DESCRIPTION

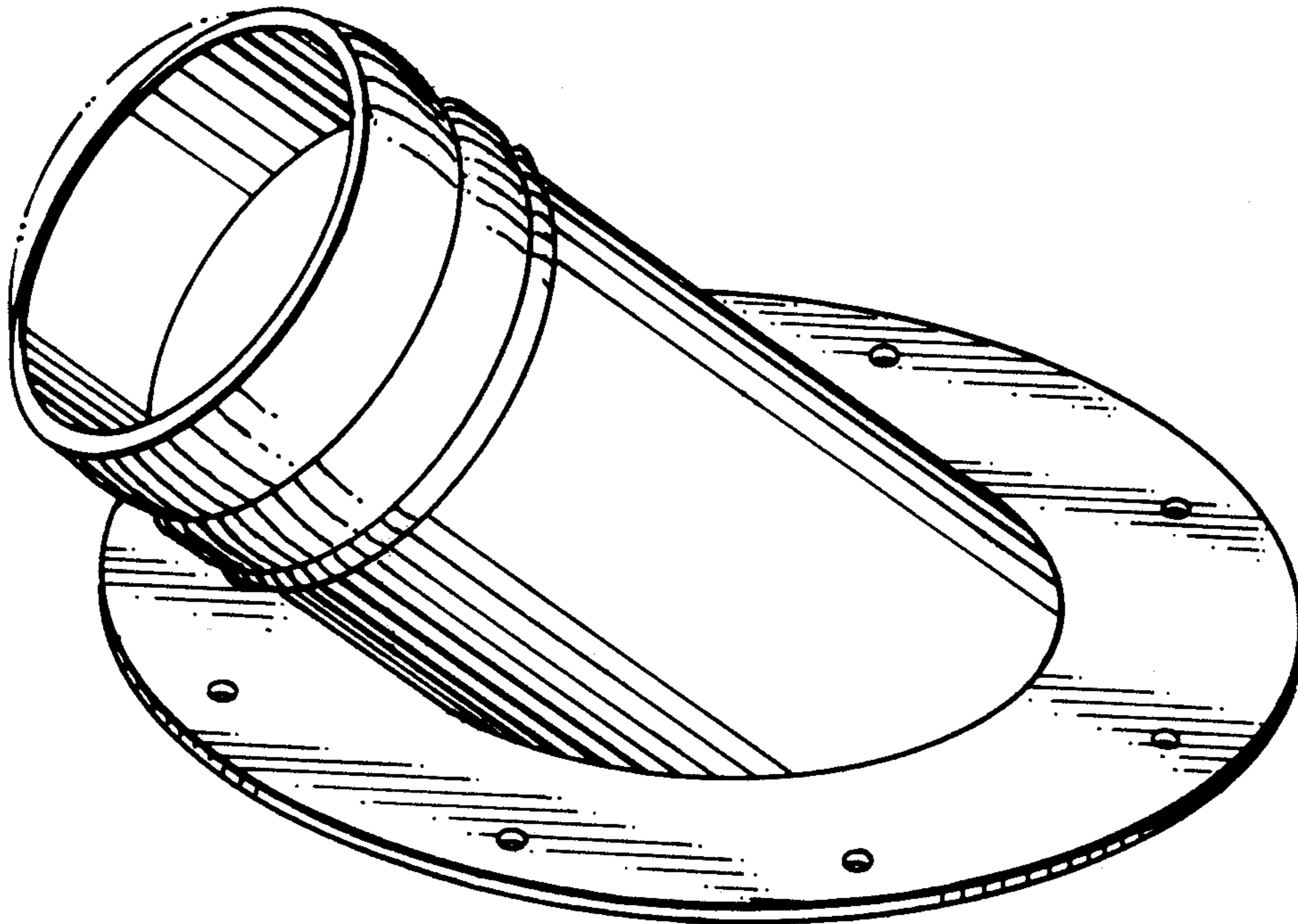
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a housing for boat light embodying the new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the housing as shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation of the housing as shown in FIG. 1; and

The lens is shown in broken lines in FIGS. 1, 3, and 4 for illustrative purposes only.



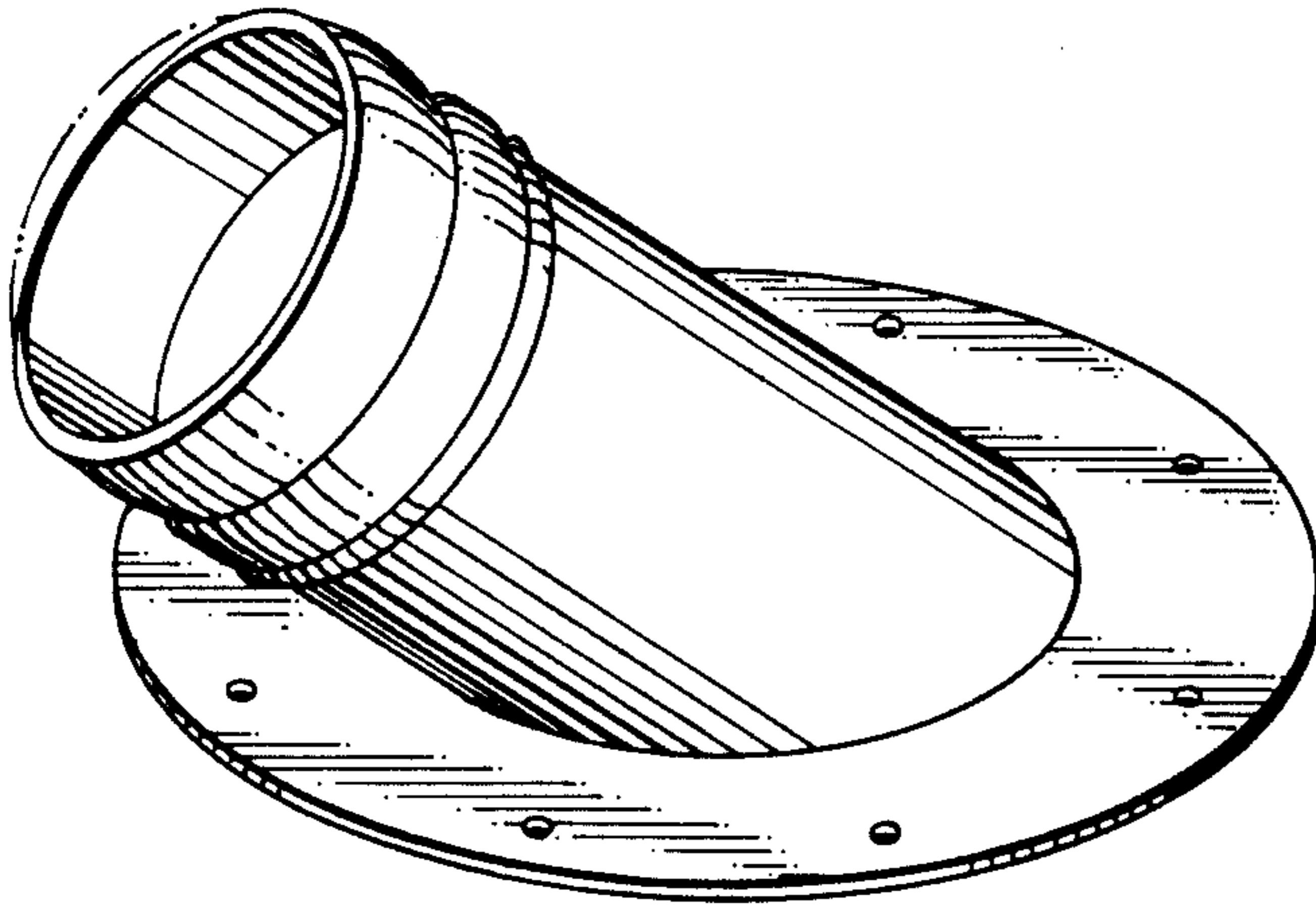

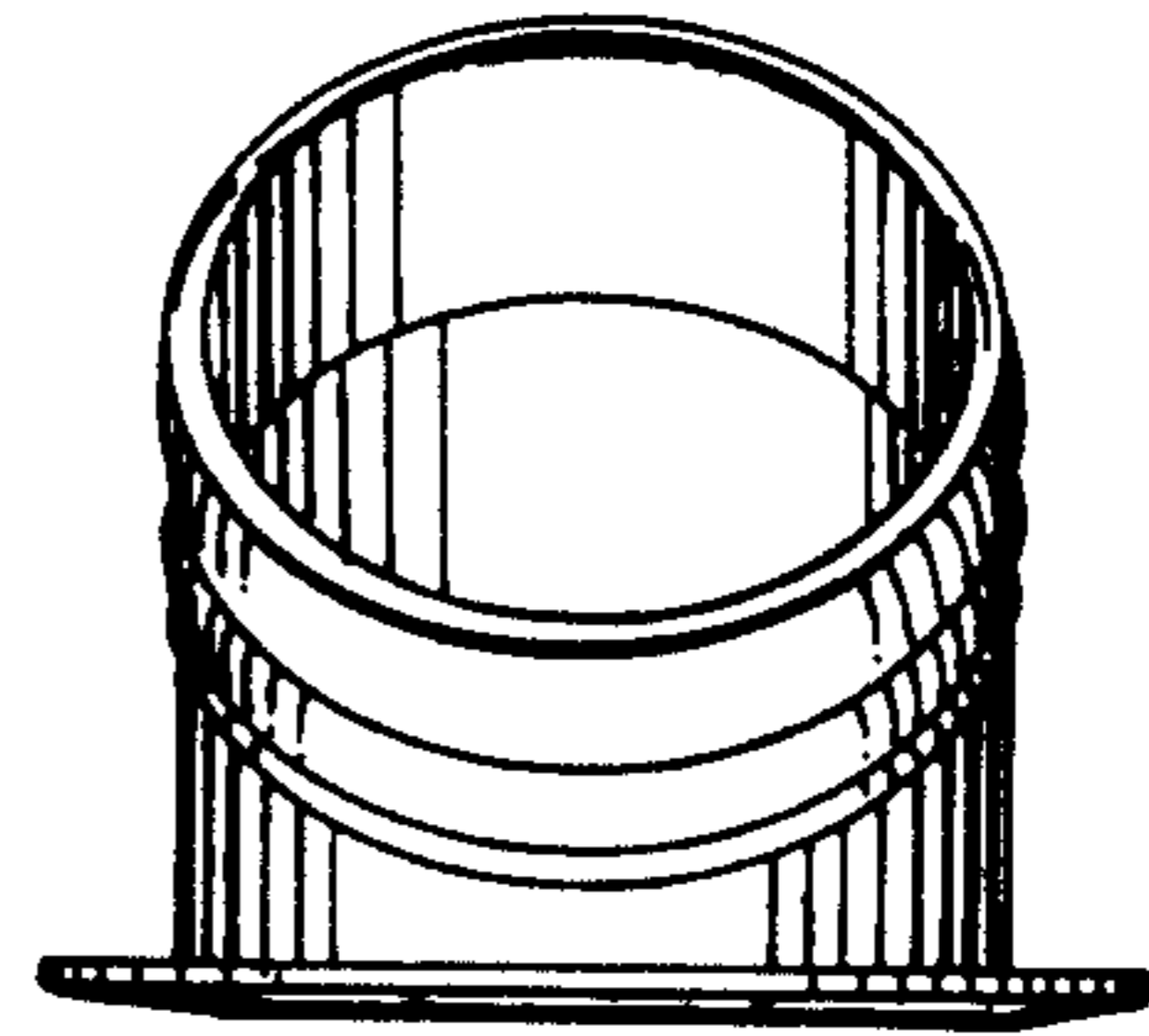

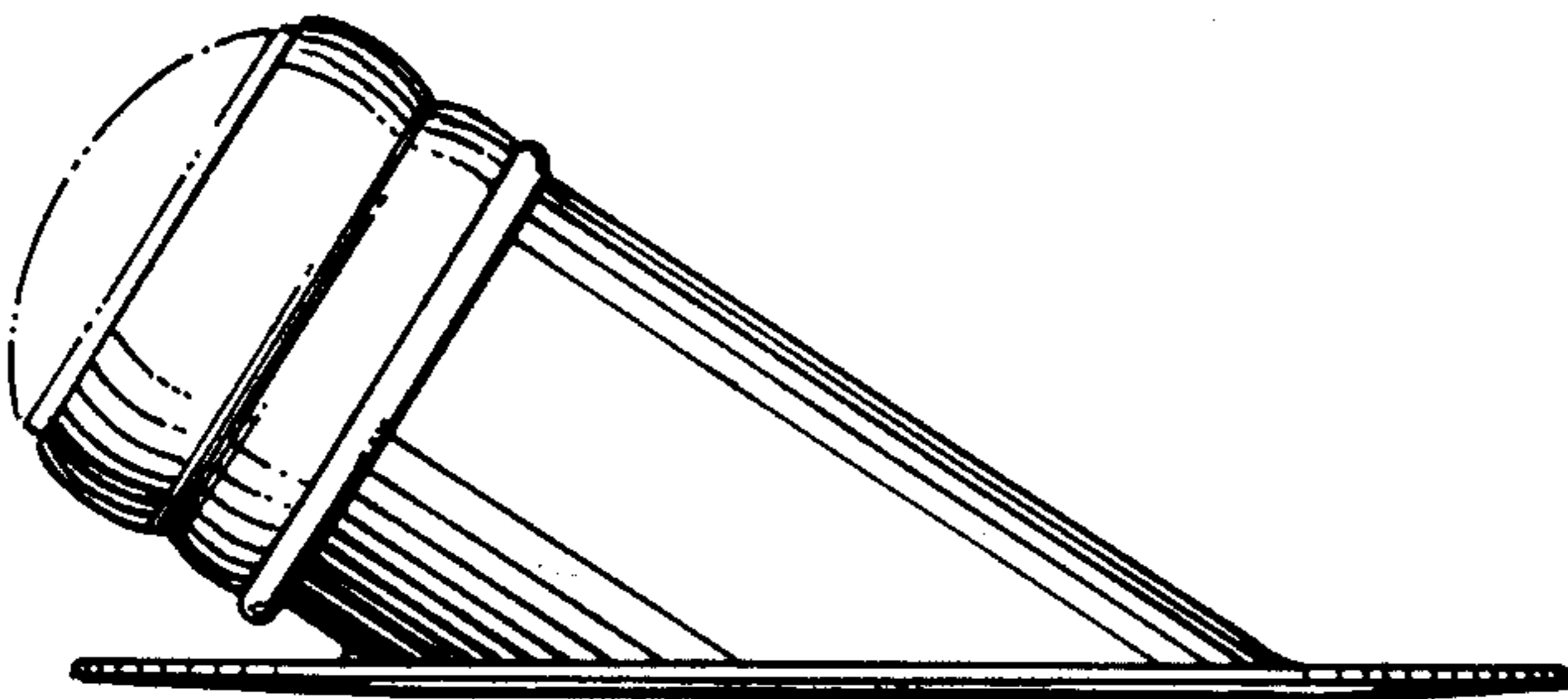

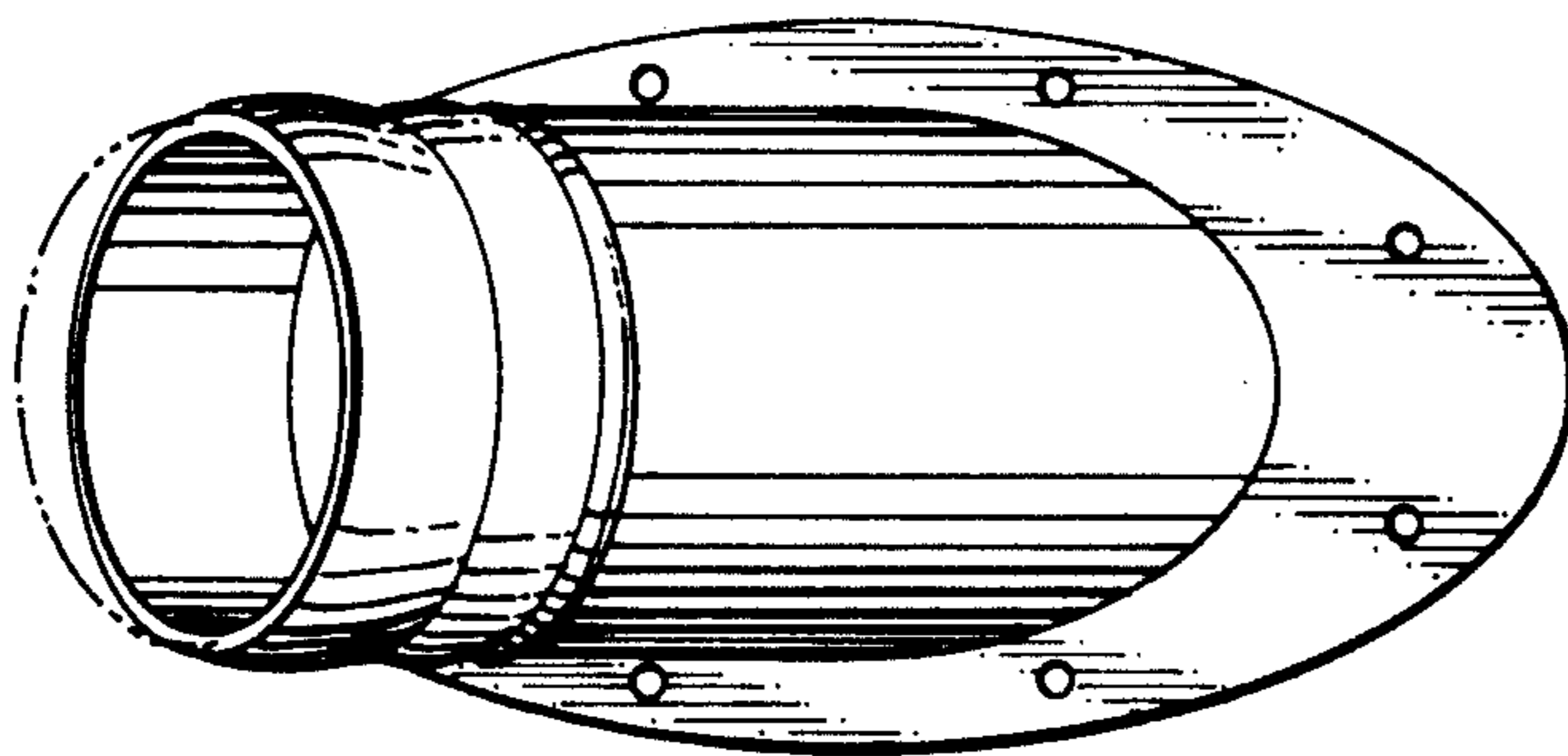
