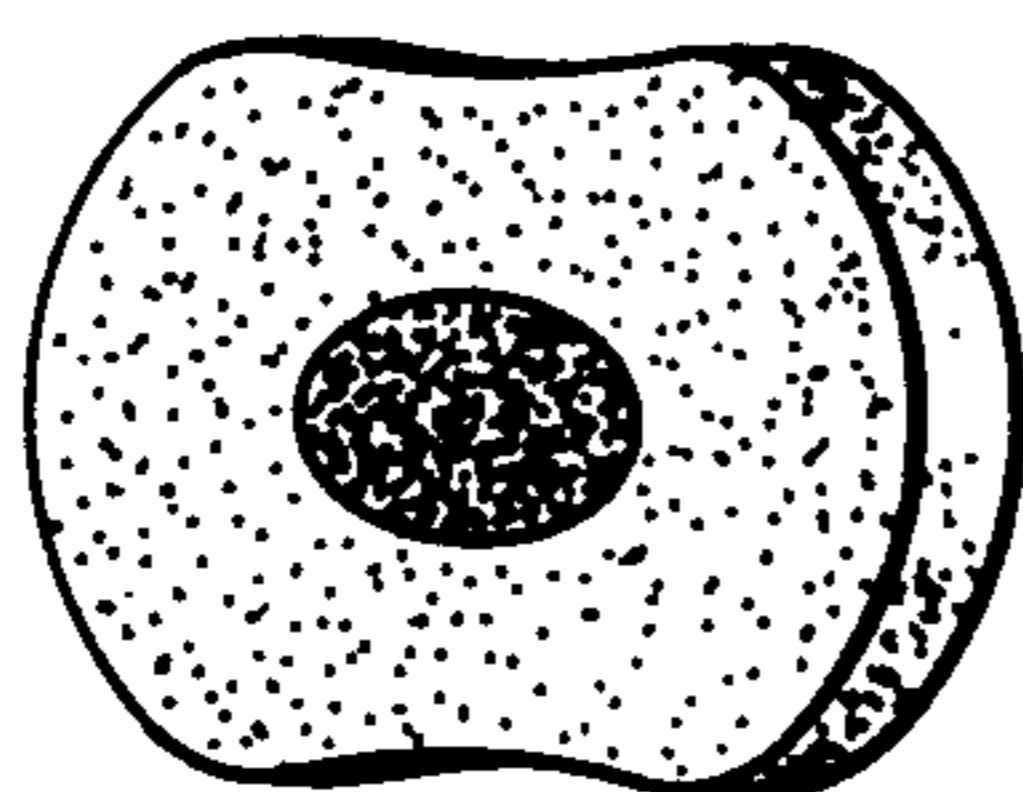

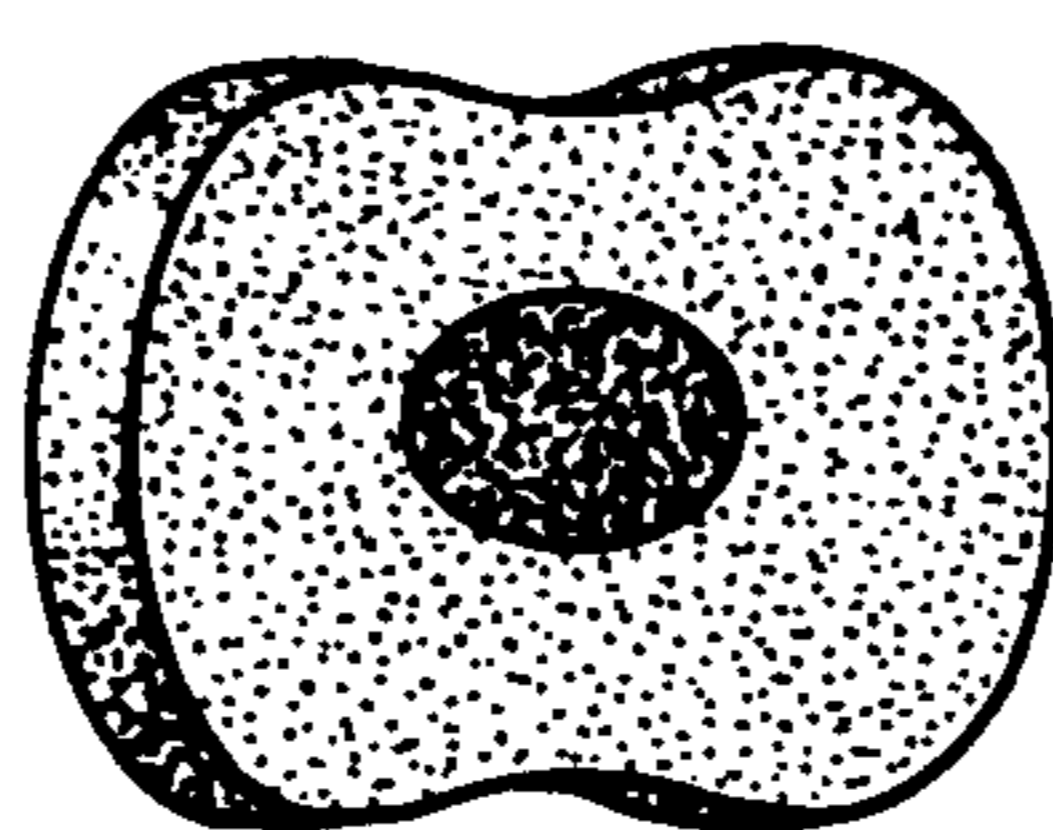
