DESCRIPTION

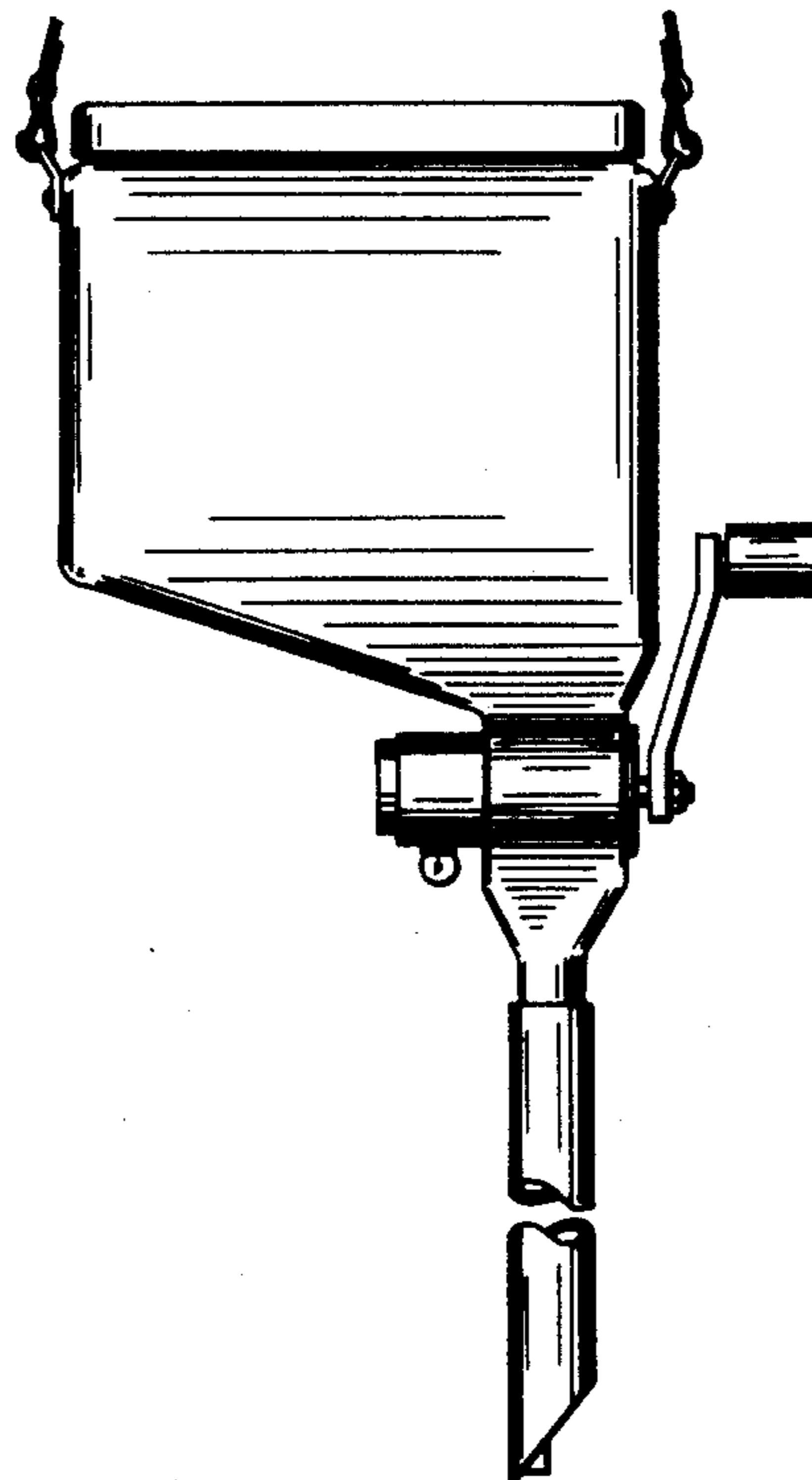
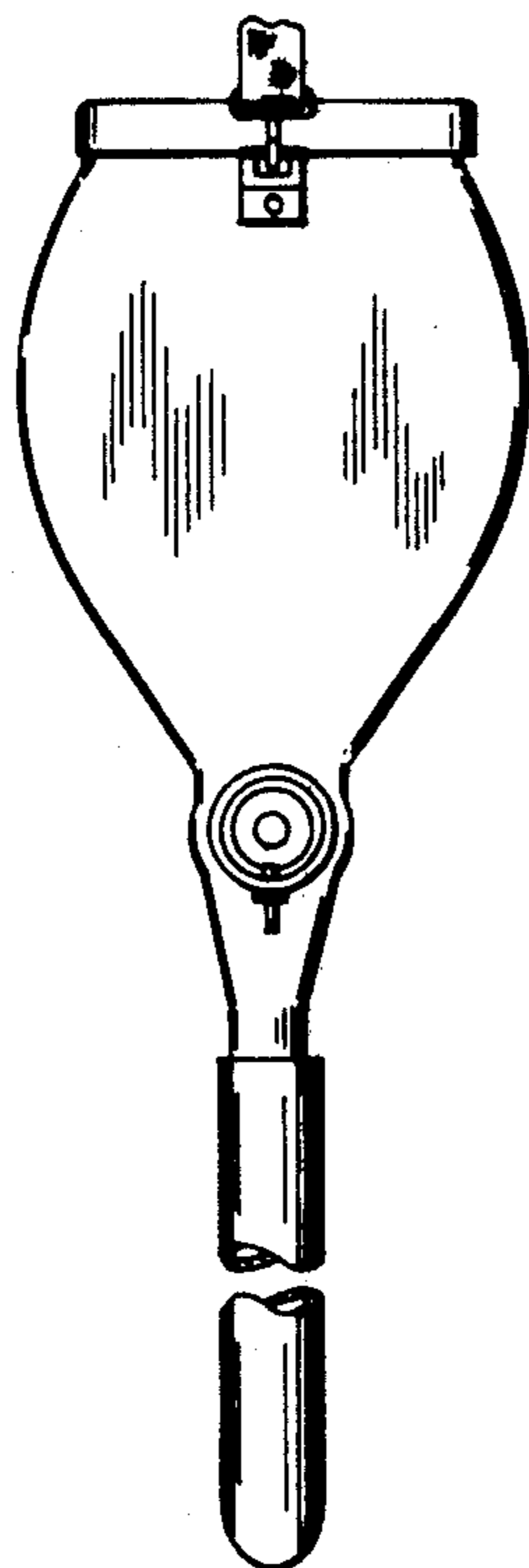
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined fertilizer and pesticide applicator for plants, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



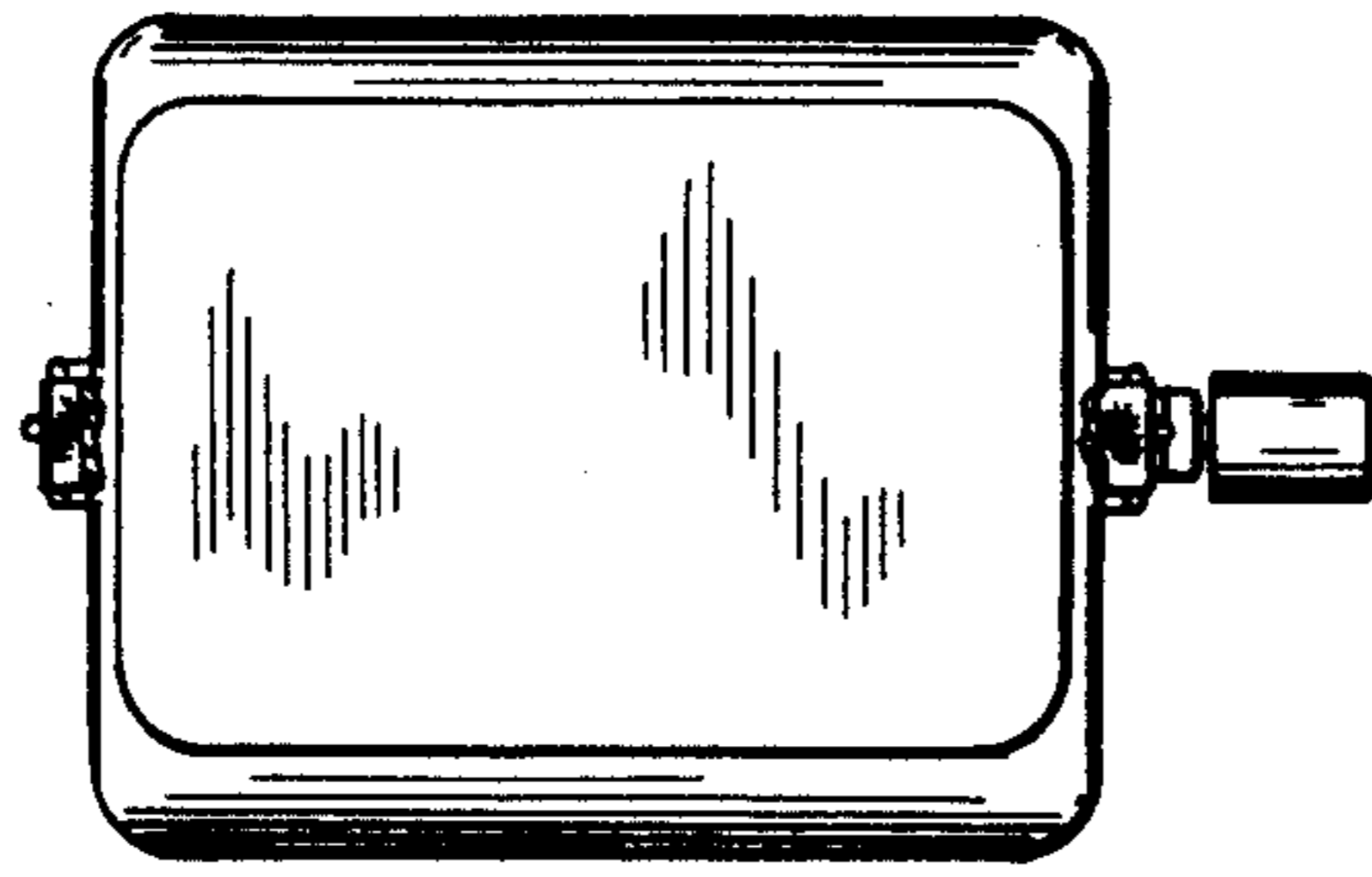

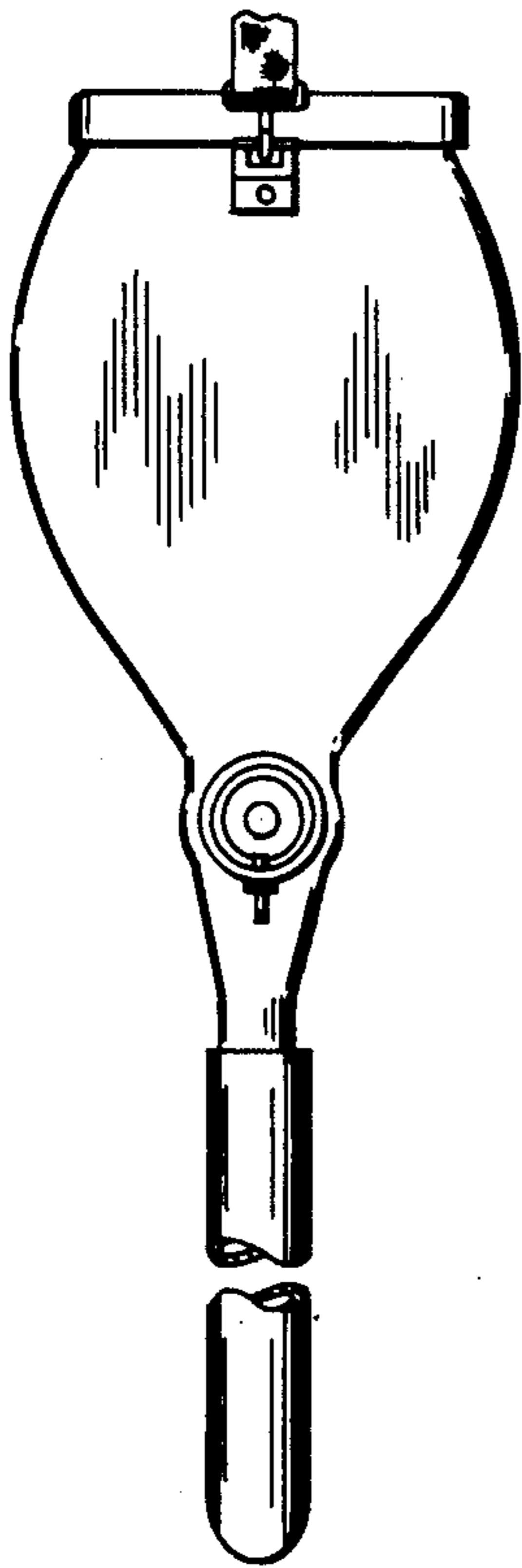

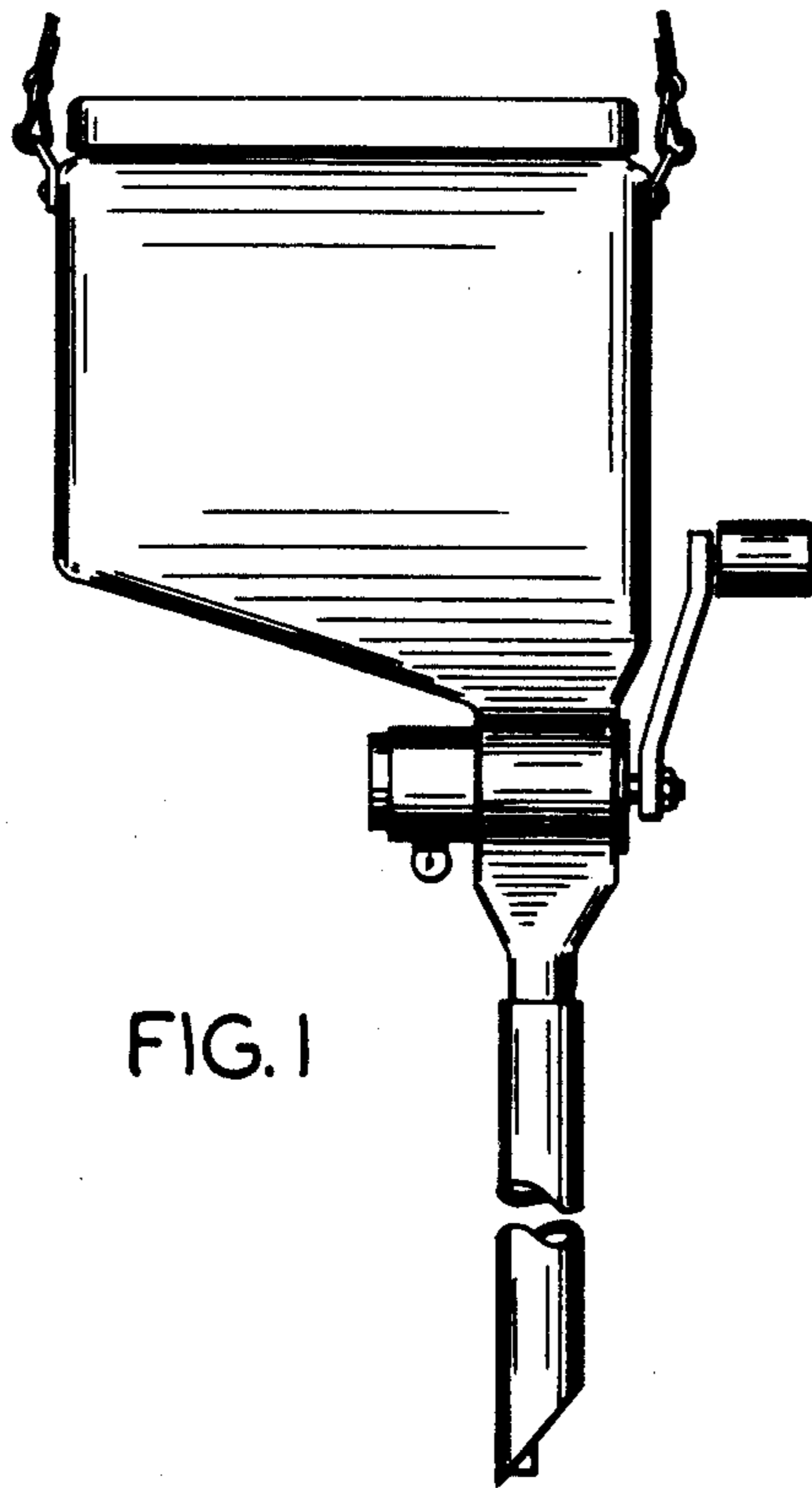

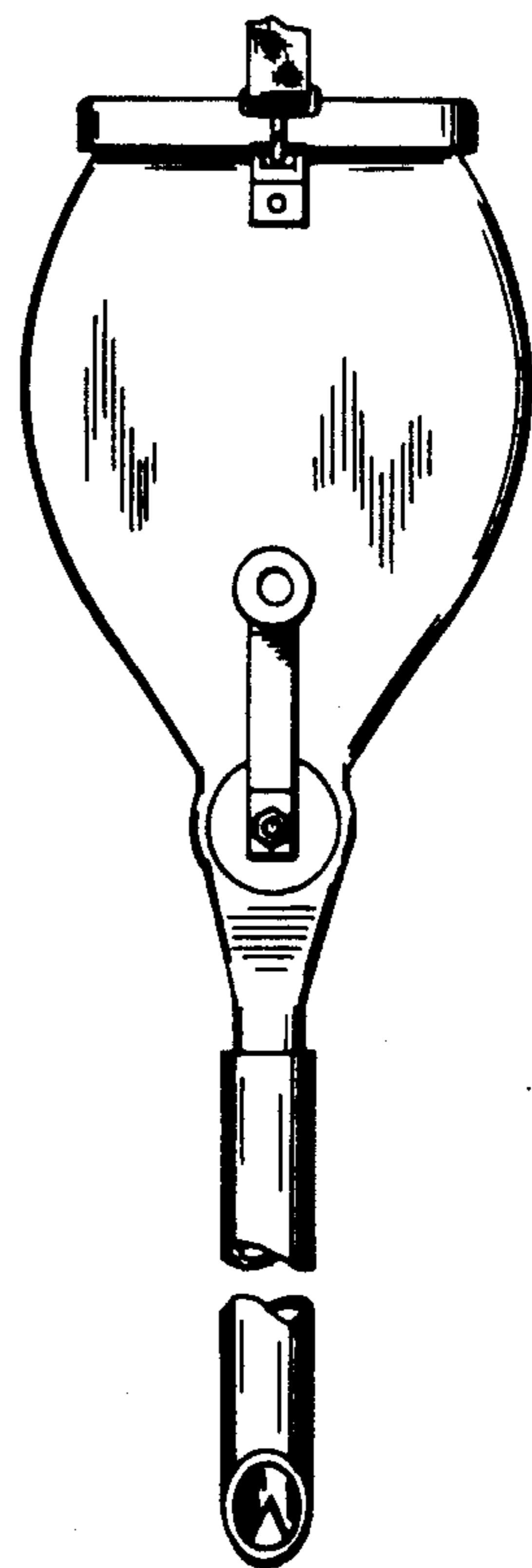

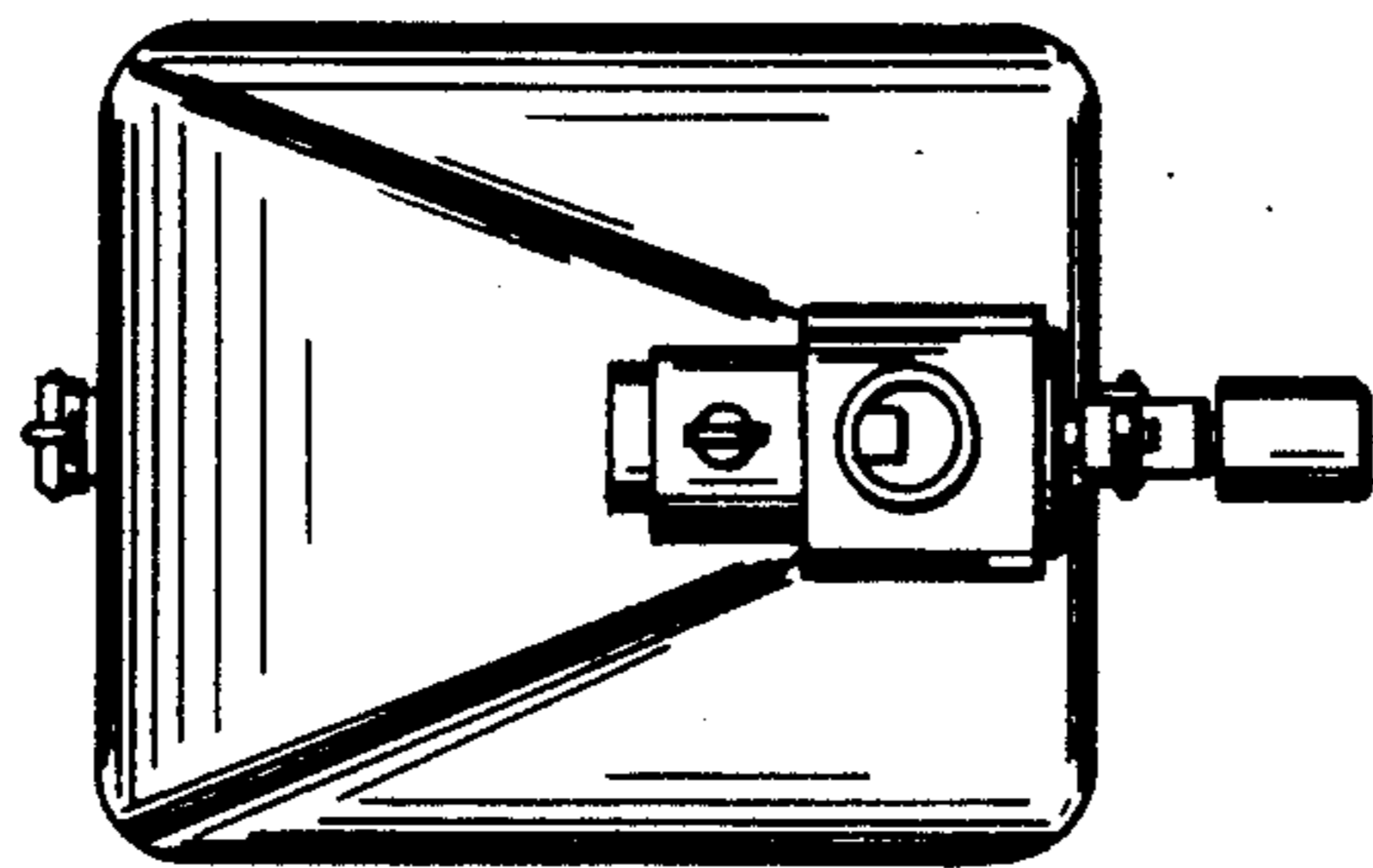
