FIG. 5 is an end elevational view from the right of FIG. 2.

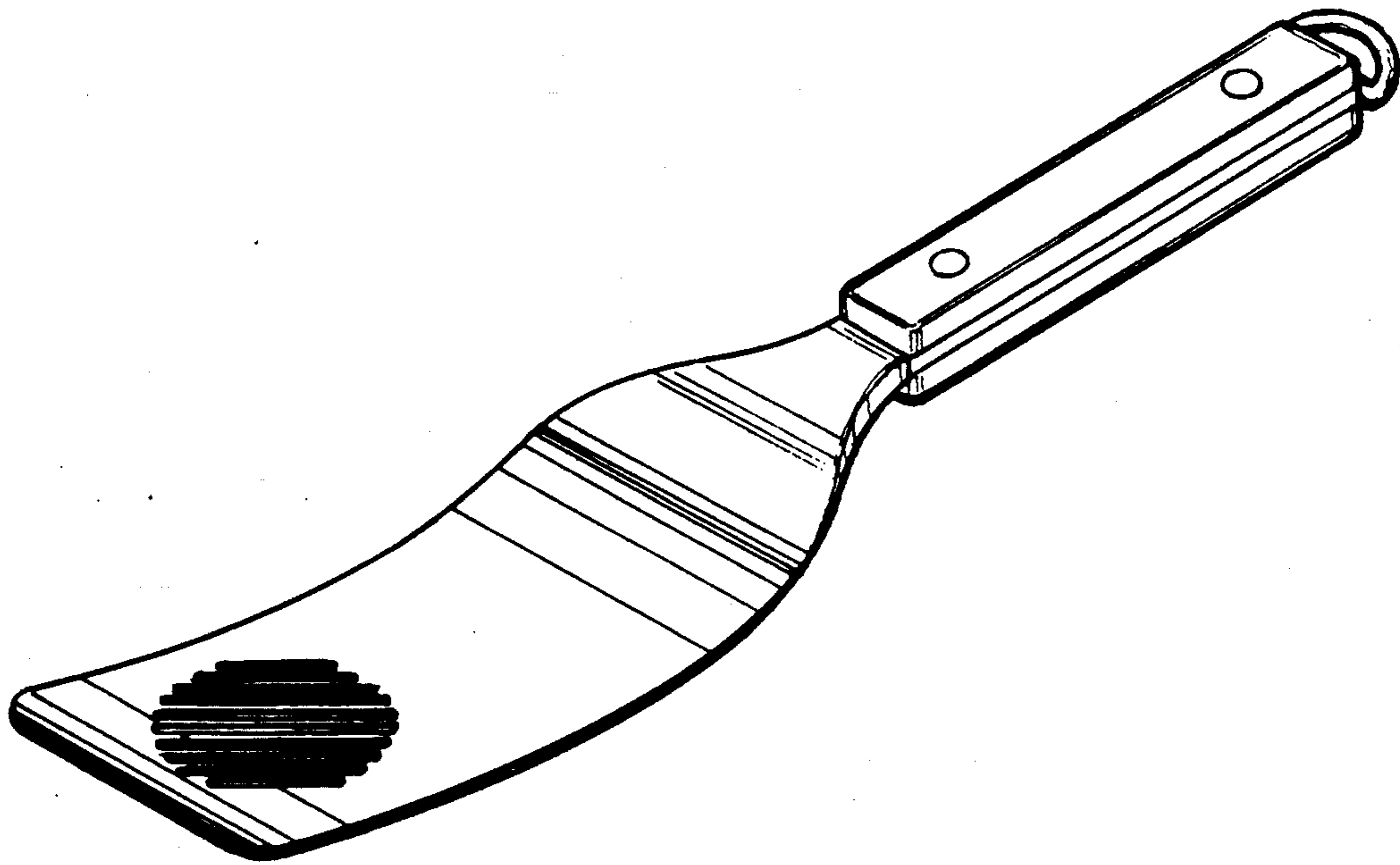

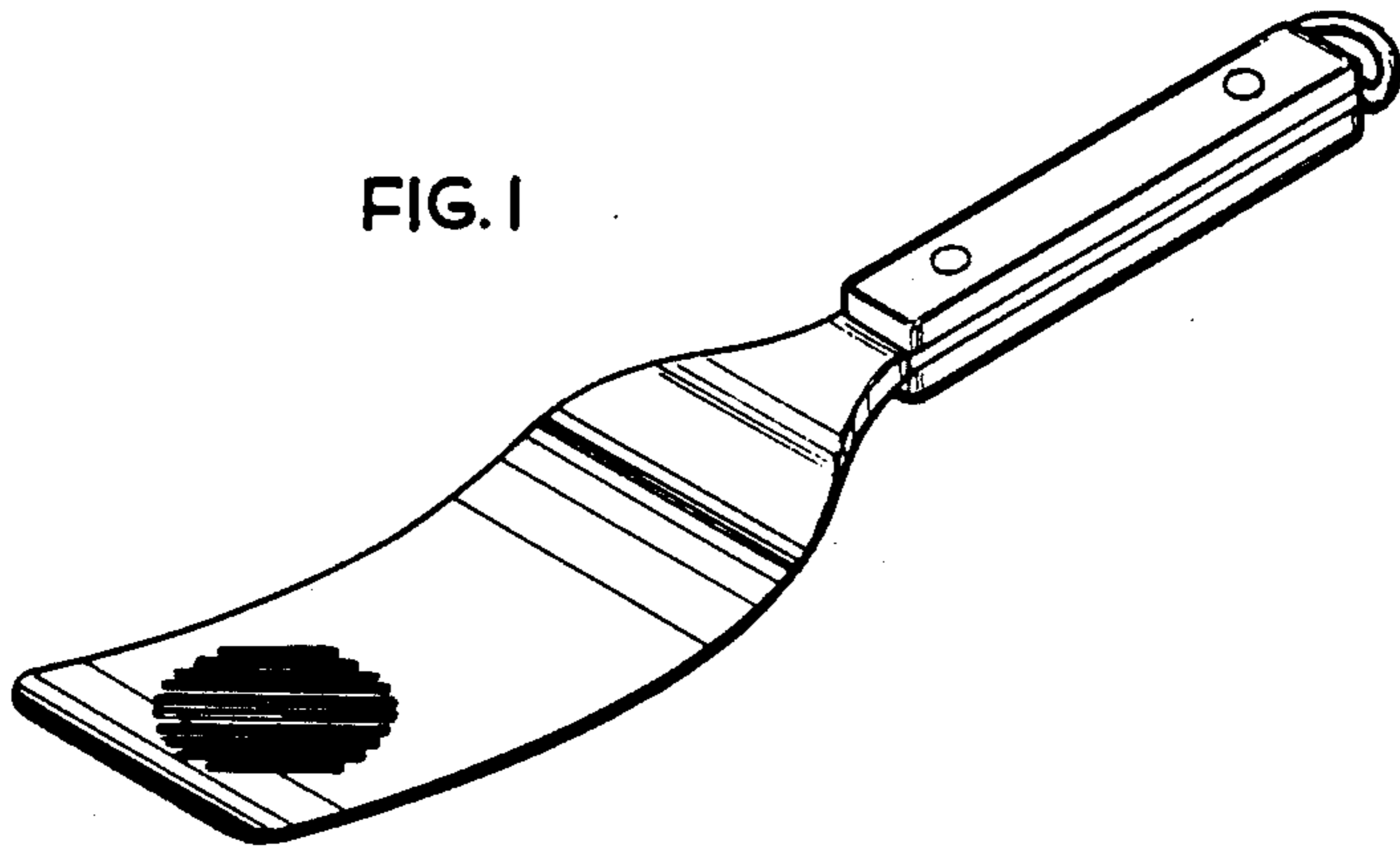

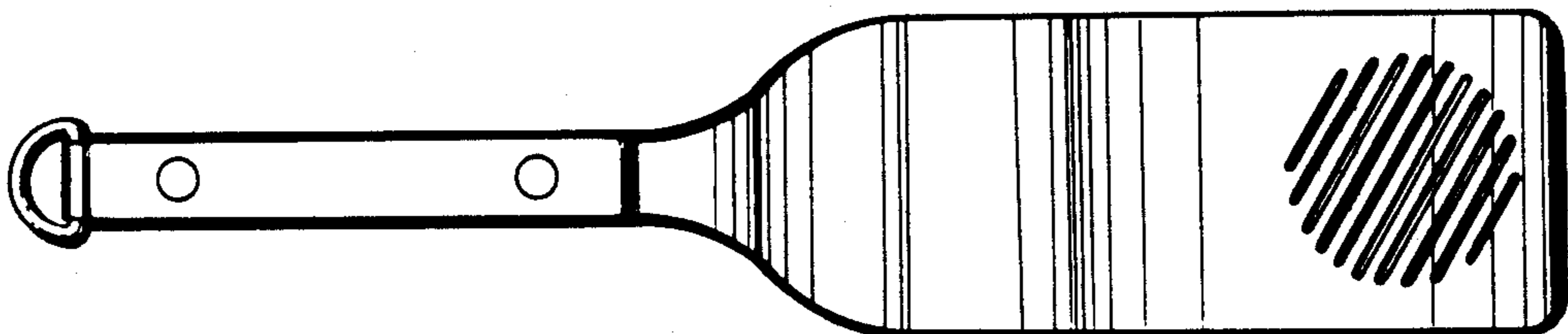
