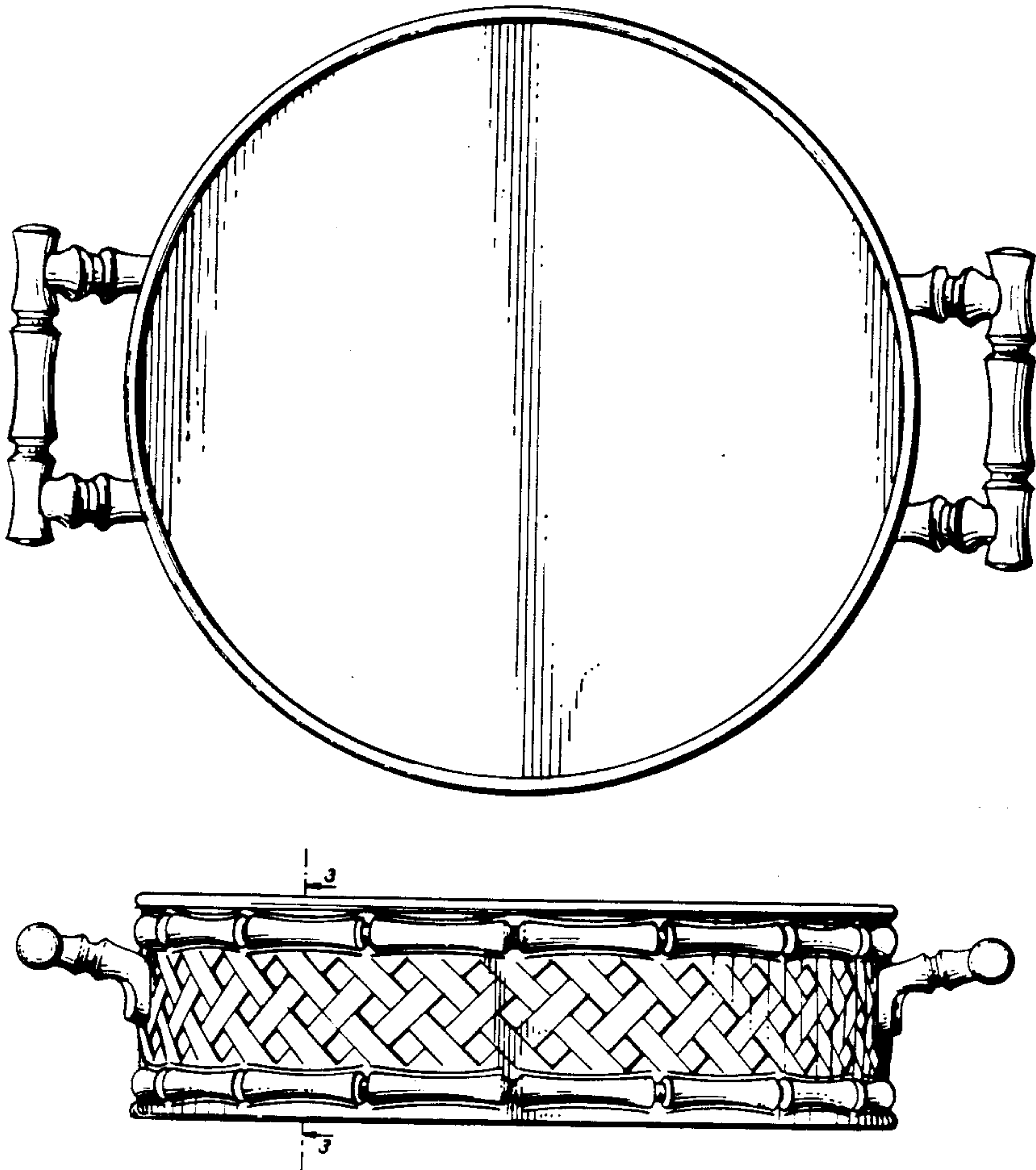

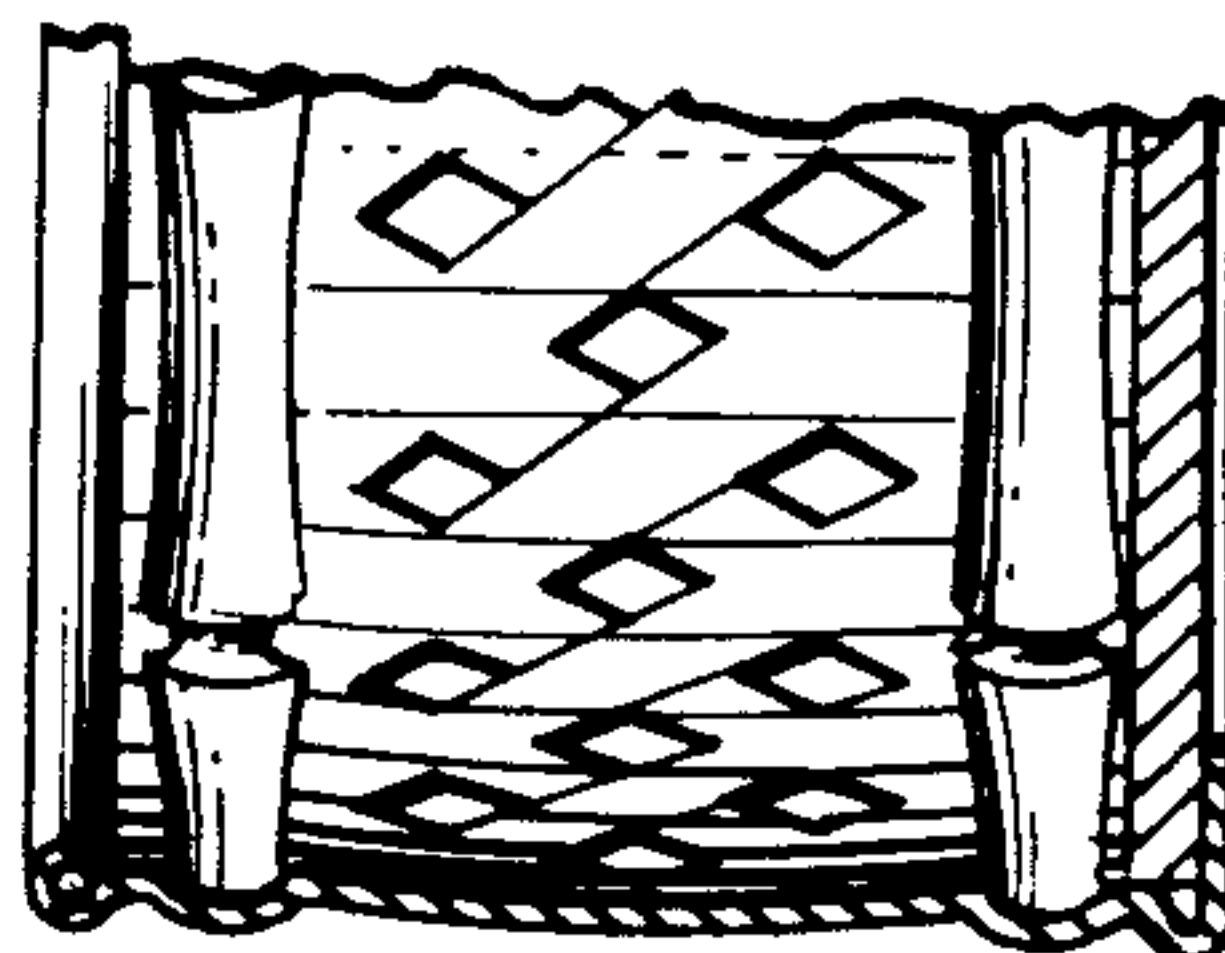
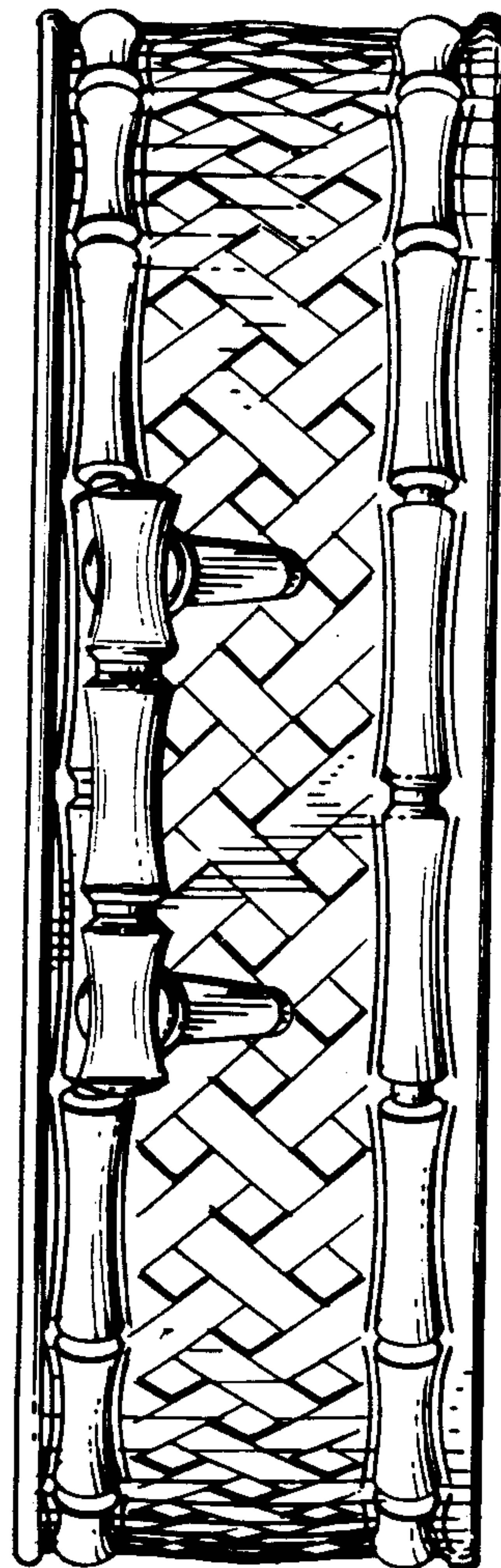
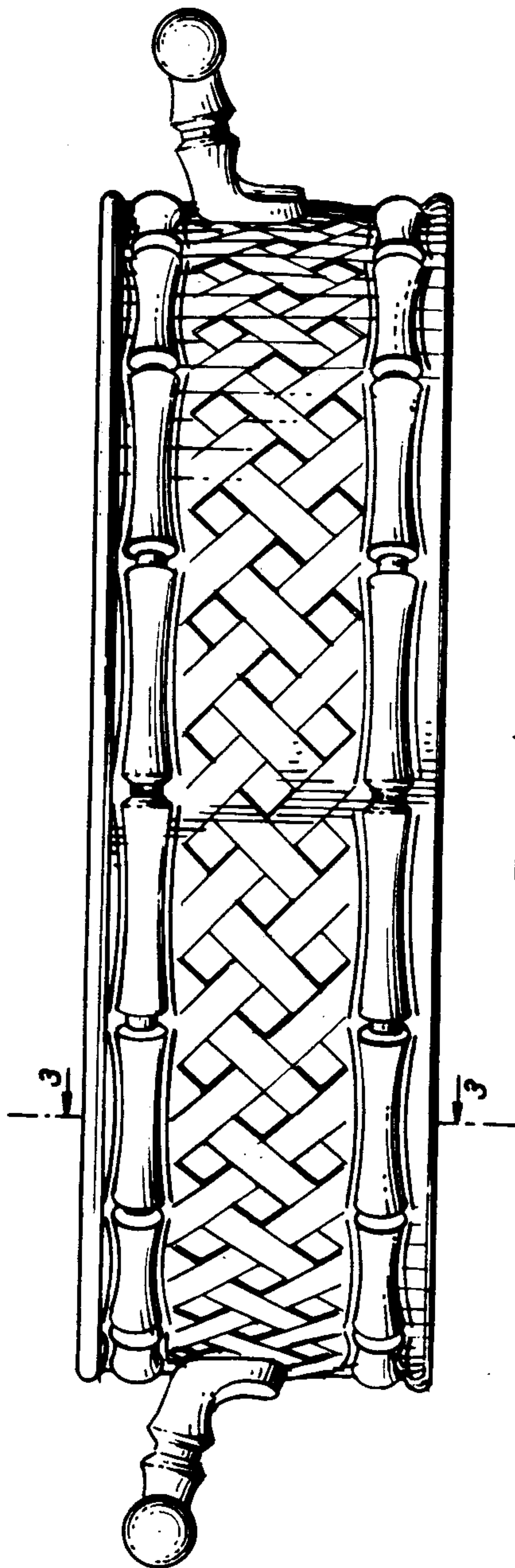
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a gallery tray show-
ing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view from the left or right of
FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 3—3 of
FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale;
and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1 on a reduced
scale.





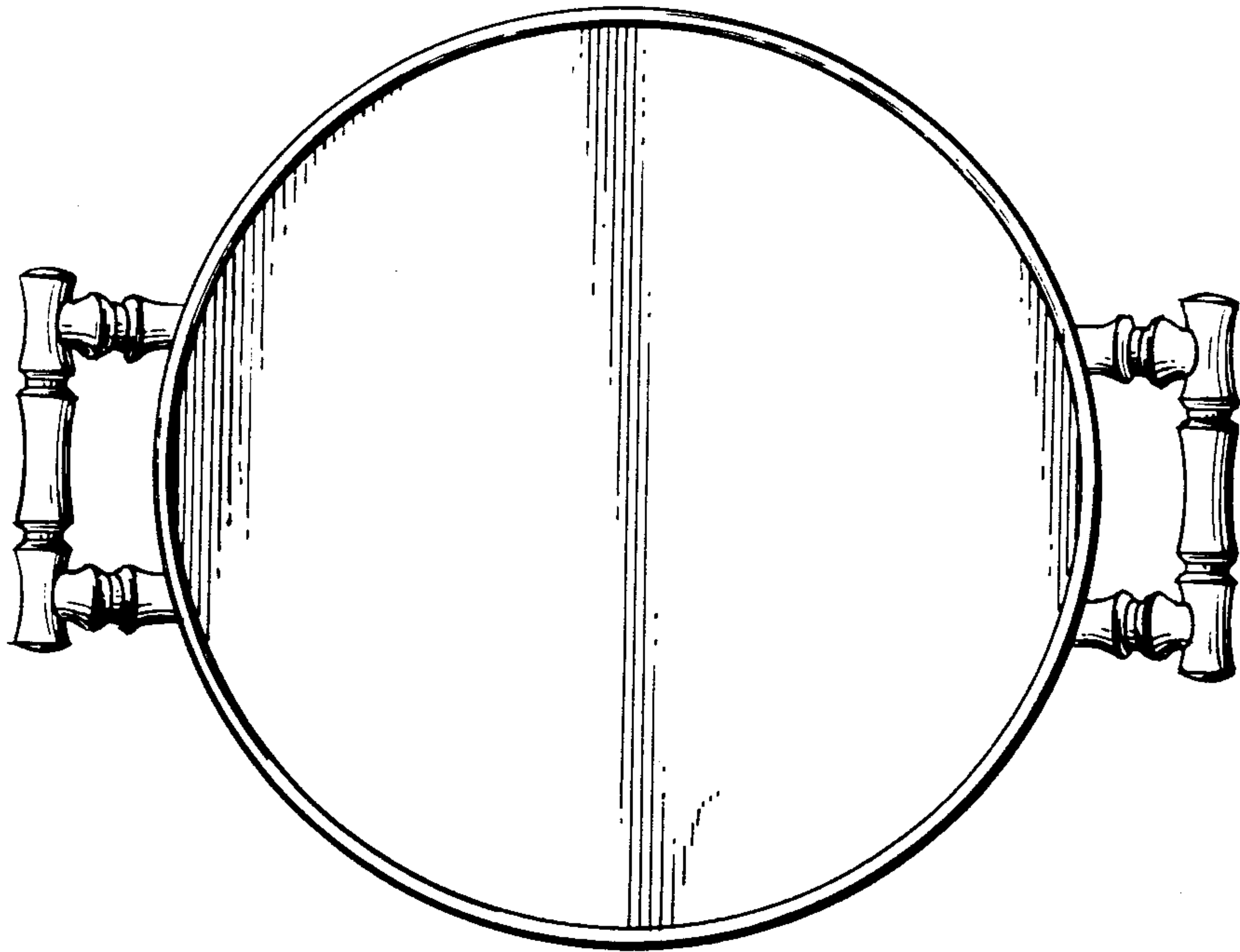

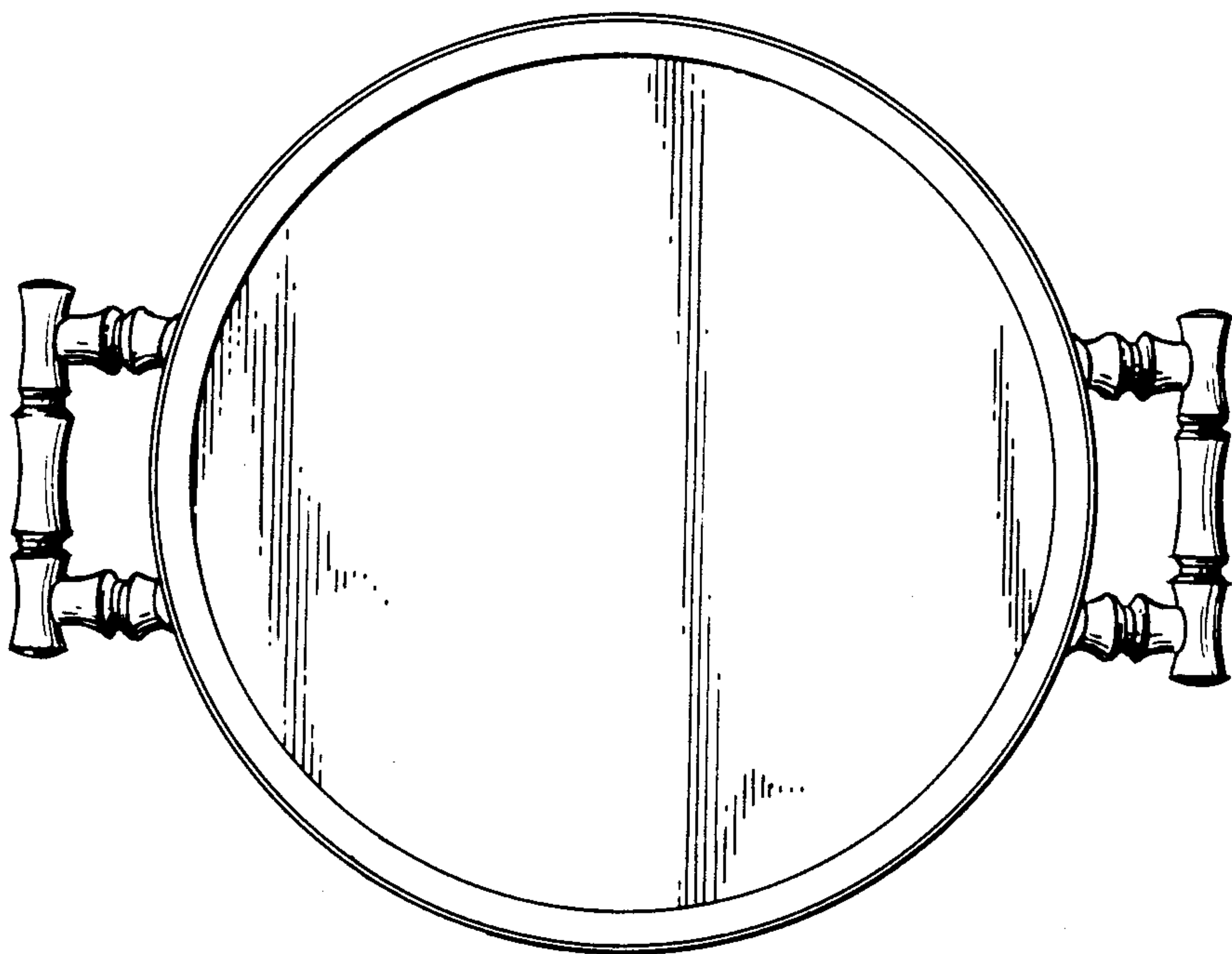
