[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined toy projector and arrow therefore, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

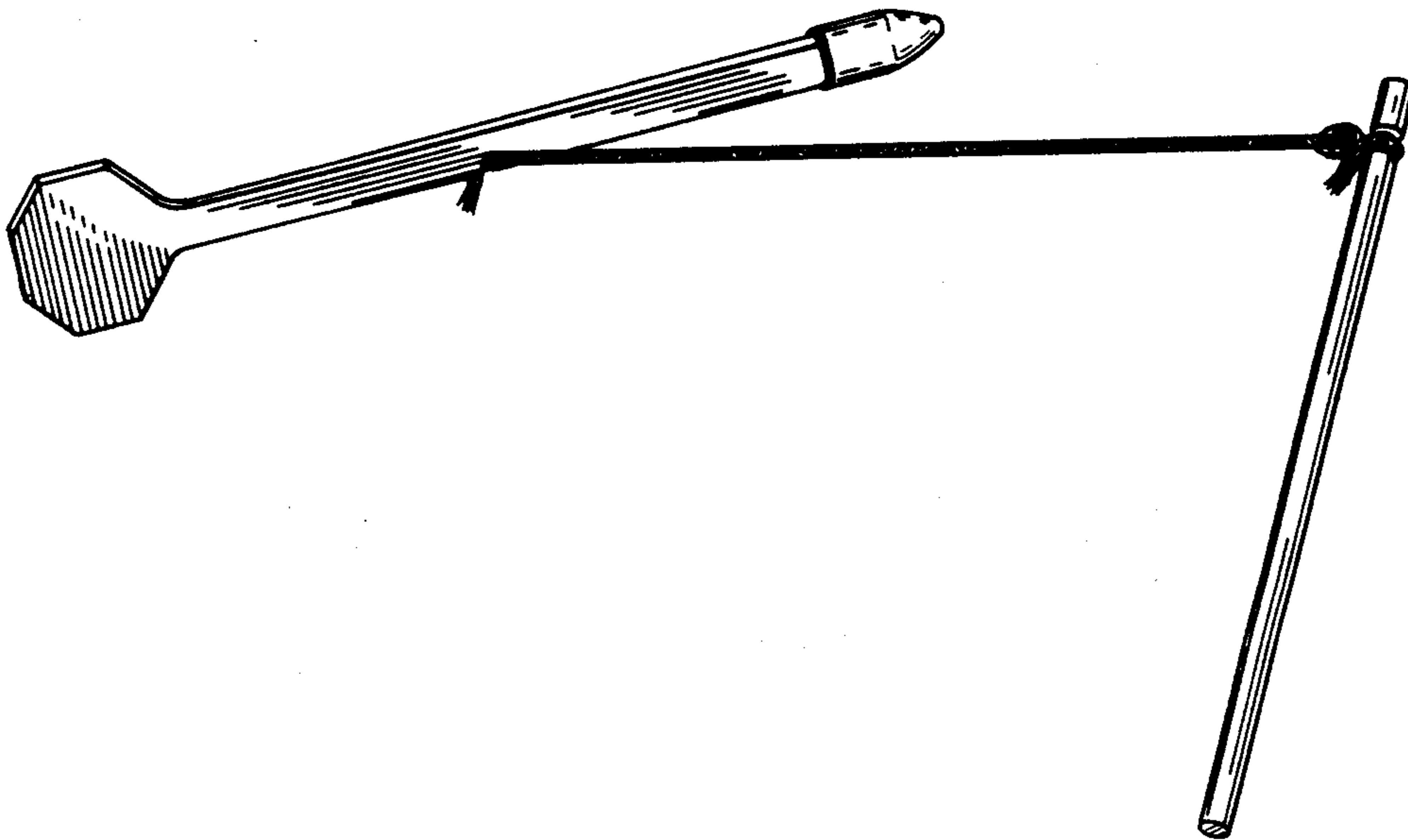

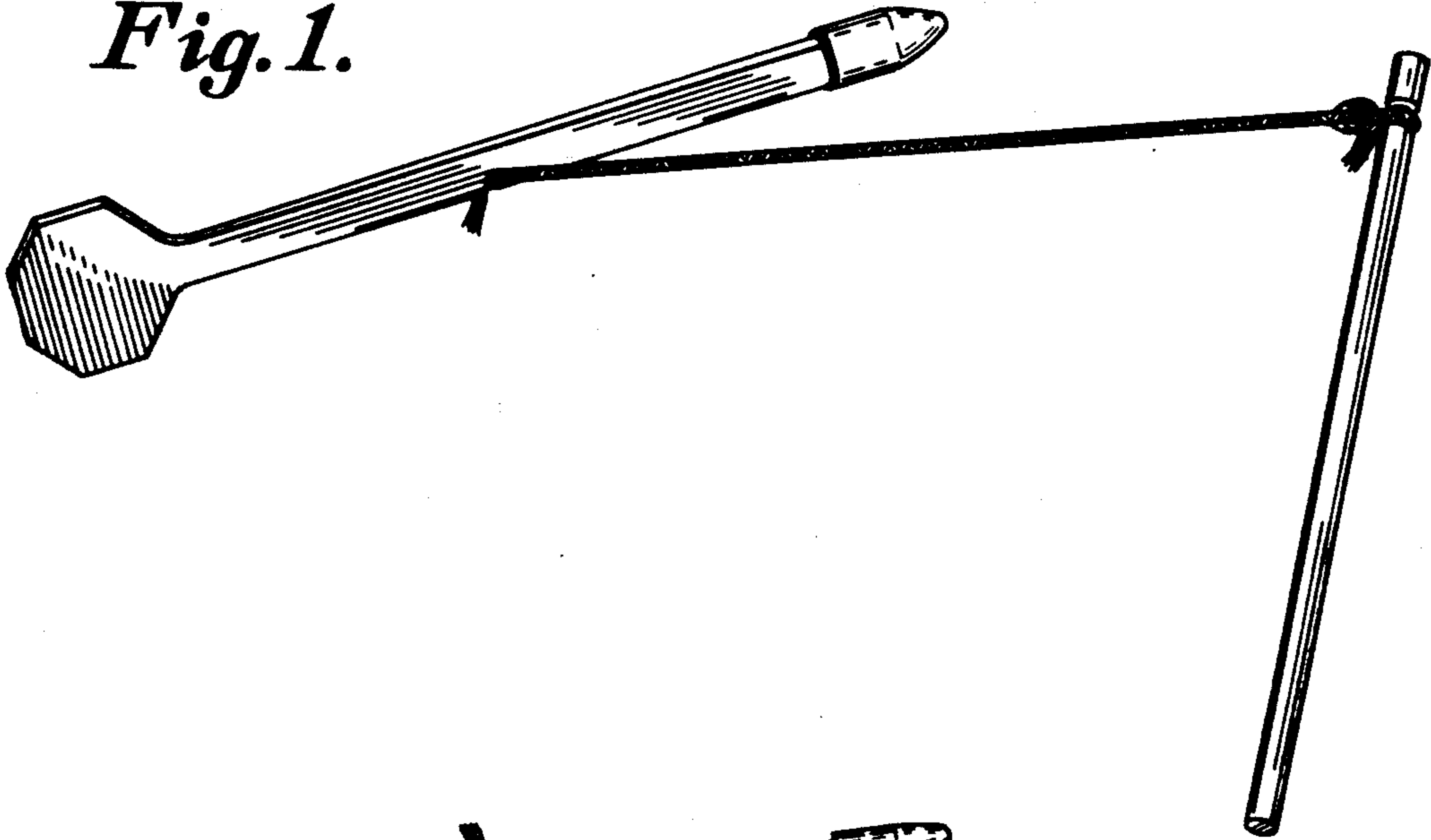

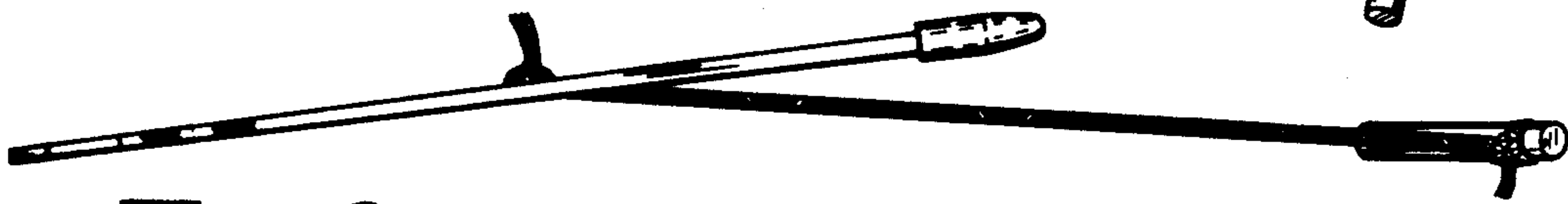
