[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hair dryer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hair dryer showing our new design, the rear elevational view being a mirror image;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view thereof.

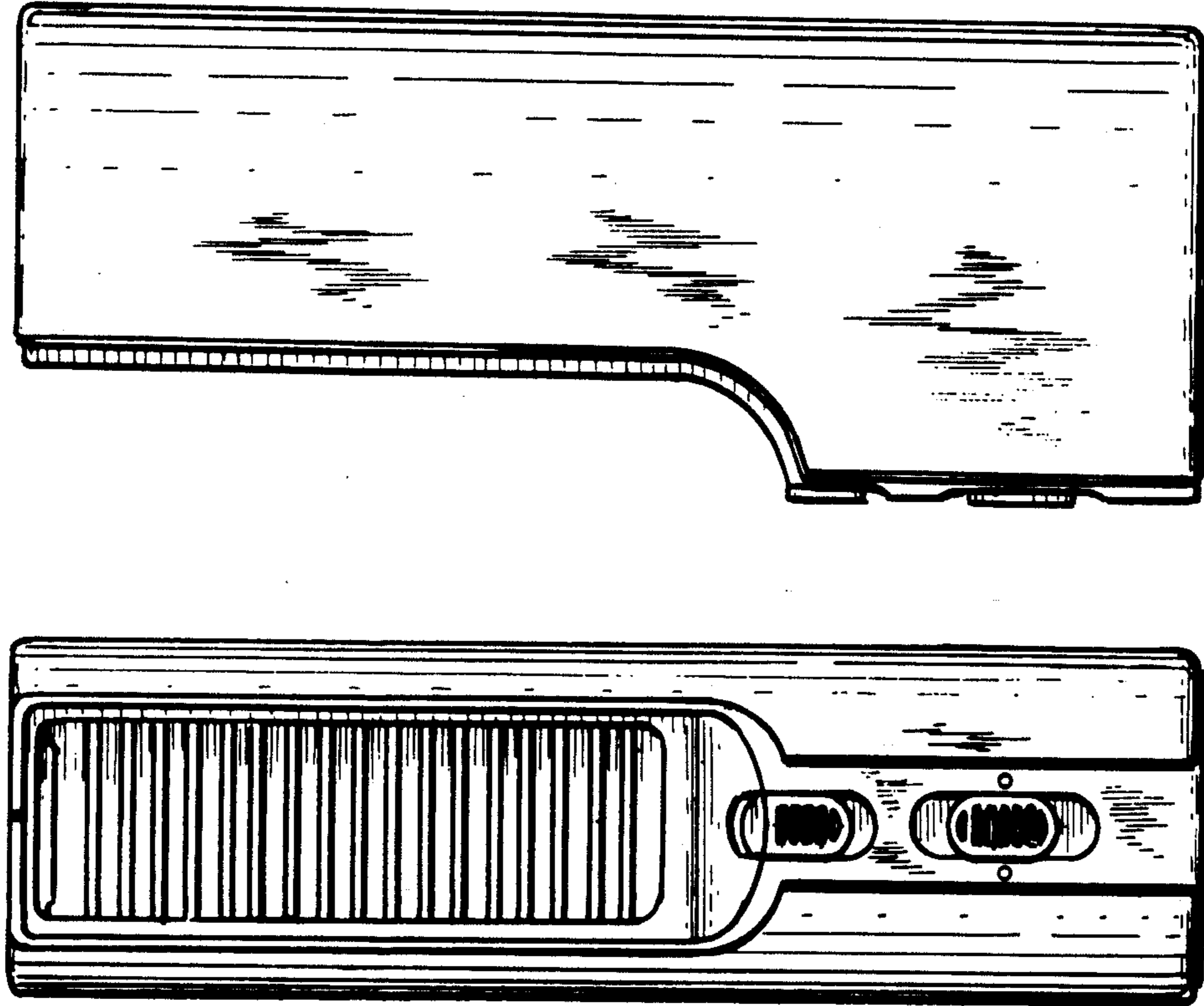

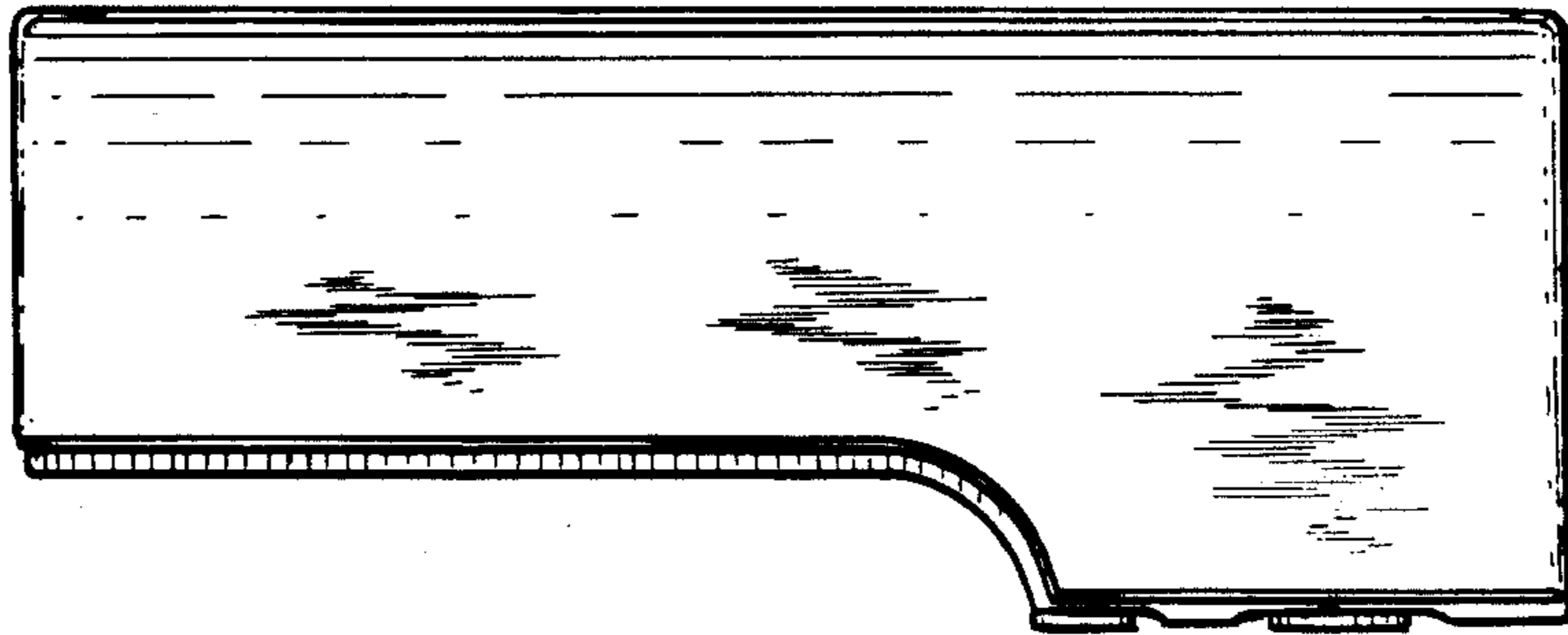

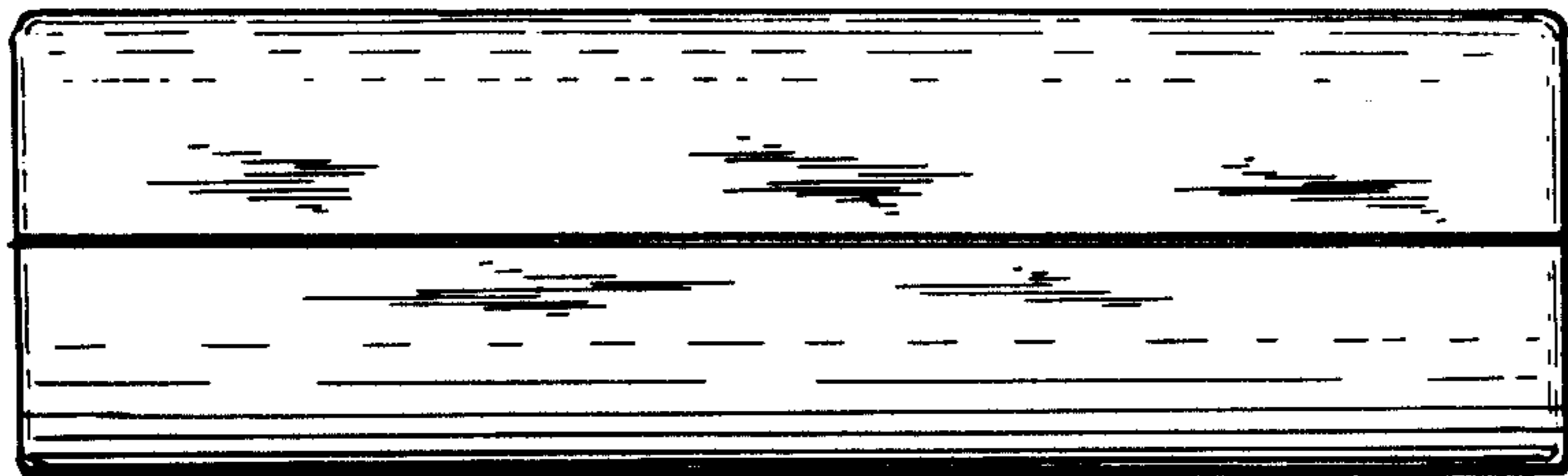

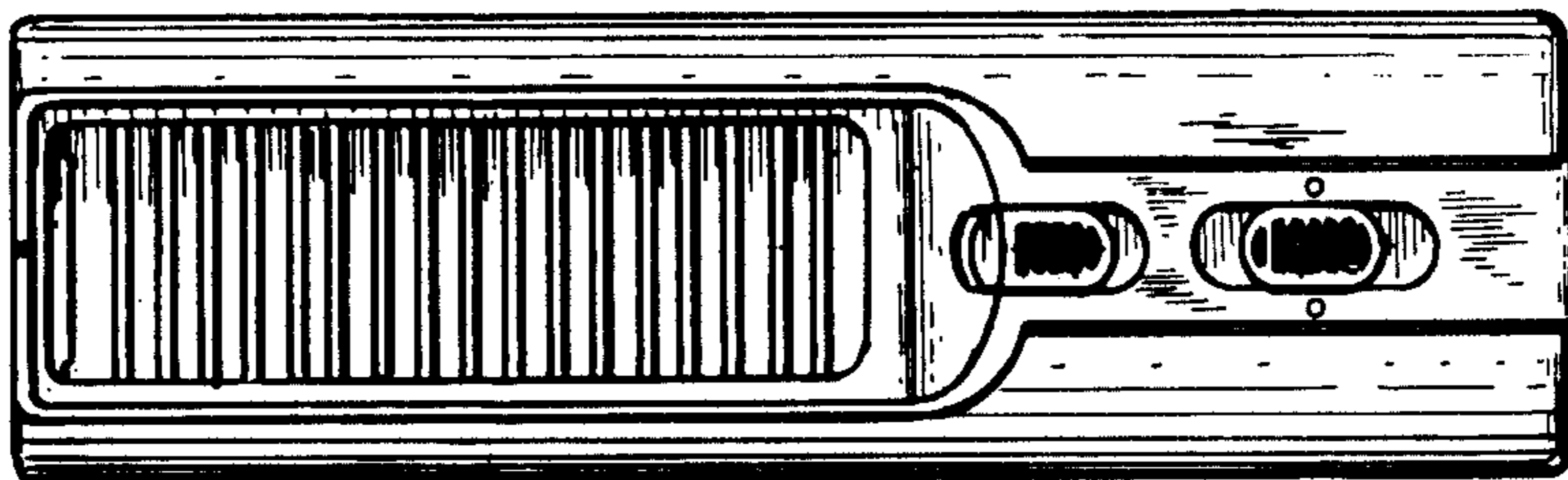

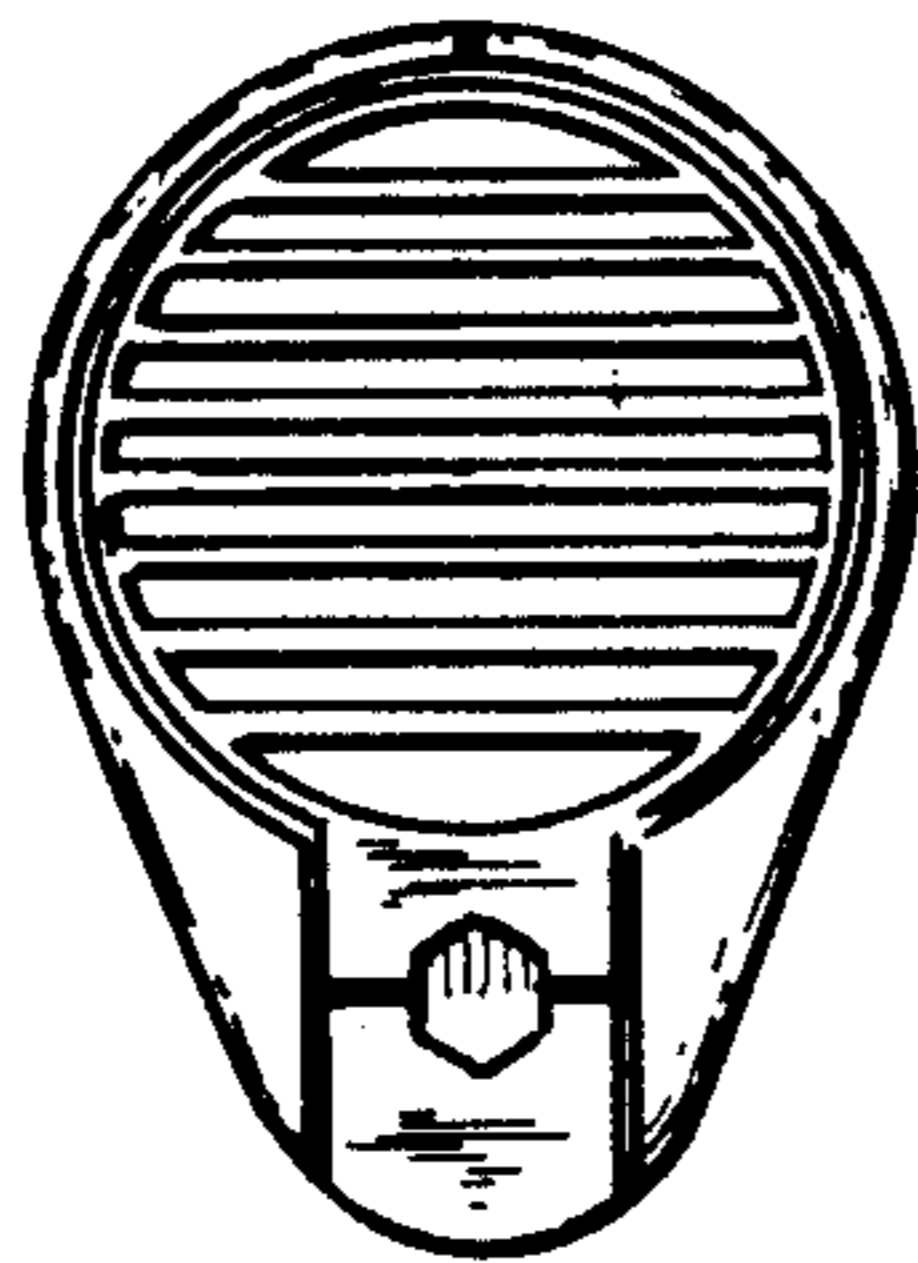
