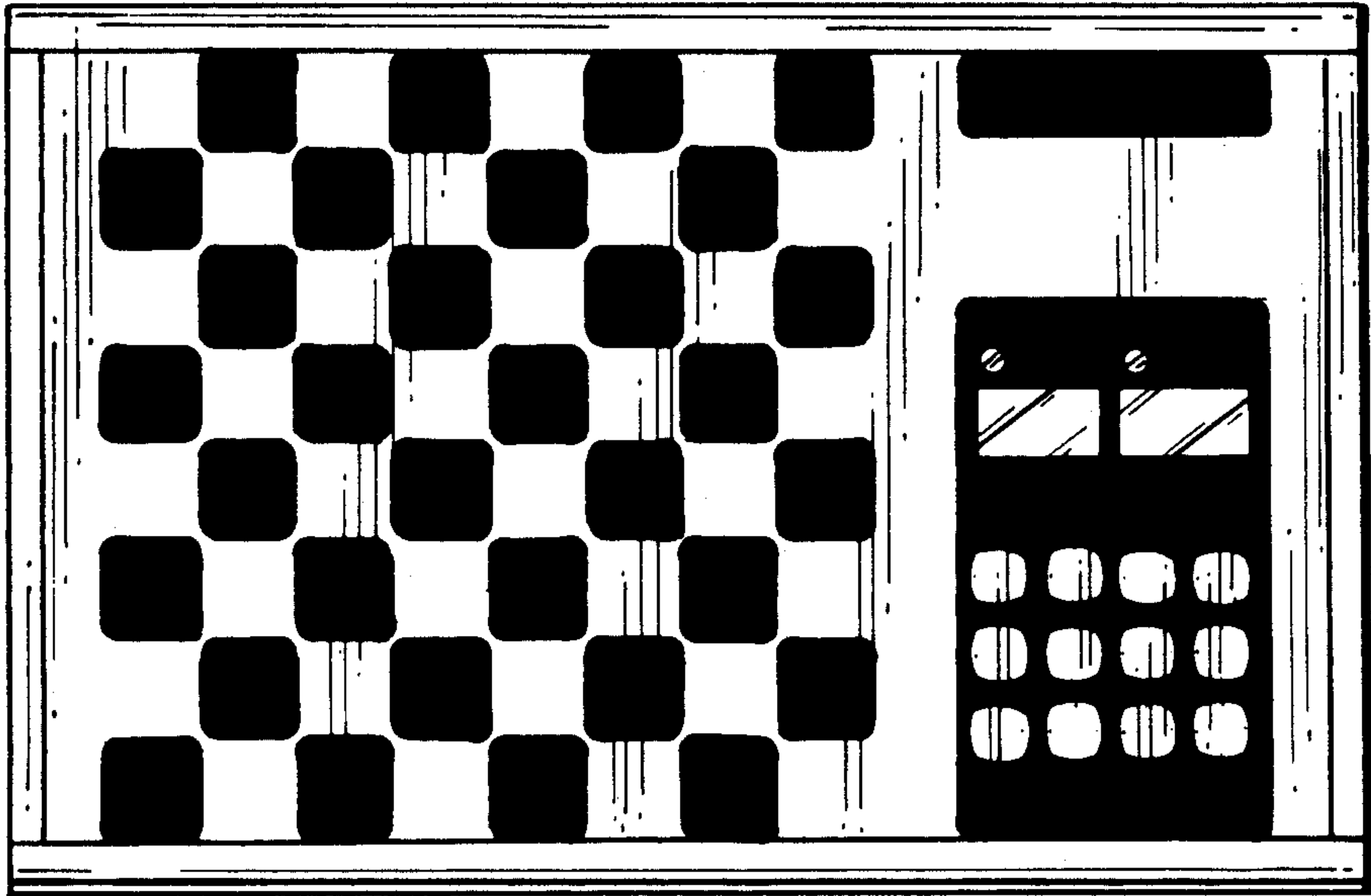

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof and is identical to the rear view.



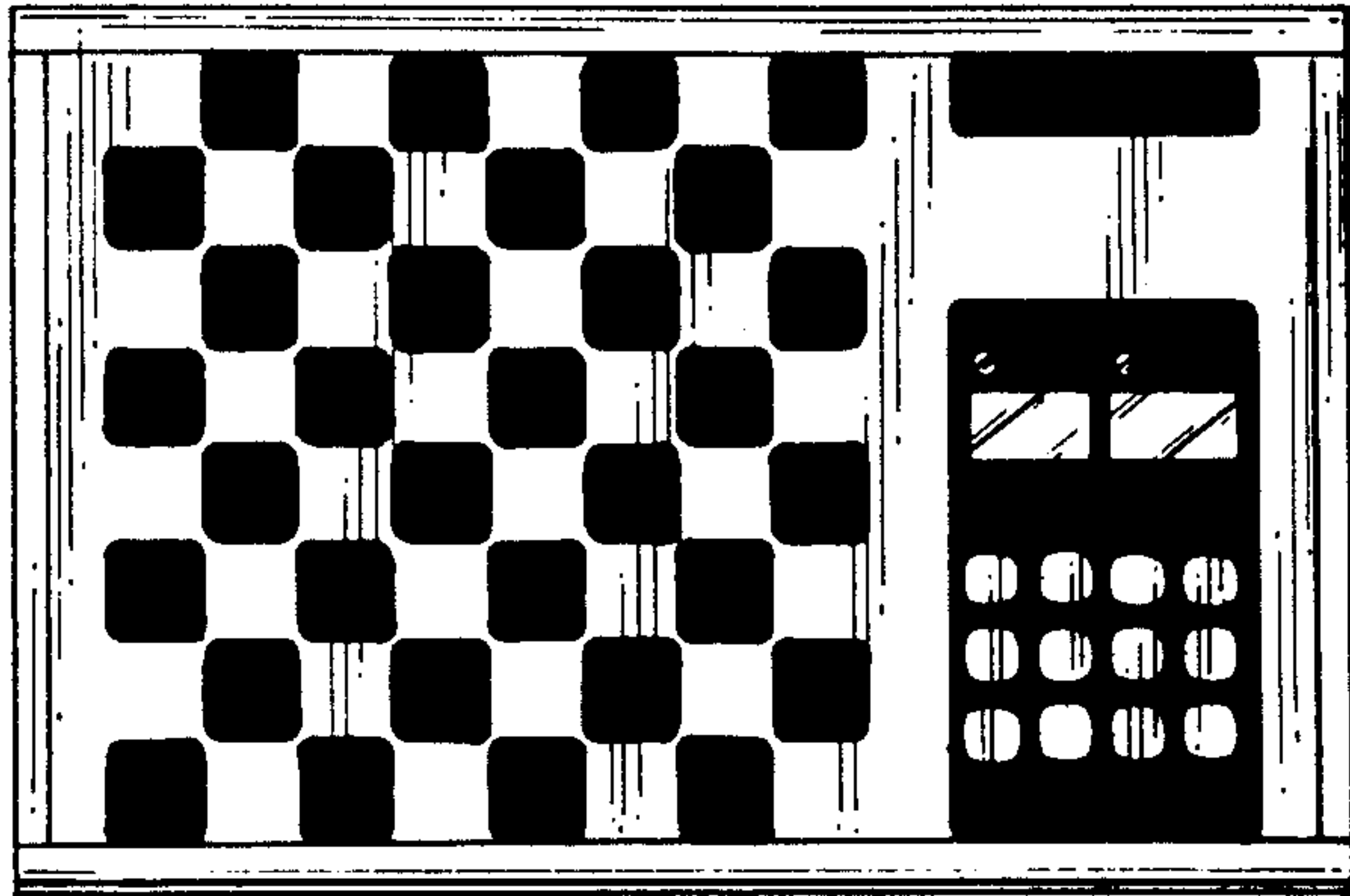

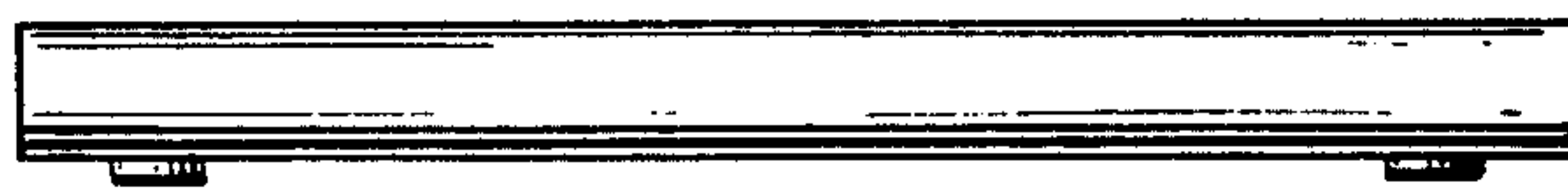
