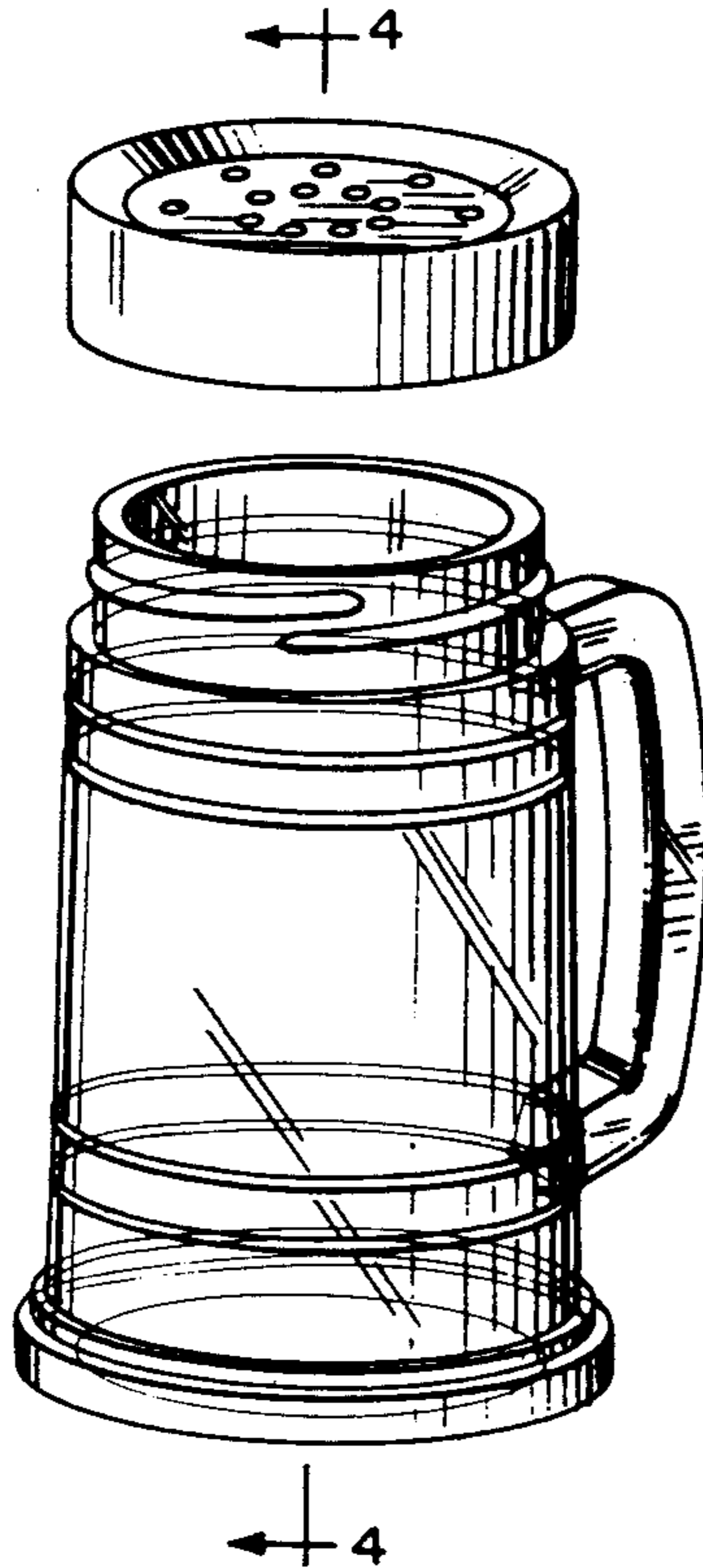

The ornamental design for a condiment shaker or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

 FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along lines 4-4 of FIG. 3.



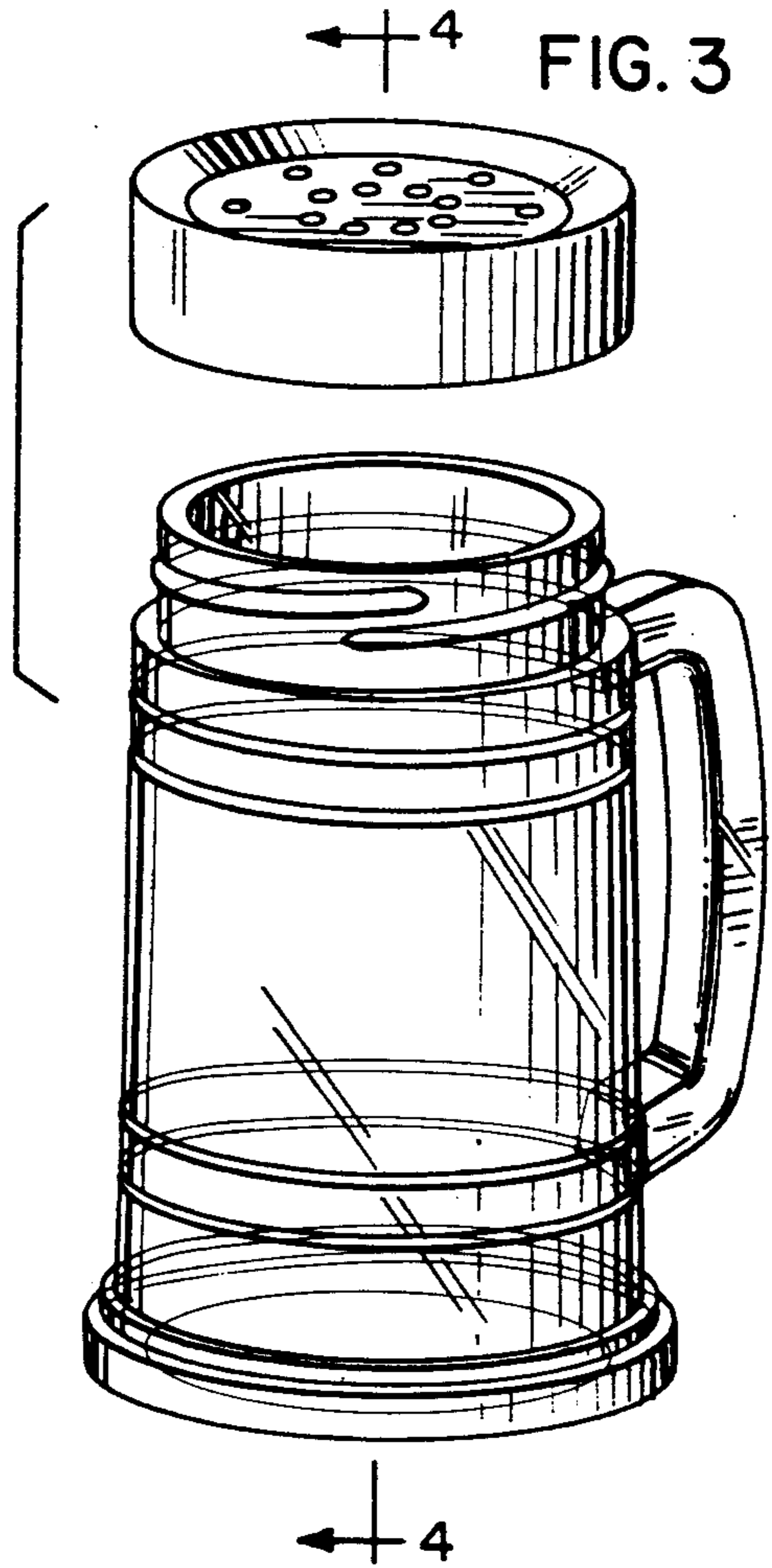
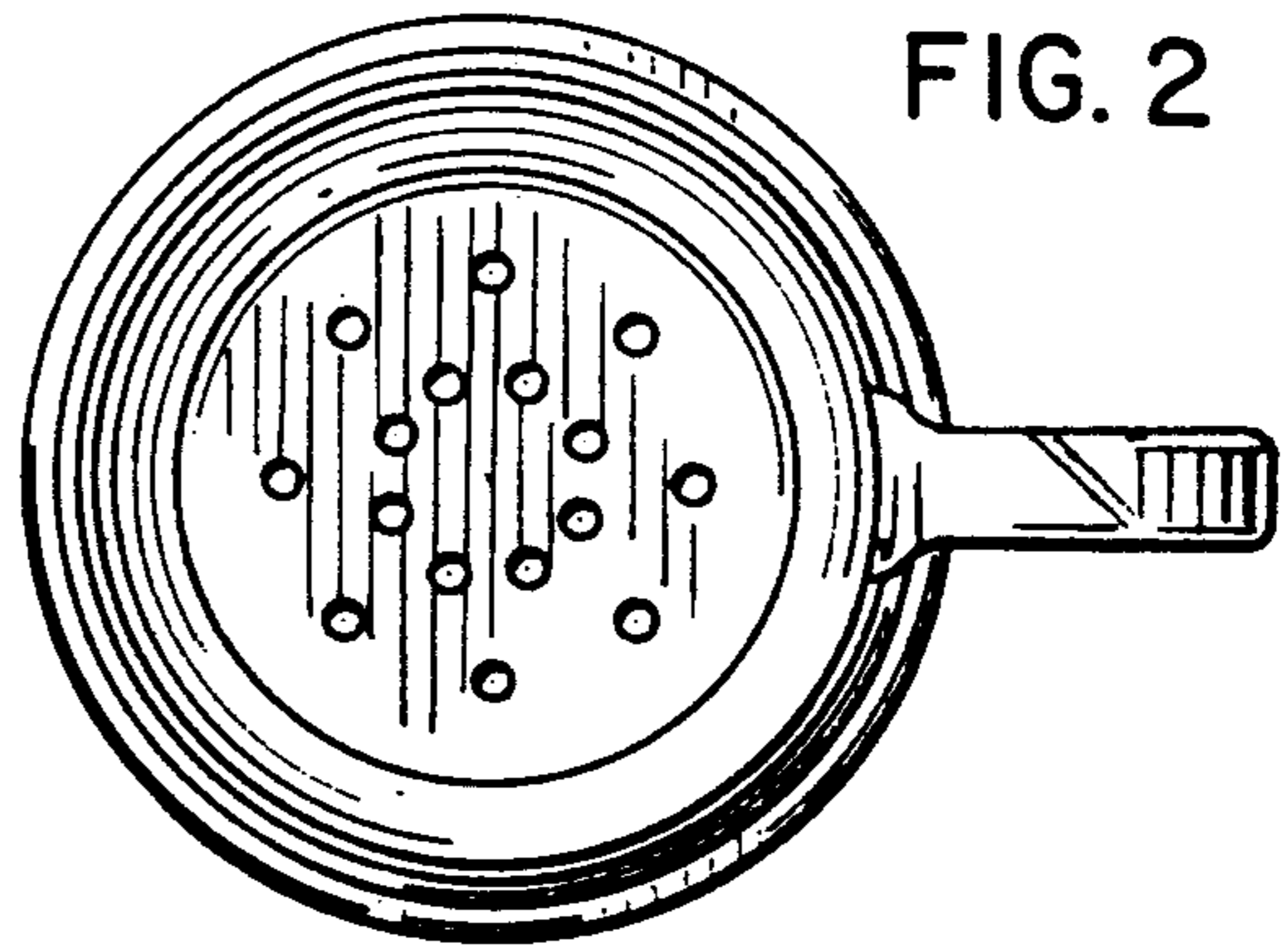
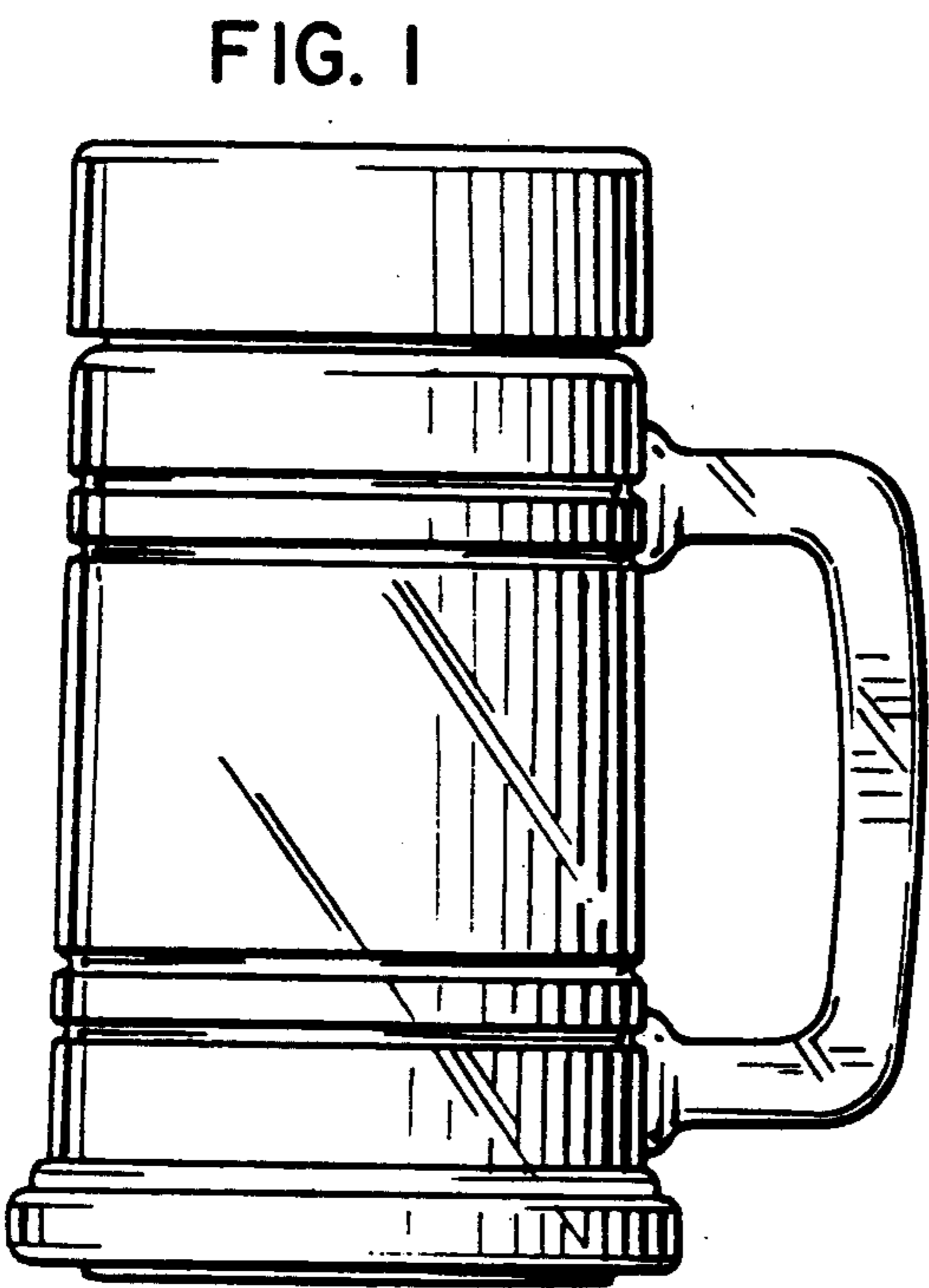
