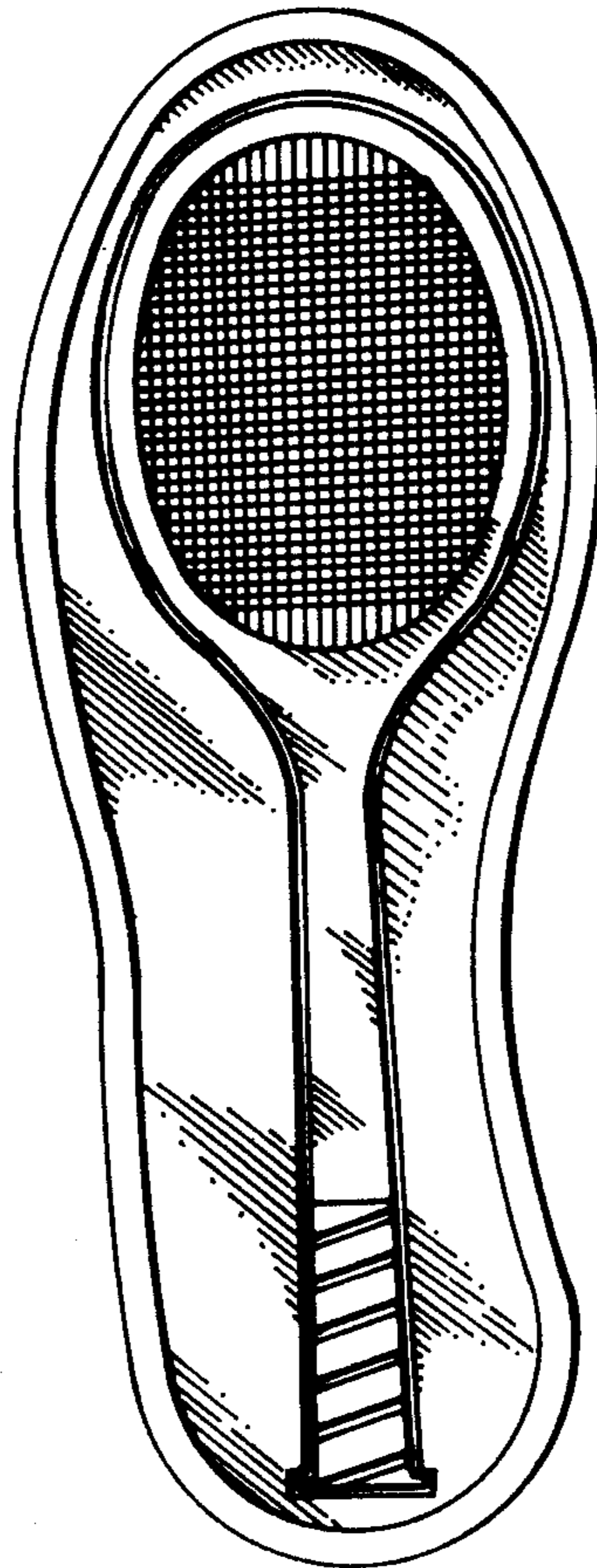
The ornamental design for a tennis shoe sole, as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.



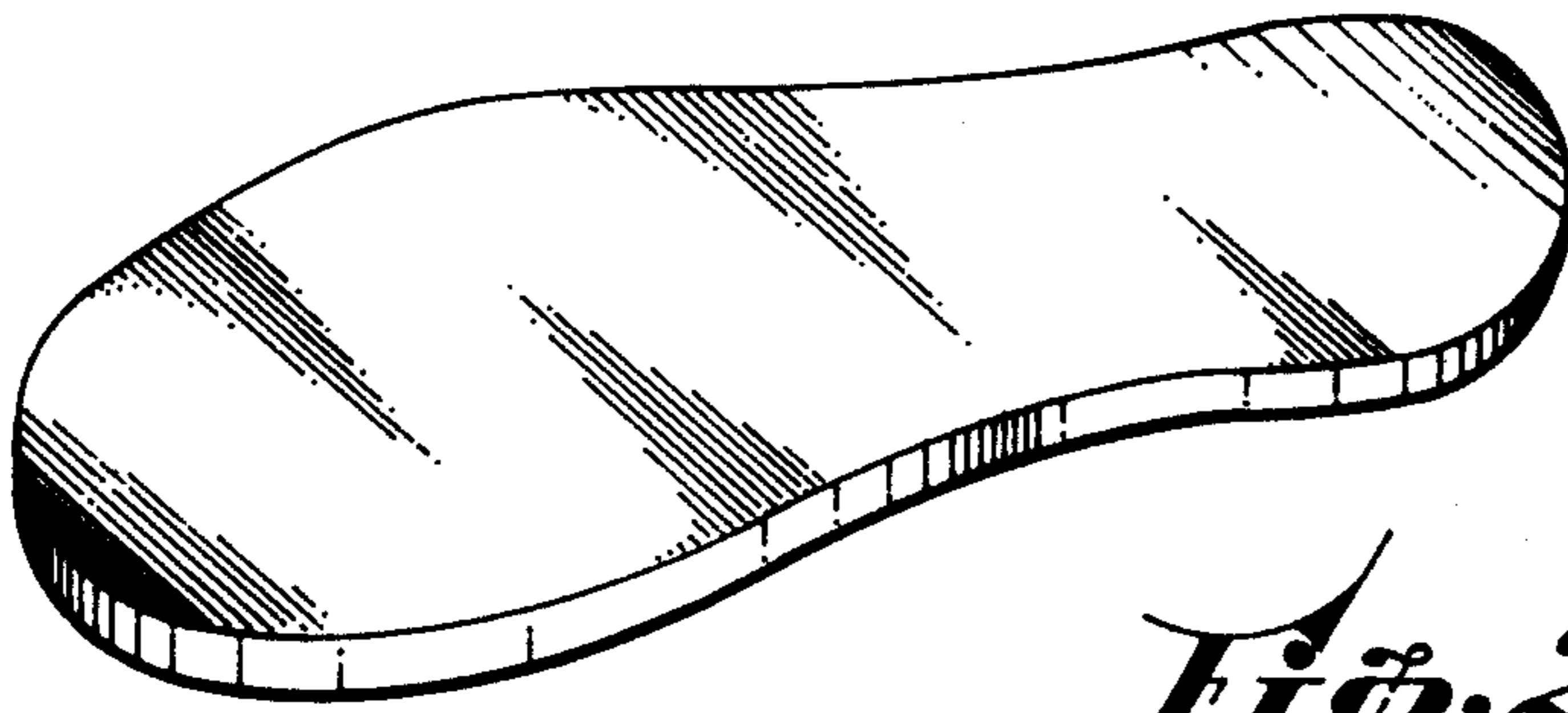

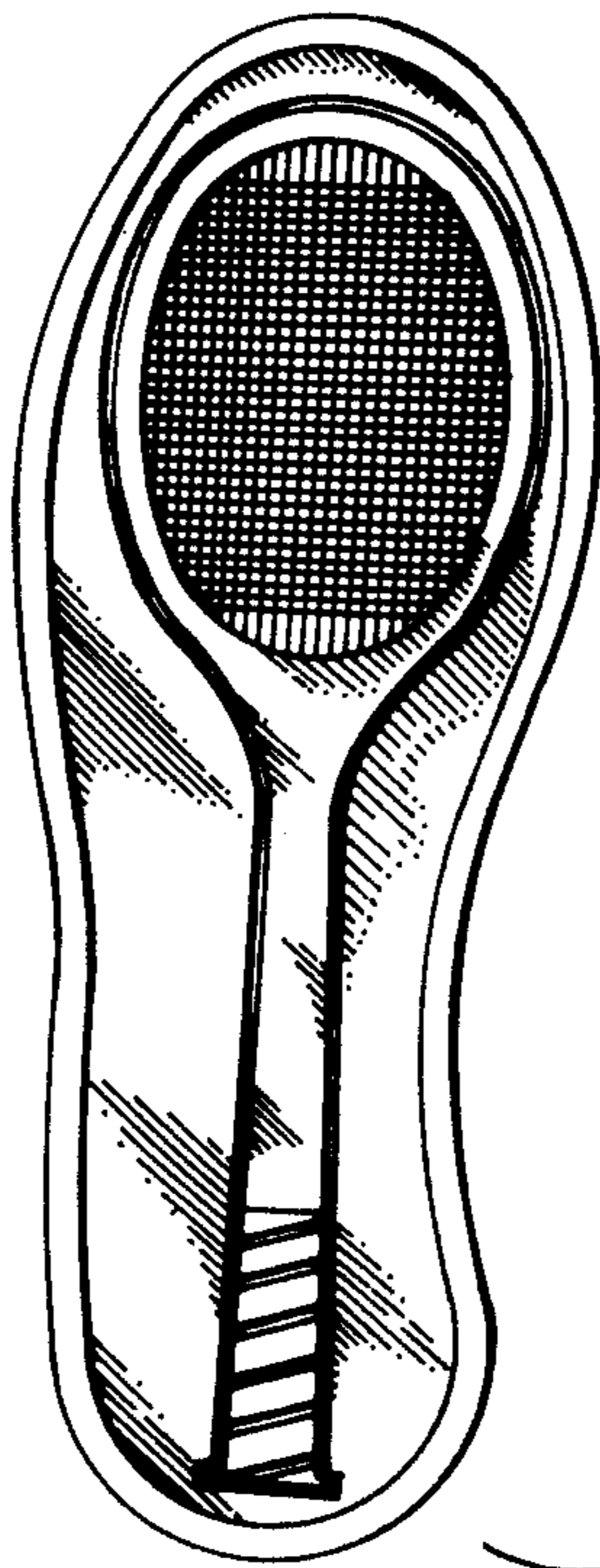
