new design;

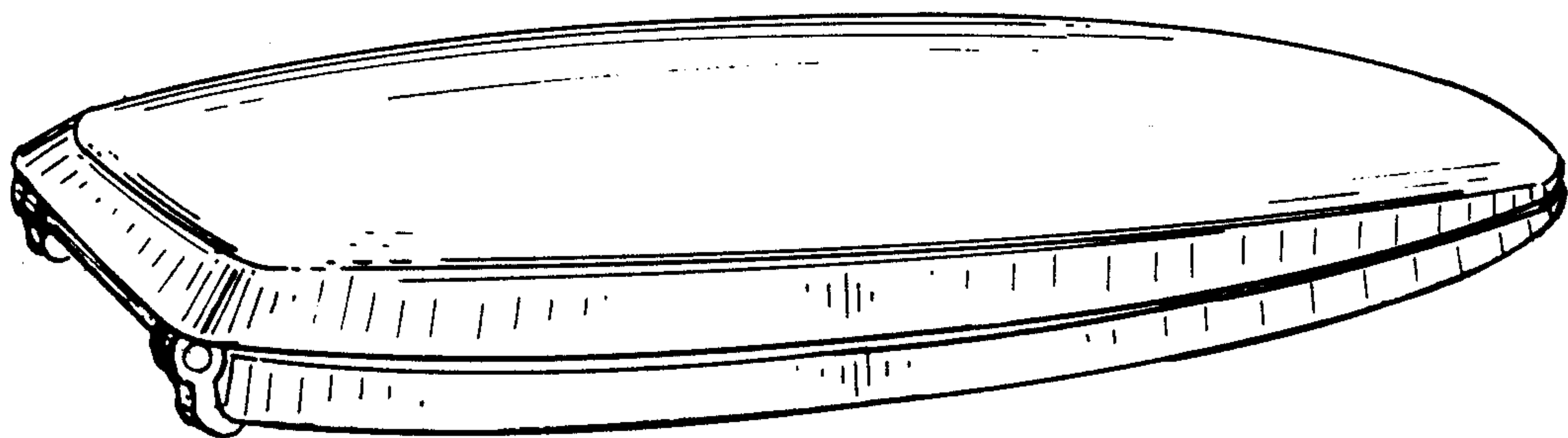
FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the top, front  
and left side thereof;

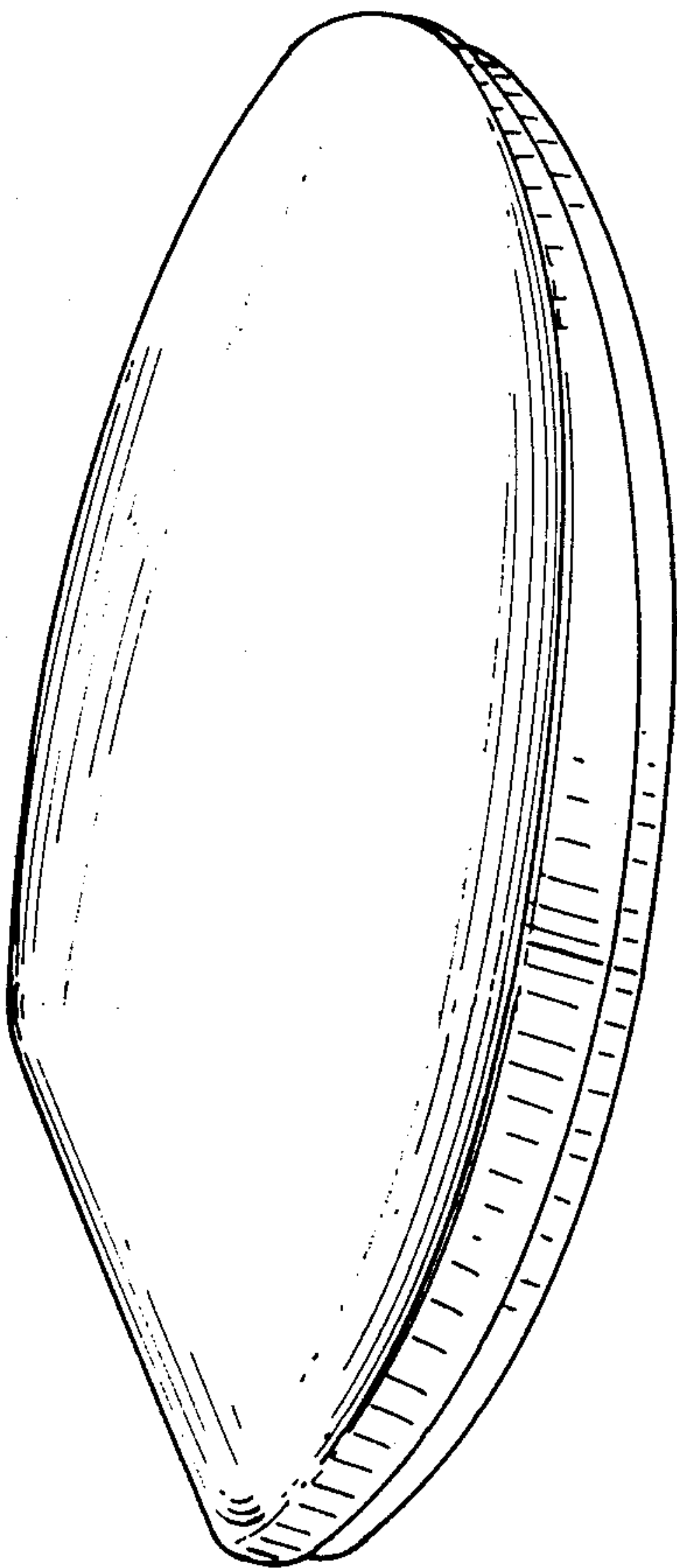
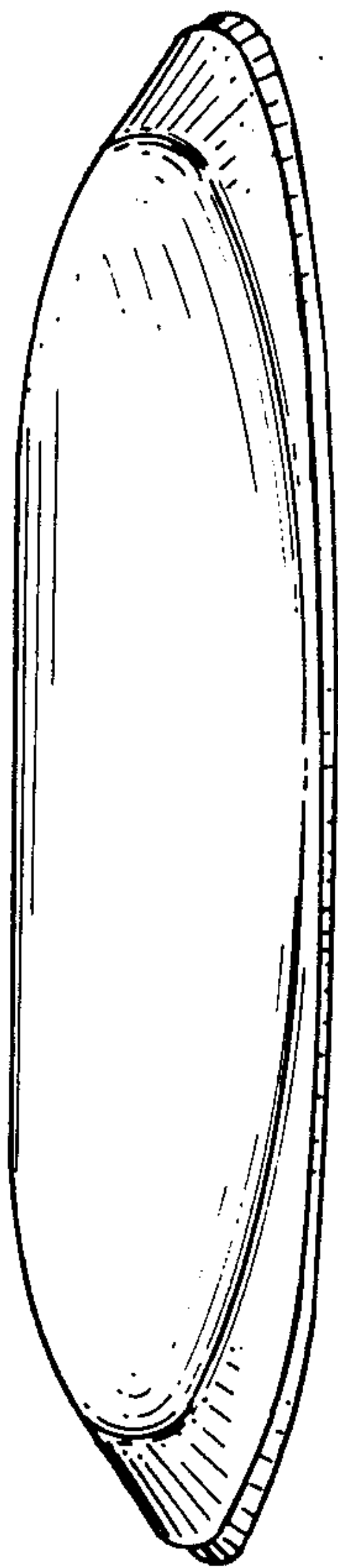
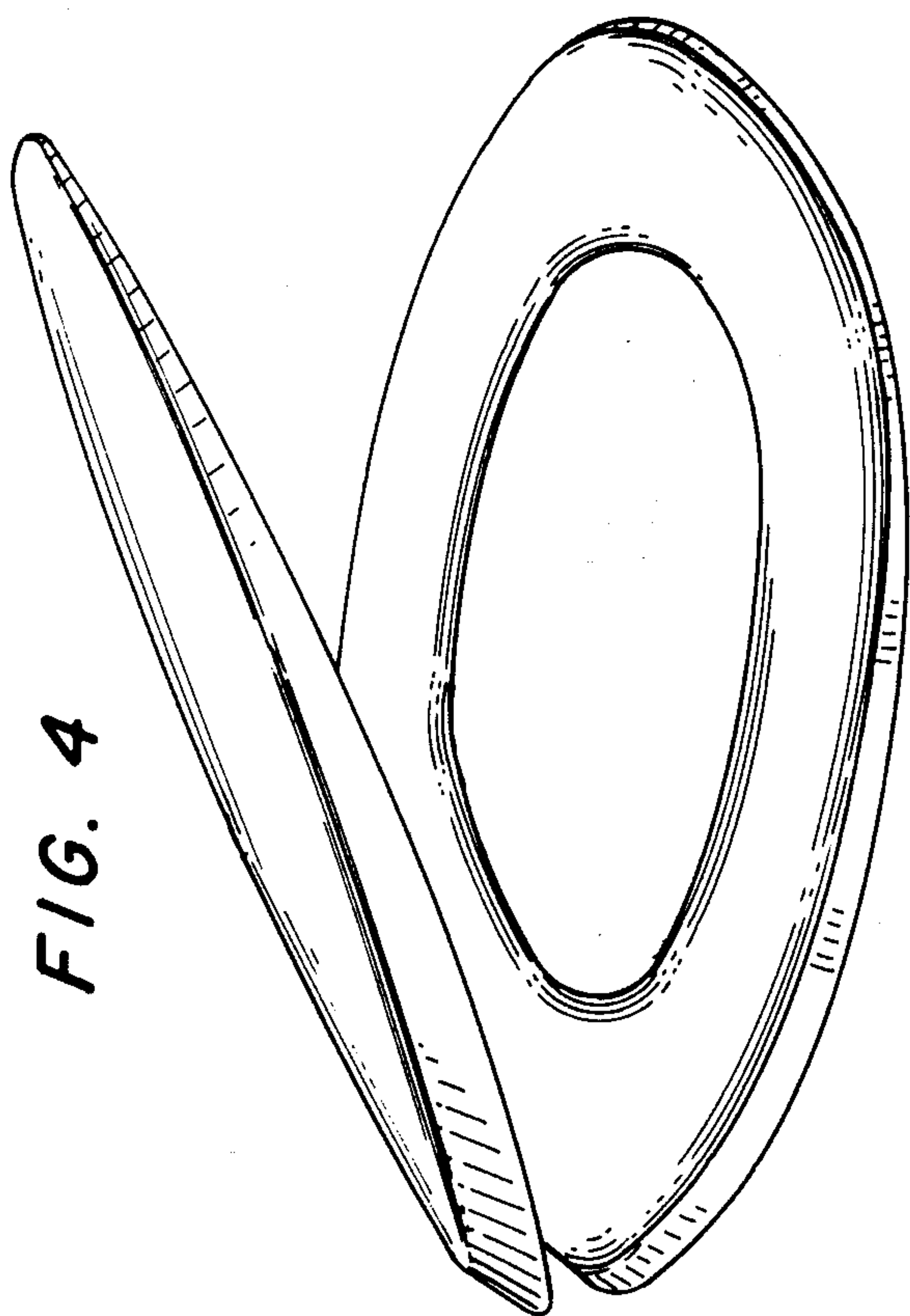
FIG. 3 is a perspective view taken from the top and

side thereof, showing the cover in an open position;

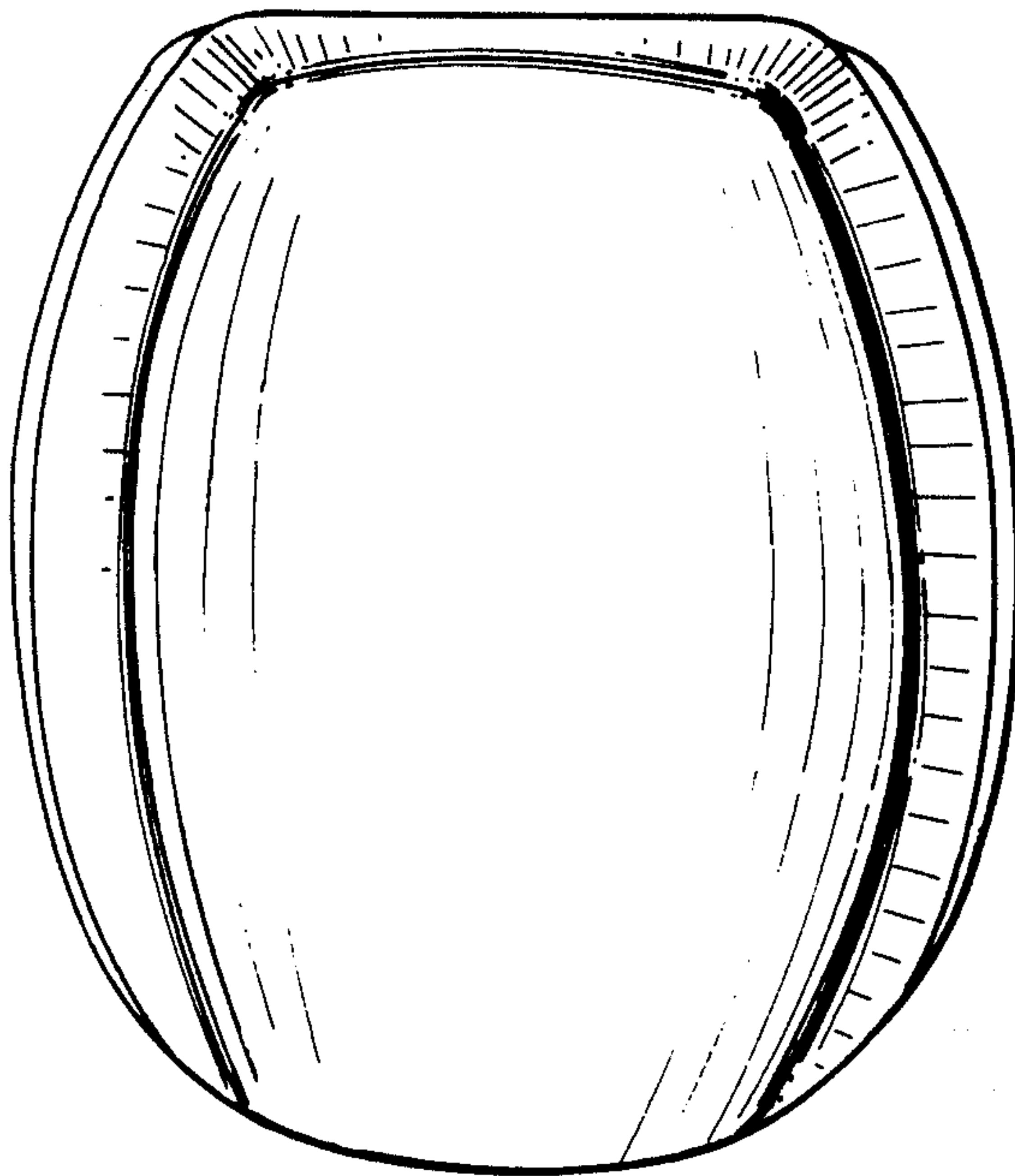
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and
