DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hydrotherapy spa showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof, taken from a different angle;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 3; and
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 5—5.

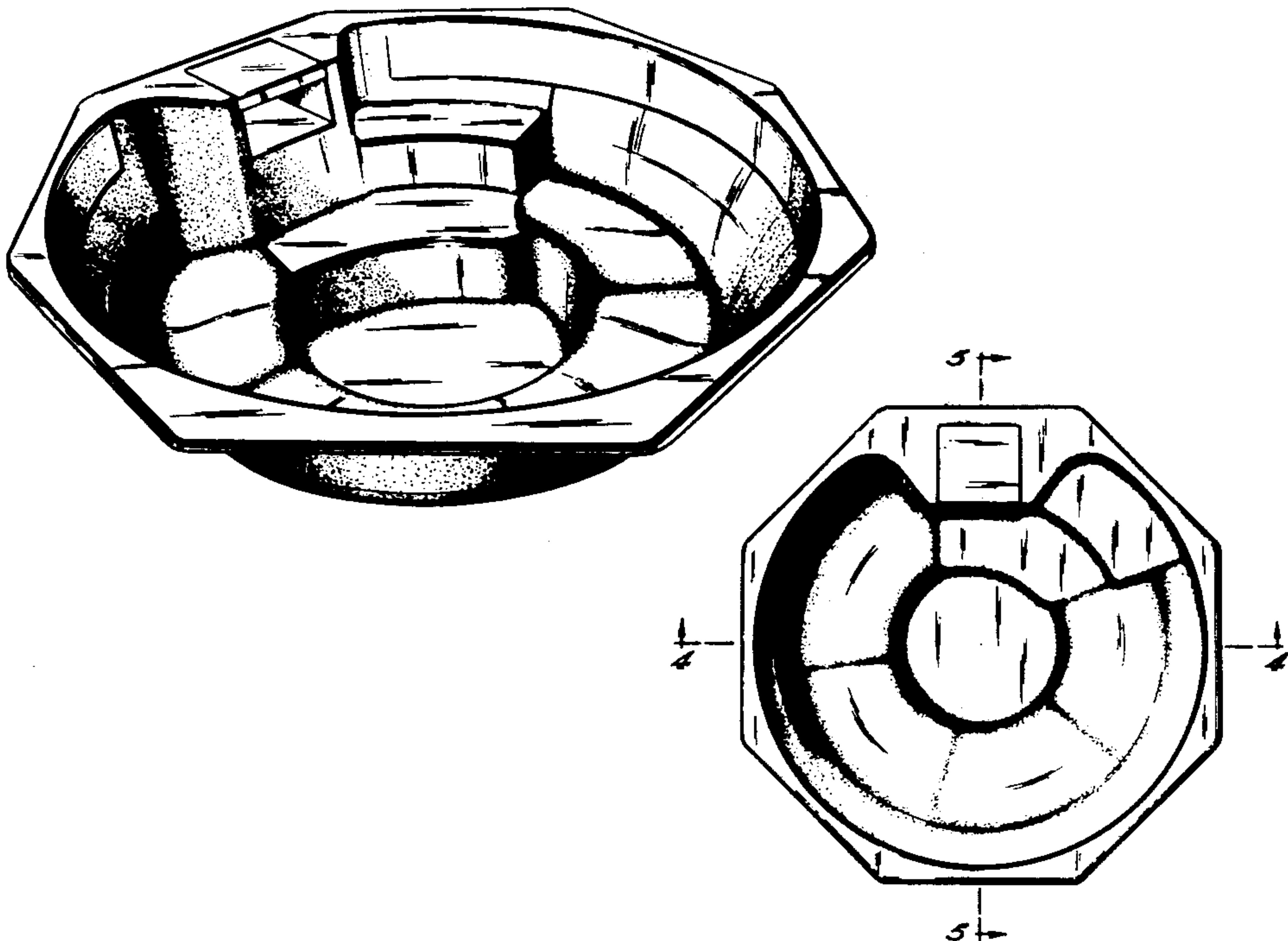

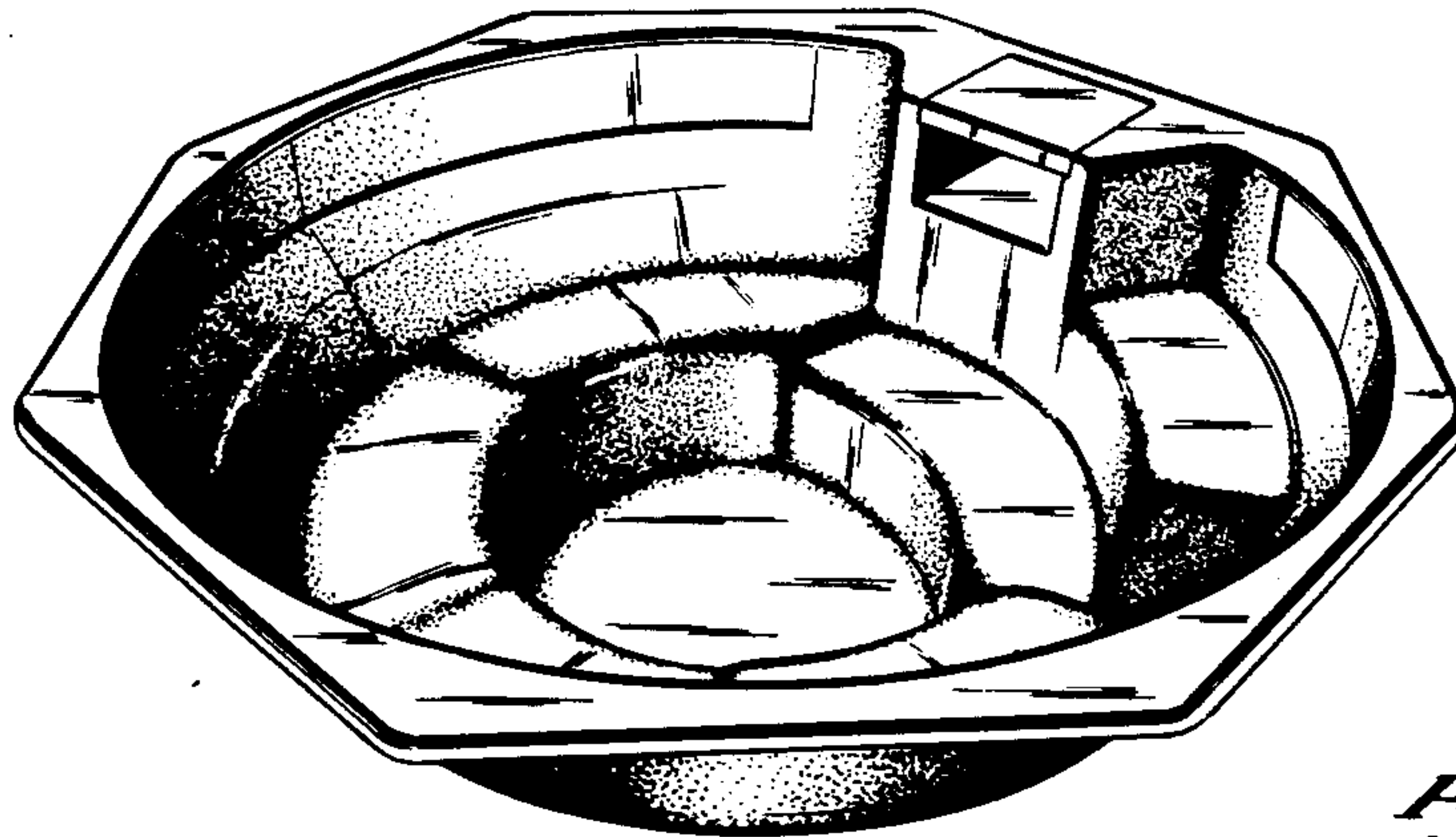
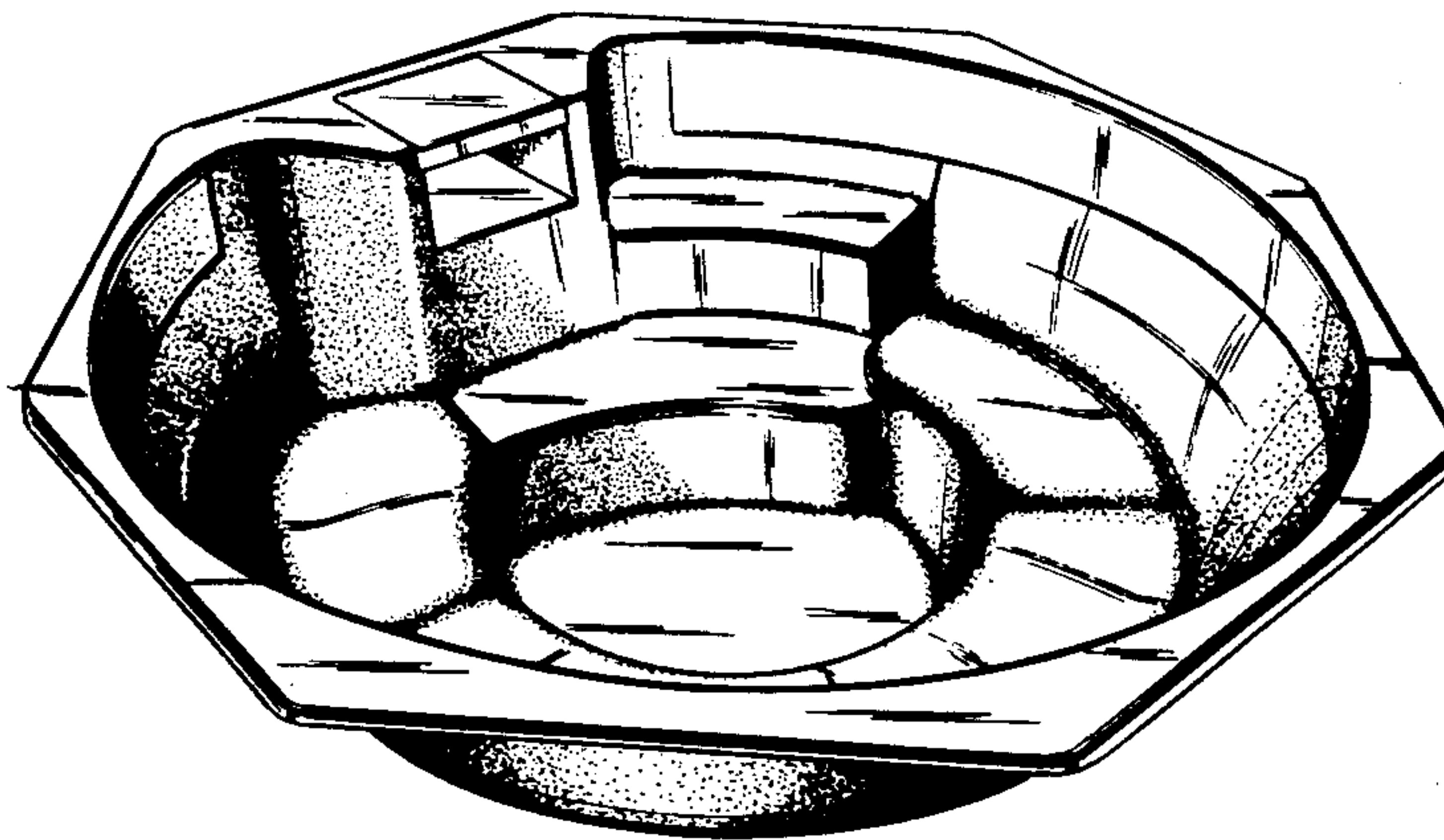

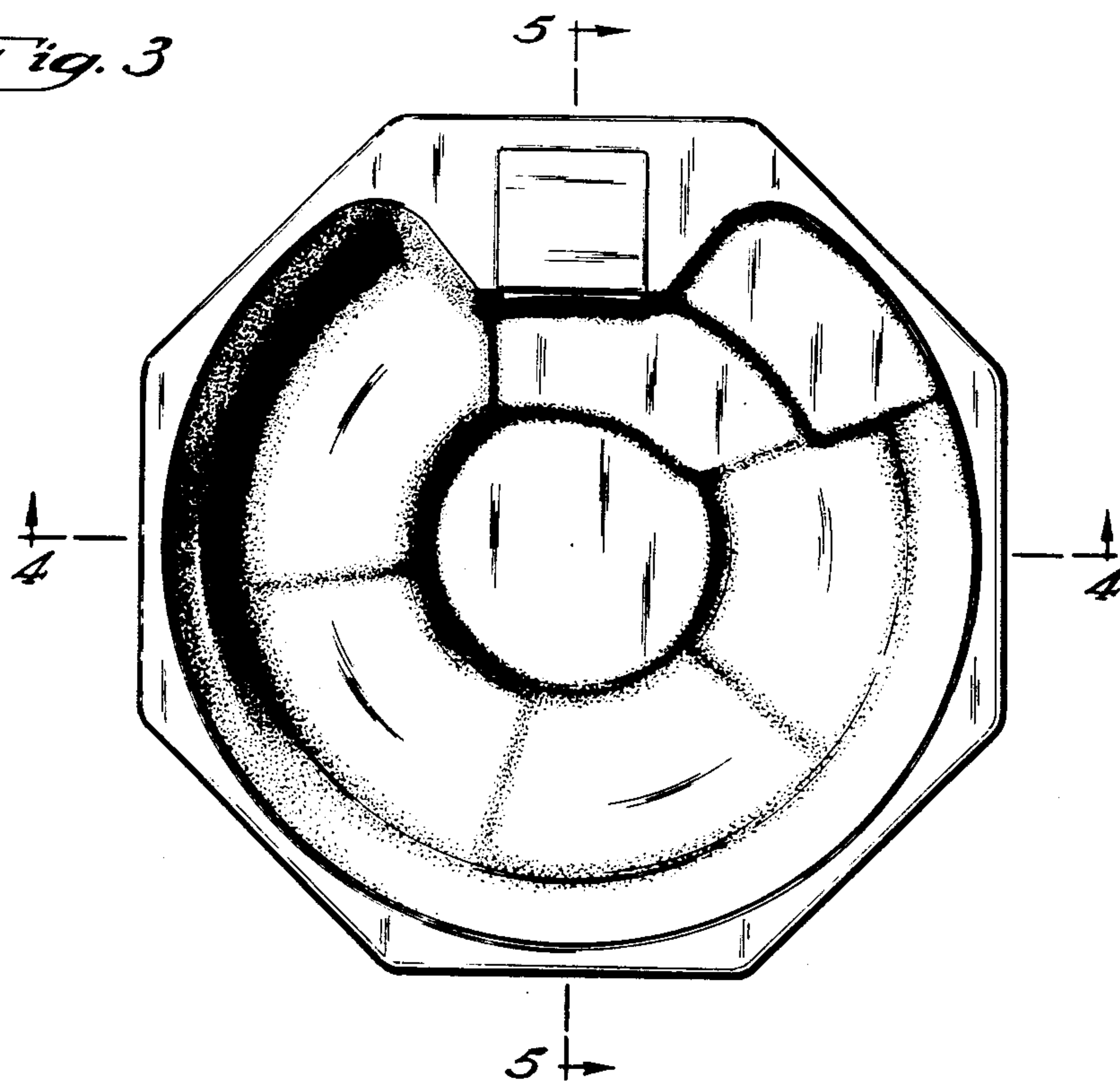

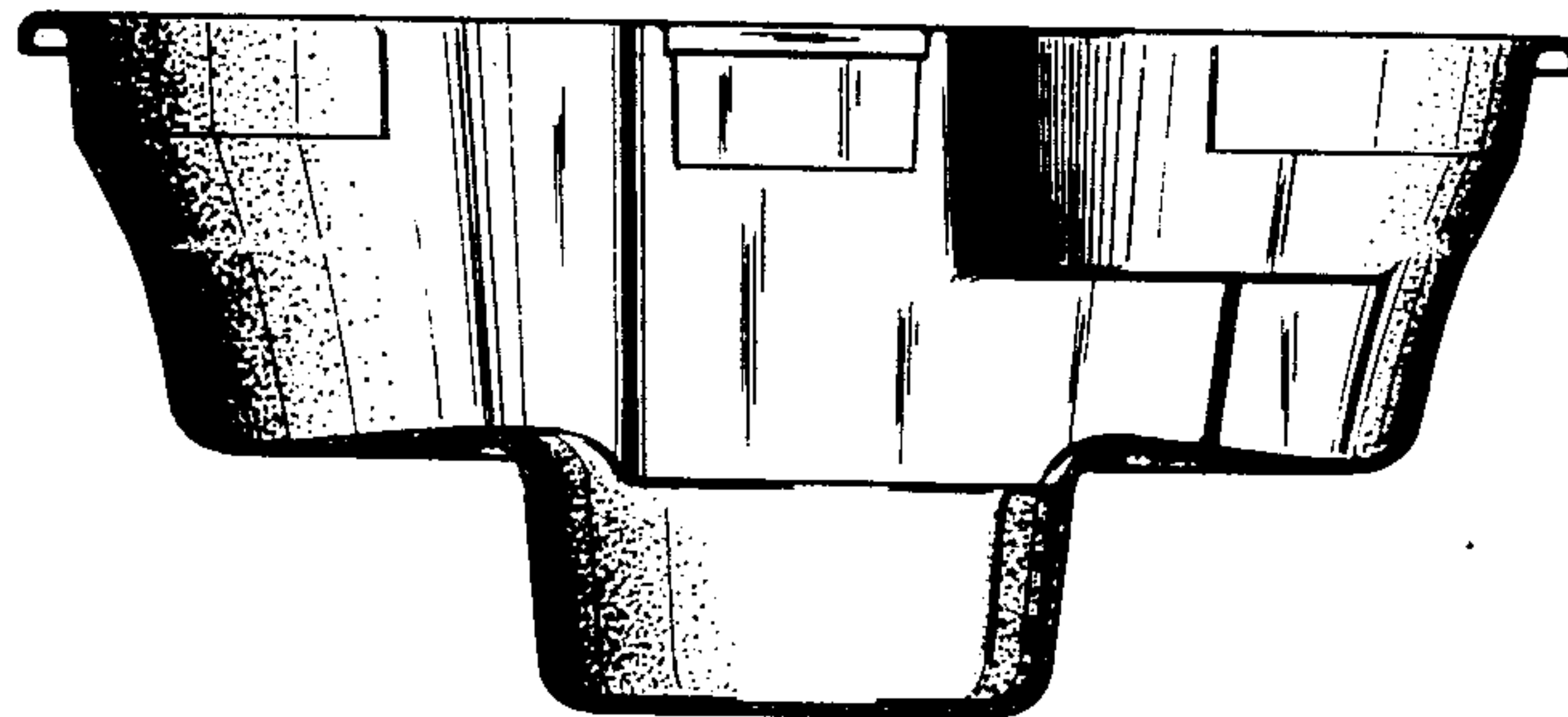
