The new and ornamental design for an electric guitar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electric guitar showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view with part of the front center structure omitted for convenience of illustration; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view.

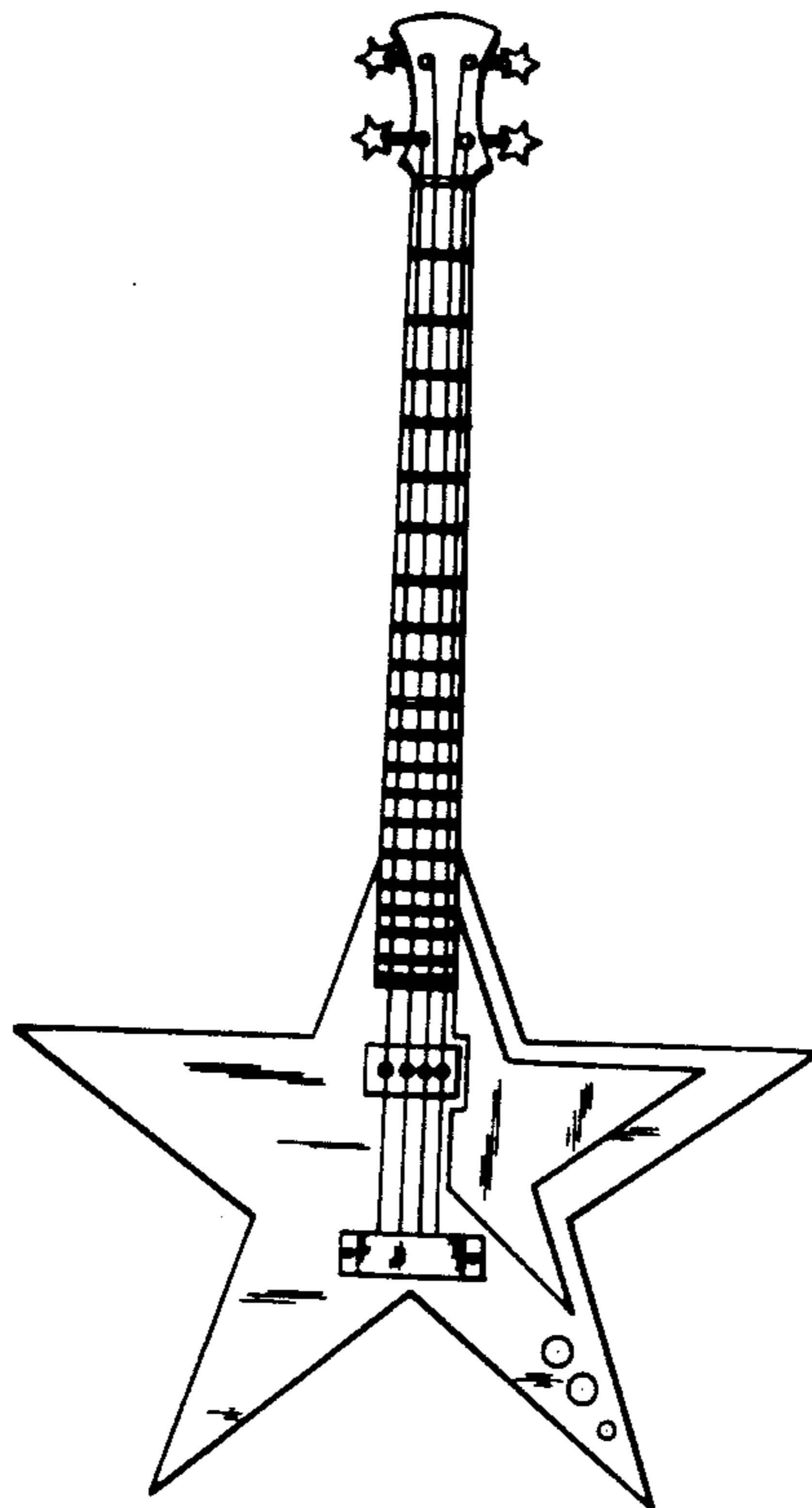

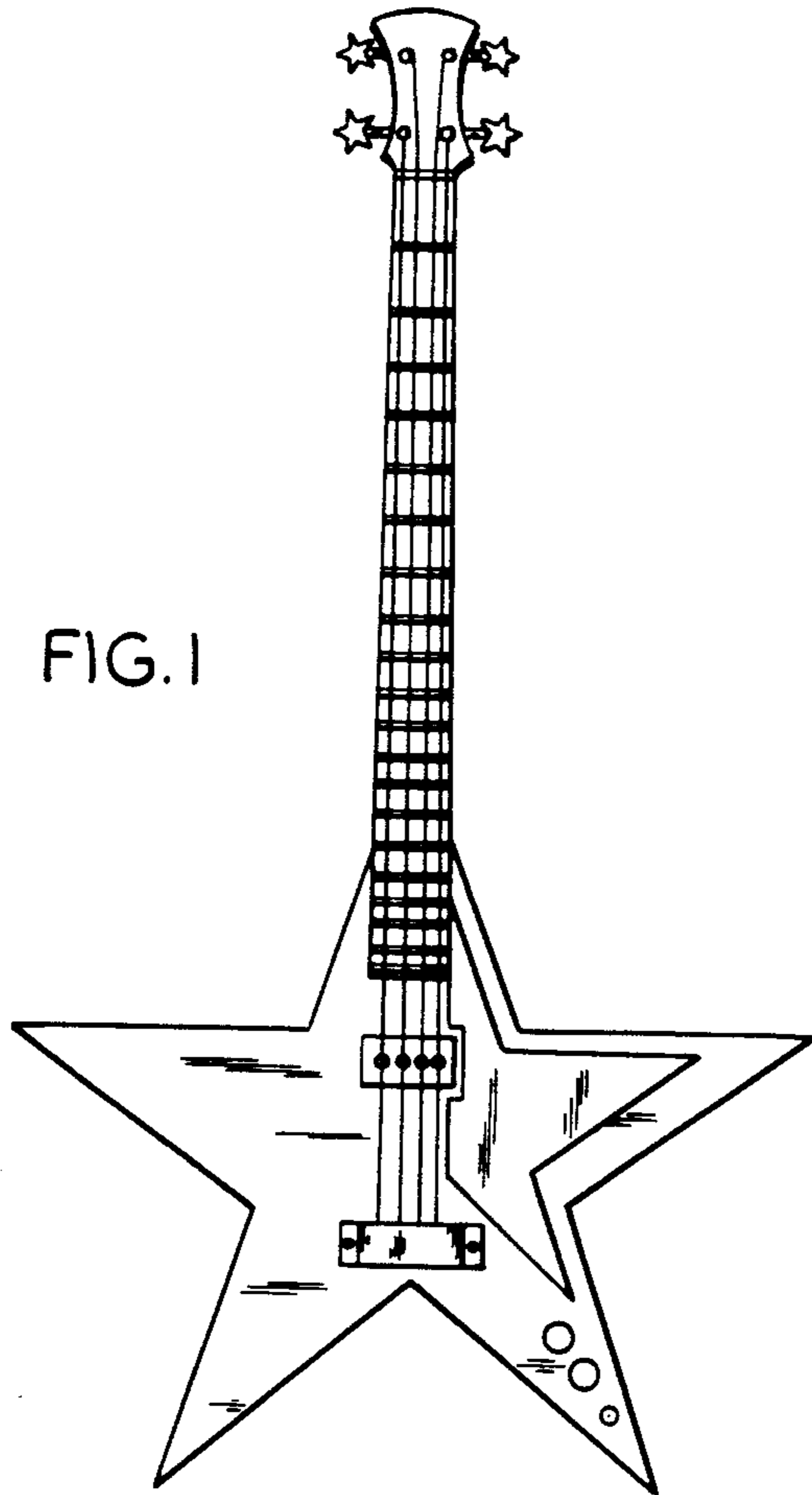

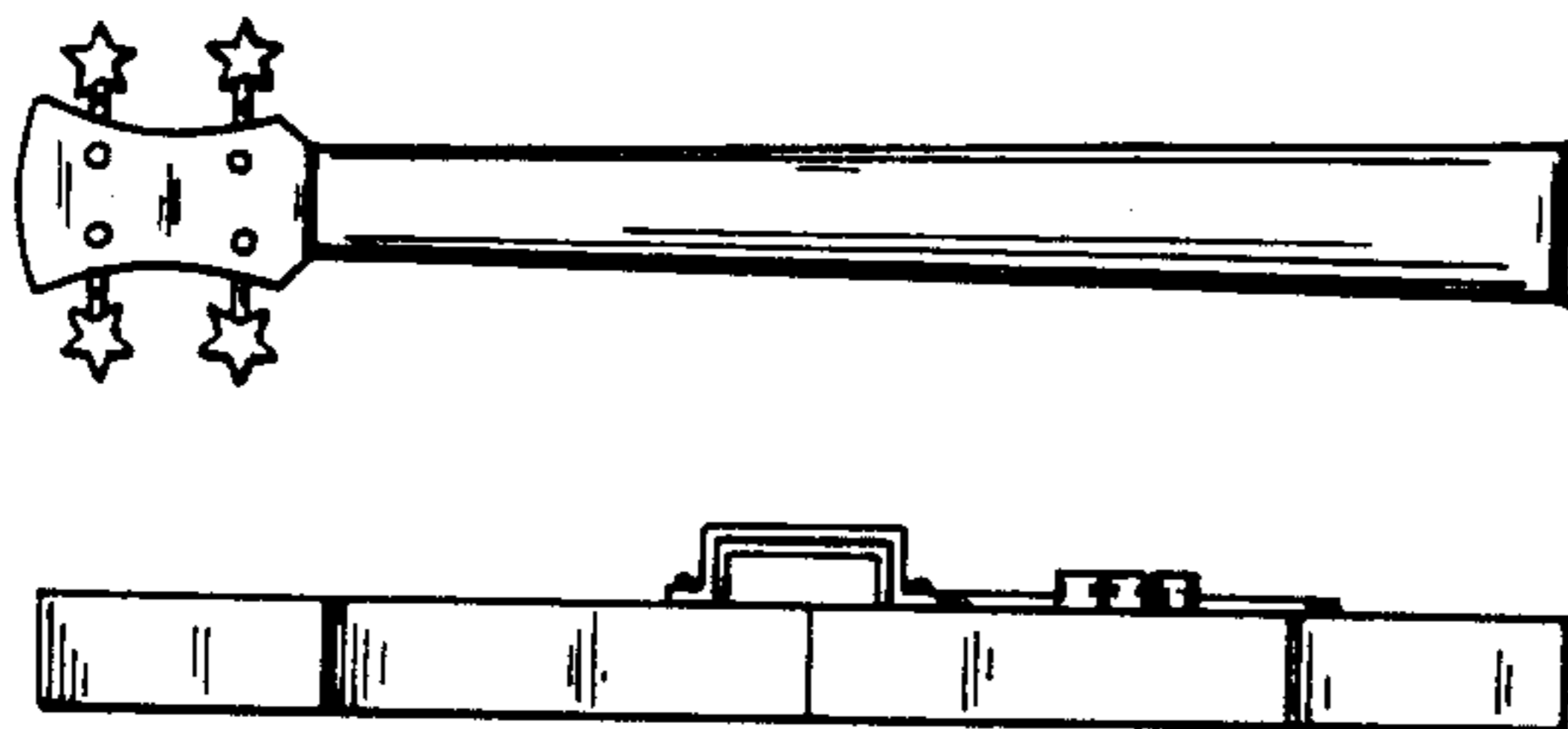
