DESCRIPTION

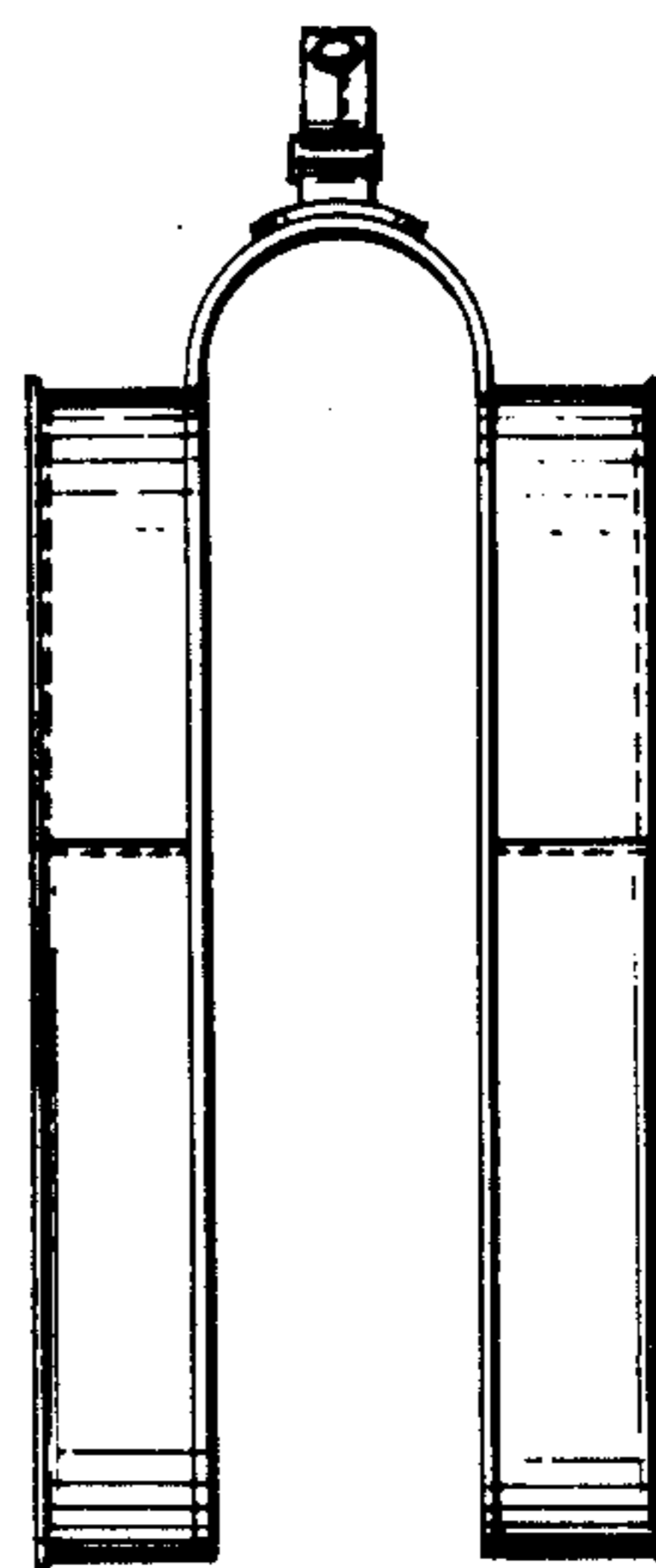
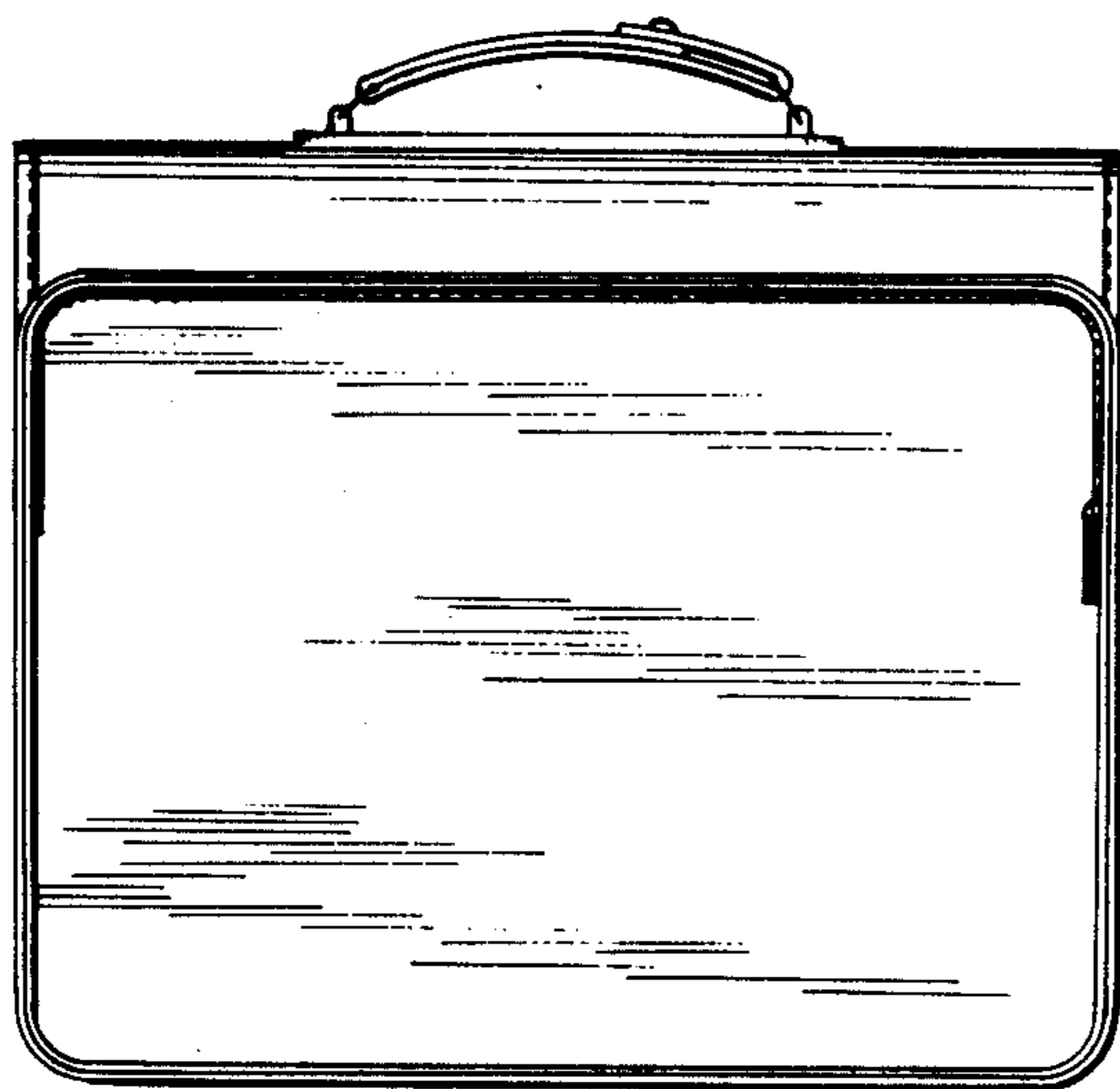
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an auxiliary suitcase or similar article showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof in a fully extended condition.



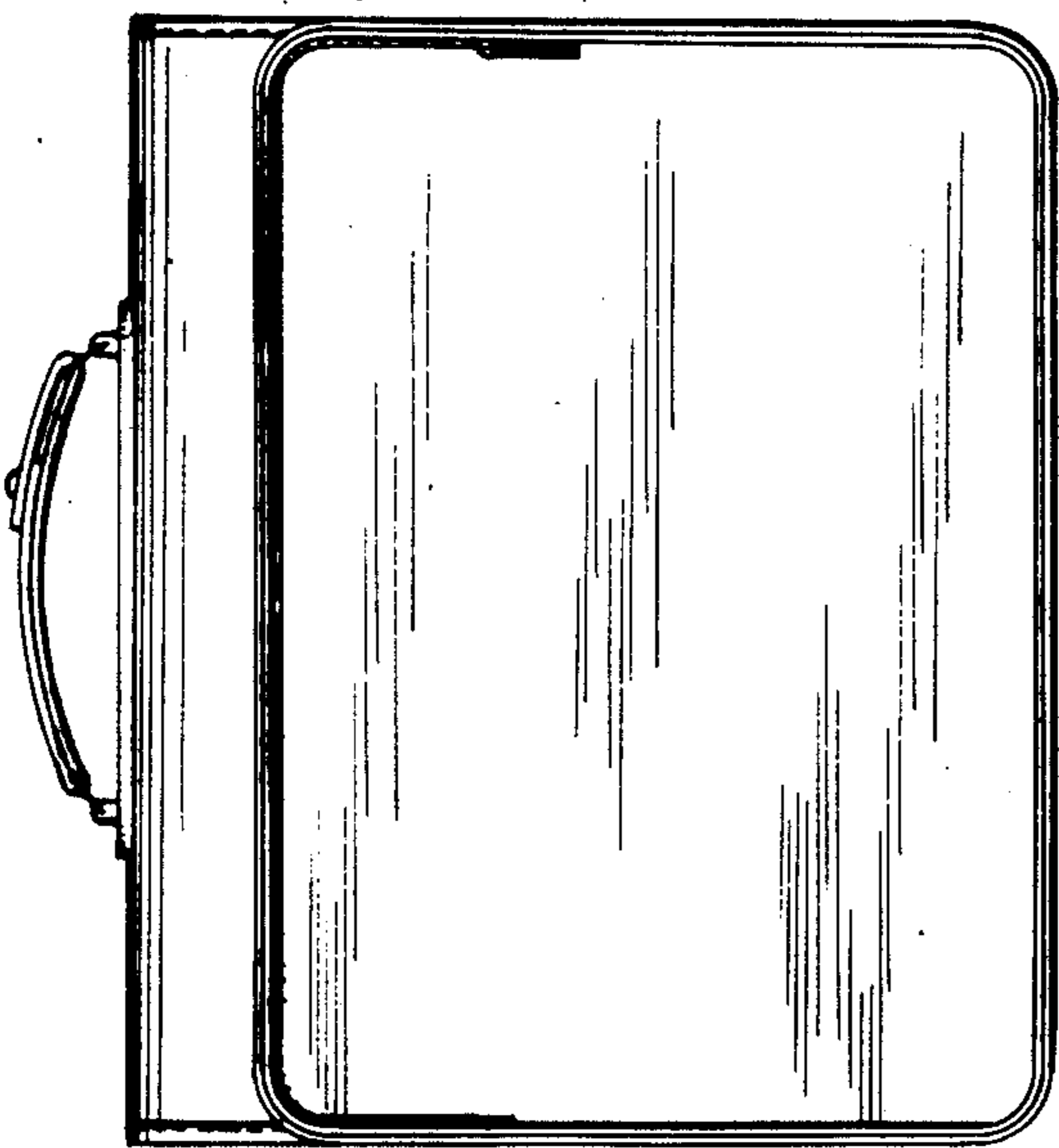

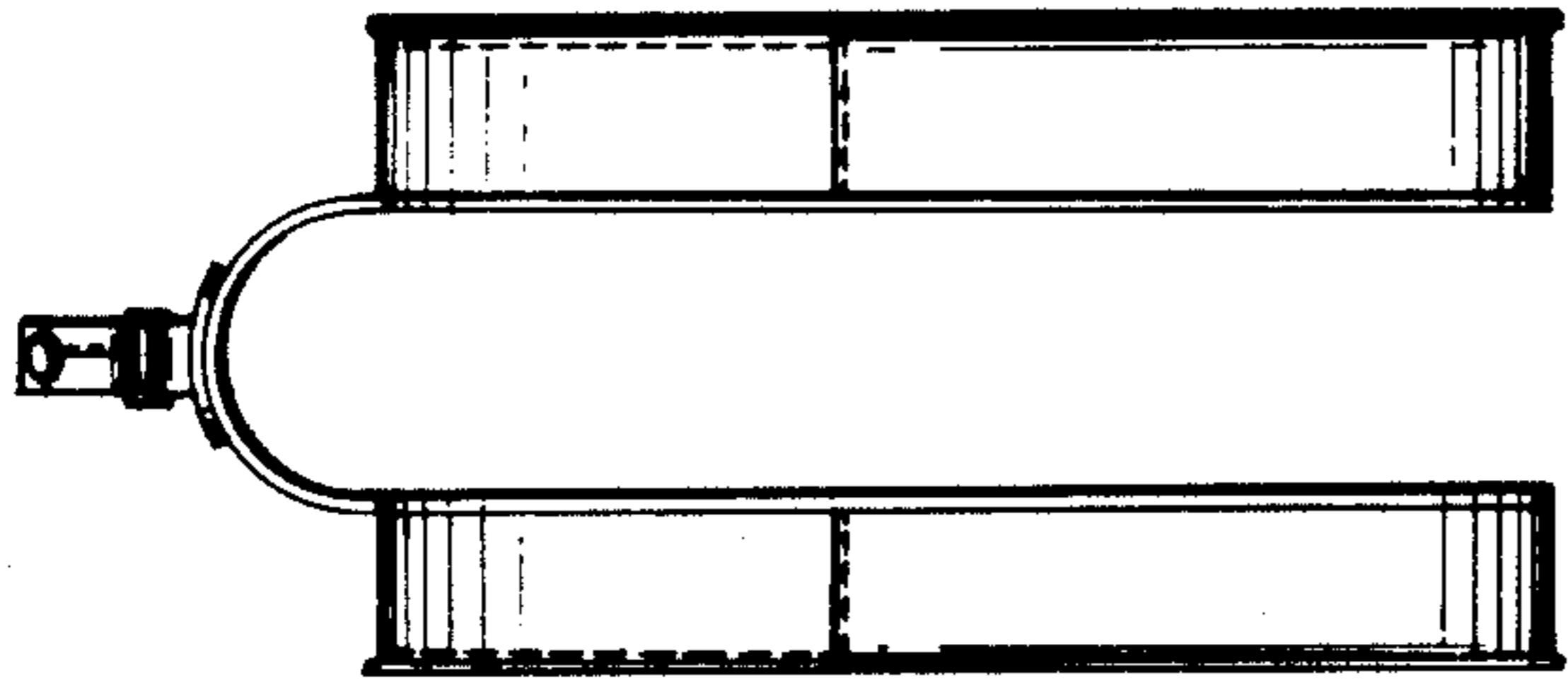

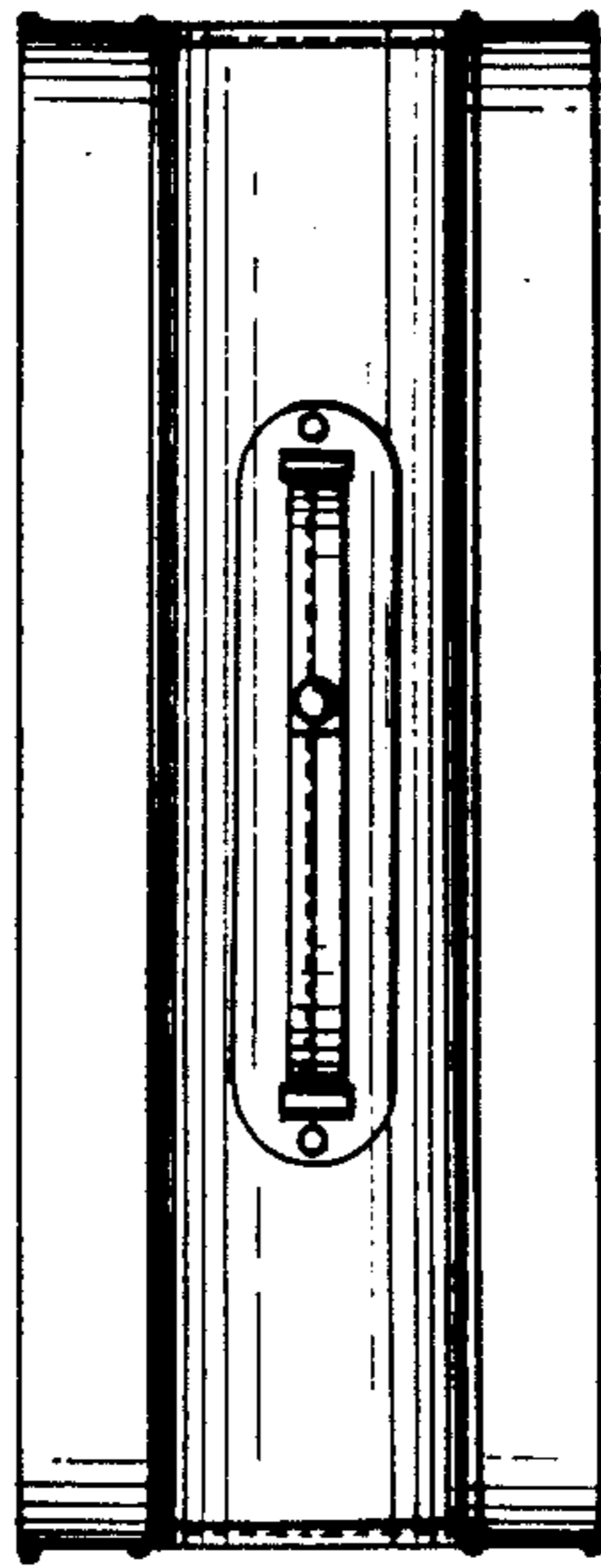

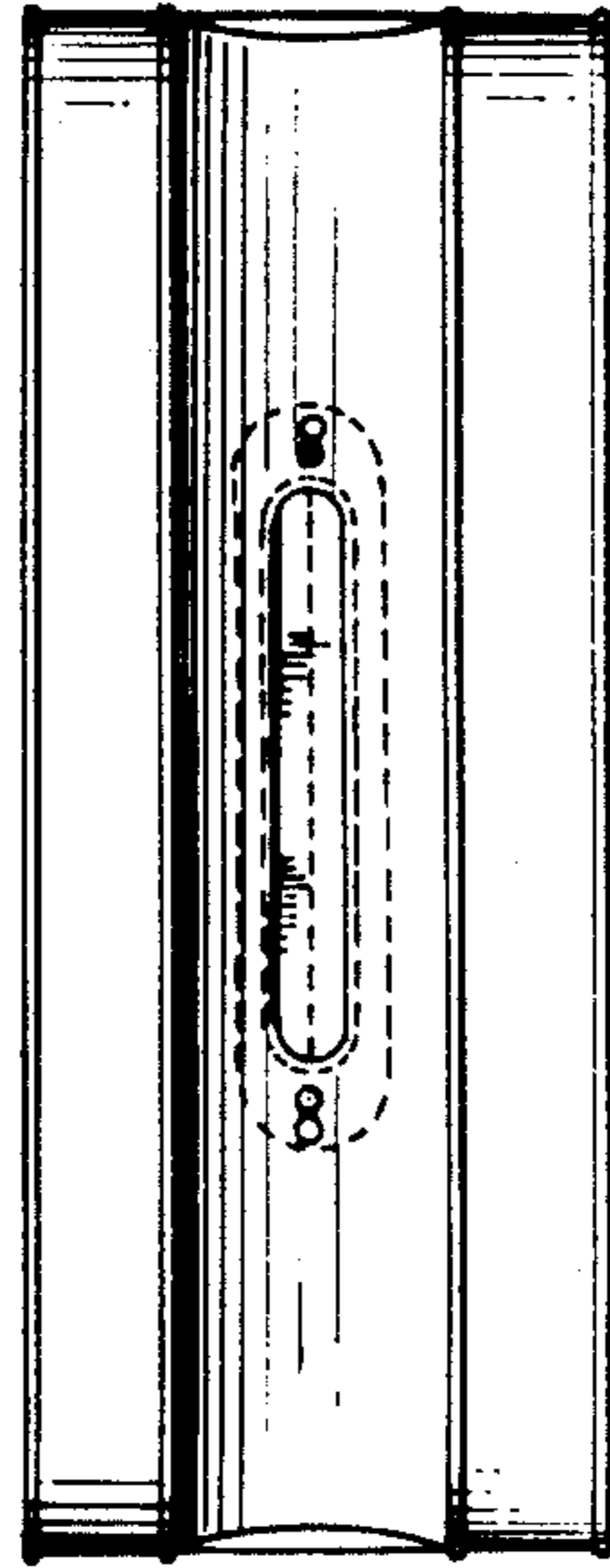

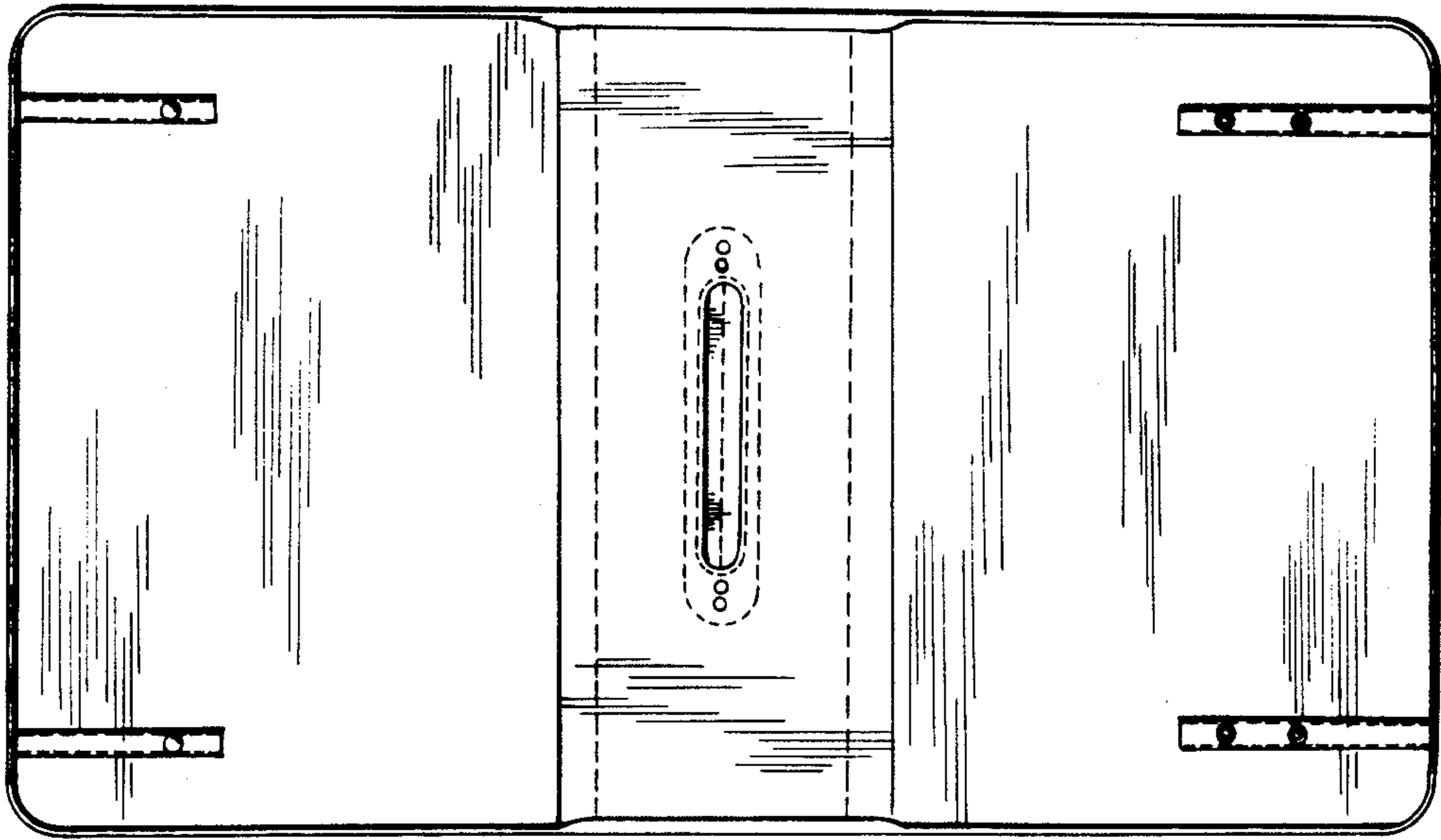
