[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left-side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a vertical sectional view taken generally on the line 5—5 of FIG. 1.
