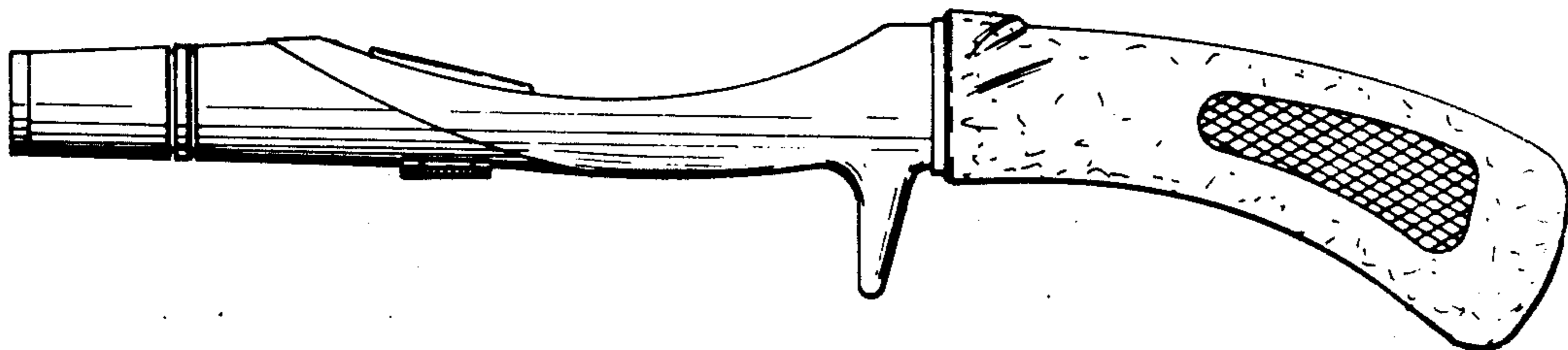
DESCRIPTION

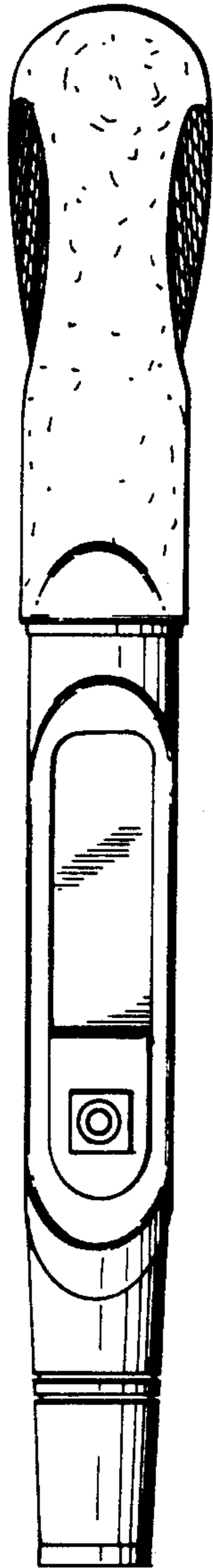

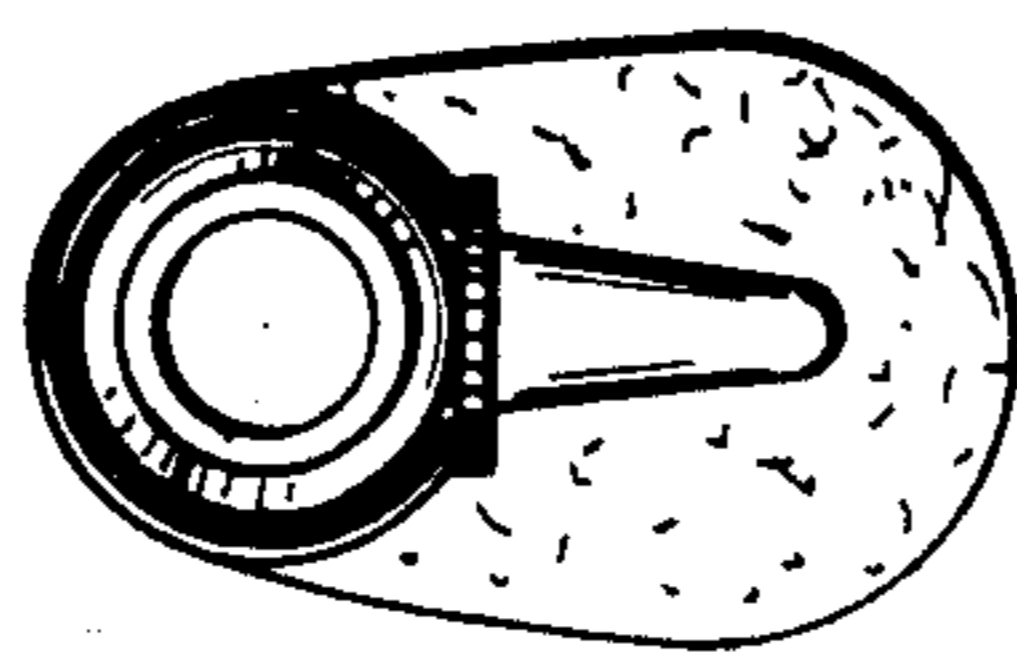

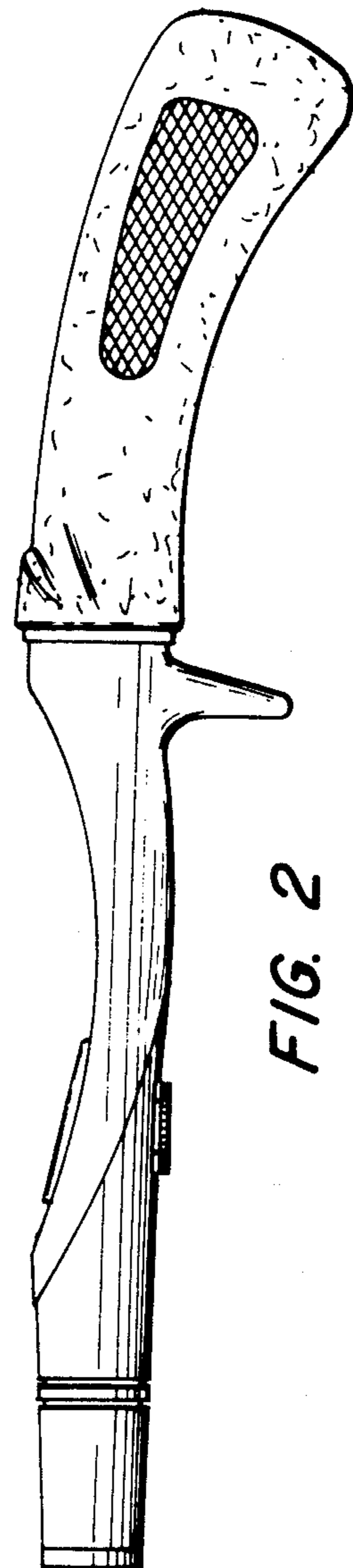

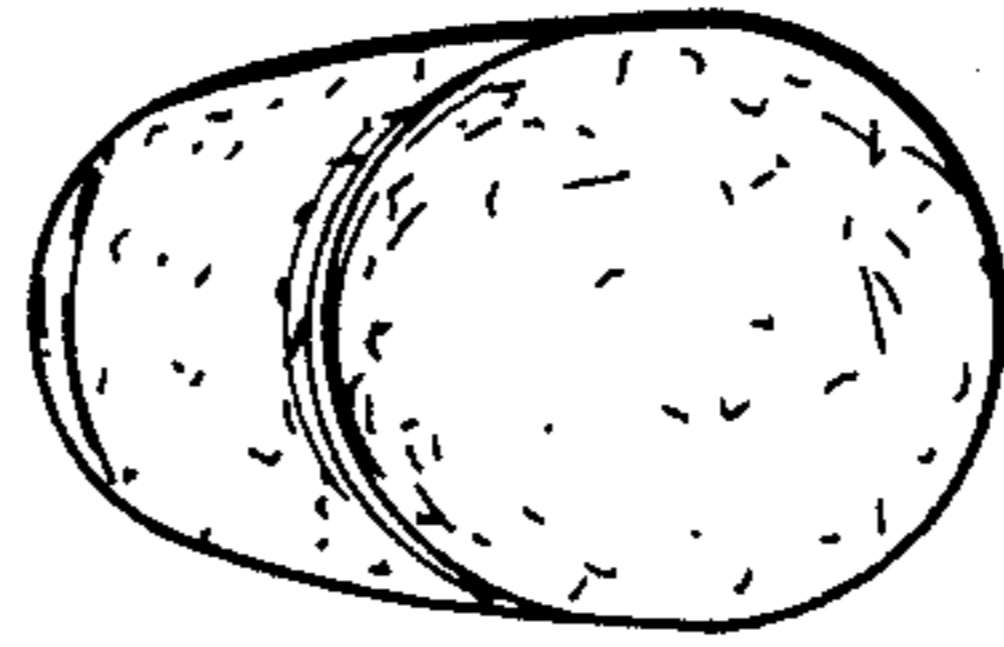

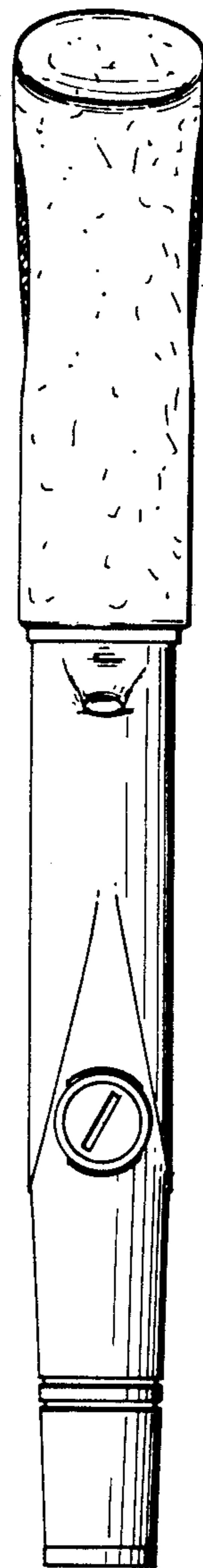
