thereof.

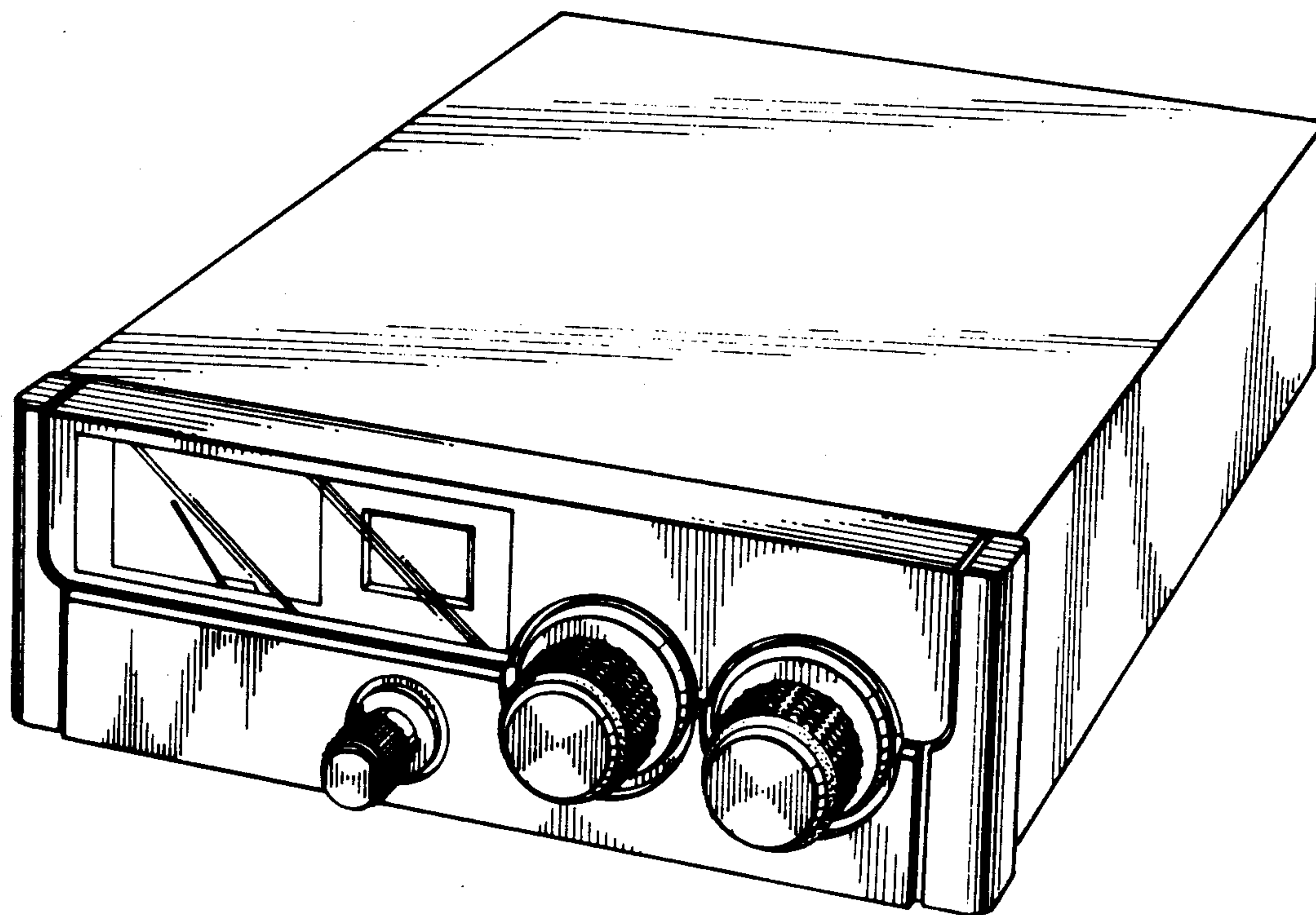

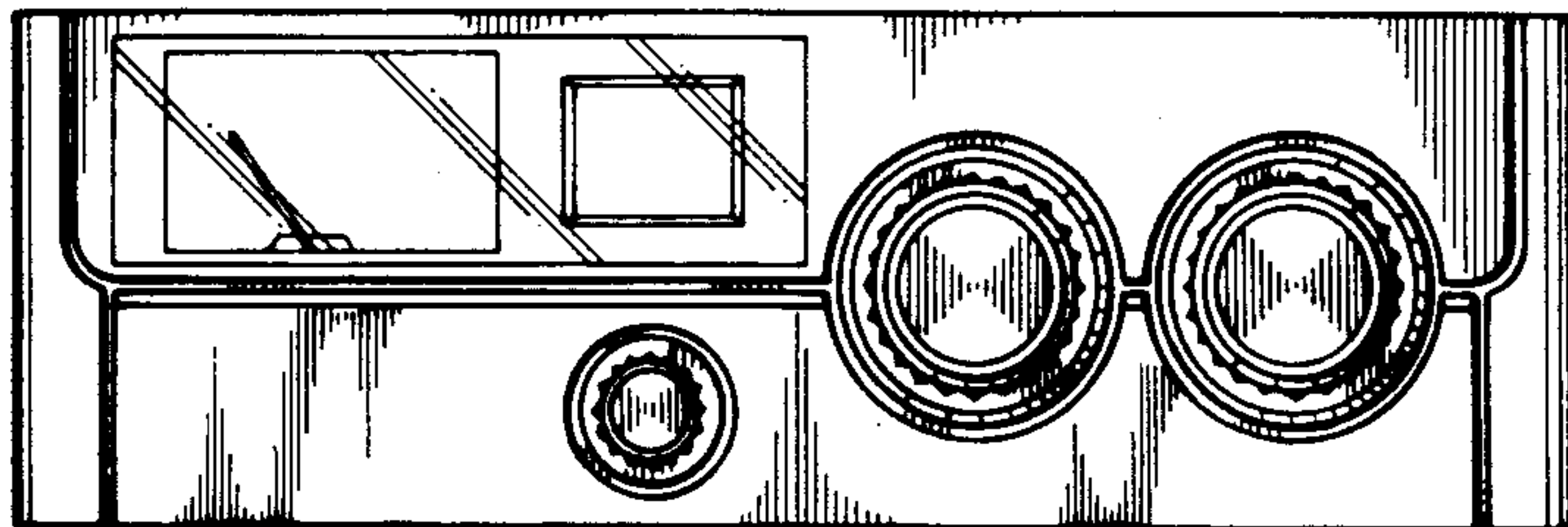

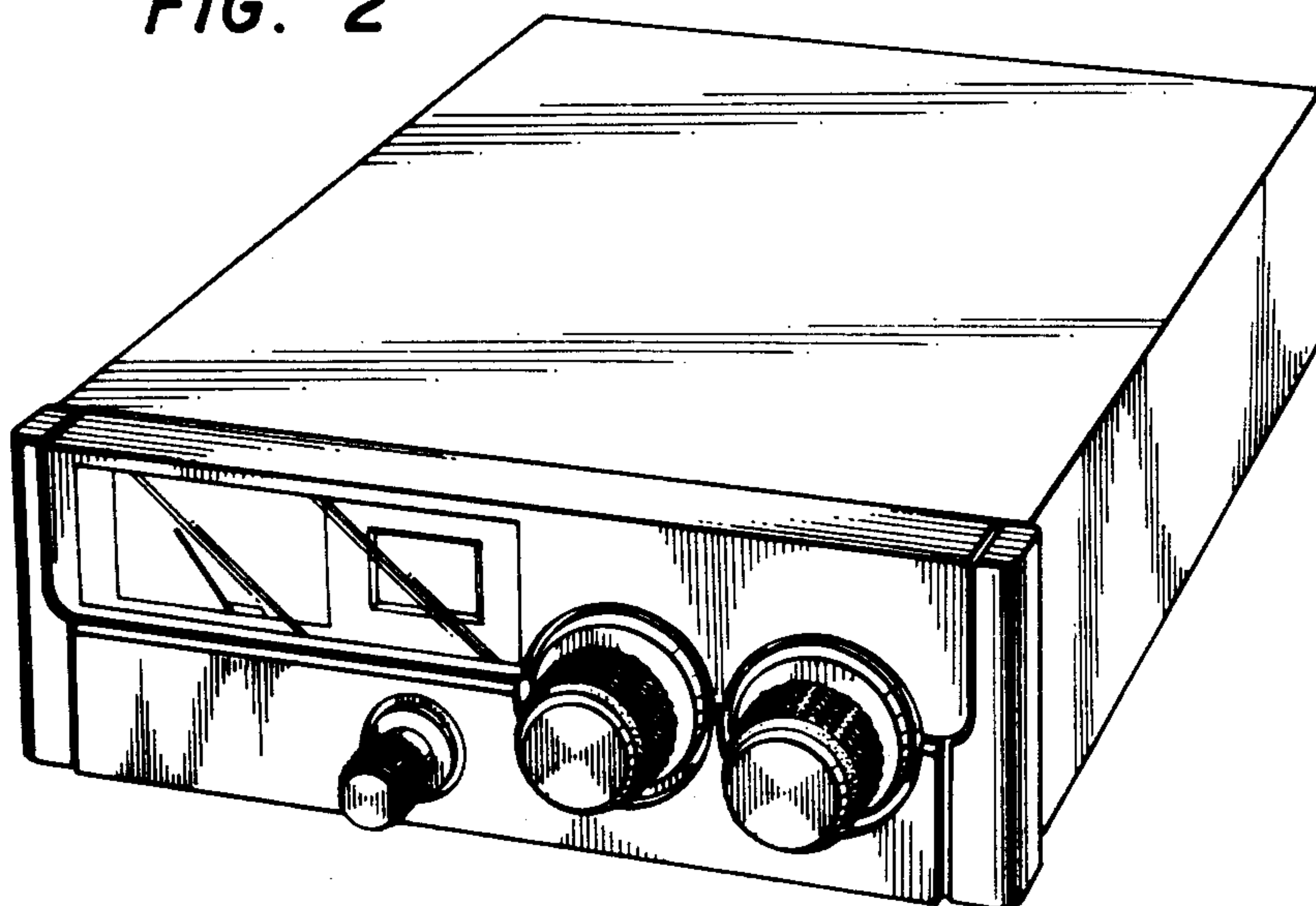
