[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tennis ball carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tennis ball carrier showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 3.

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a modified form of a tennis ball carrier showing my new design wherein the belt portion passes through the base portion of the U-shaped ball holding members; and

FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 6.

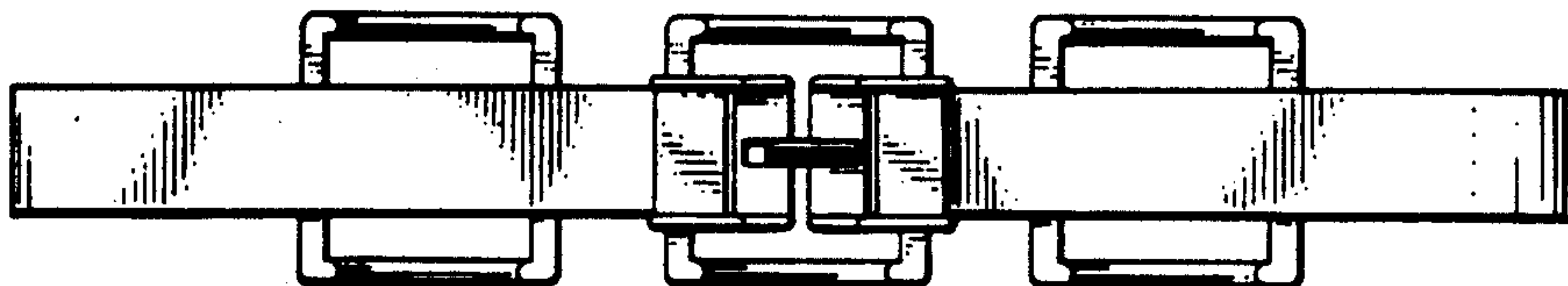

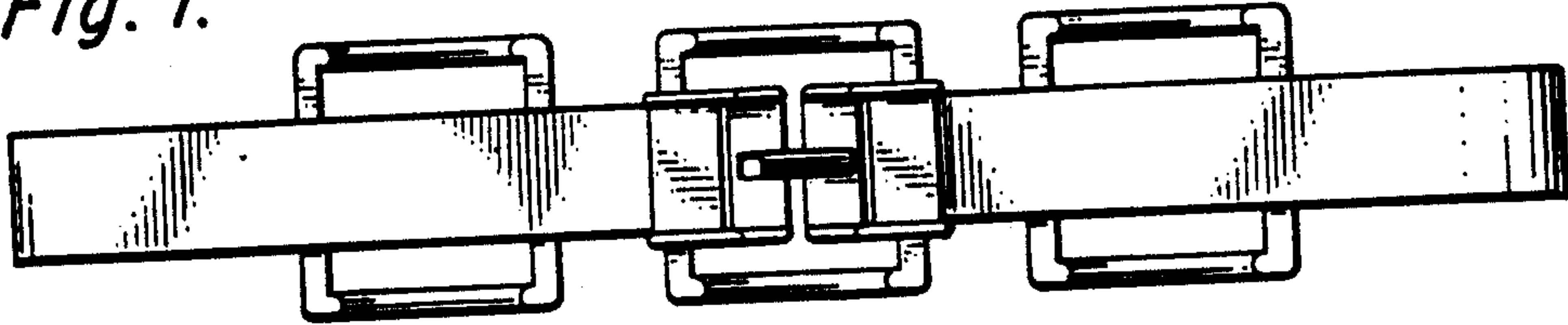

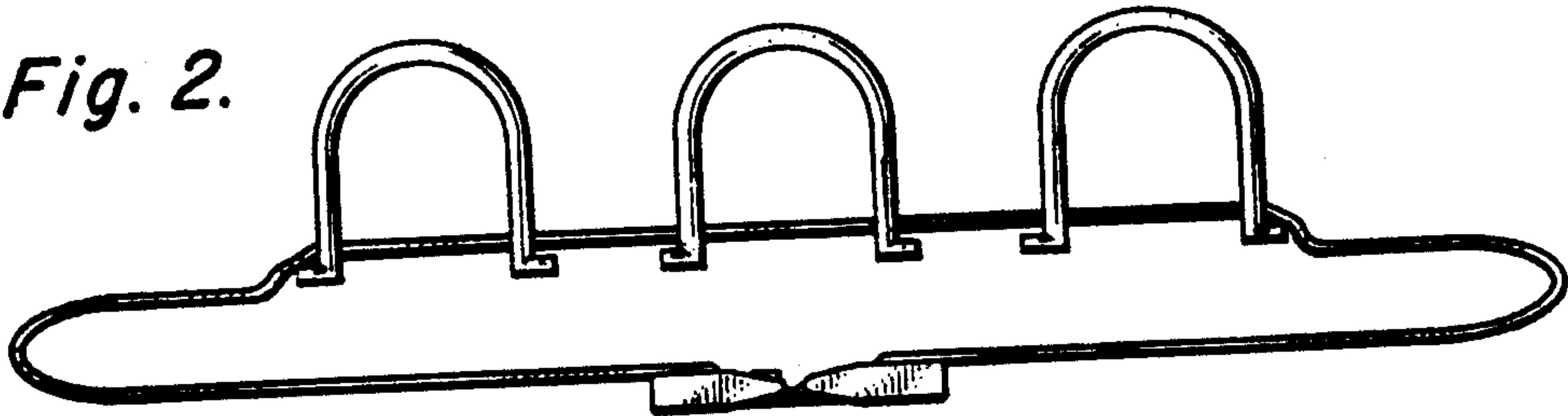

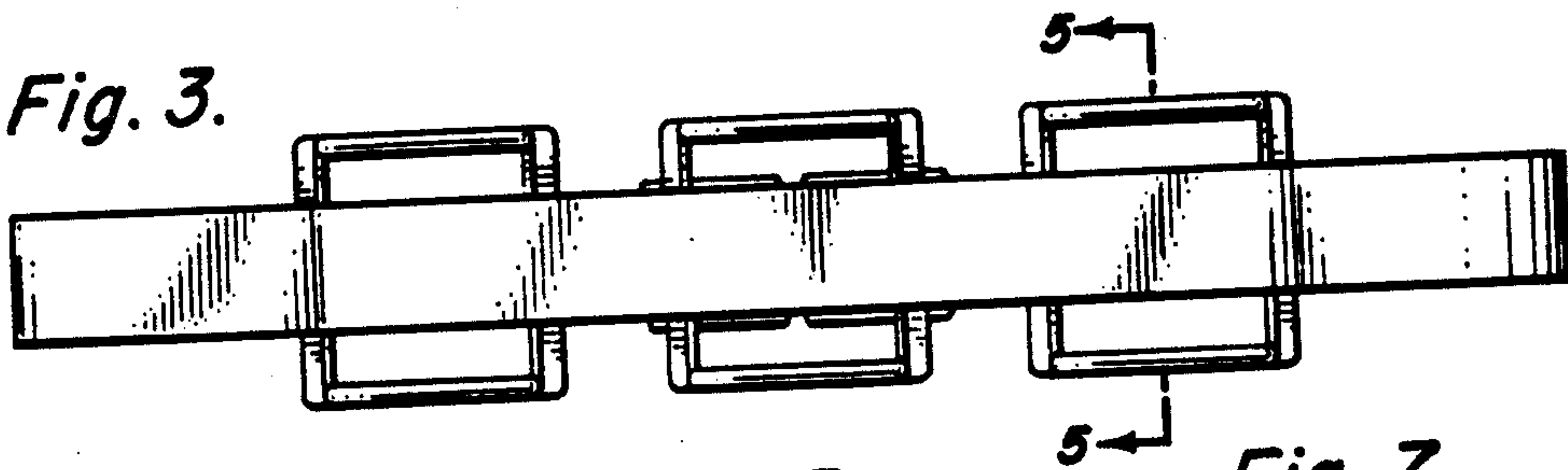

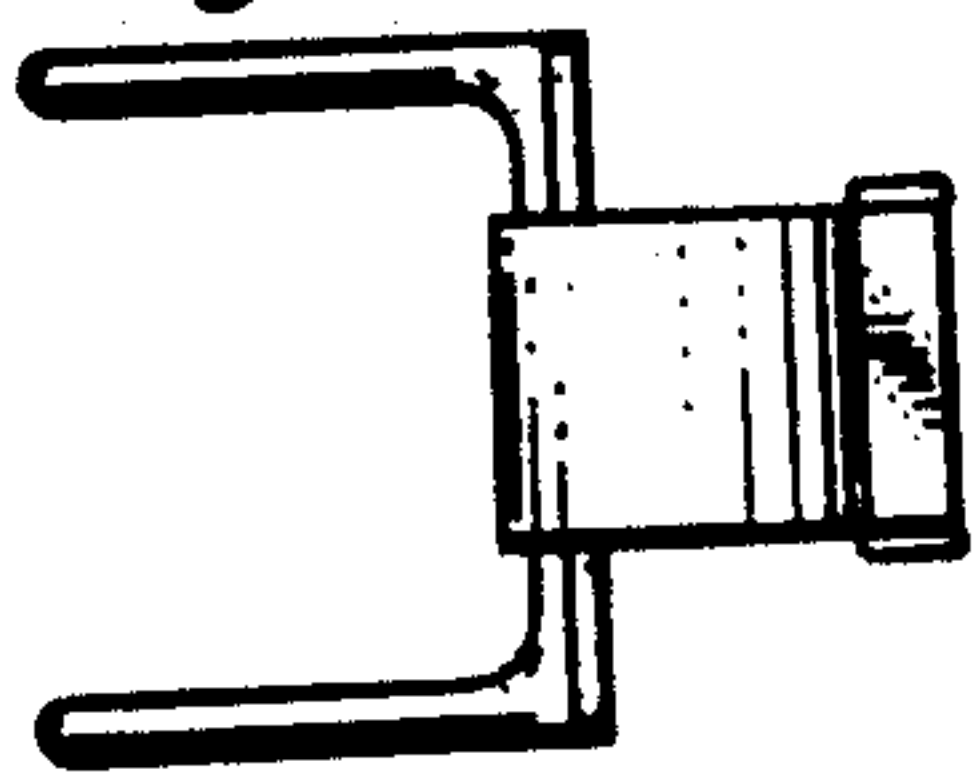

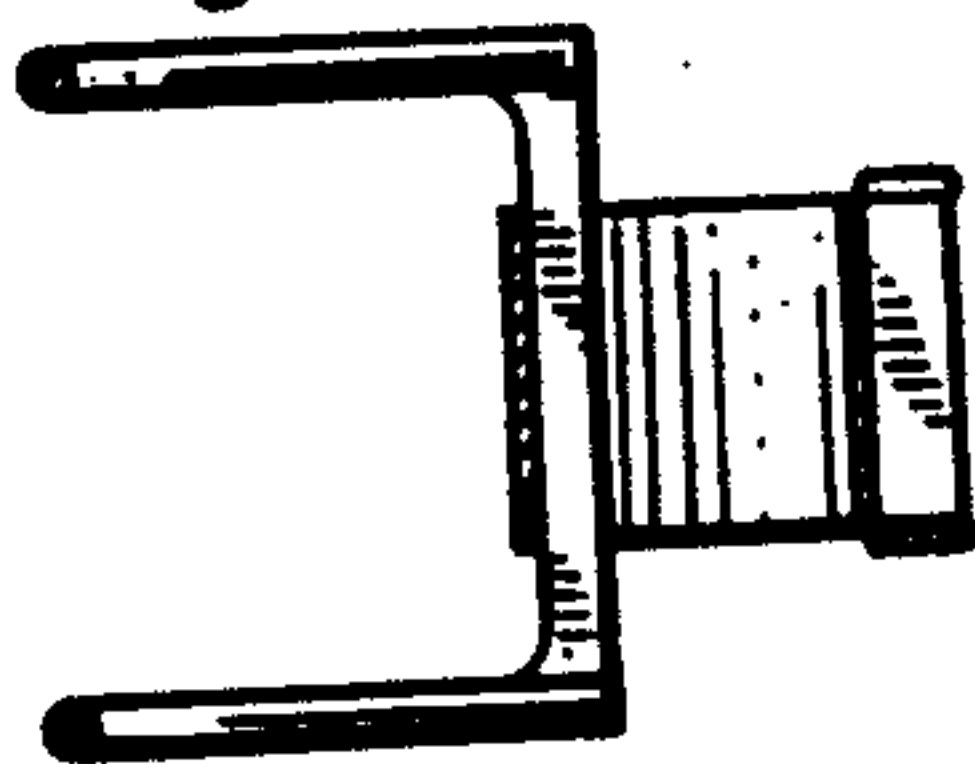

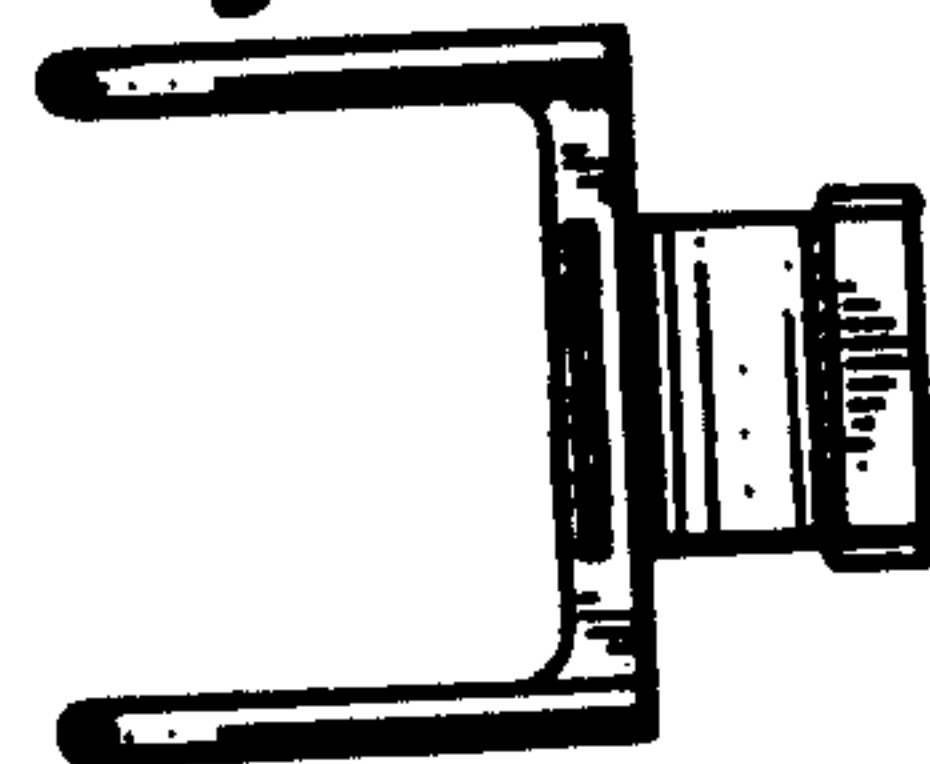
