FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof showing the mirror in an alternate position.

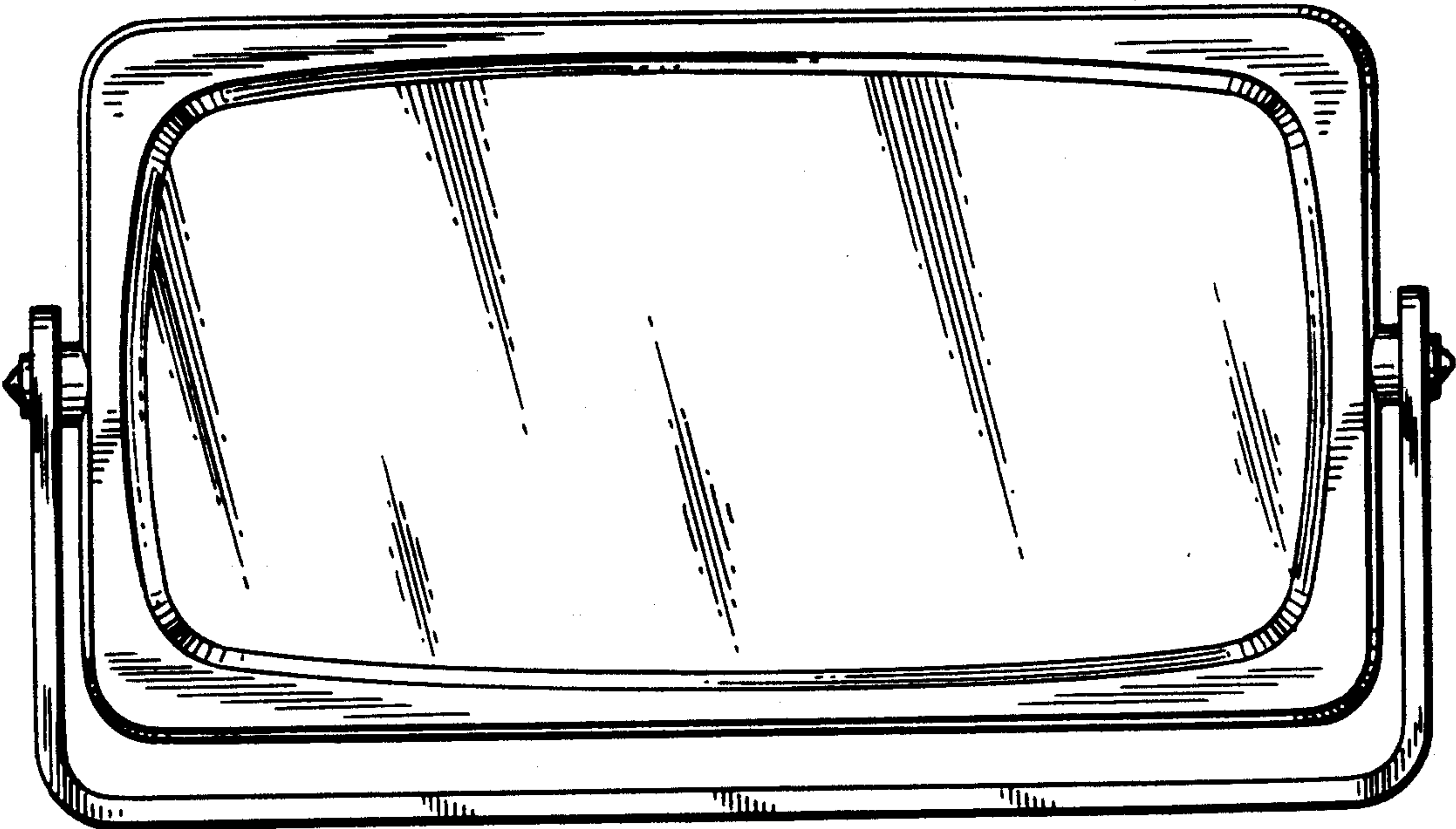


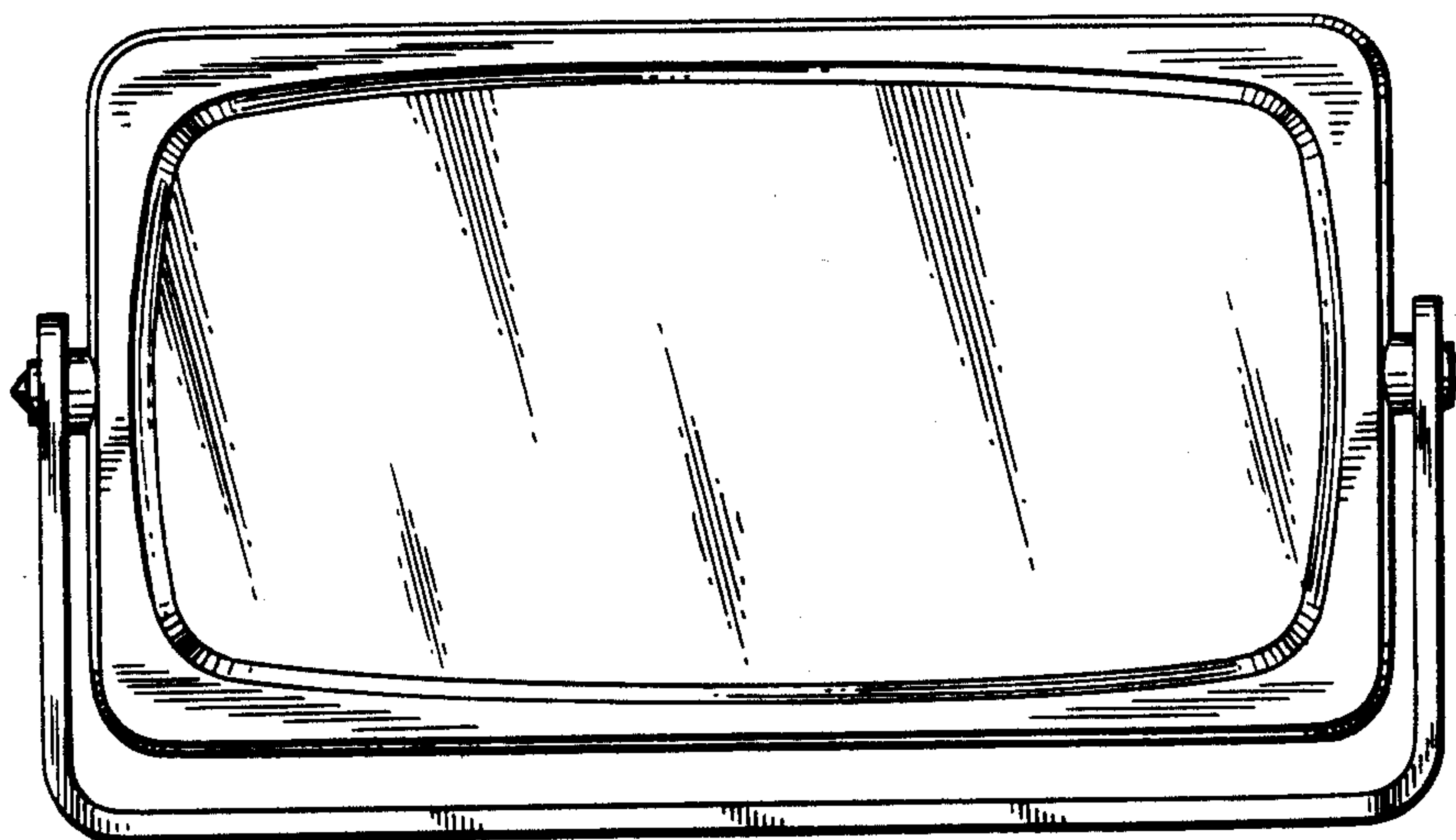
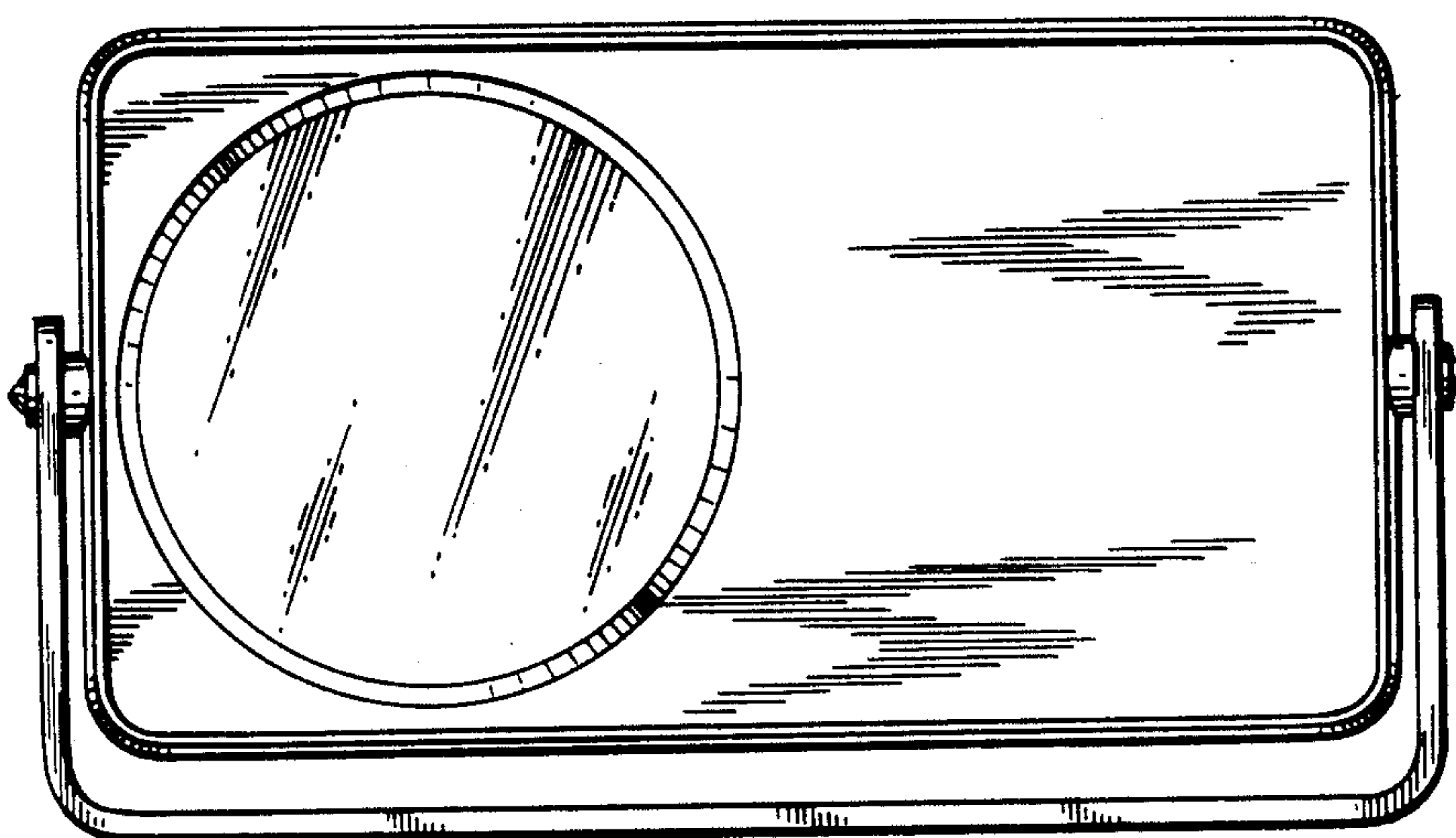
FIG. 1*FIG. 2*

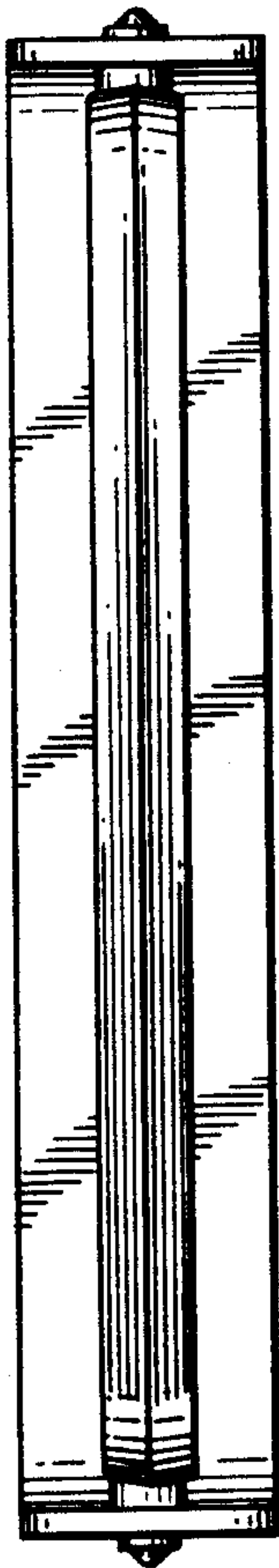

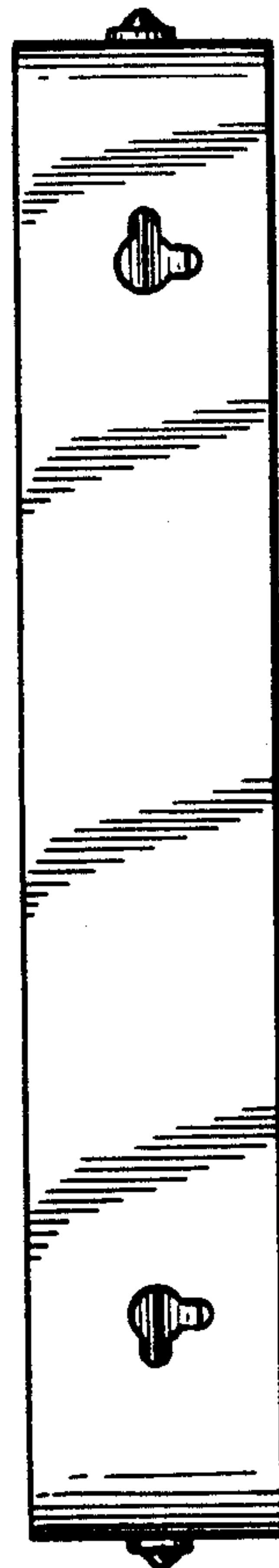
