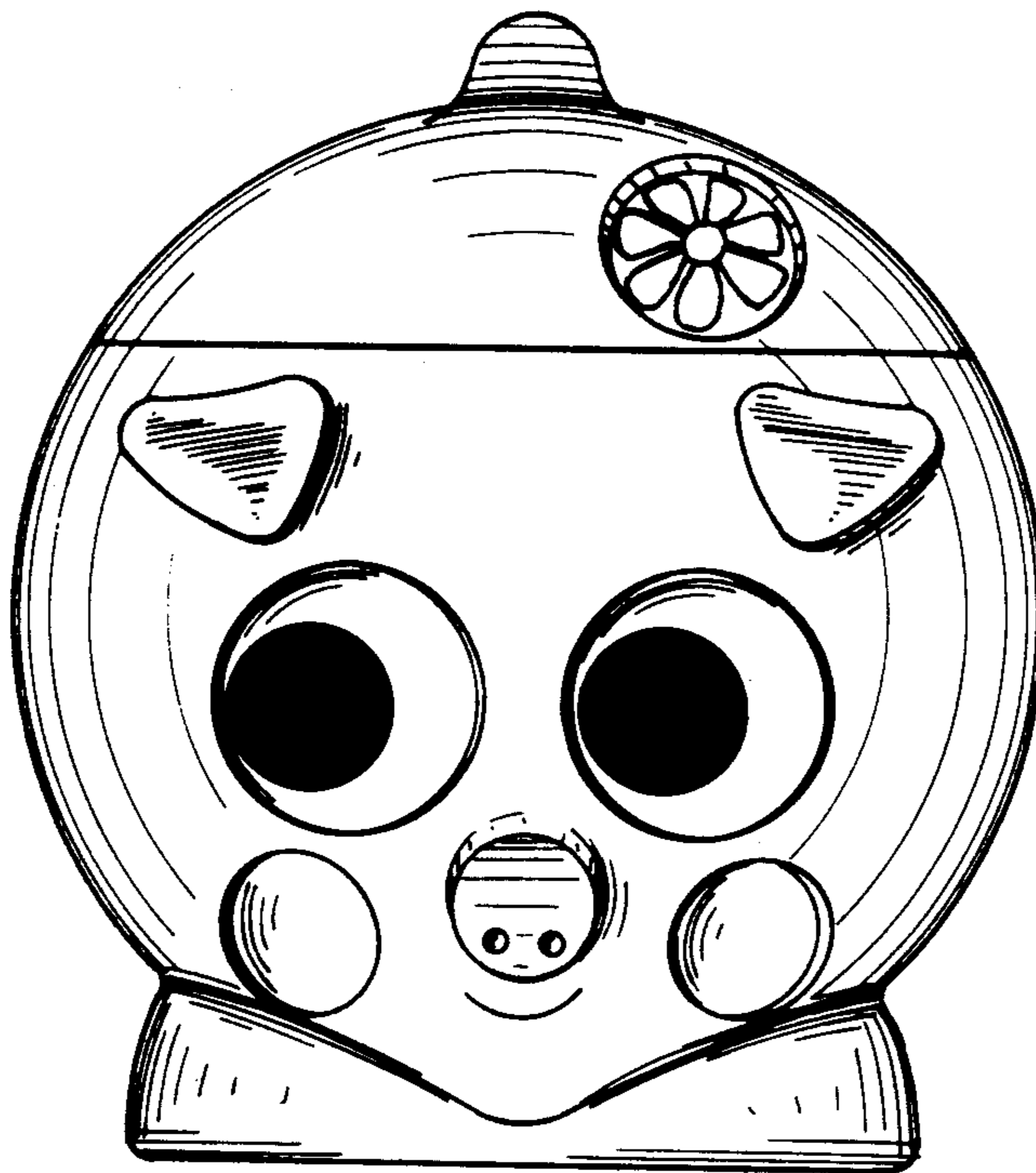

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy chest showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof.



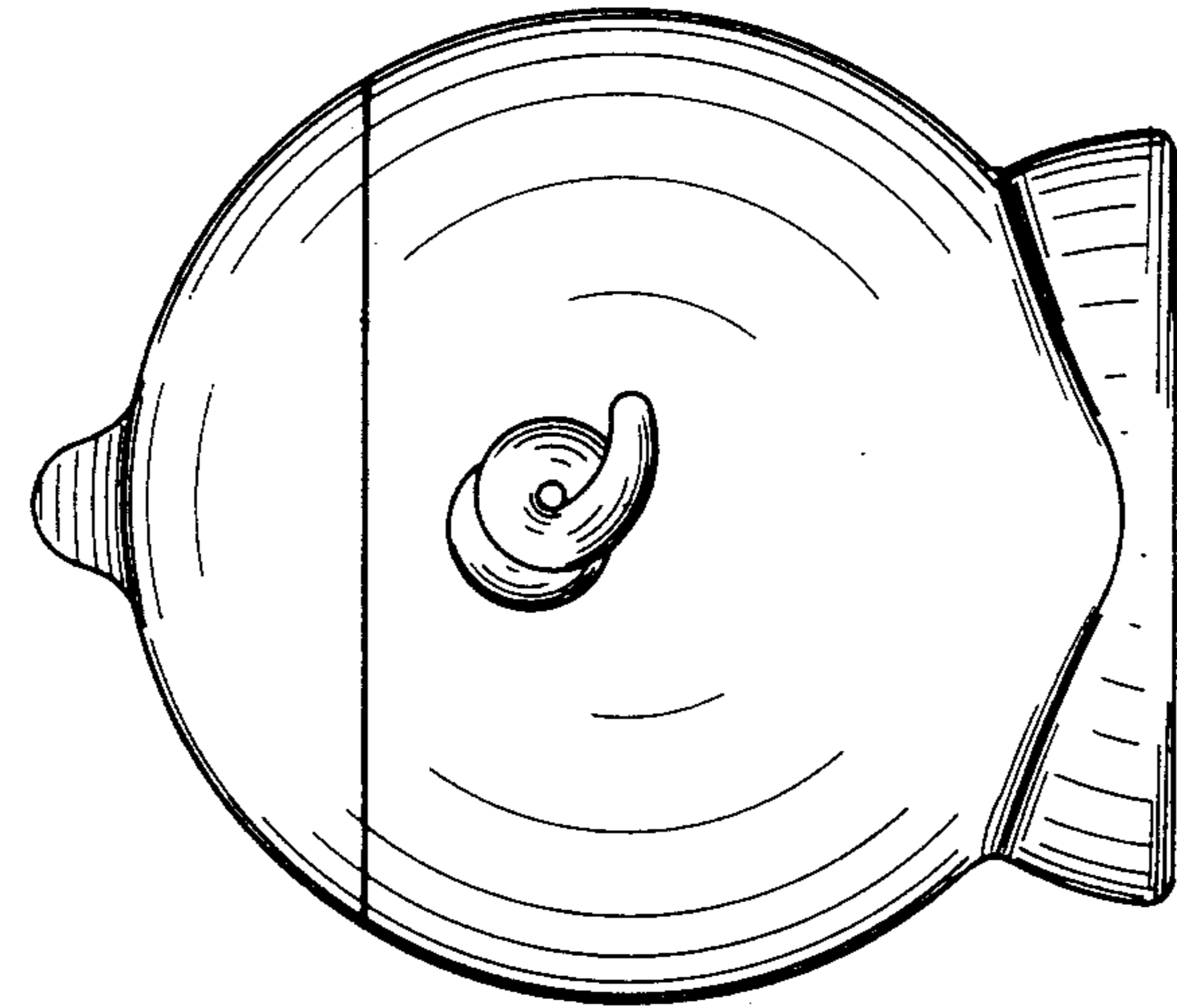

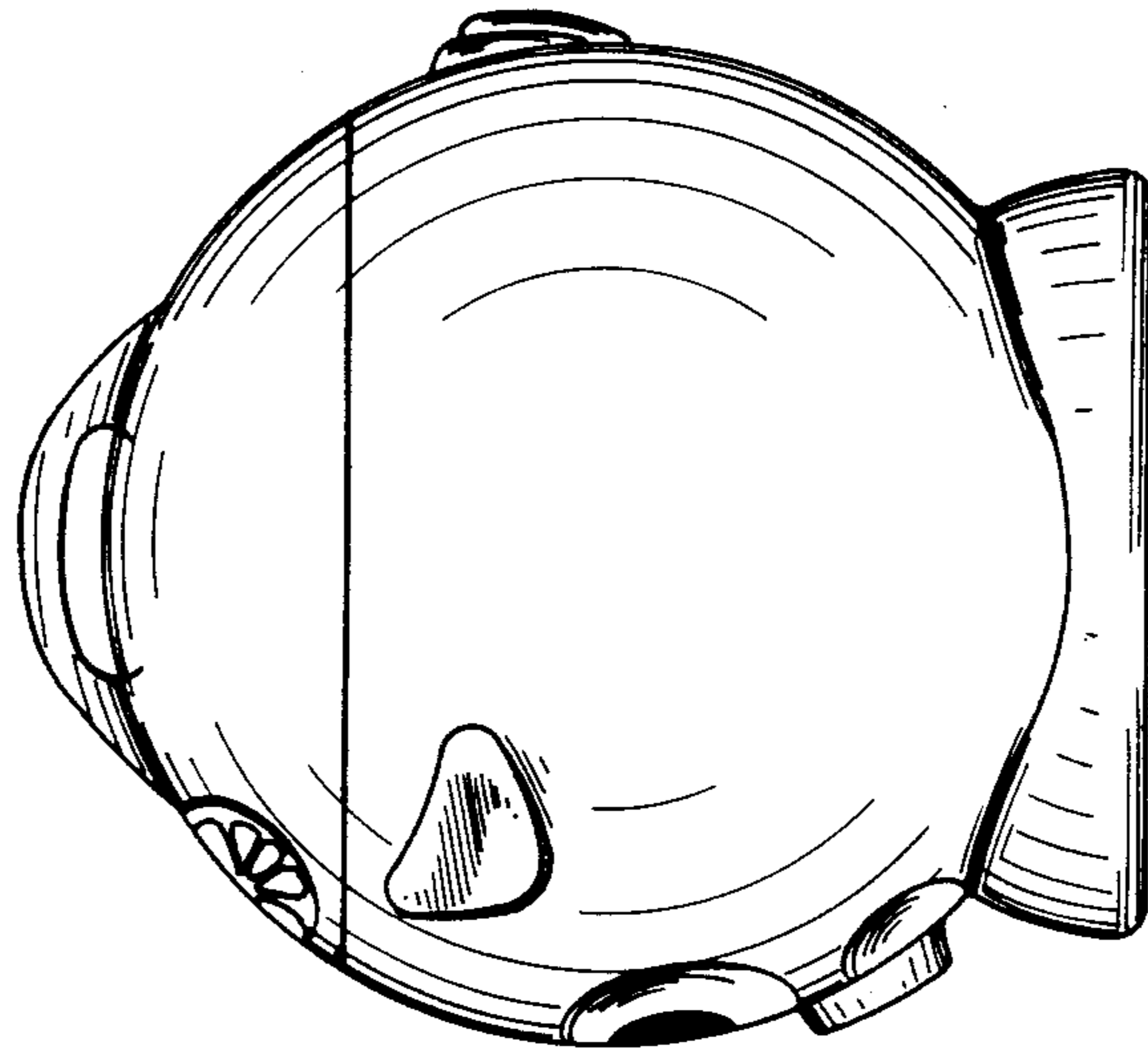

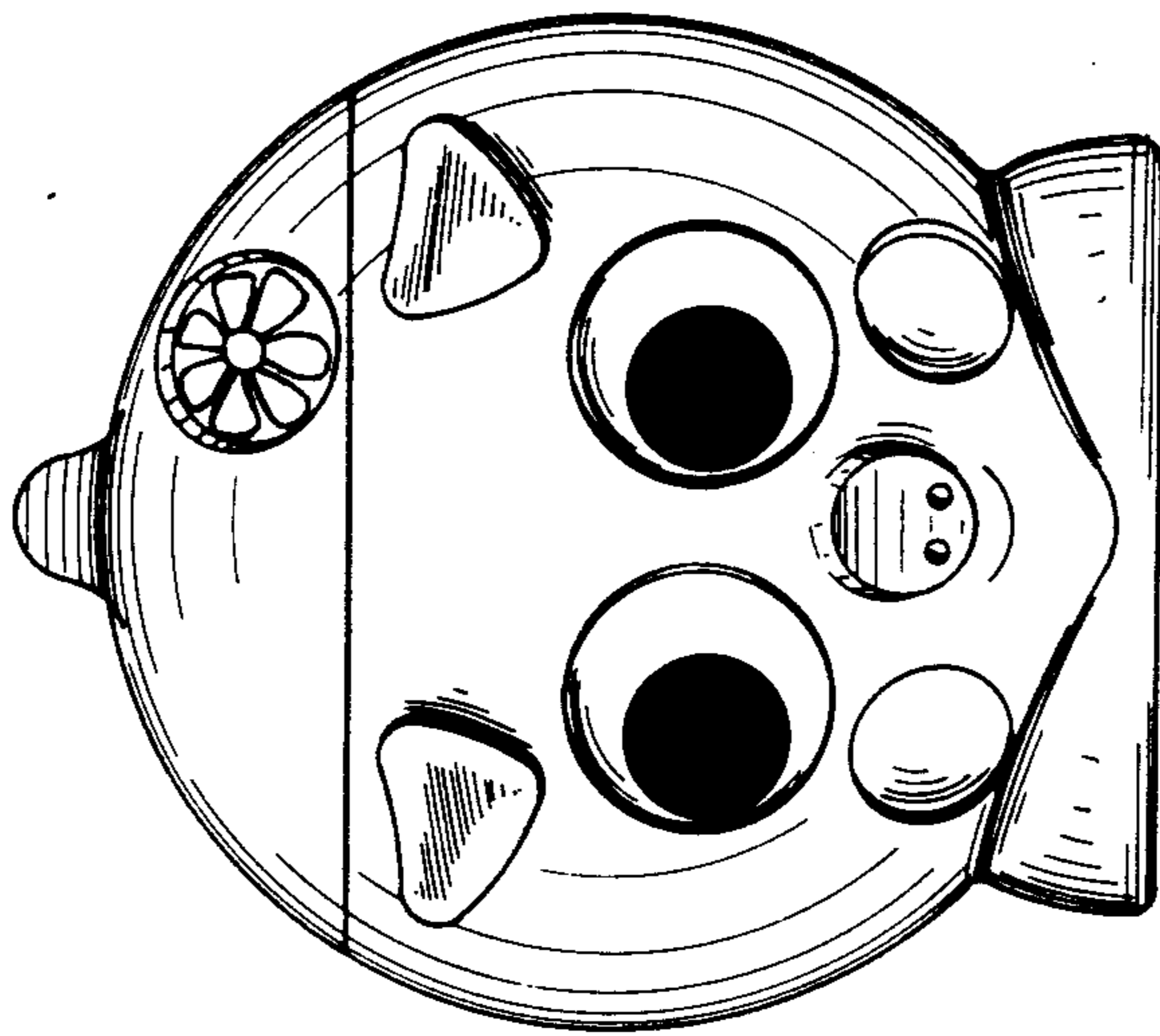
