thereof.

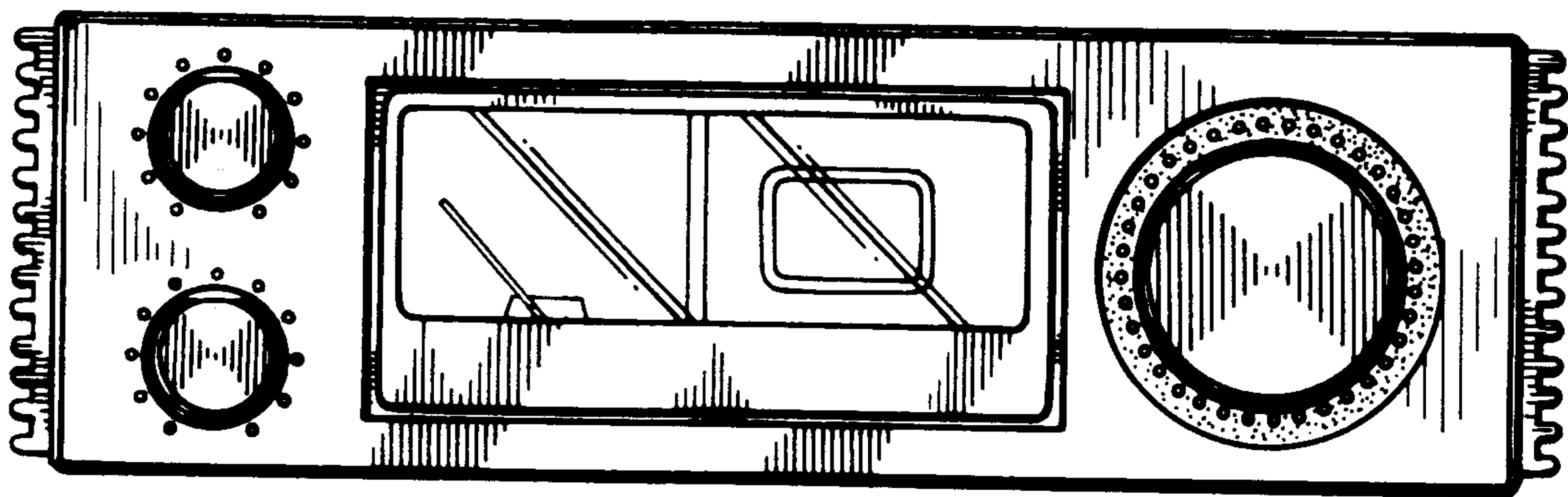

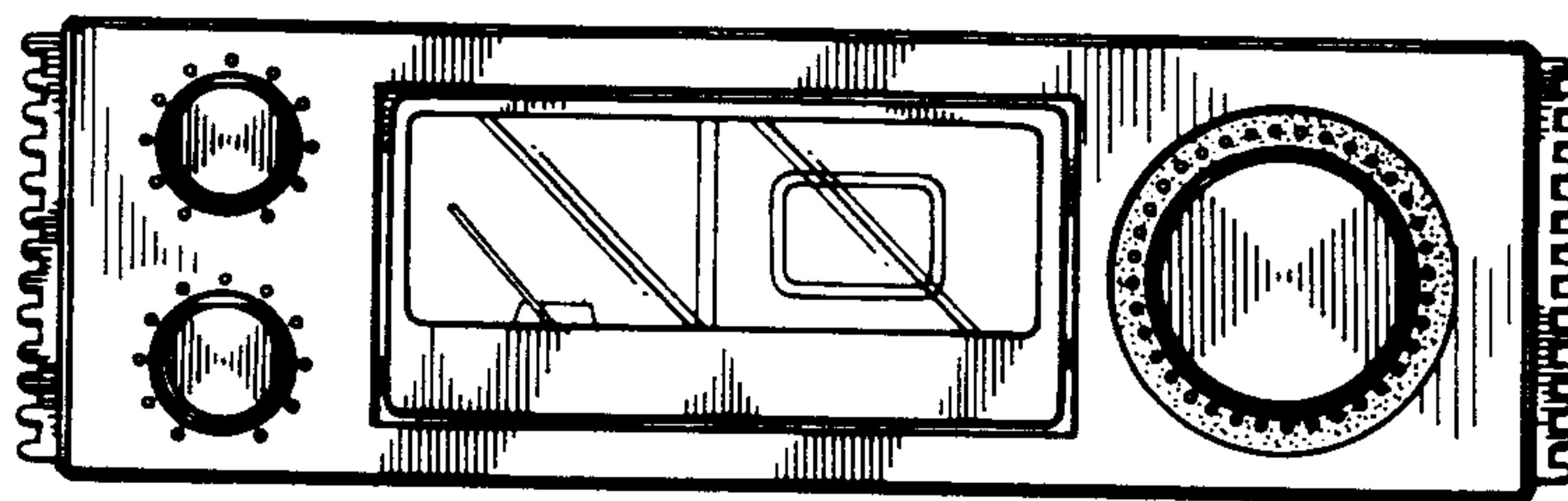

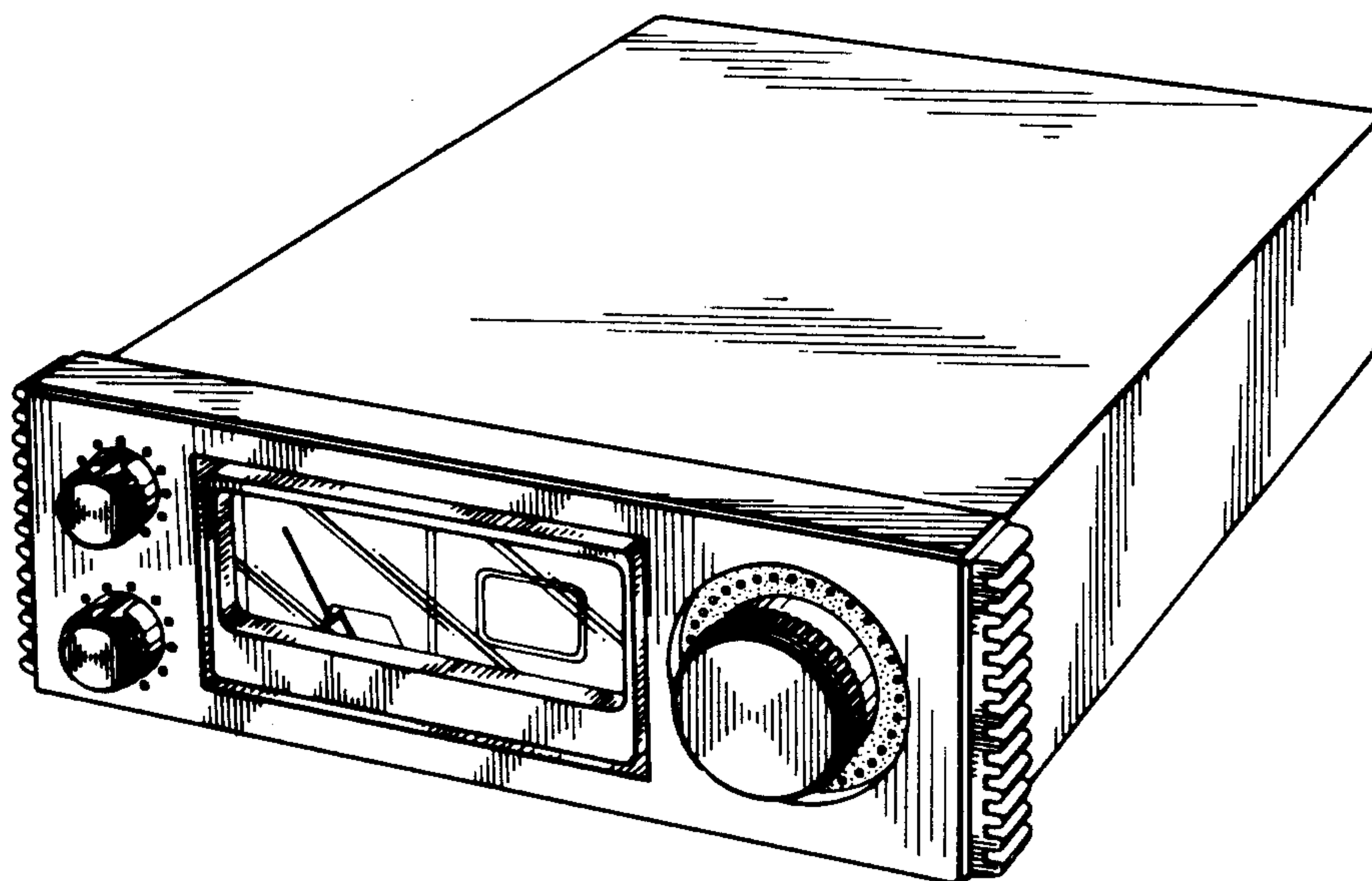
