DESCRIPTION

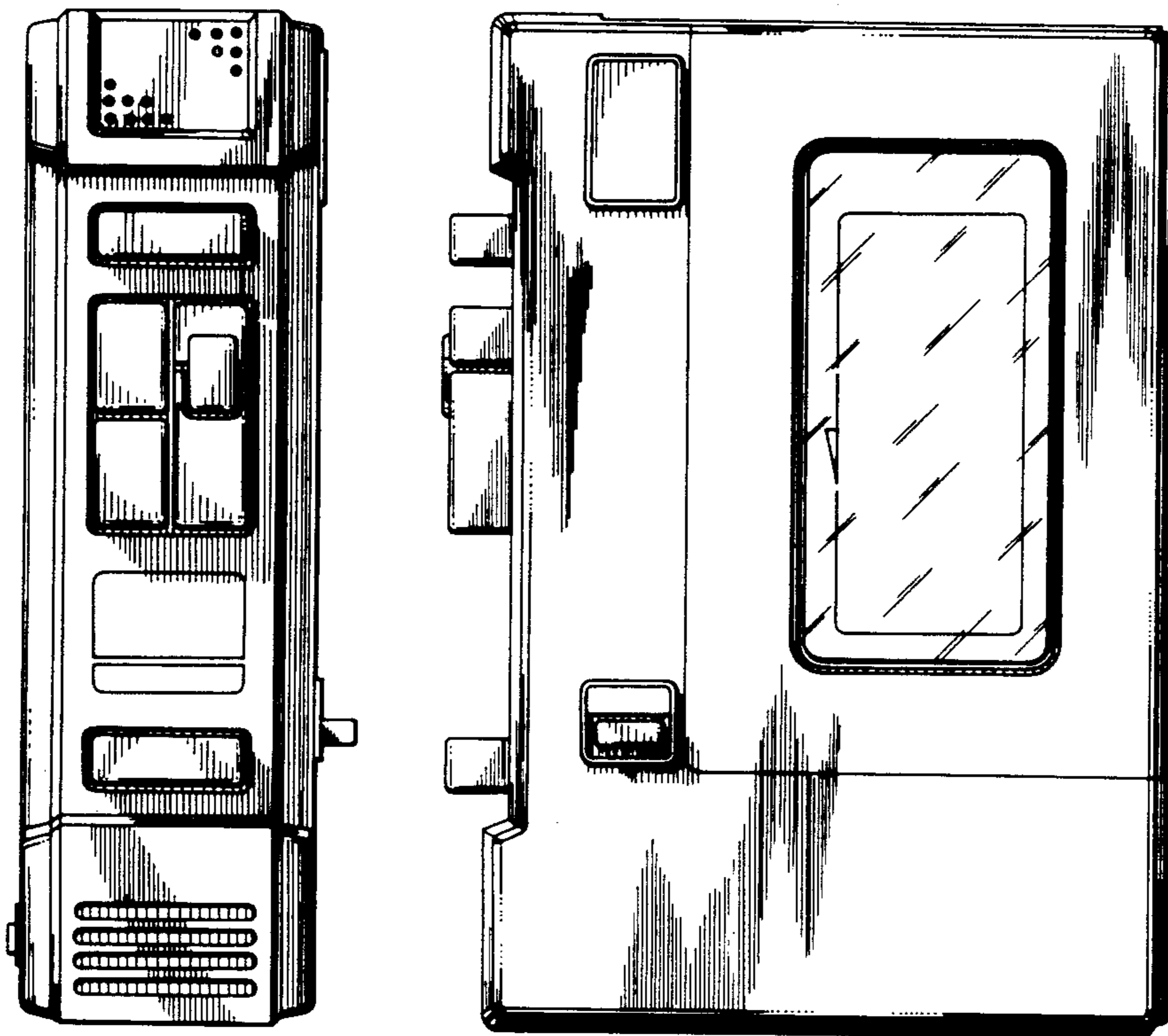

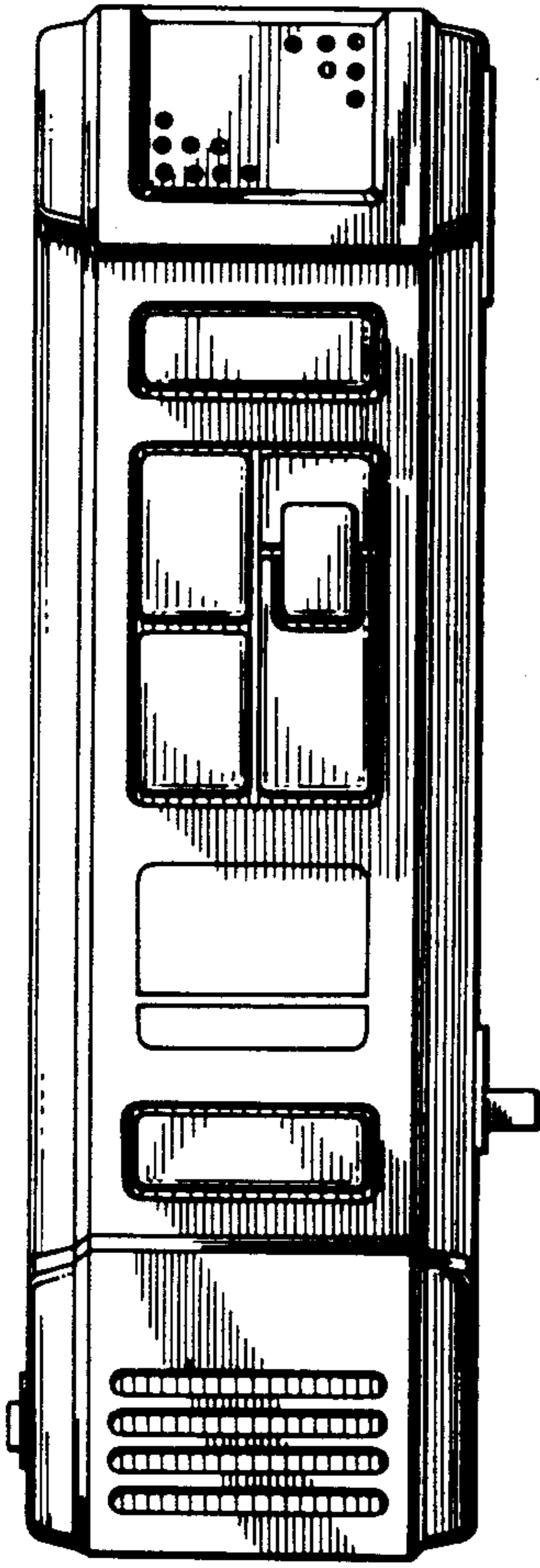

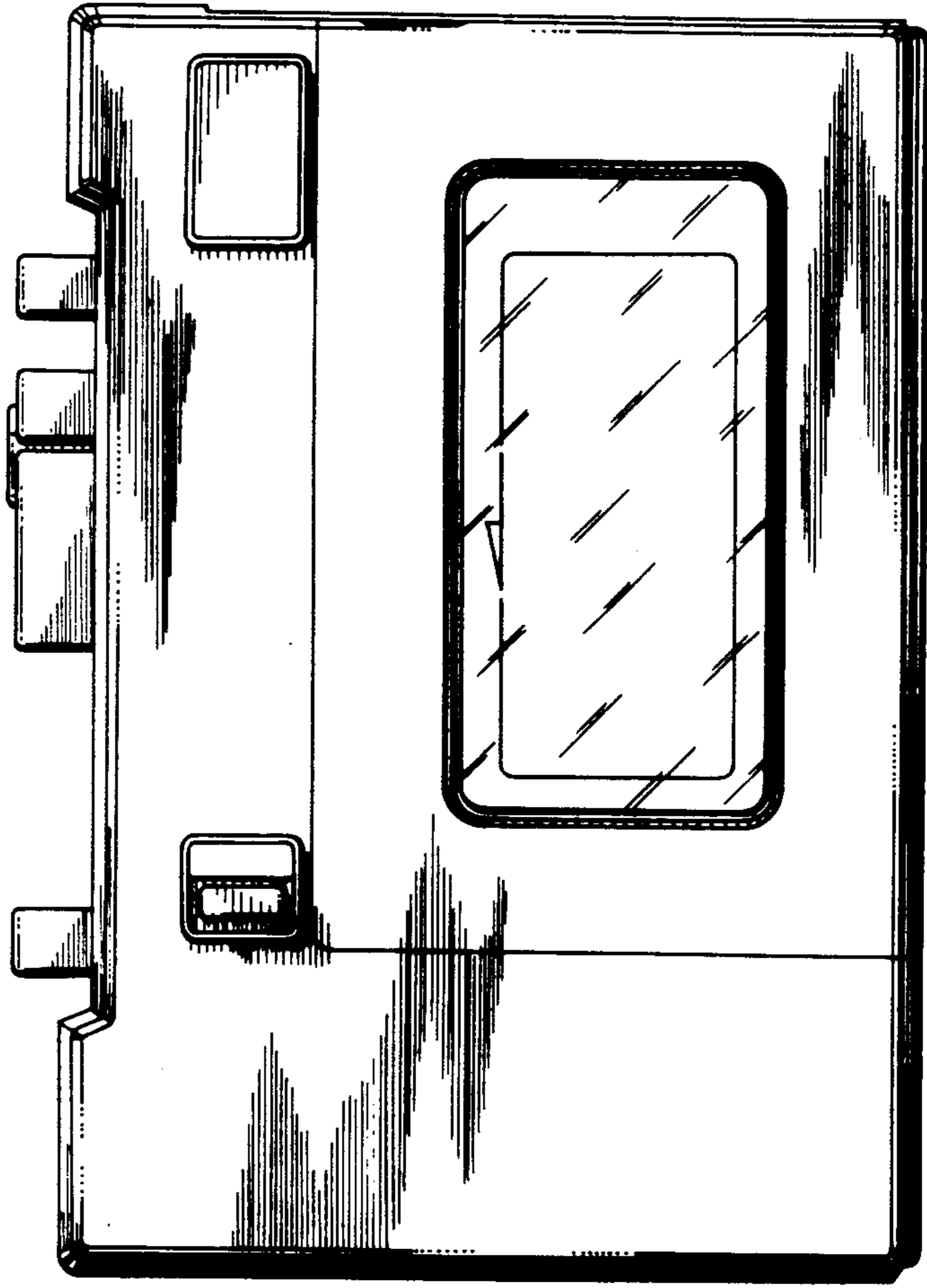

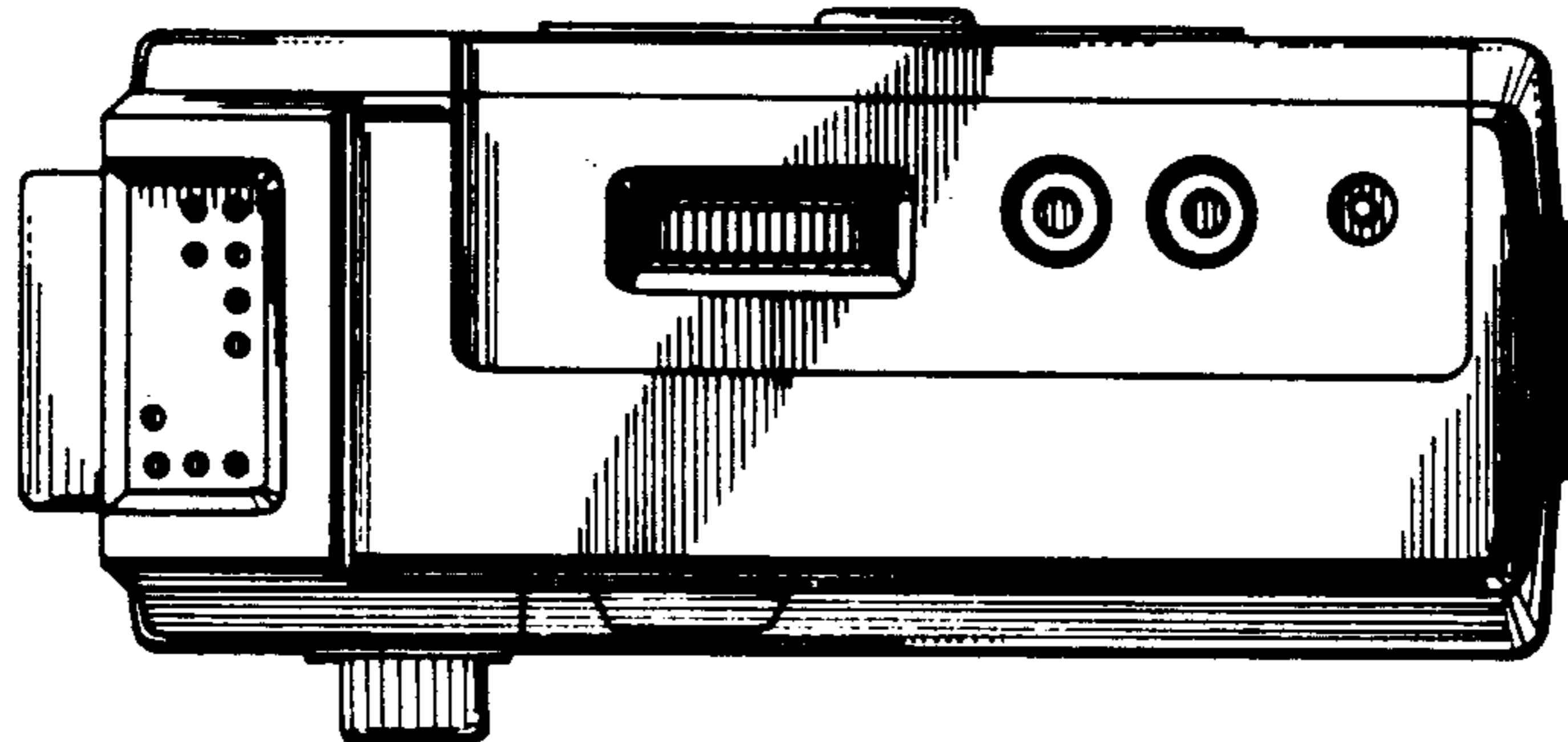

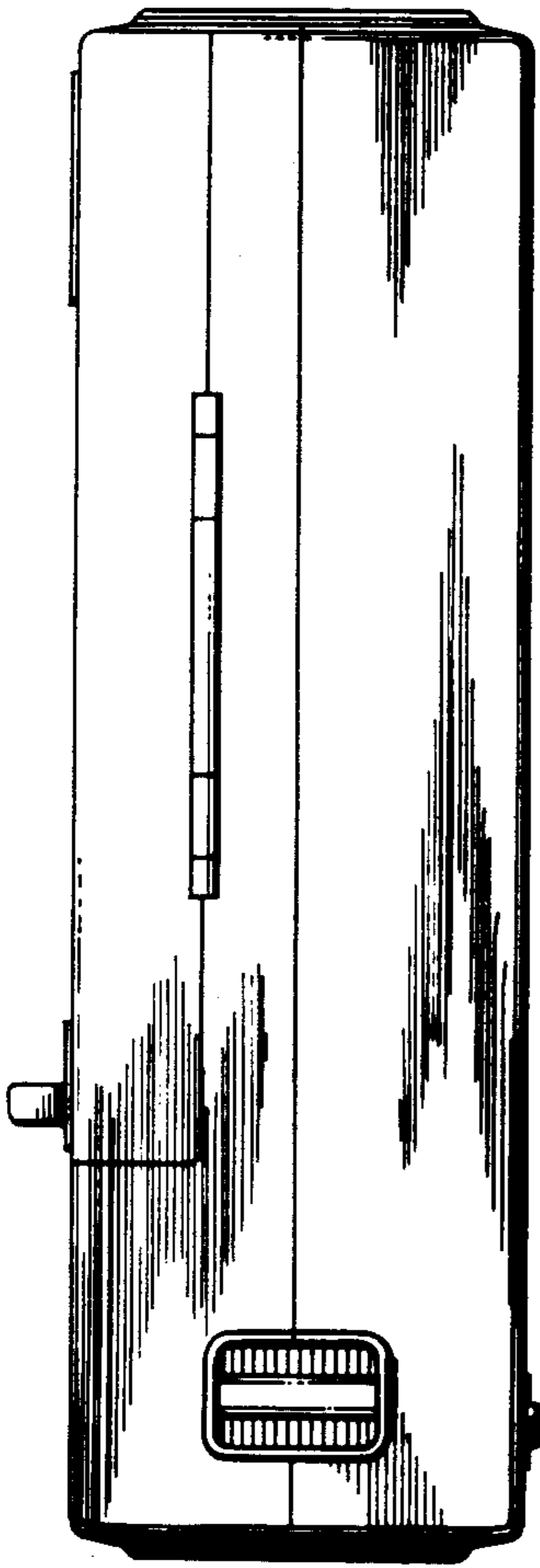

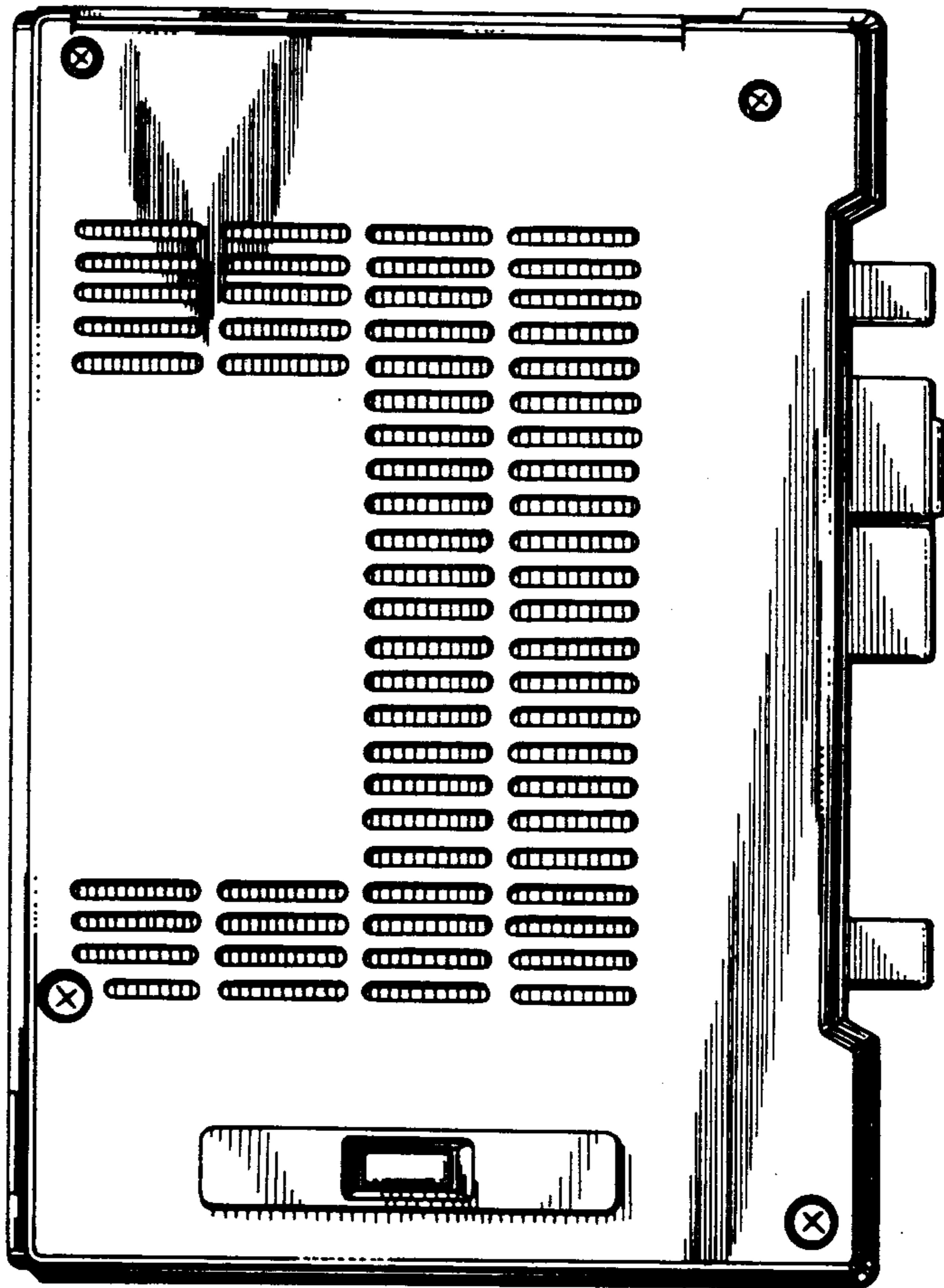
