DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a belt buckle showing my
new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the left of

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5-5 of FIG.
1; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

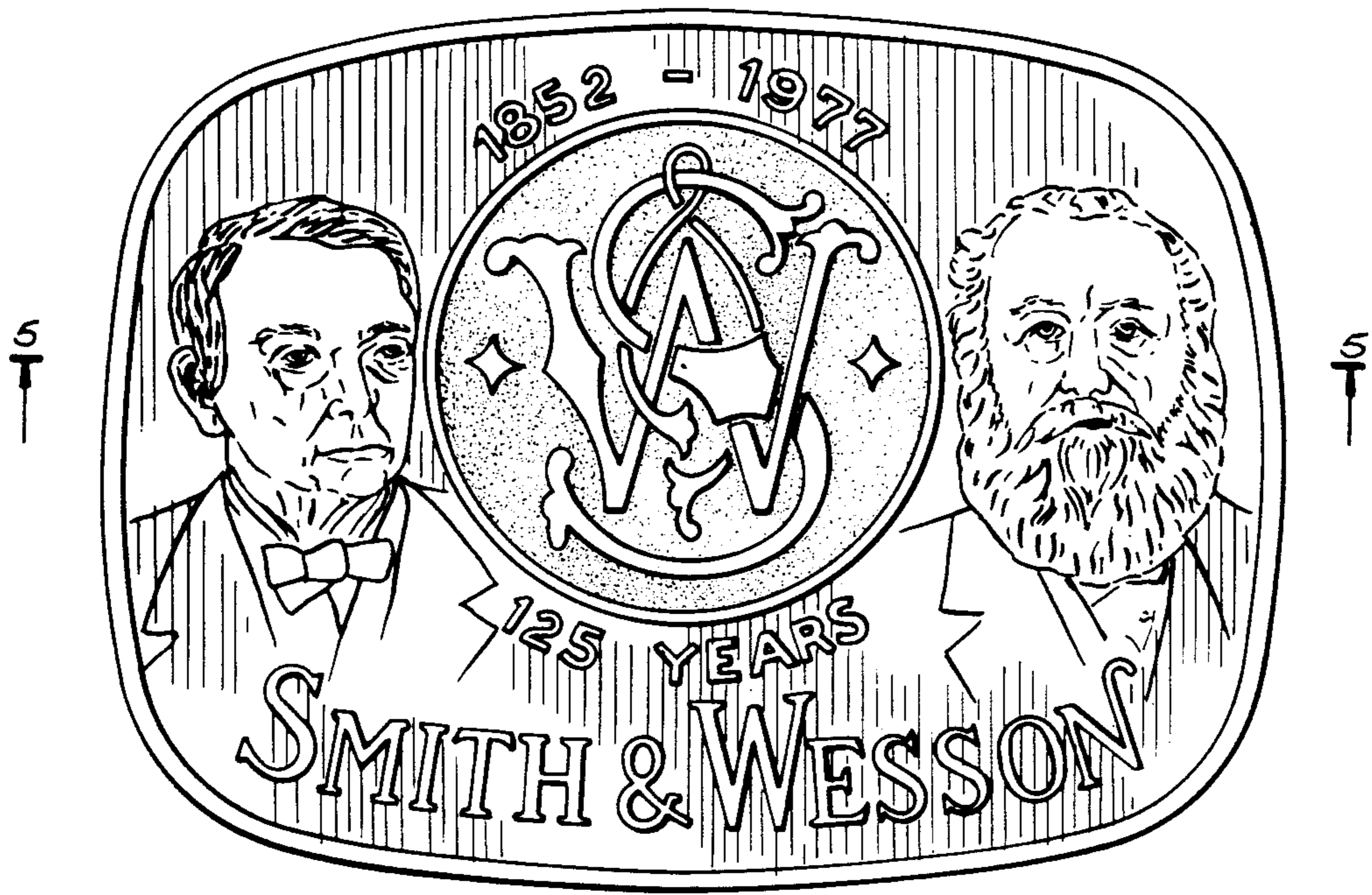

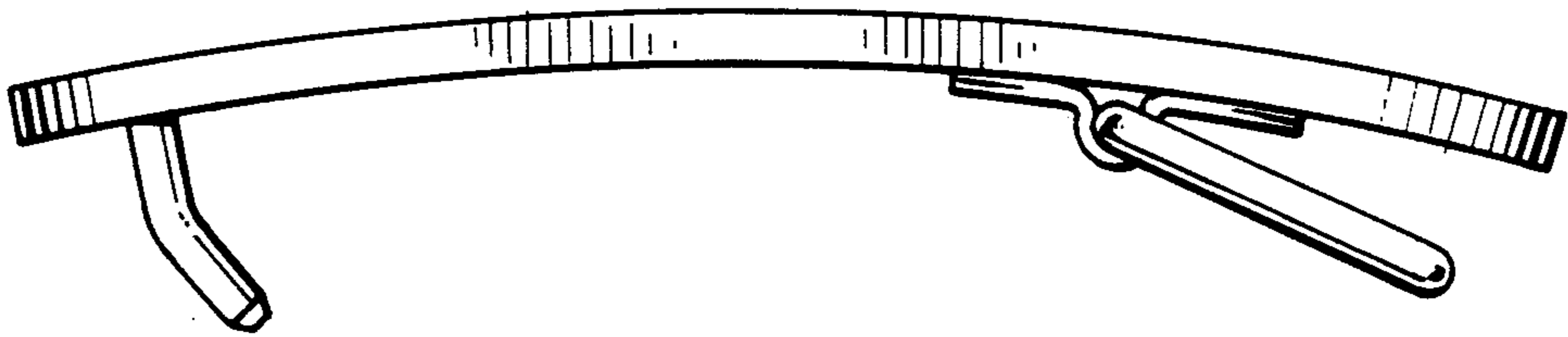

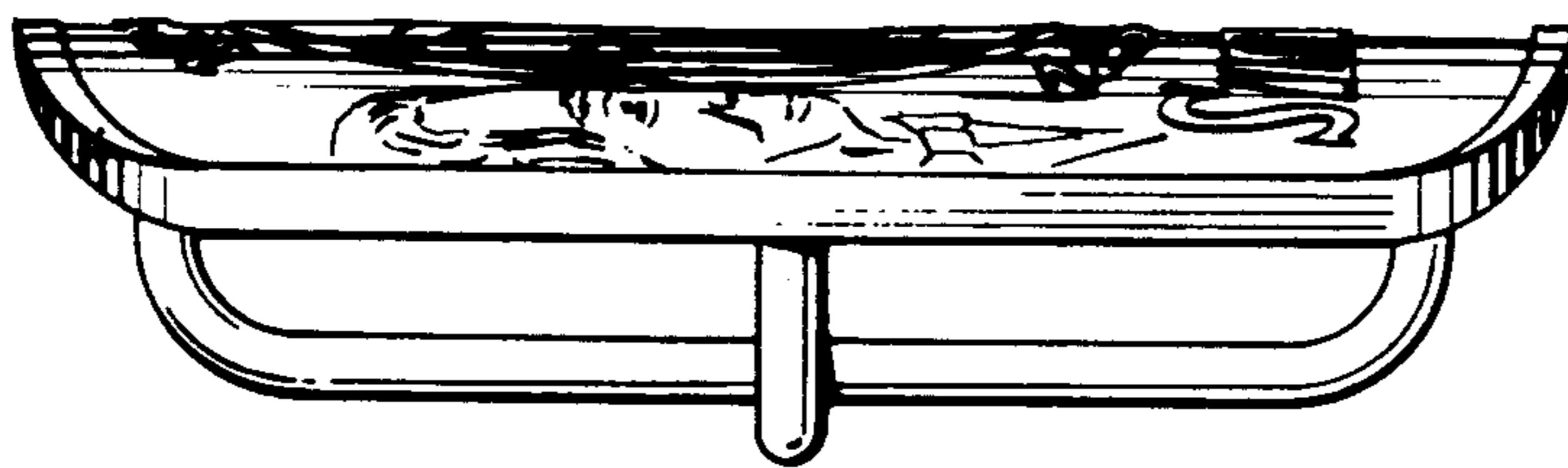

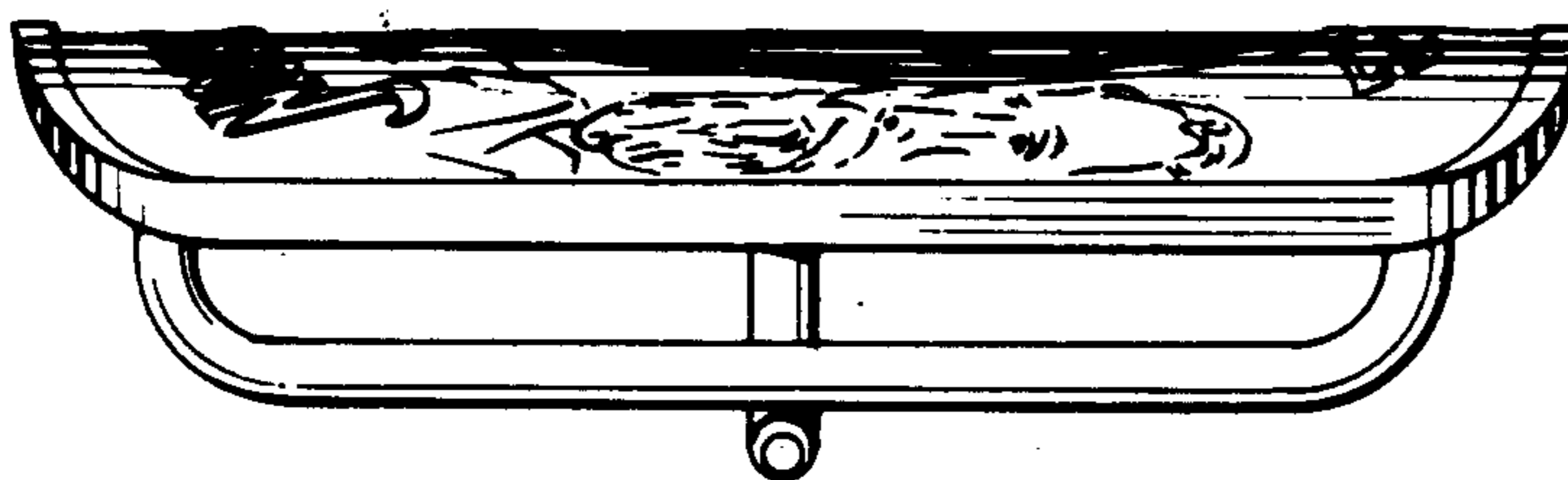
