FIG. 2 is a plan view of the combined molded case circuit breaker accessory package of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale;


FIG. 3 is an elevational view of one side of the combined molded case circuit breaker and accessory package of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale;


FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the other side of the combined molded case circuit breaker accessory package of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale;









