FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof in an unfolded position.

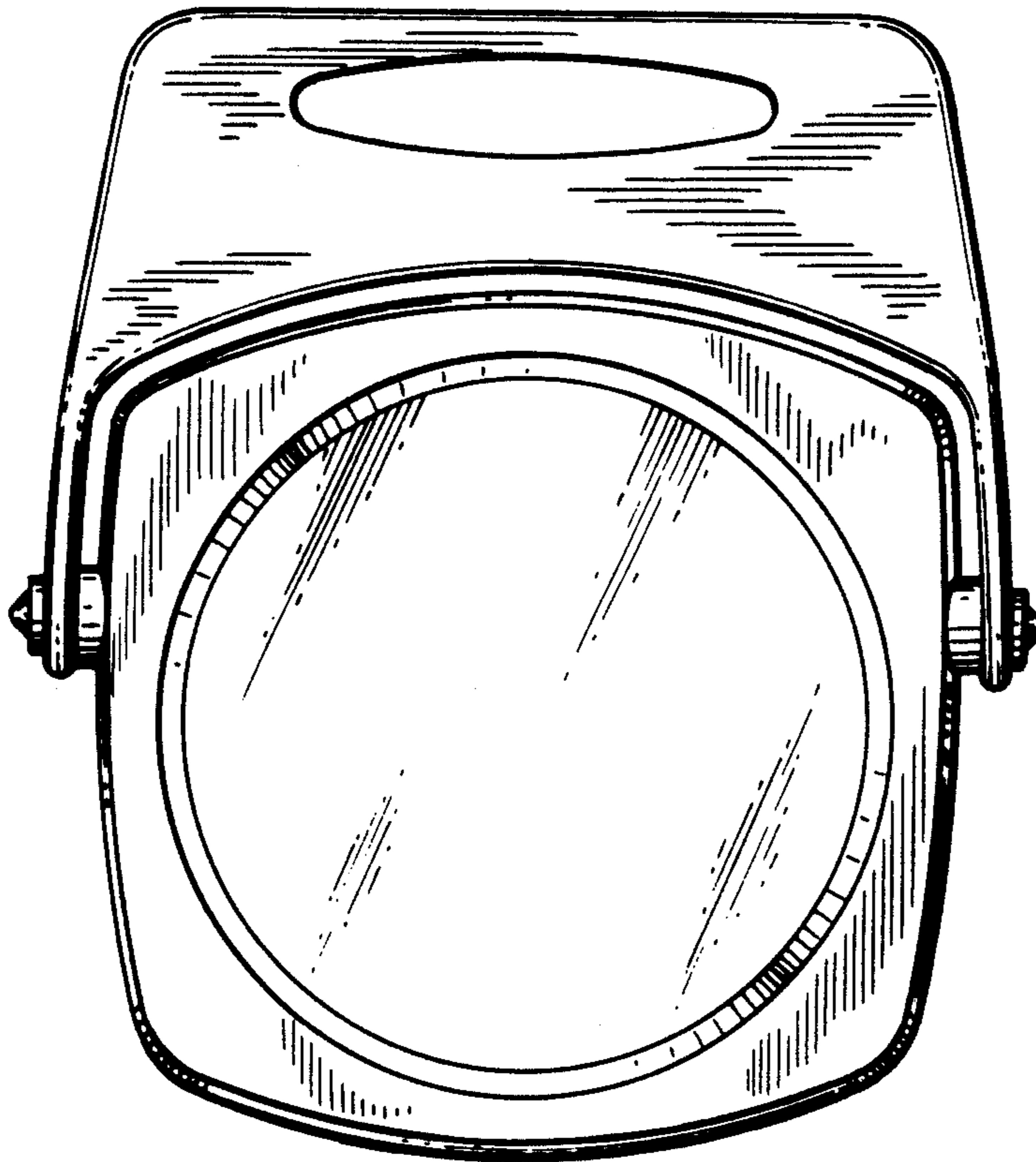

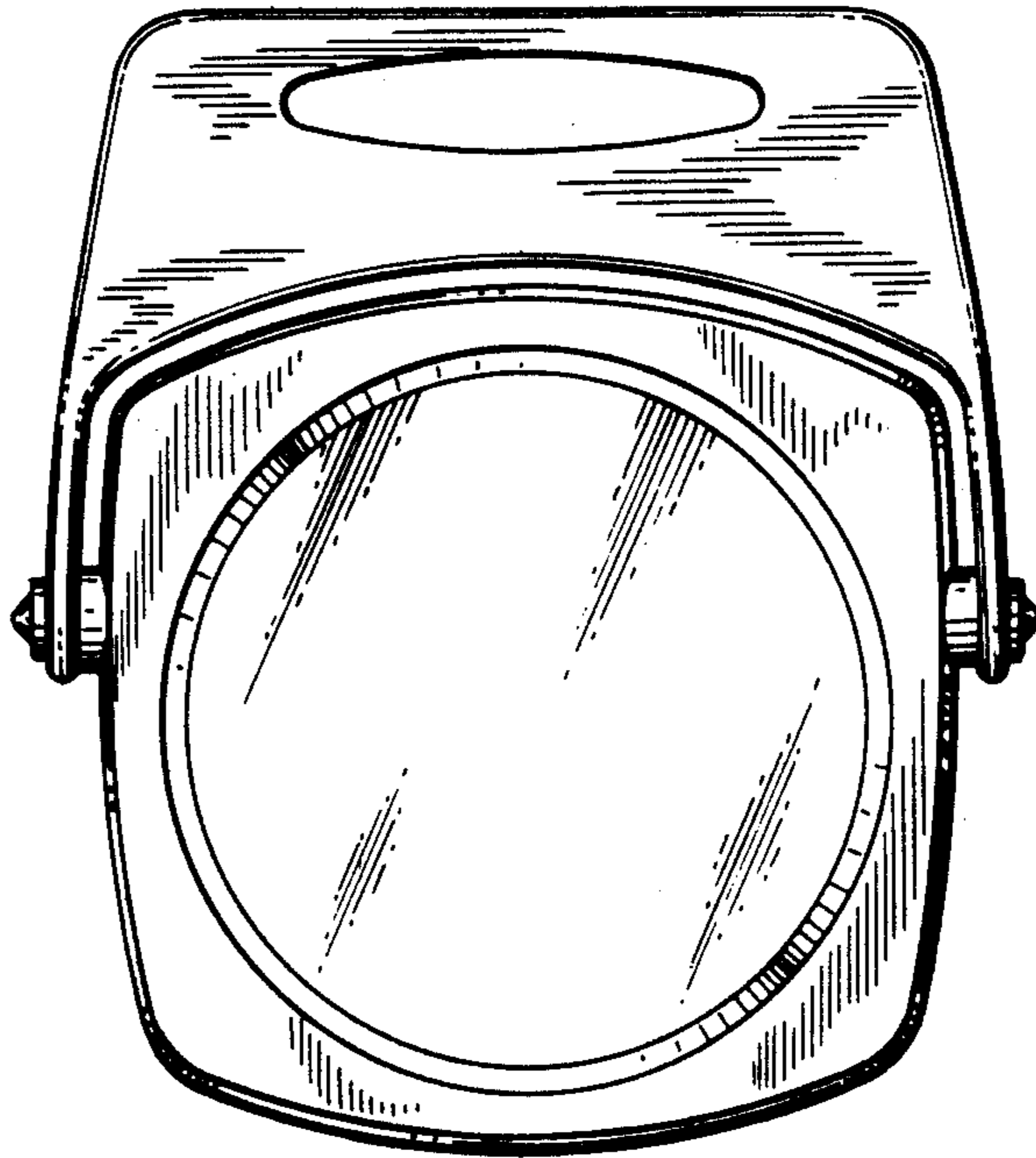

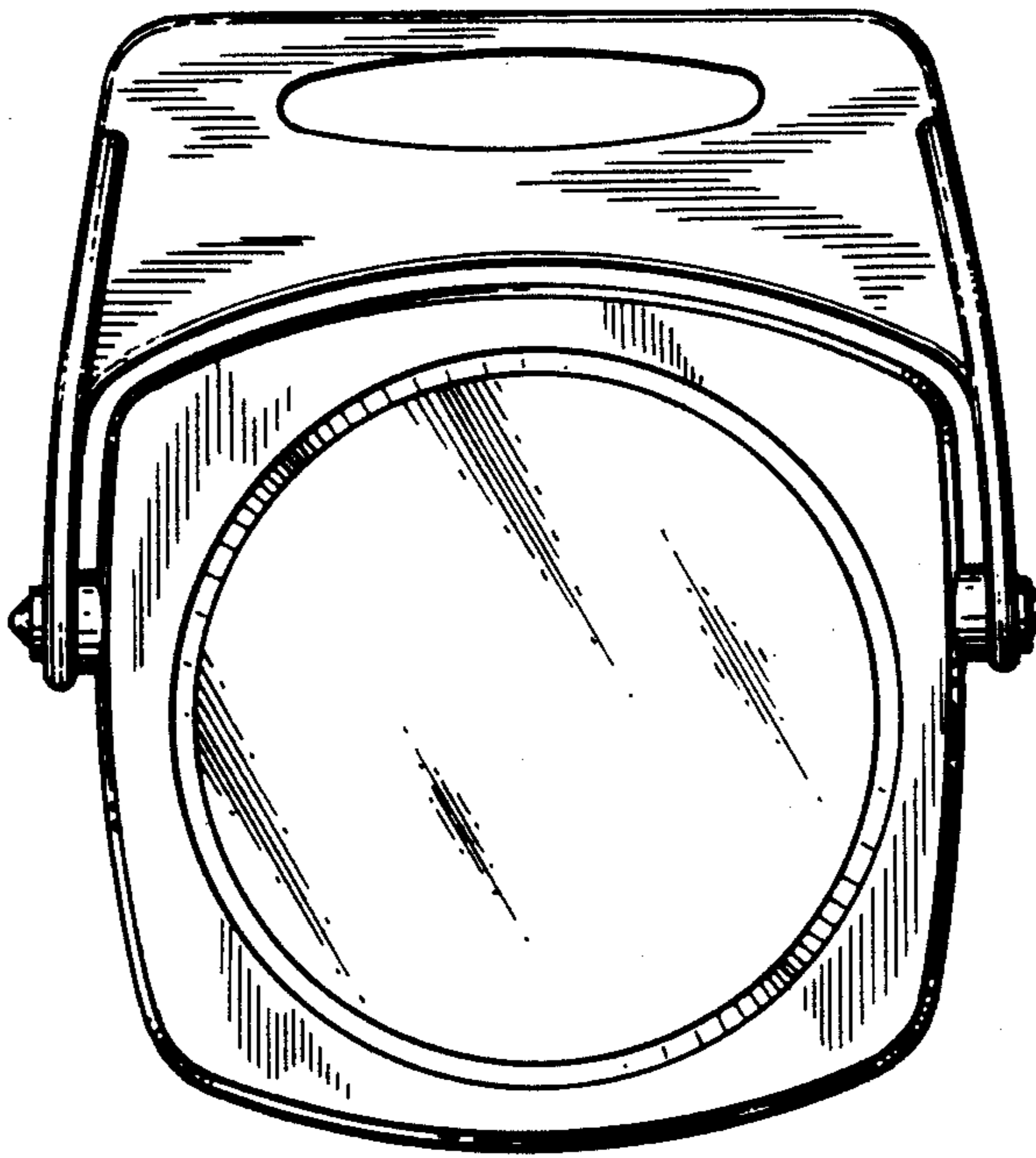
