The bottom is planar and unornamental.

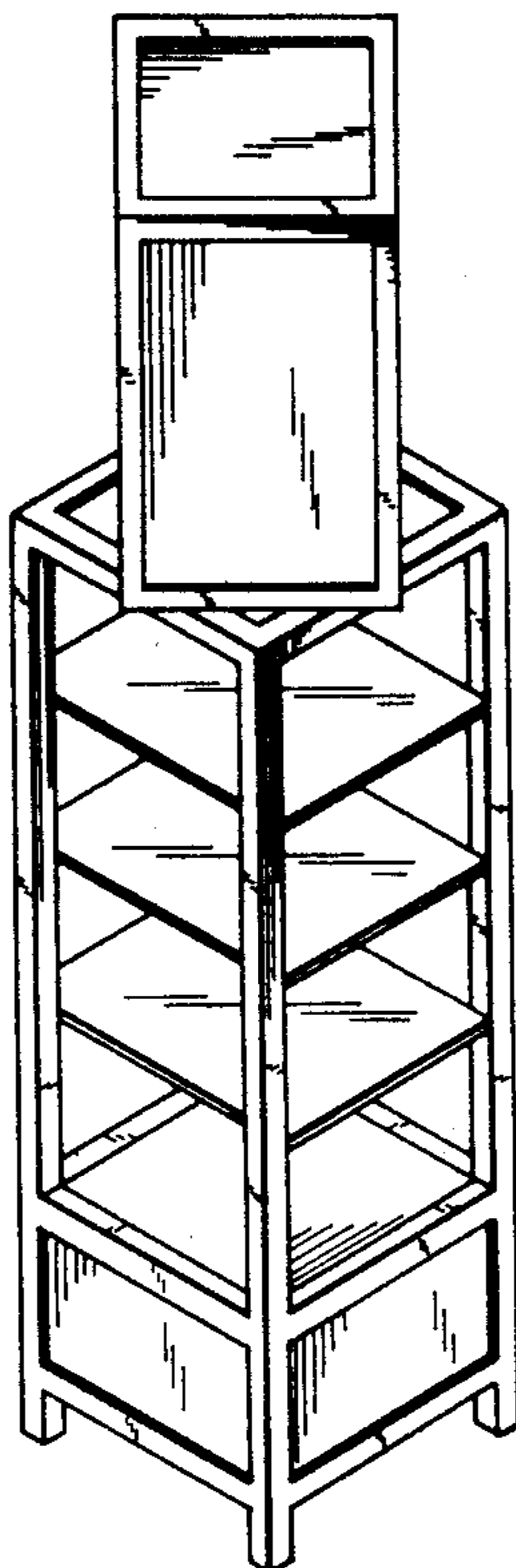
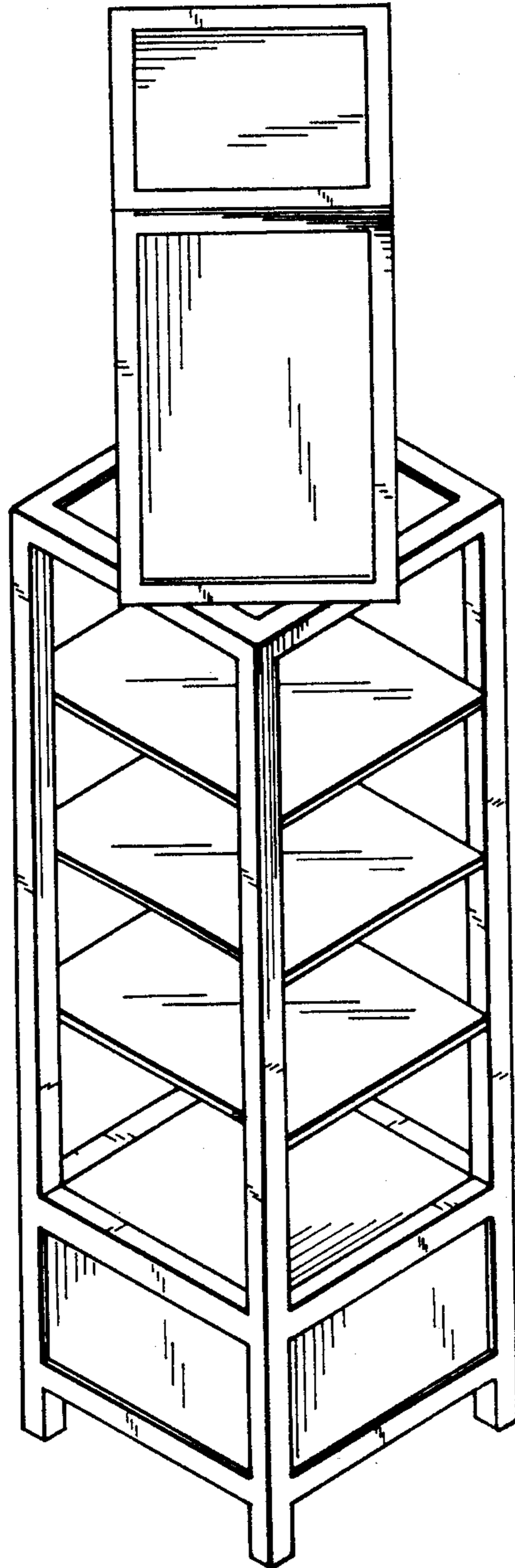

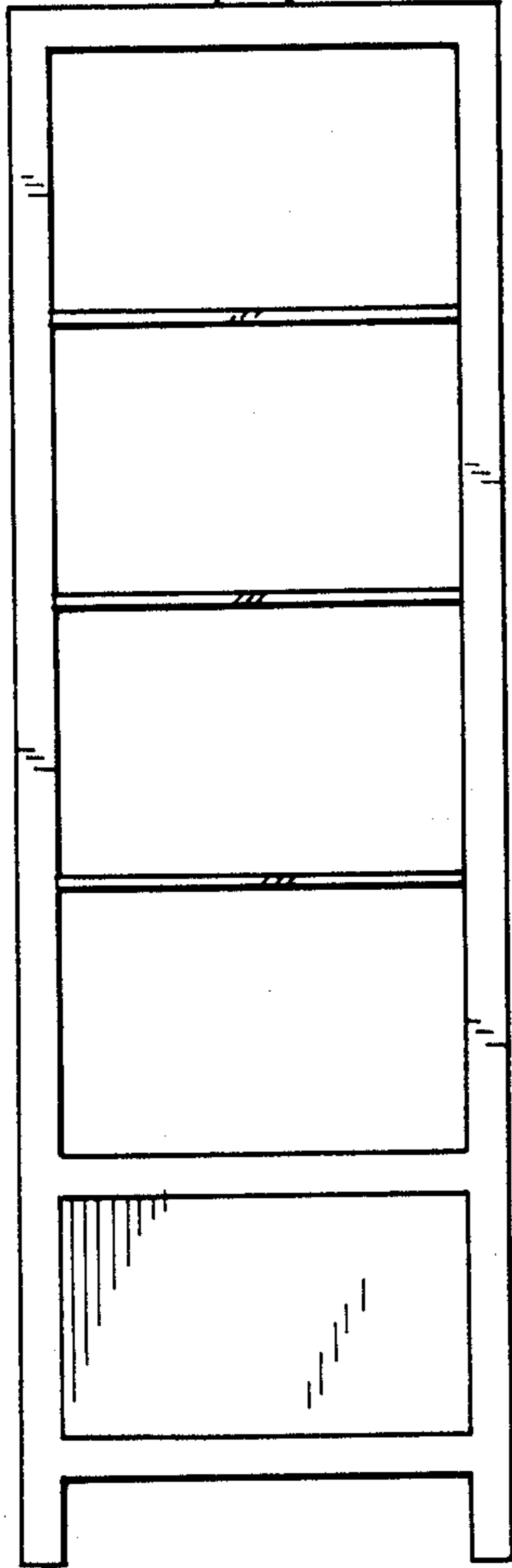
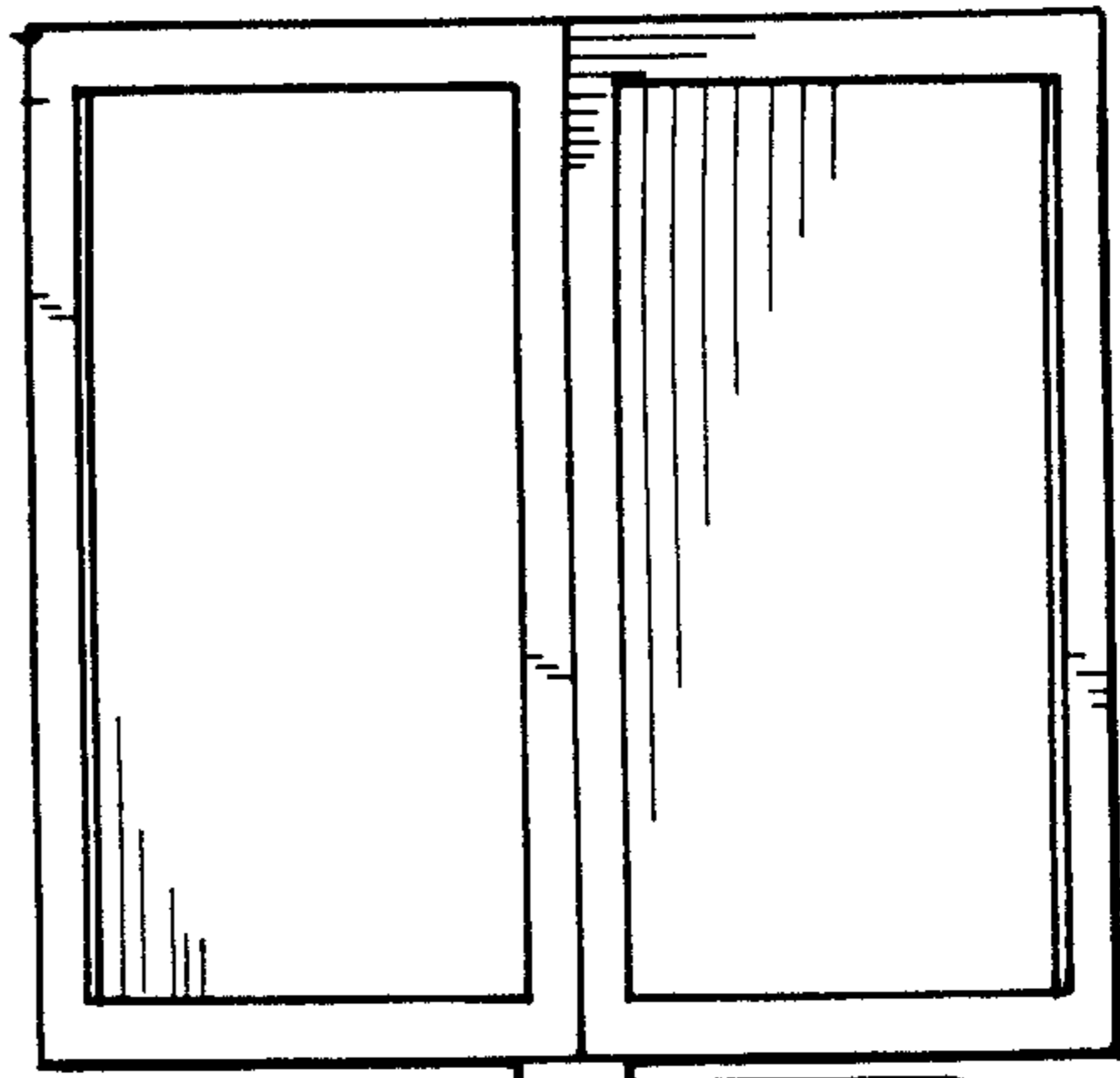
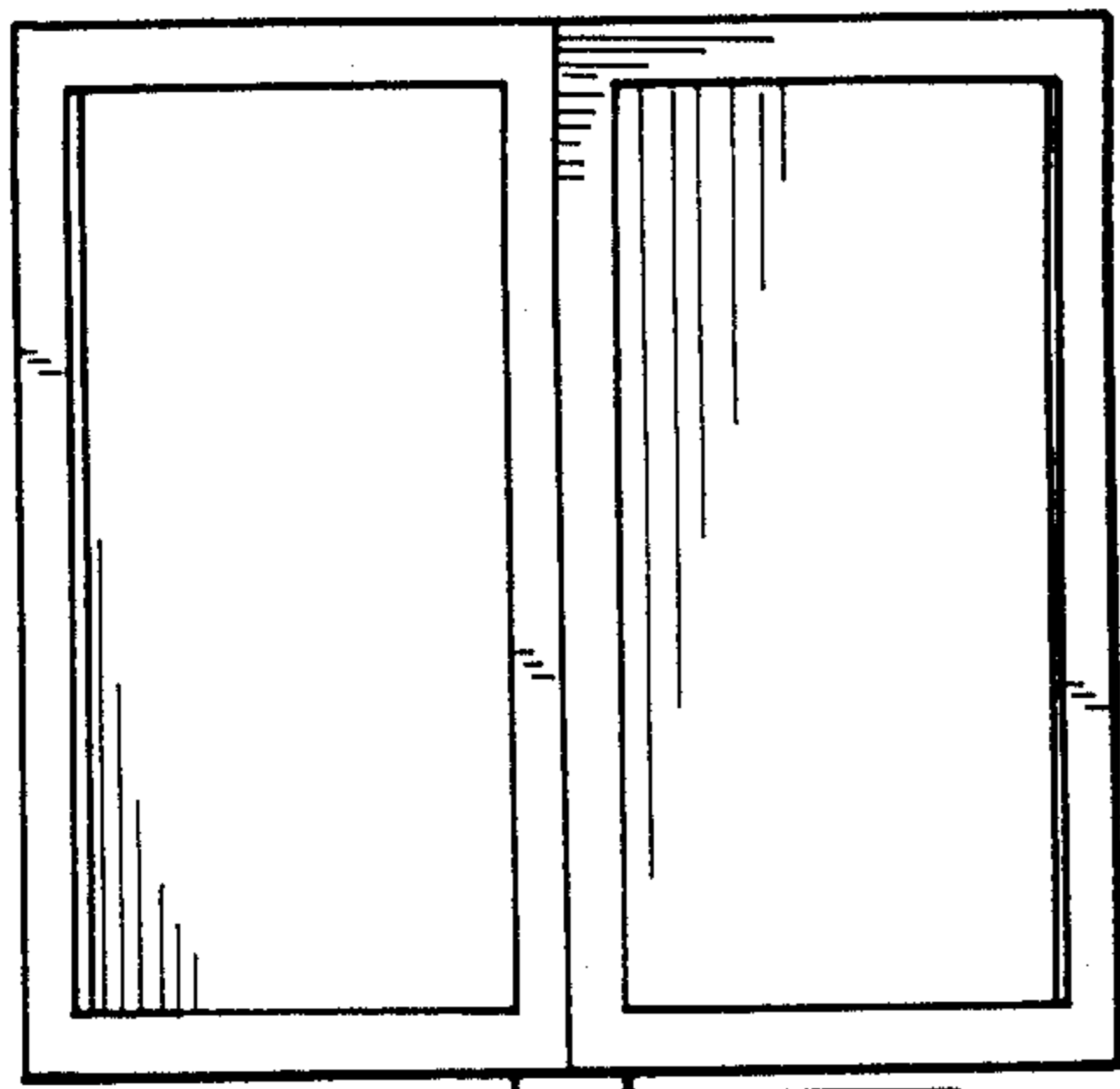

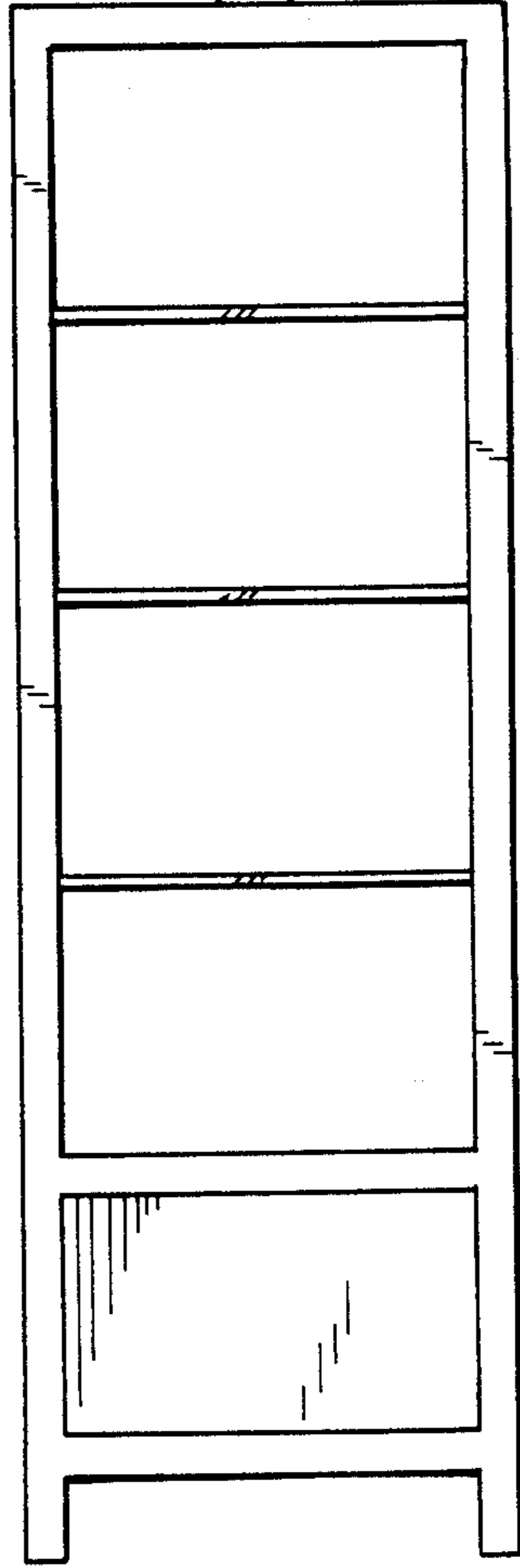
