[57] CLAIM

The new and ornamental design for retail sales building, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a retail sales building showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is an end view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, taken from the side opposite the side shown in FIG. 2.

FIG. 5 is an end elevational view thereof, taken from the end thereof opposite the end shown in FIG. 3.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing a modification in the retail sales building of this invention.

FIG. 7 is a perspective view showing another modification in the retail sales building of this invention.

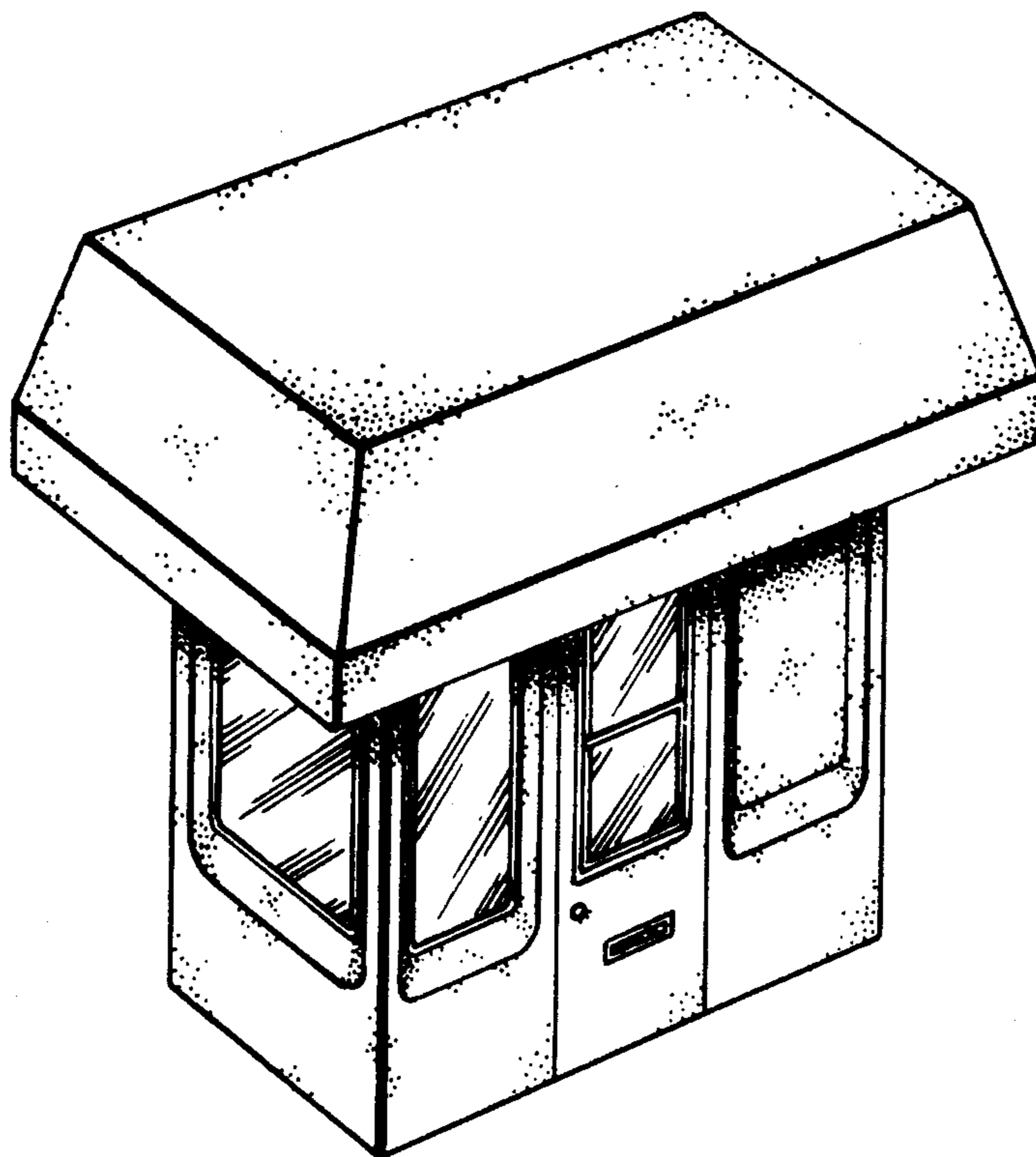

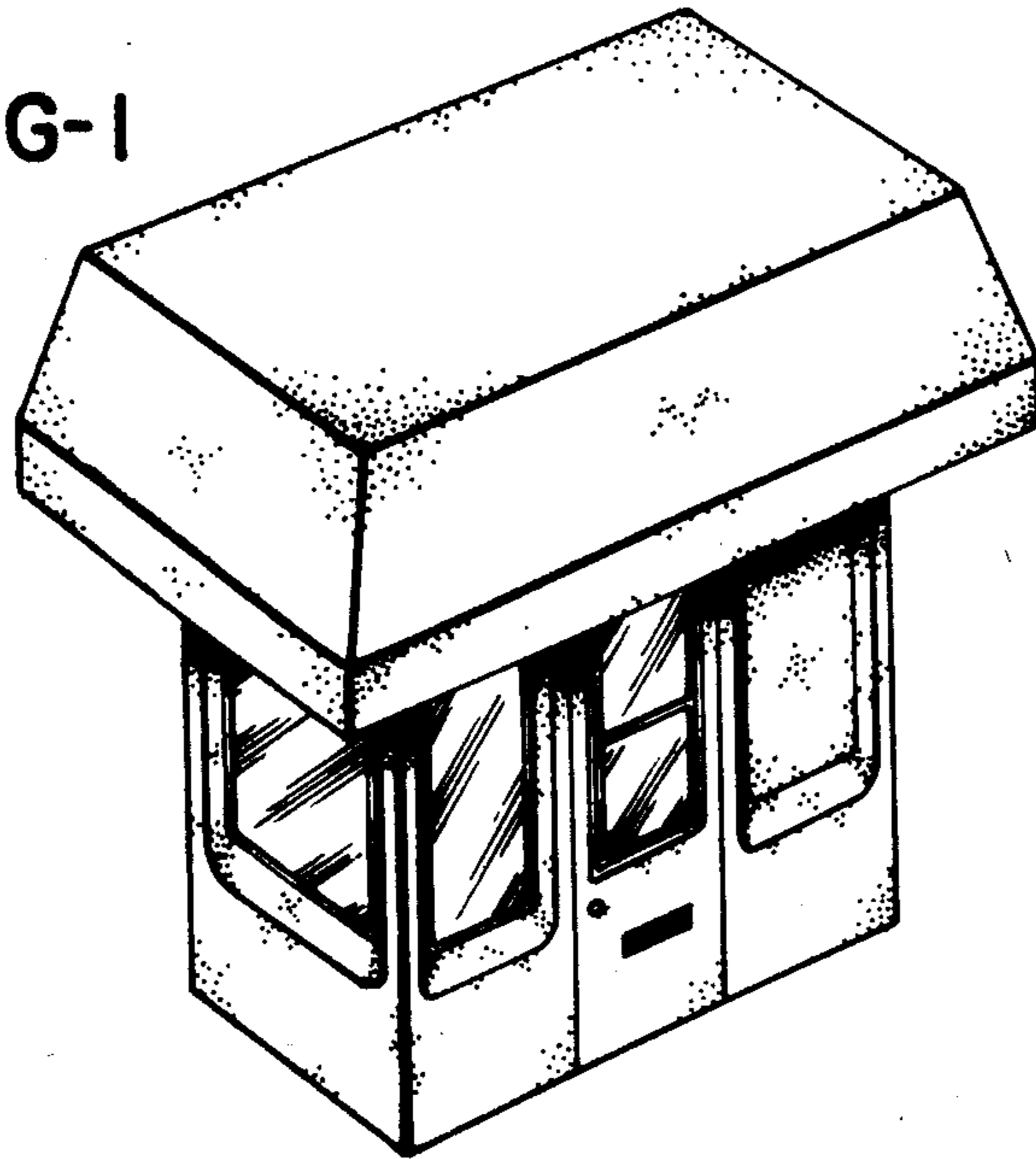

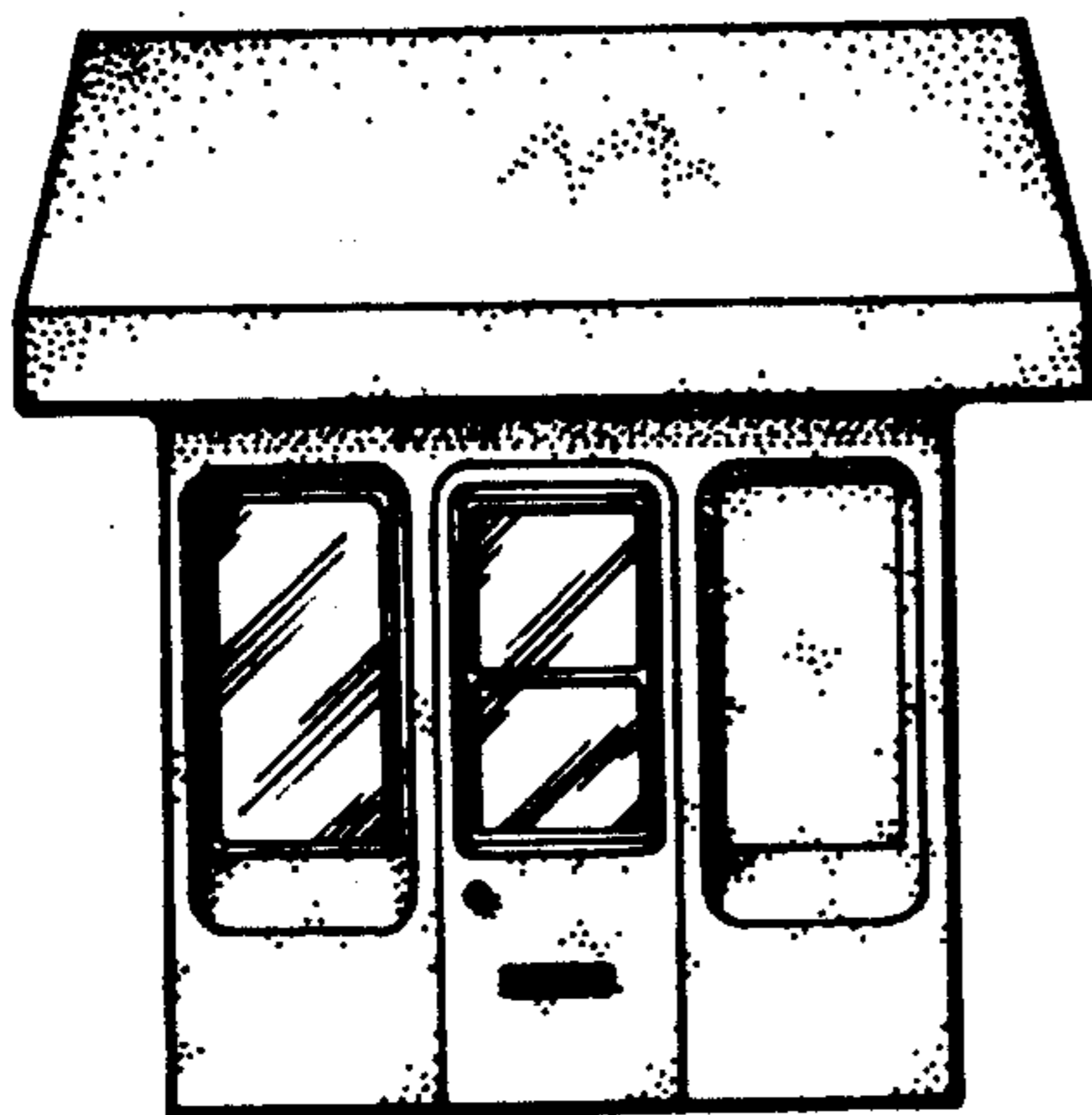

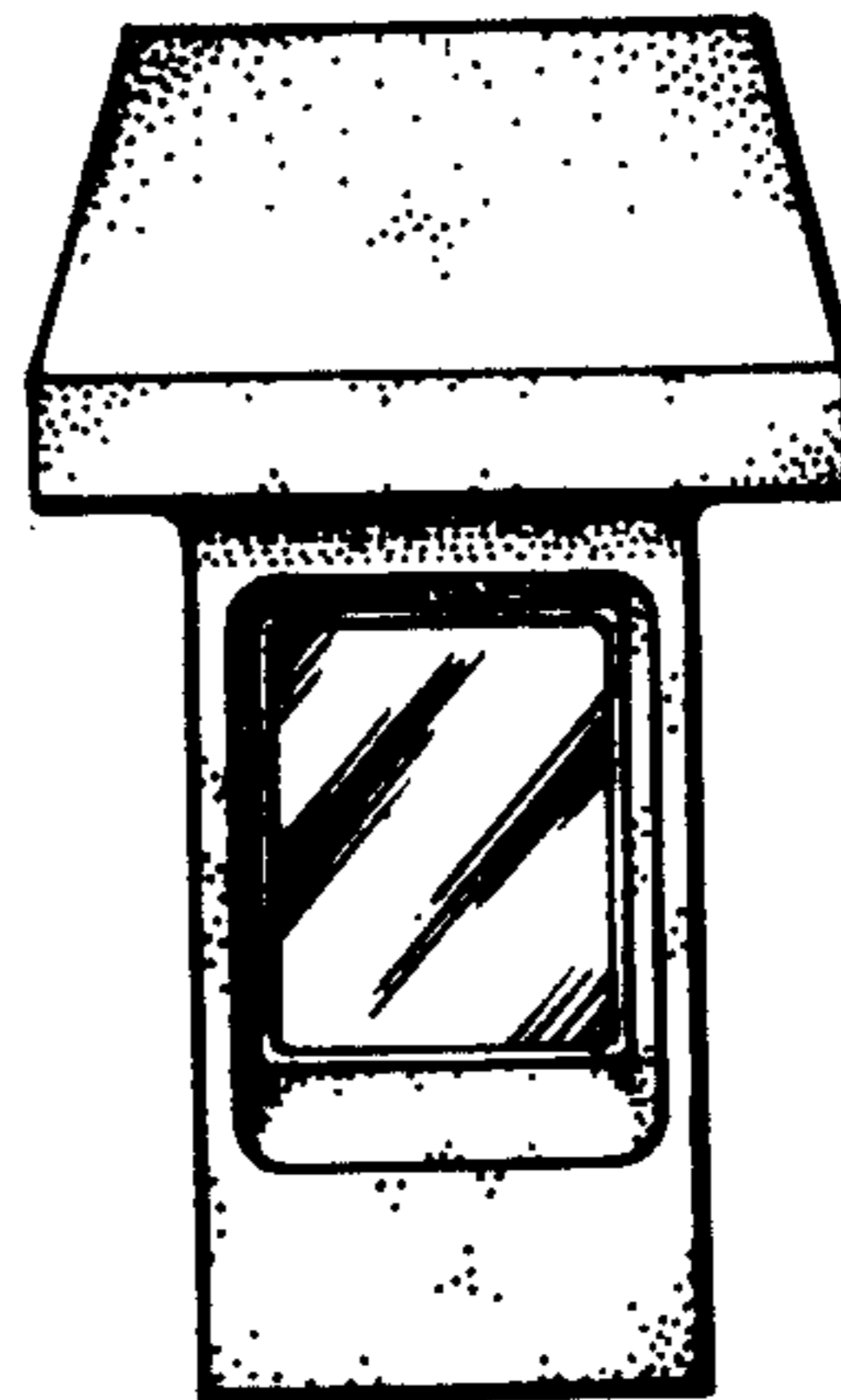

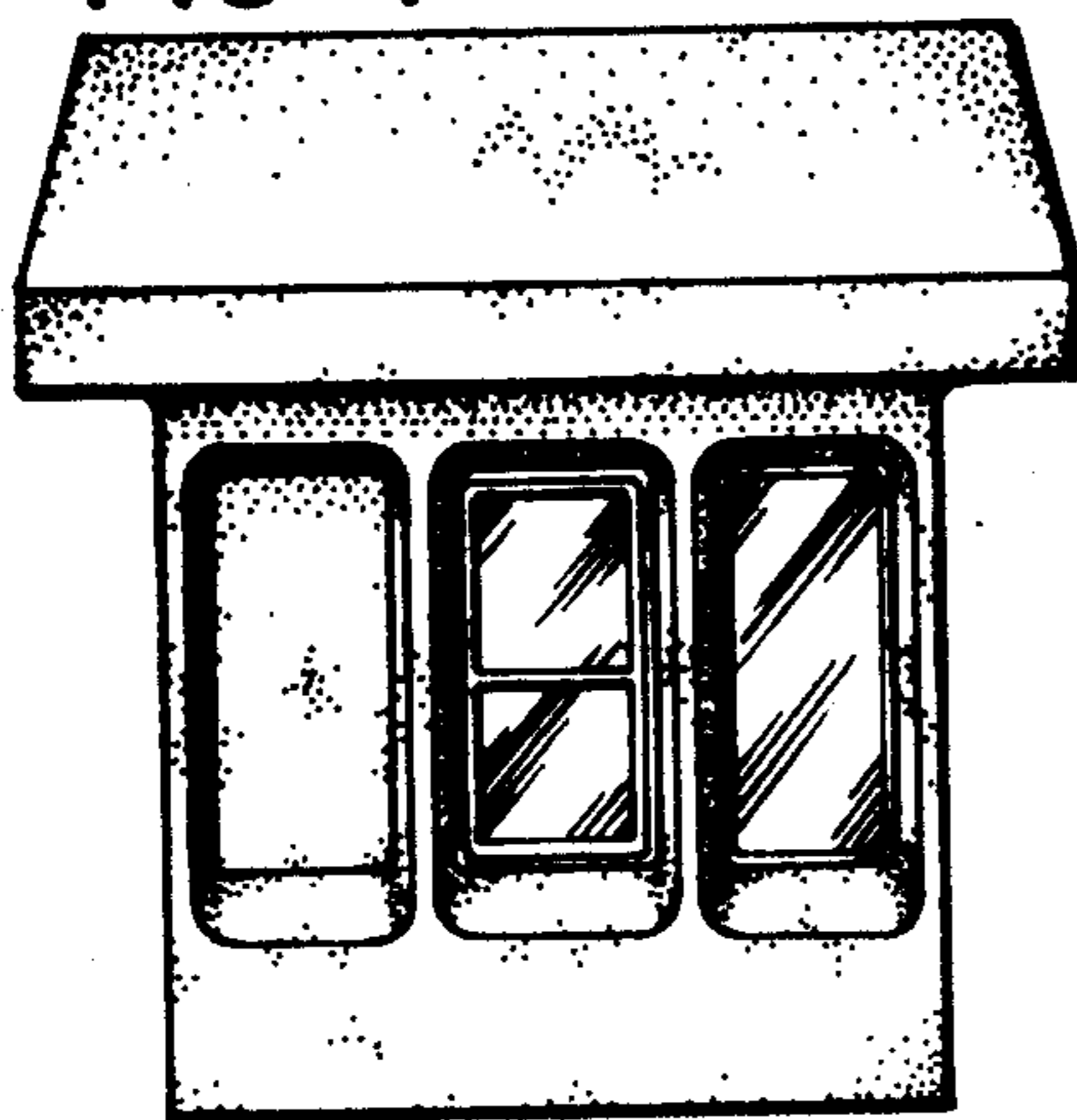

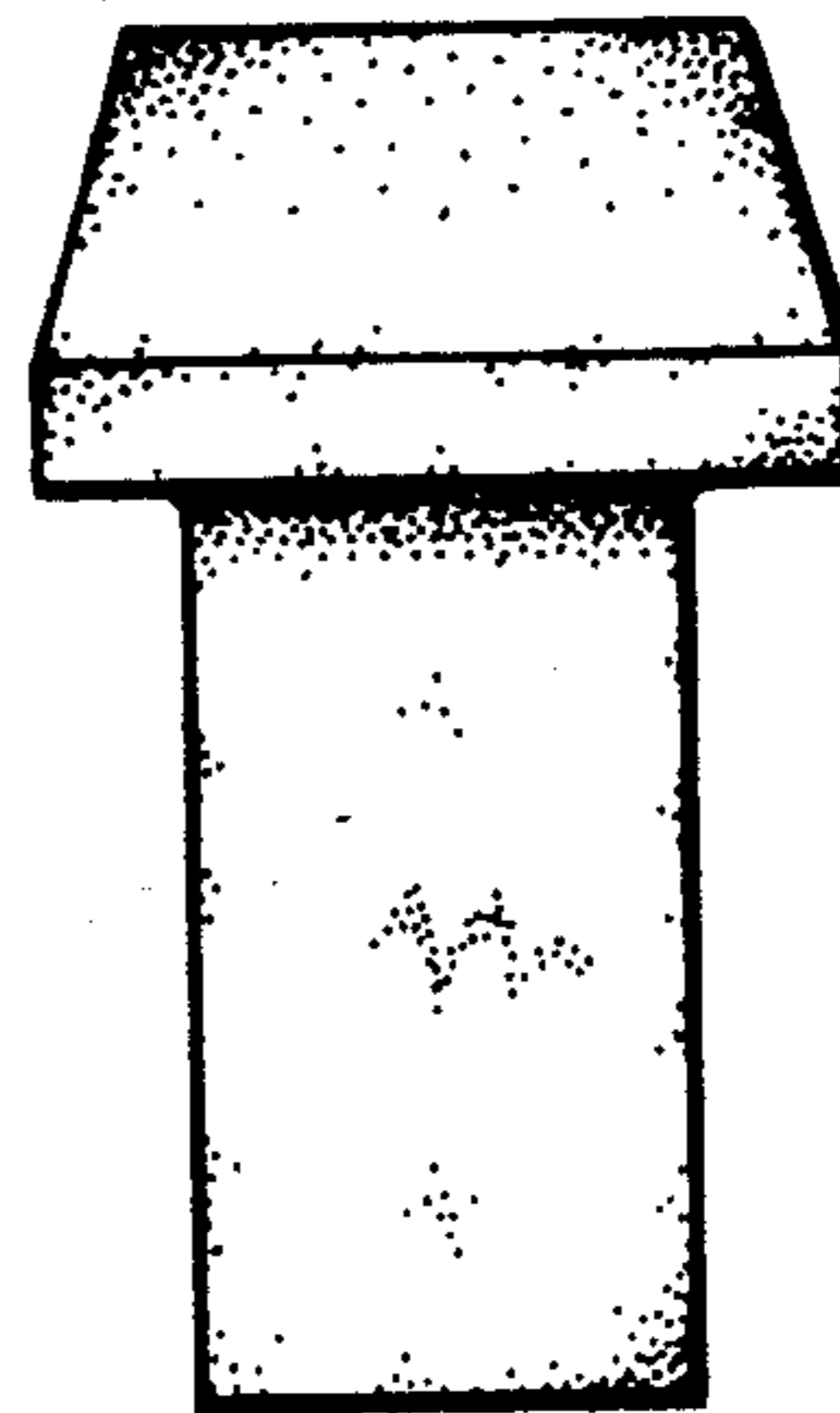

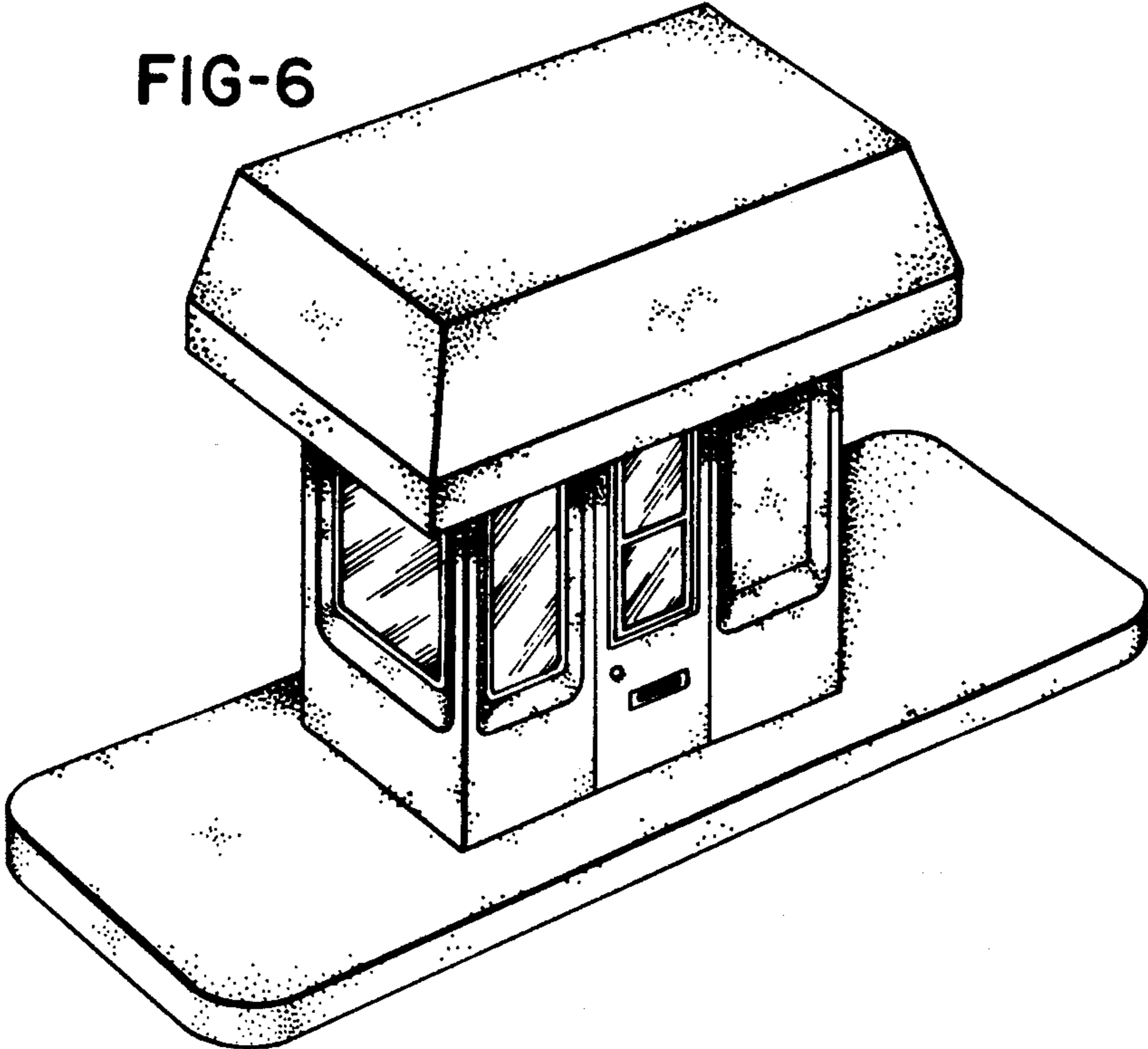
