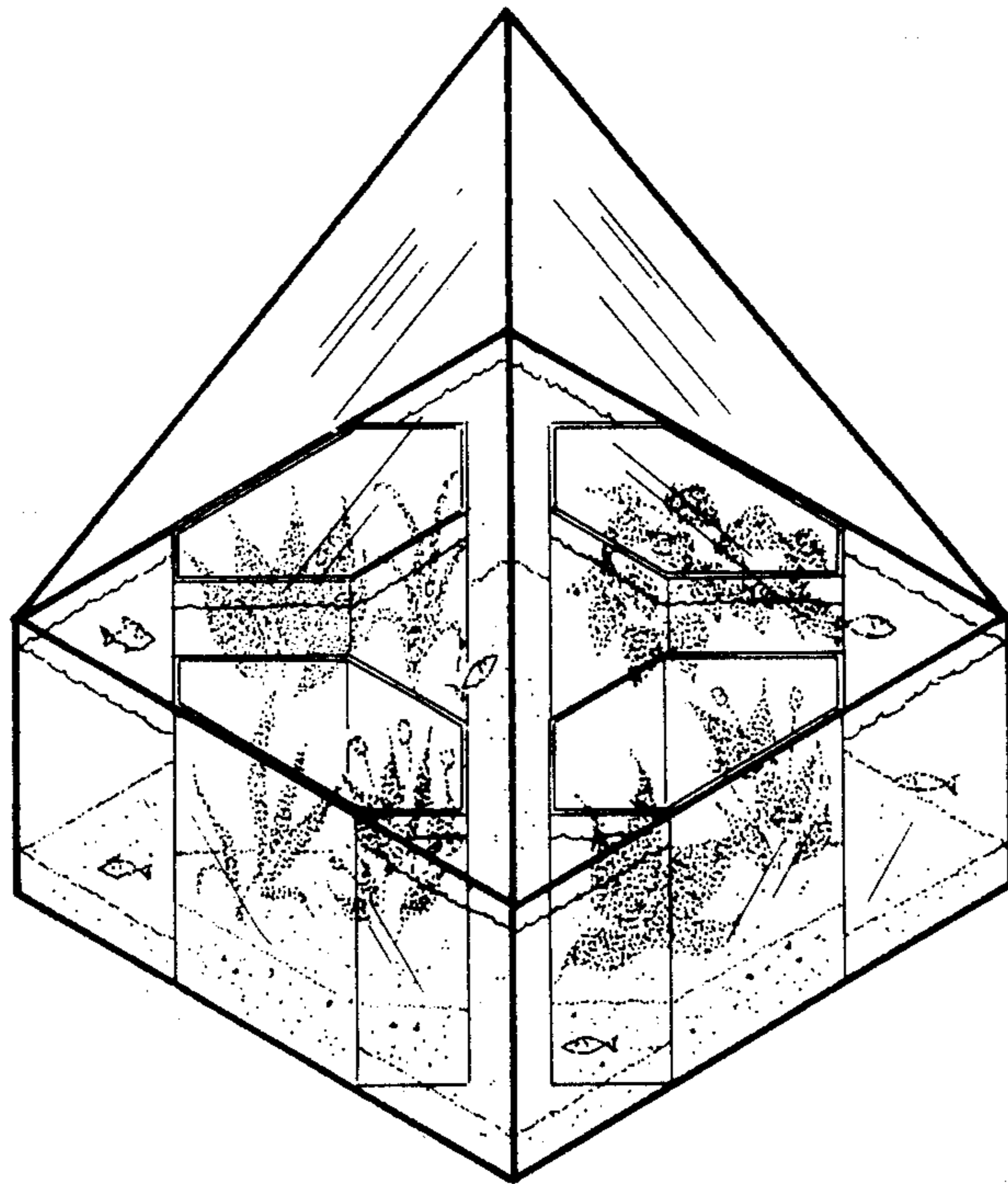
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined aquarium and terrarium showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof, with the cover removed for convenience of illustration.

The broken line representation of fish, water, plants and ground in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for purposes of illustration only.



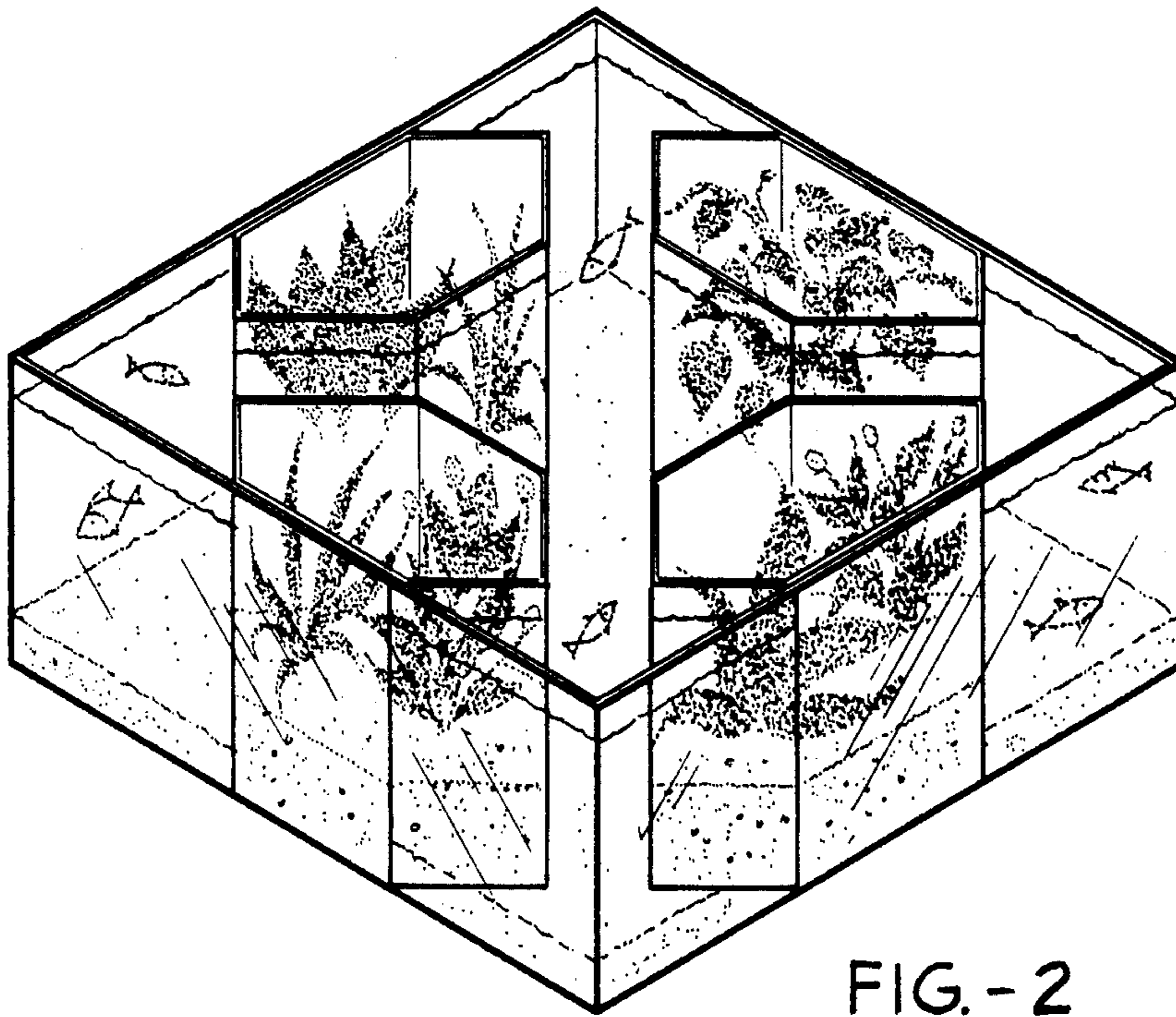

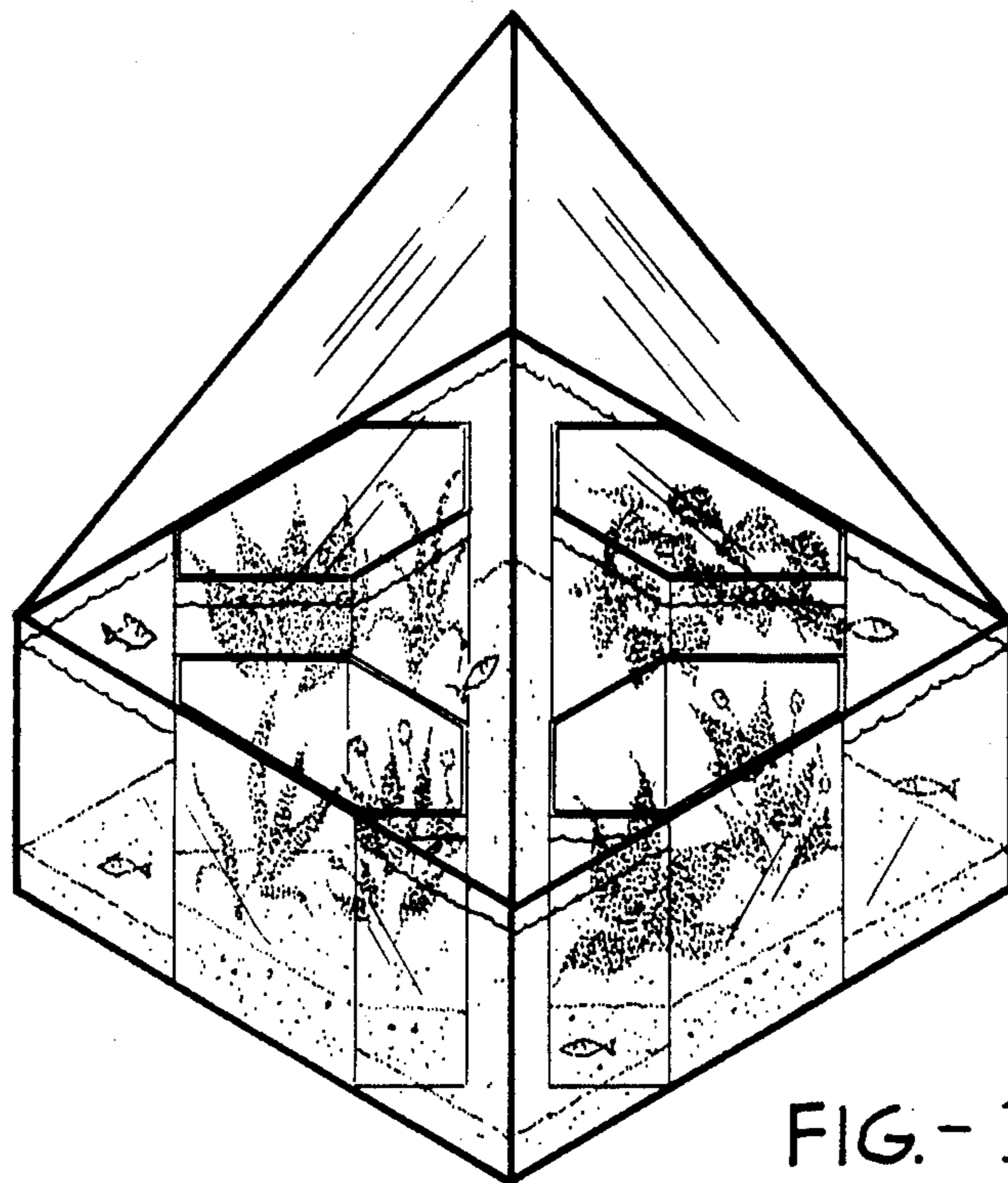
