[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a catamaran wind vane, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a catamaran wind vane showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a greatly enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken in the direction of arrows 6—6 of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken in the direction of arrows 7—7 of FIG. 1.
