DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a juicer showing our
new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof.

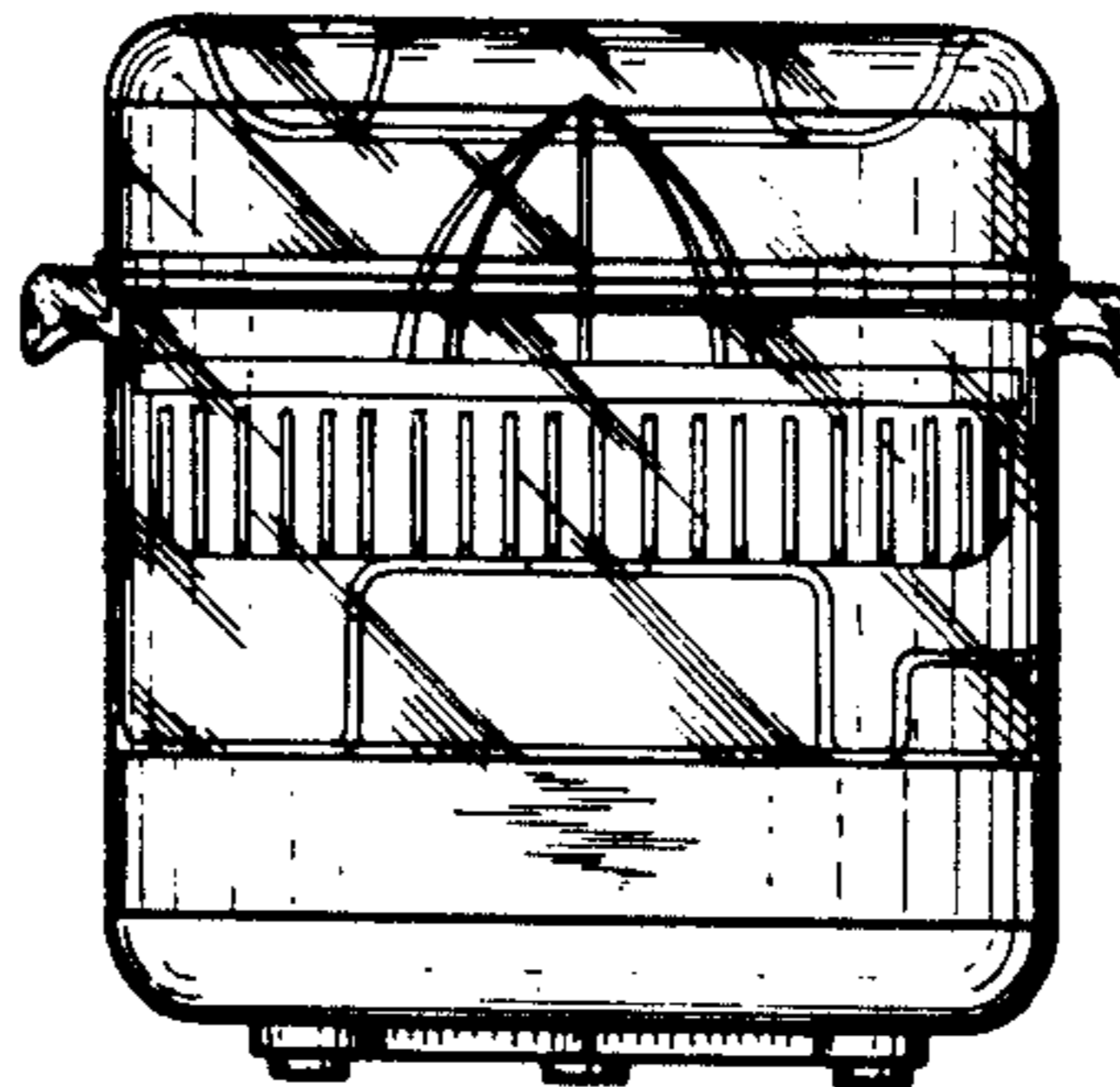
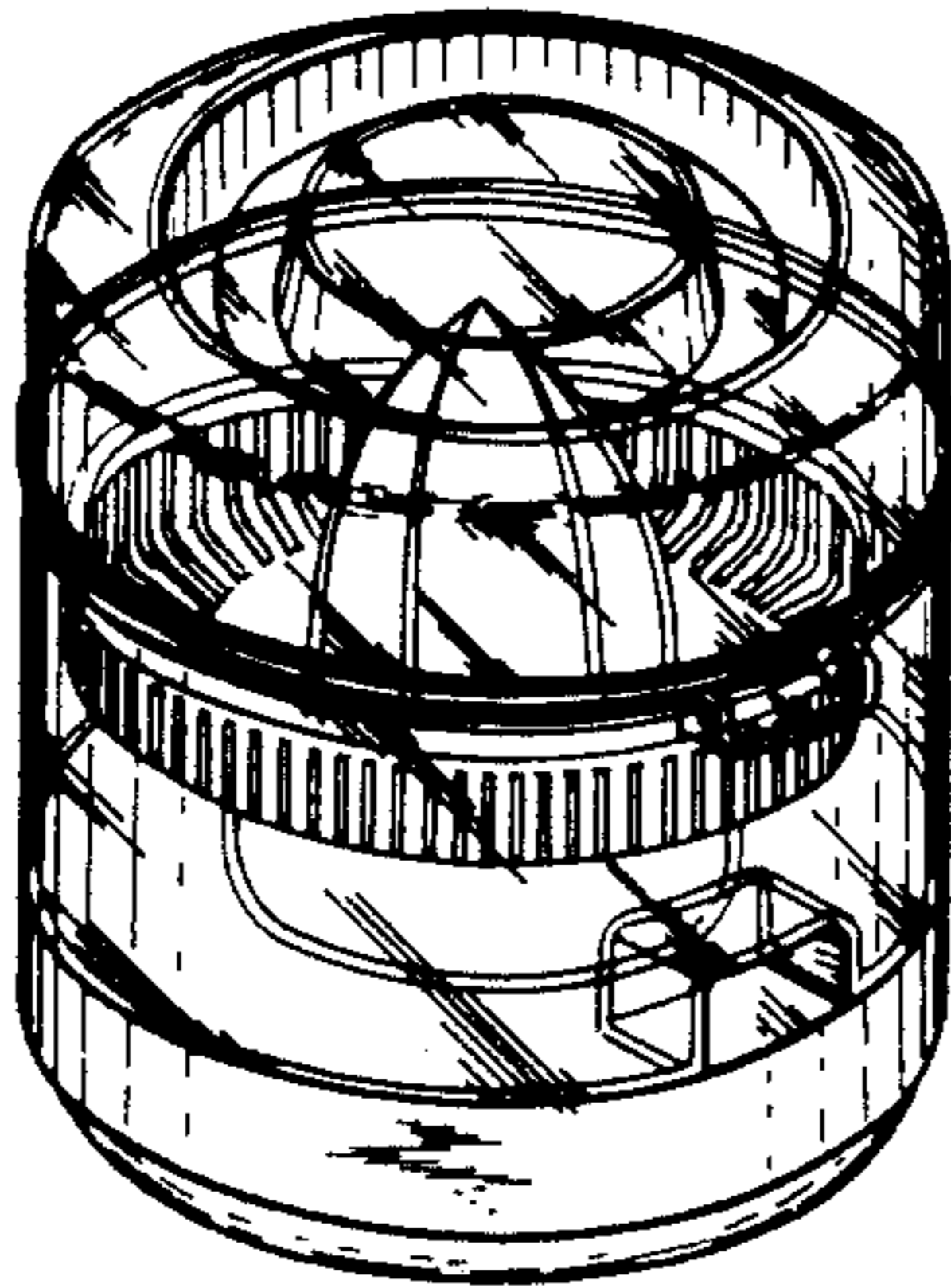

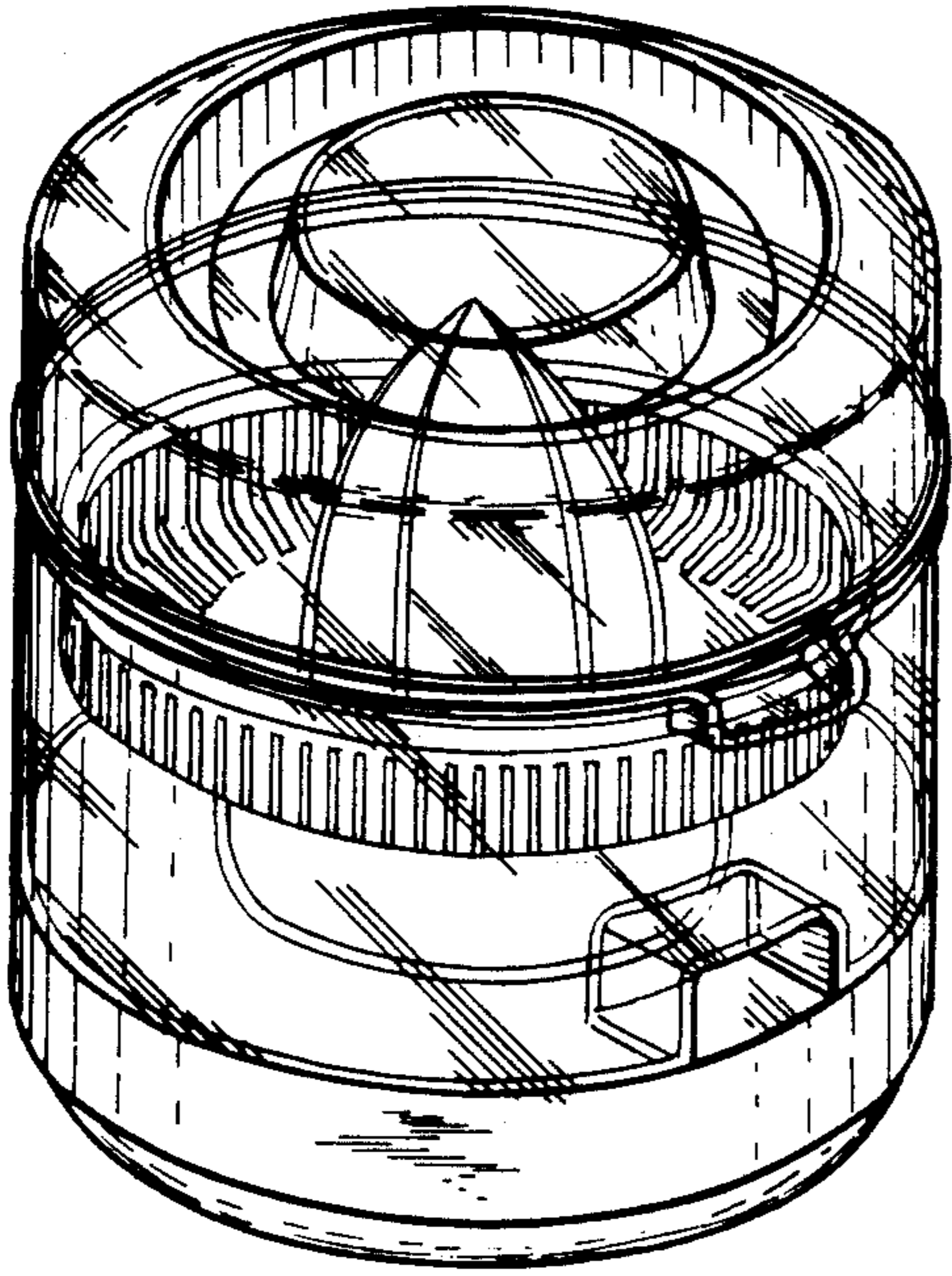

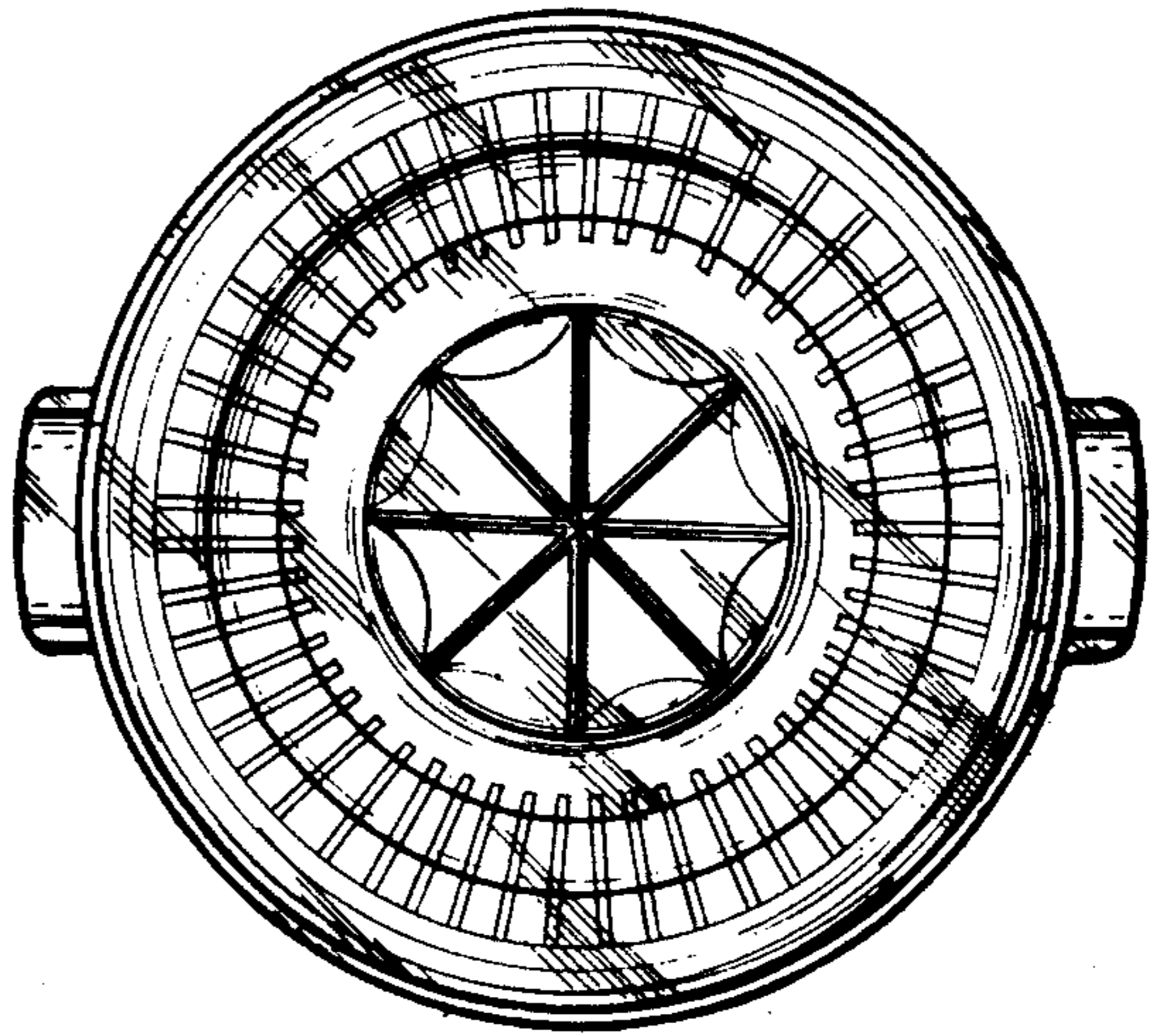

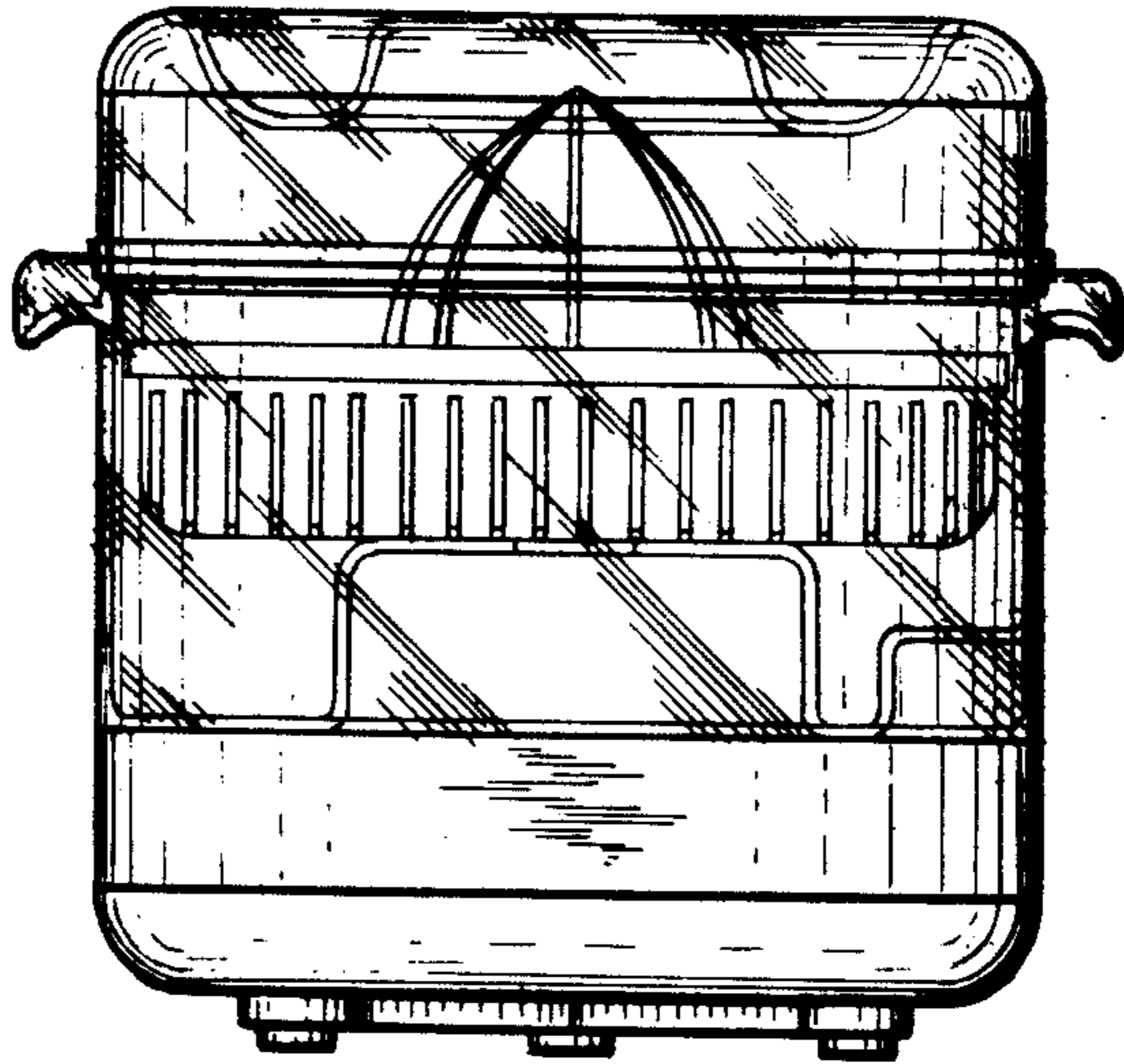

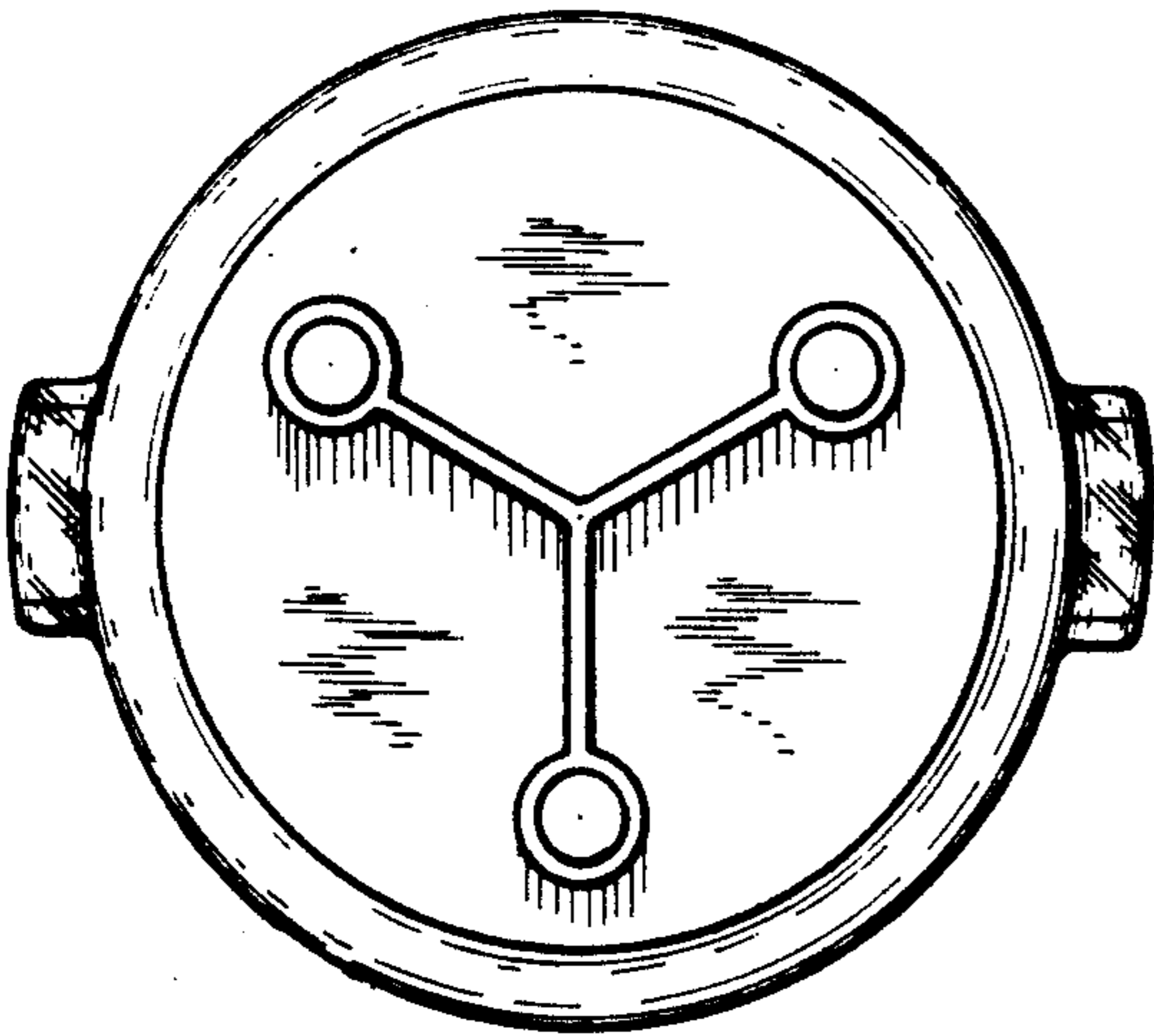

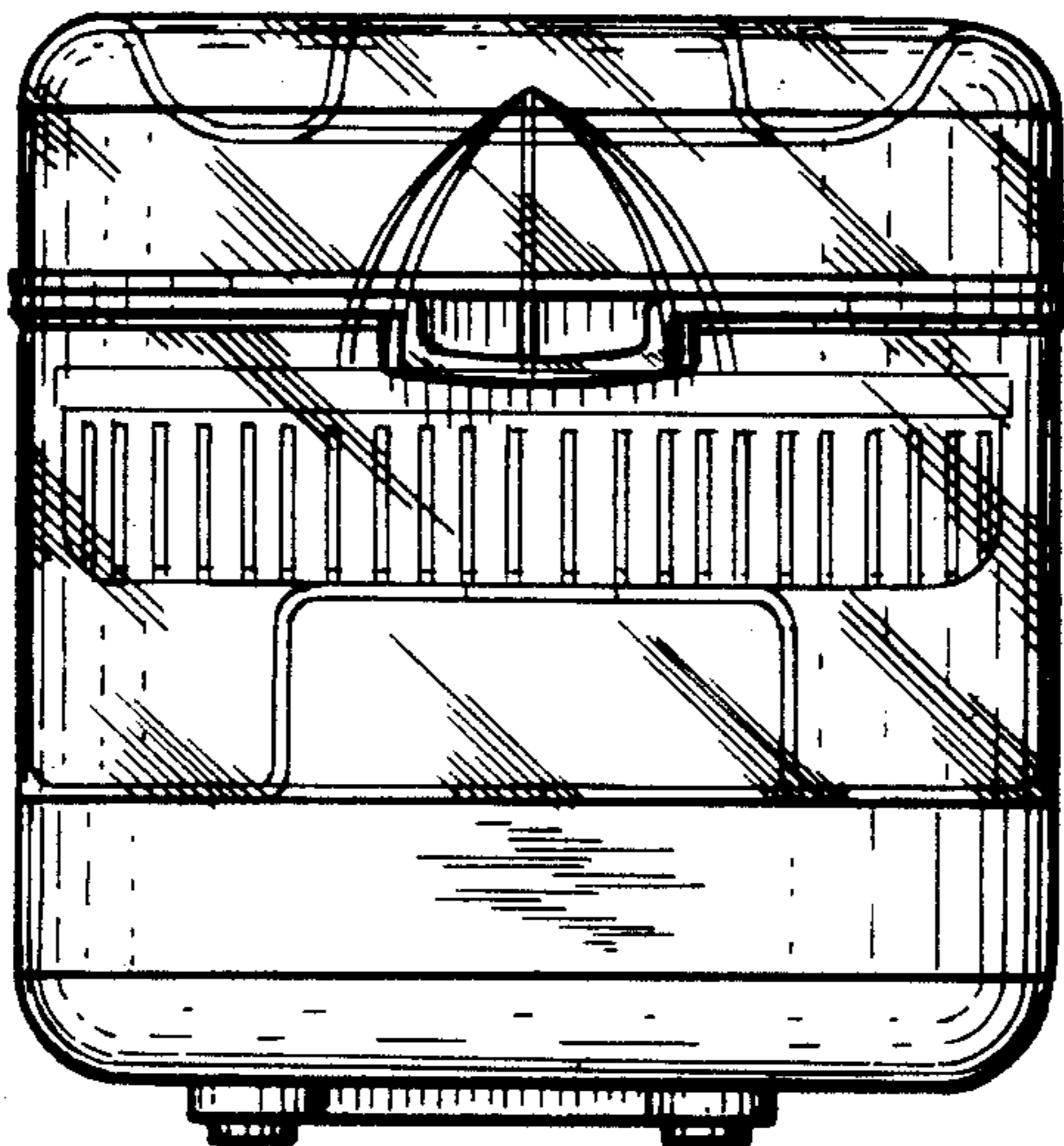
