The ornamental design for a "chair", as shown and described.

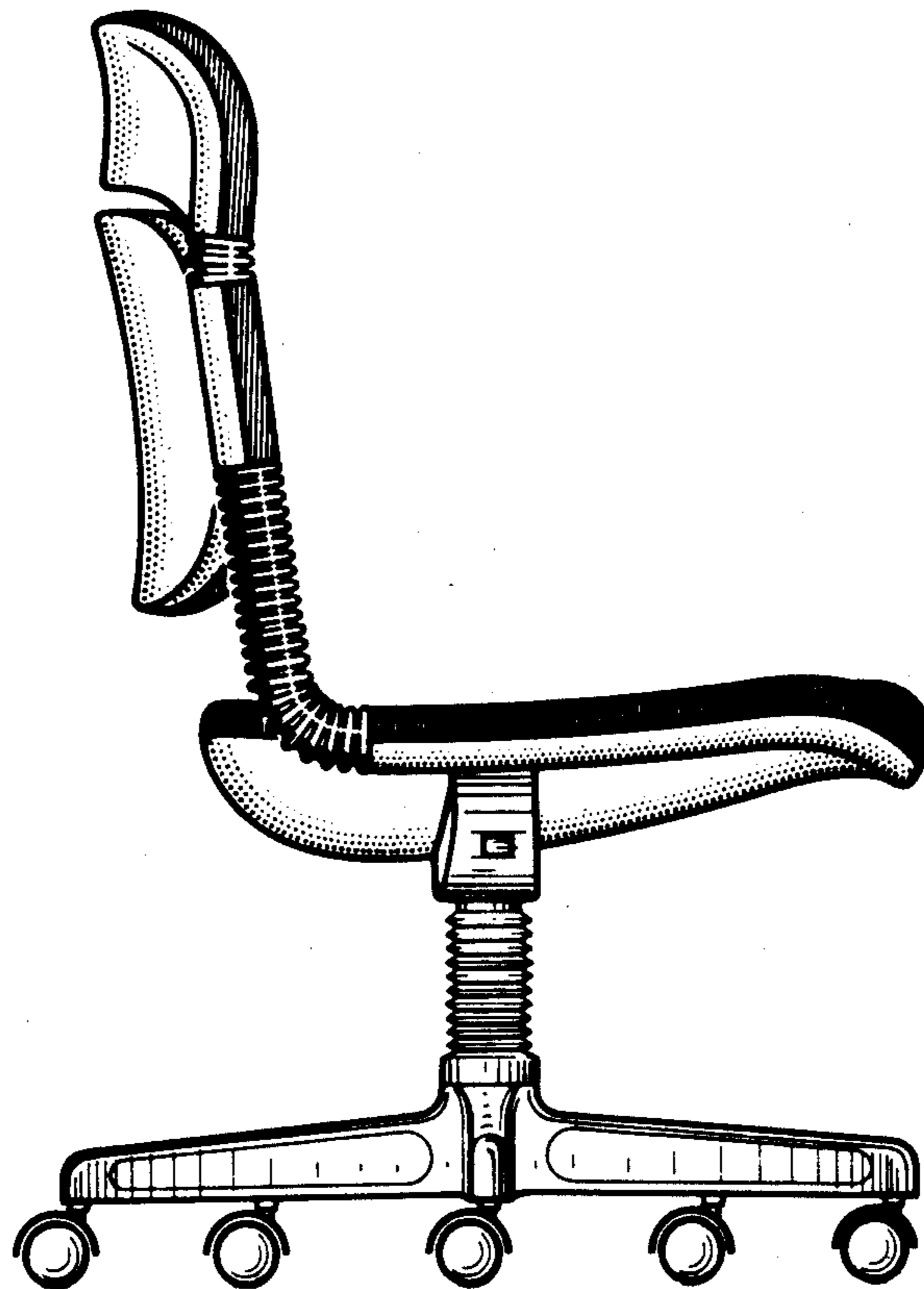
DESCRIPTION

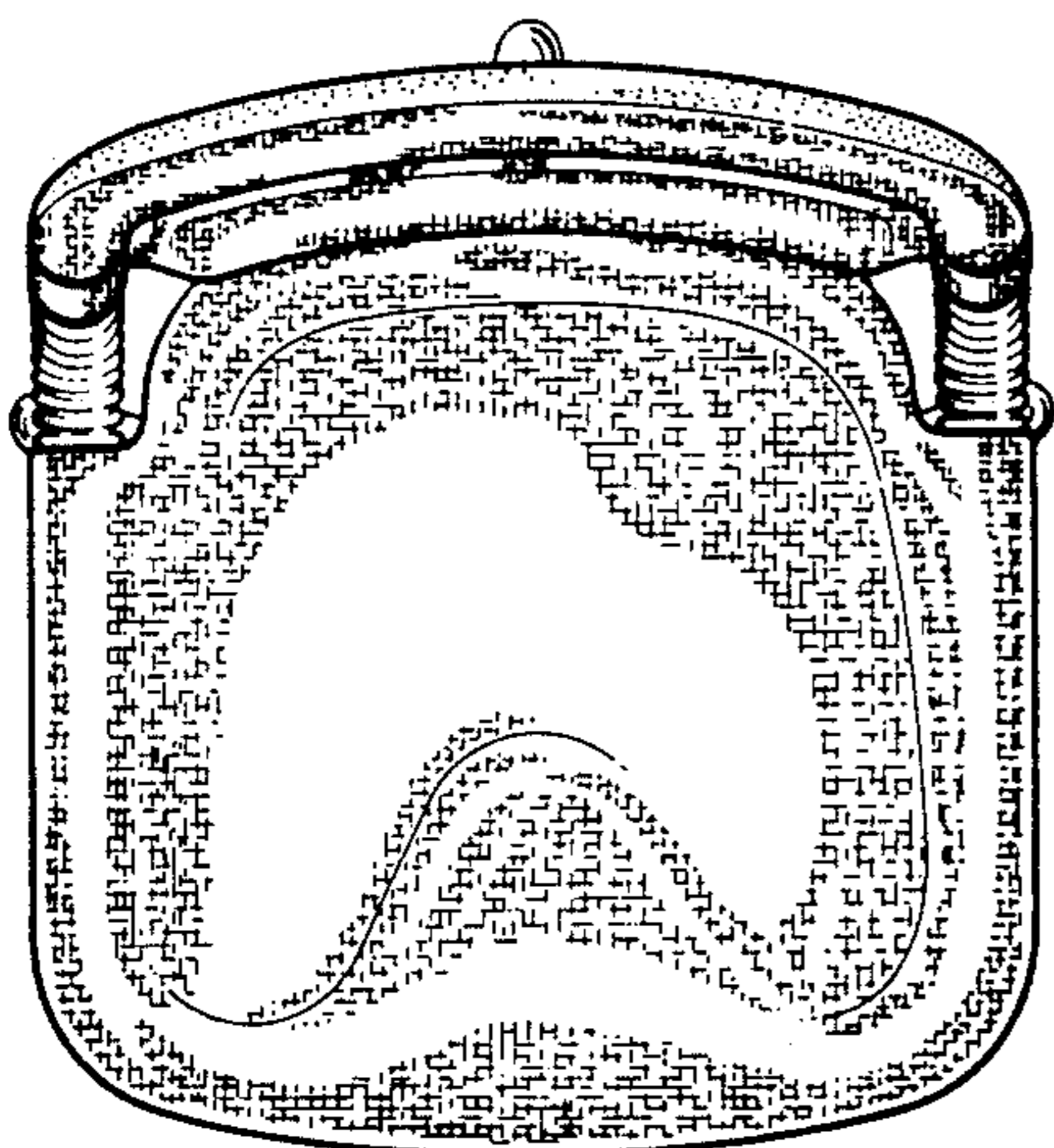

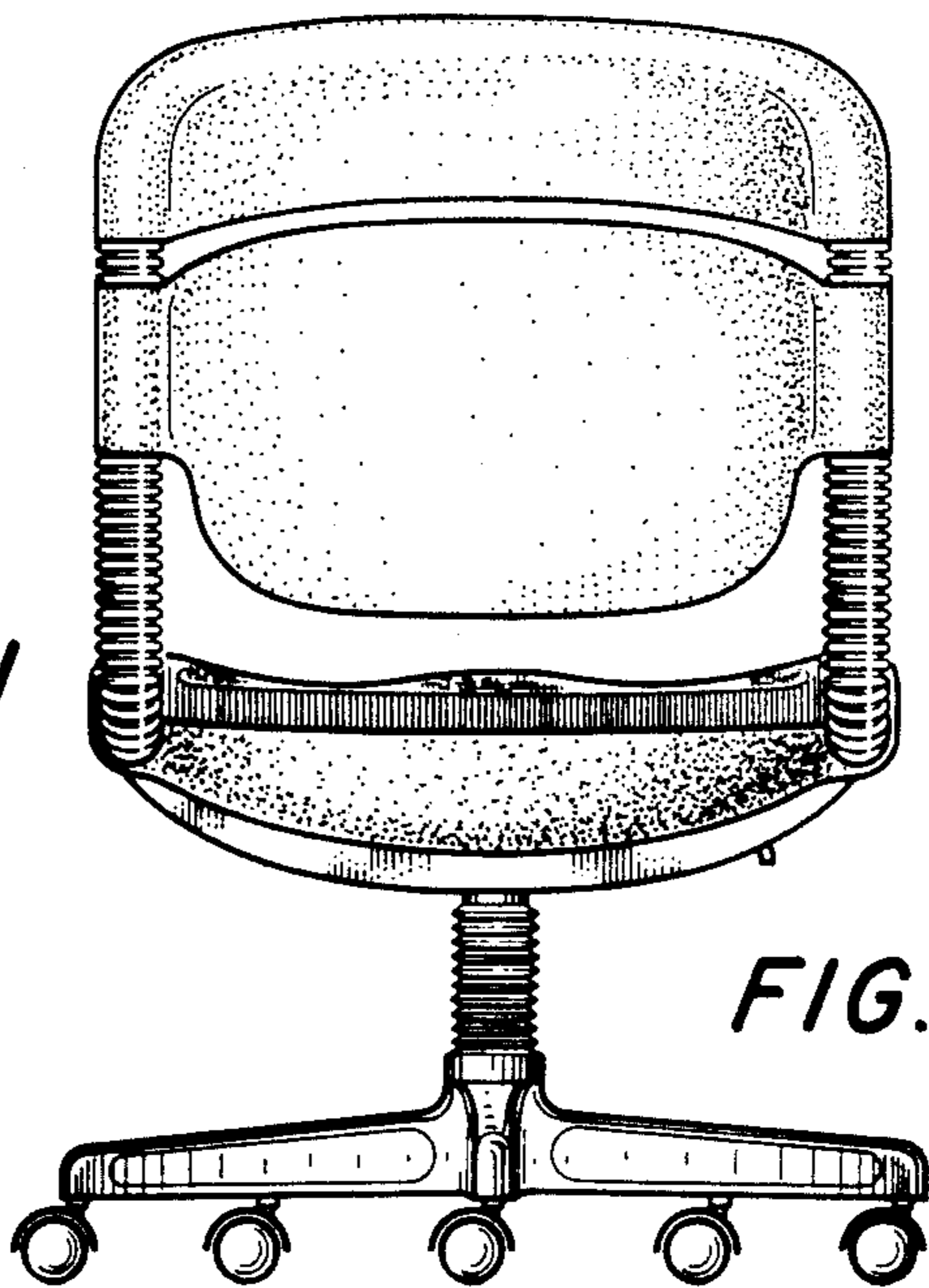

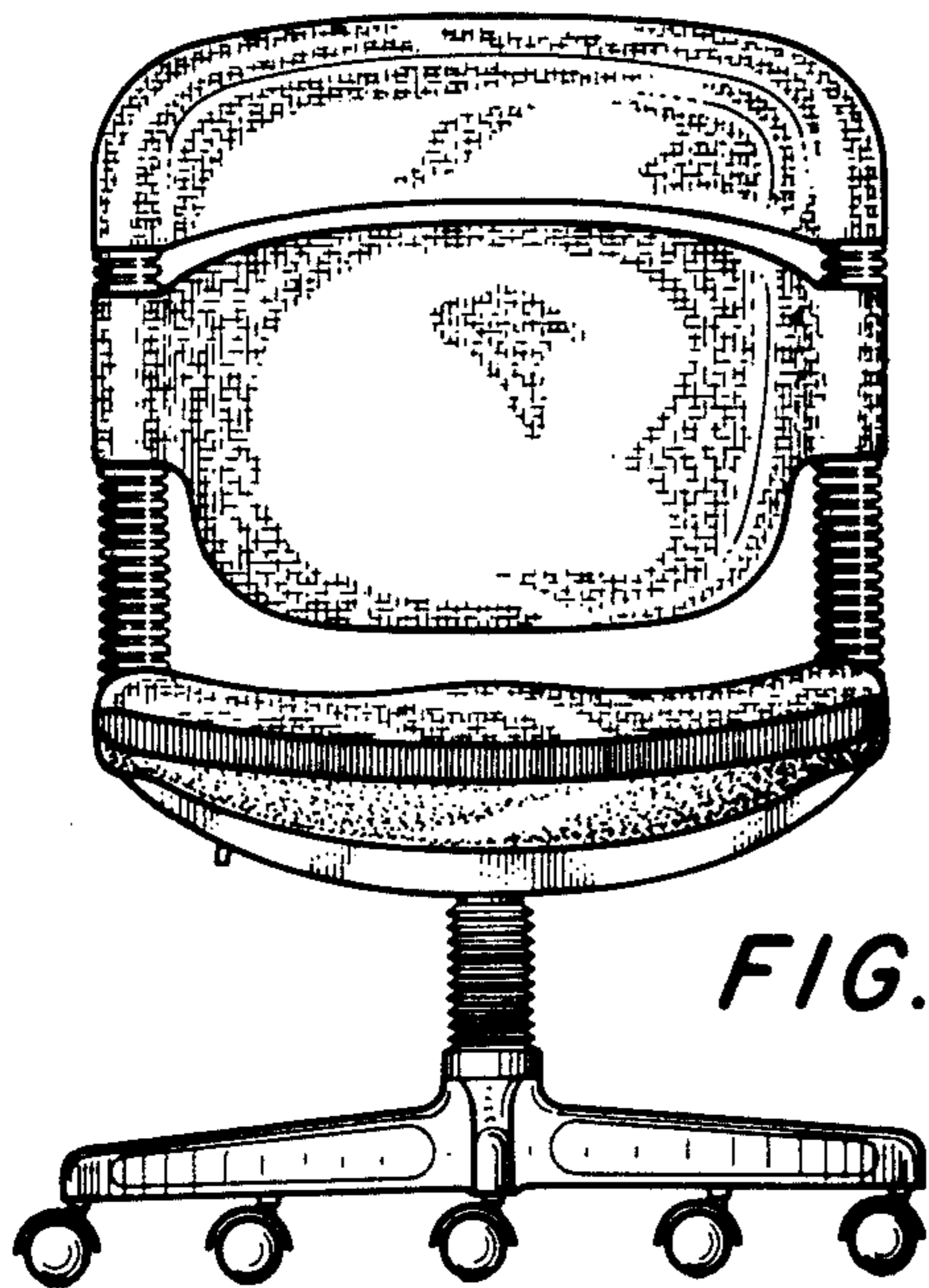

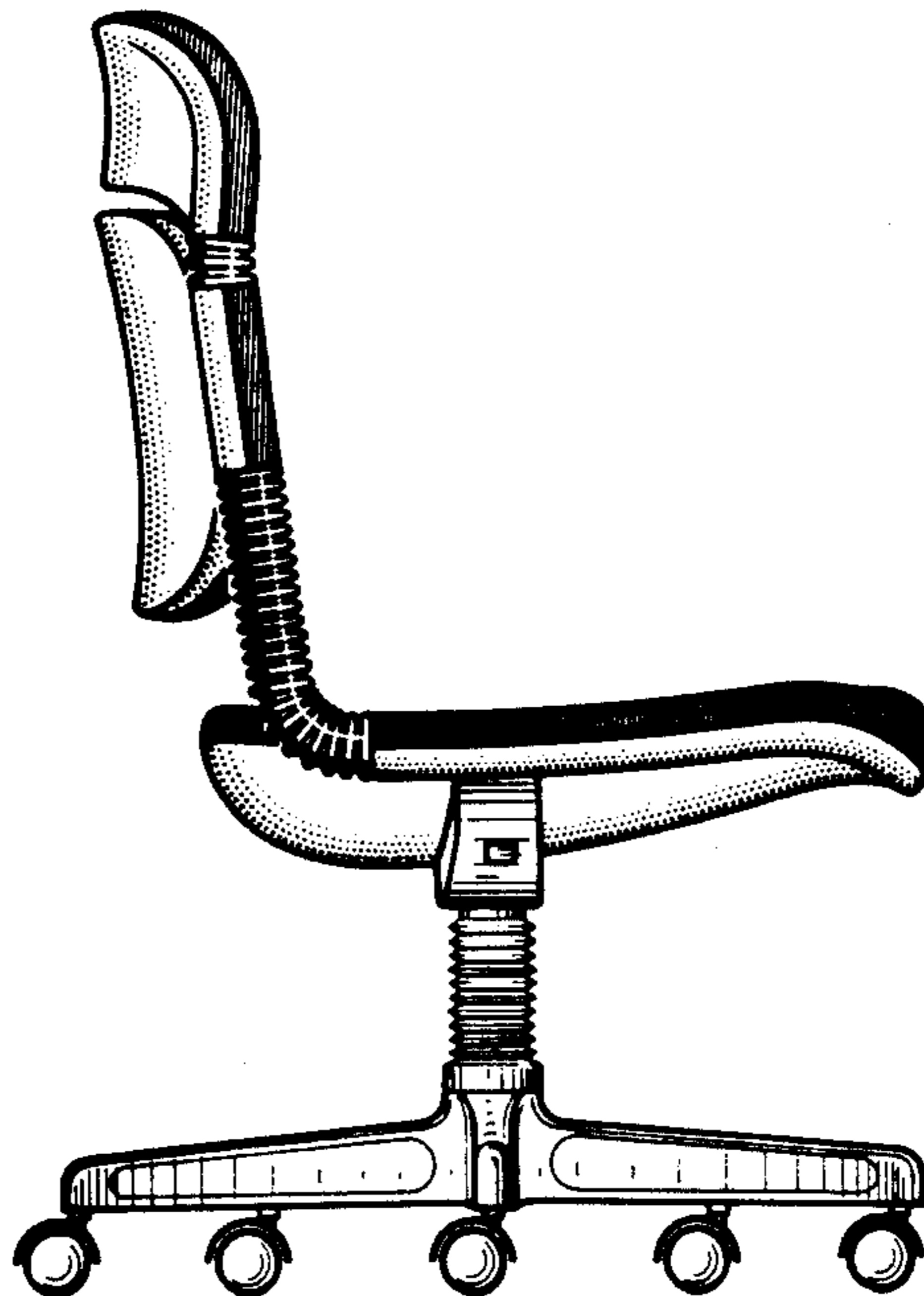

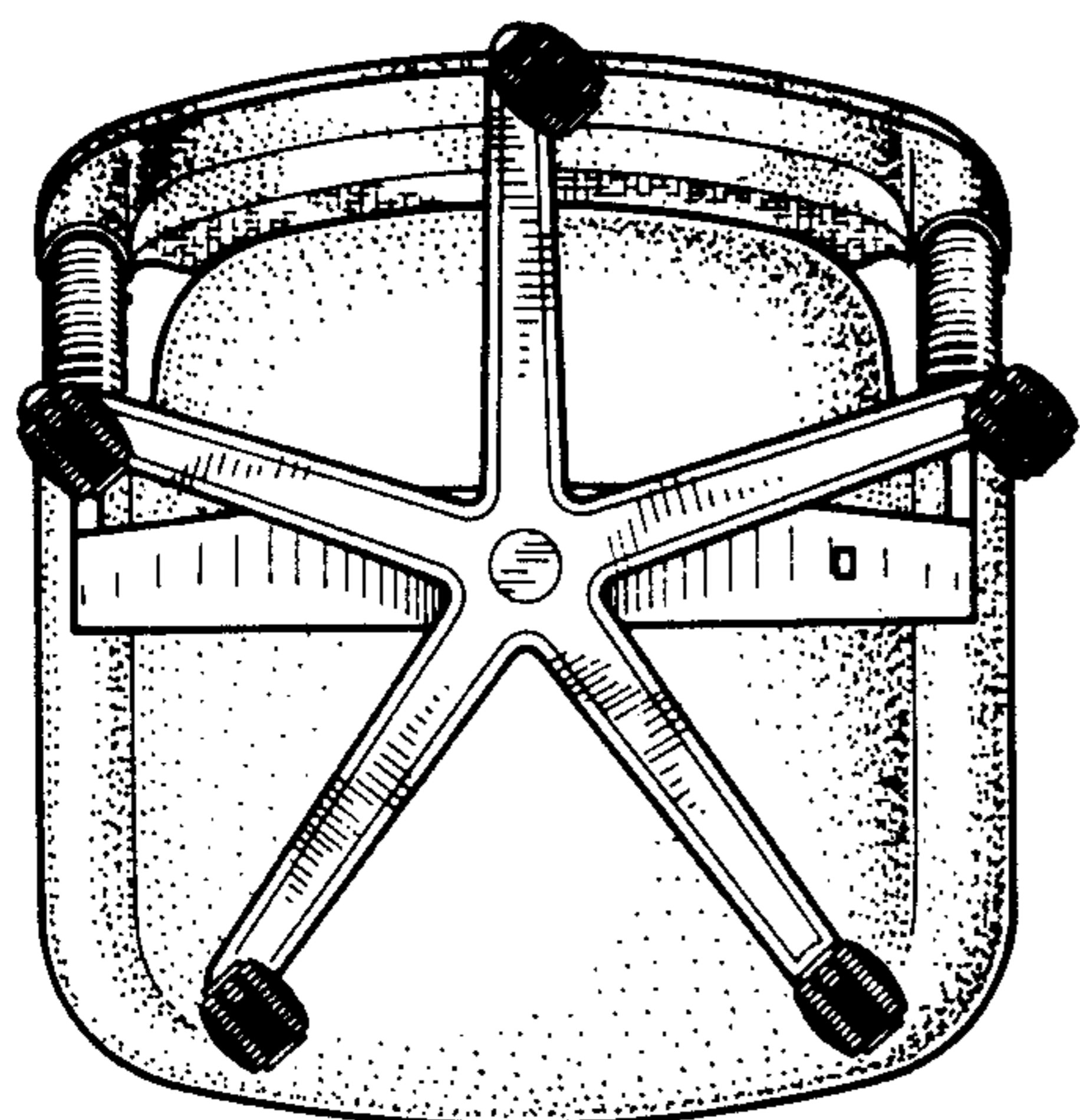

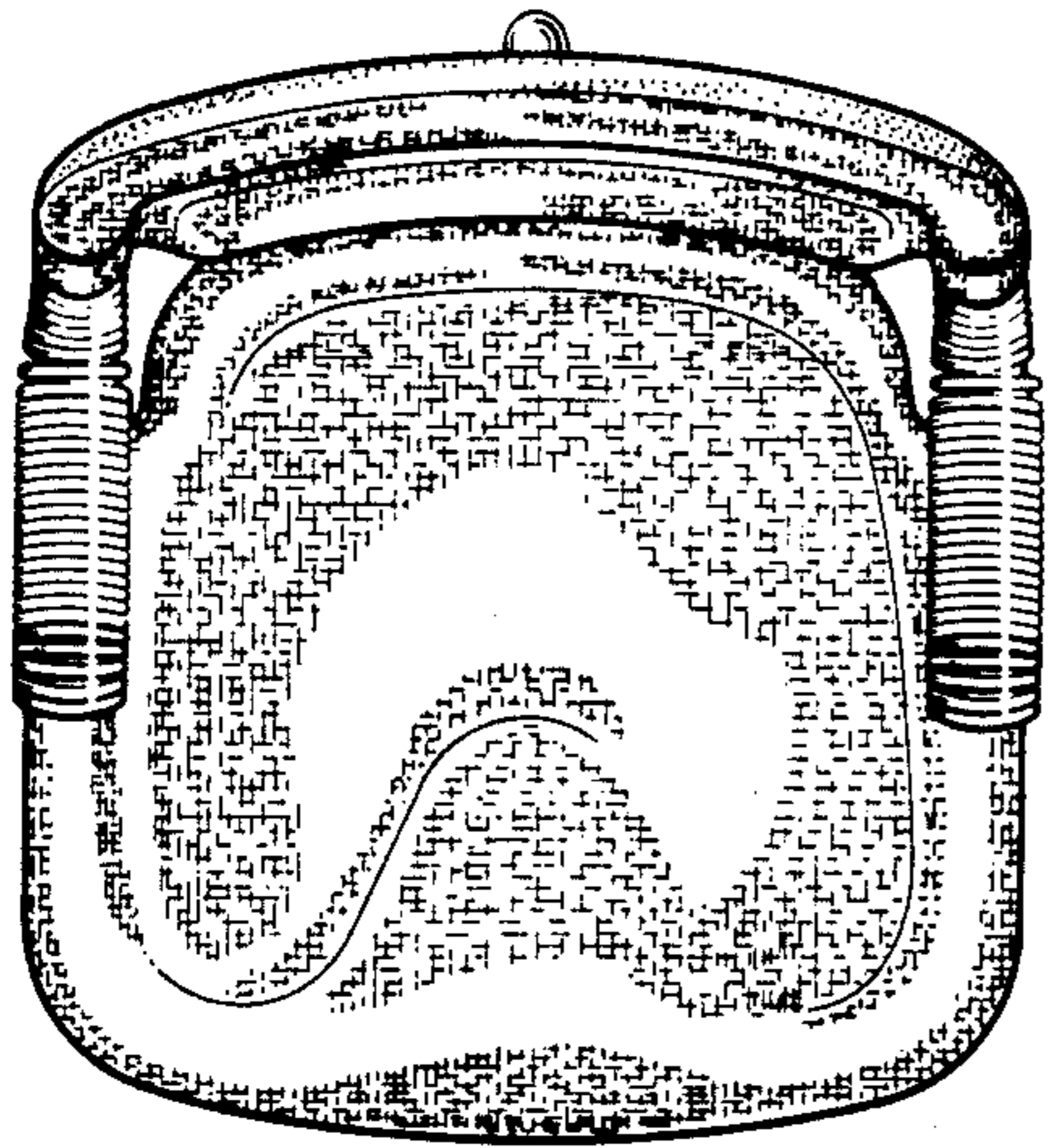

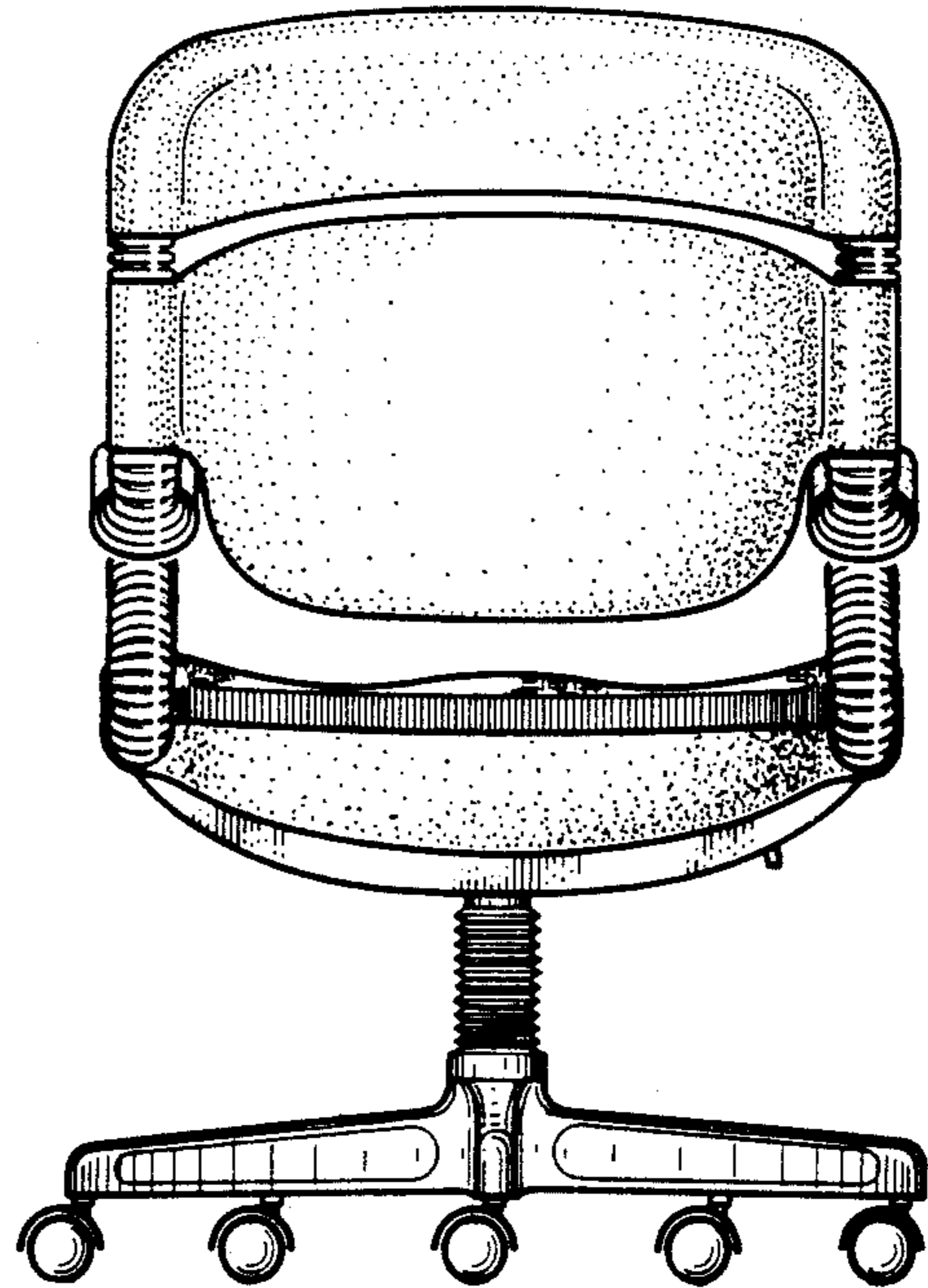

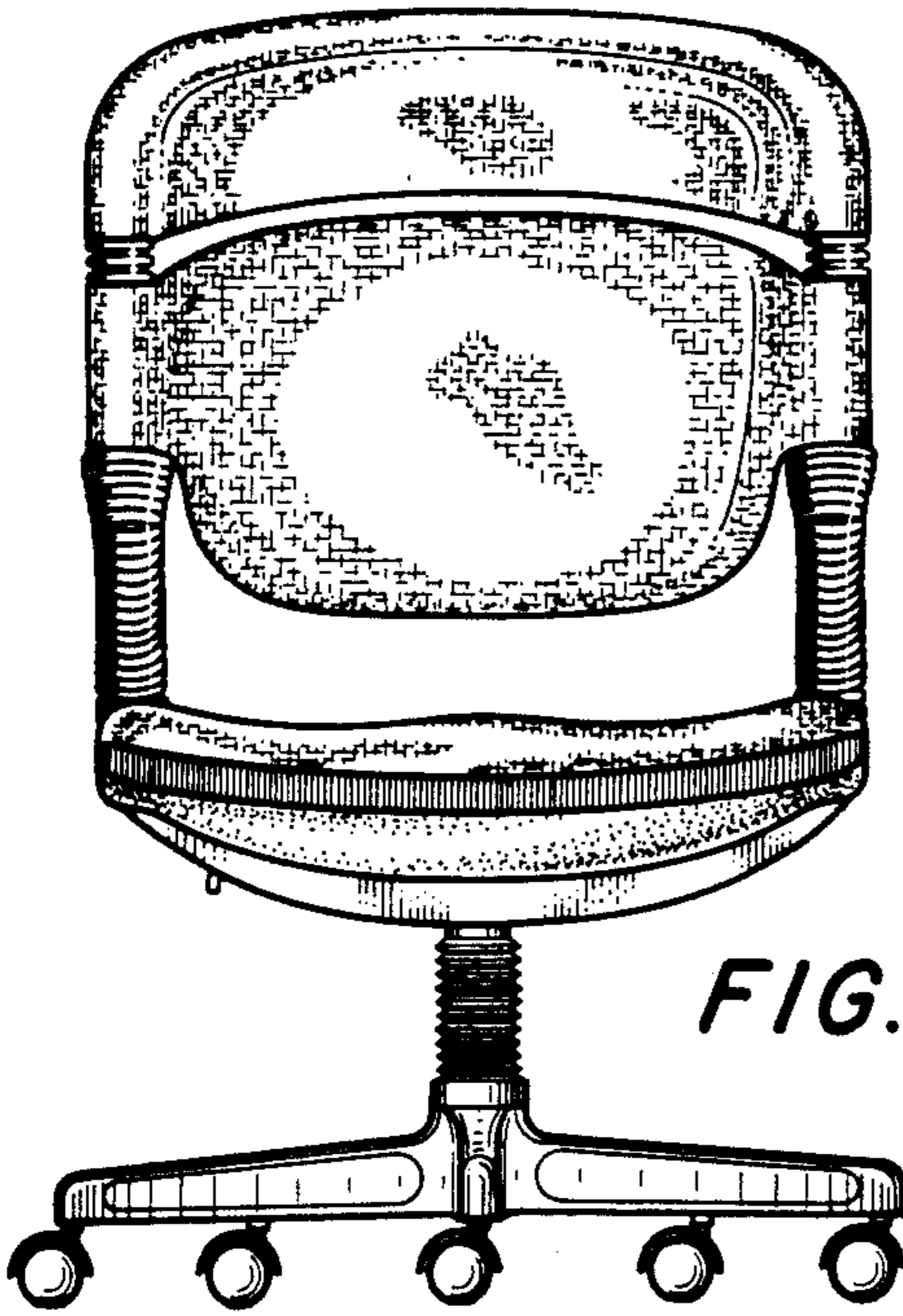

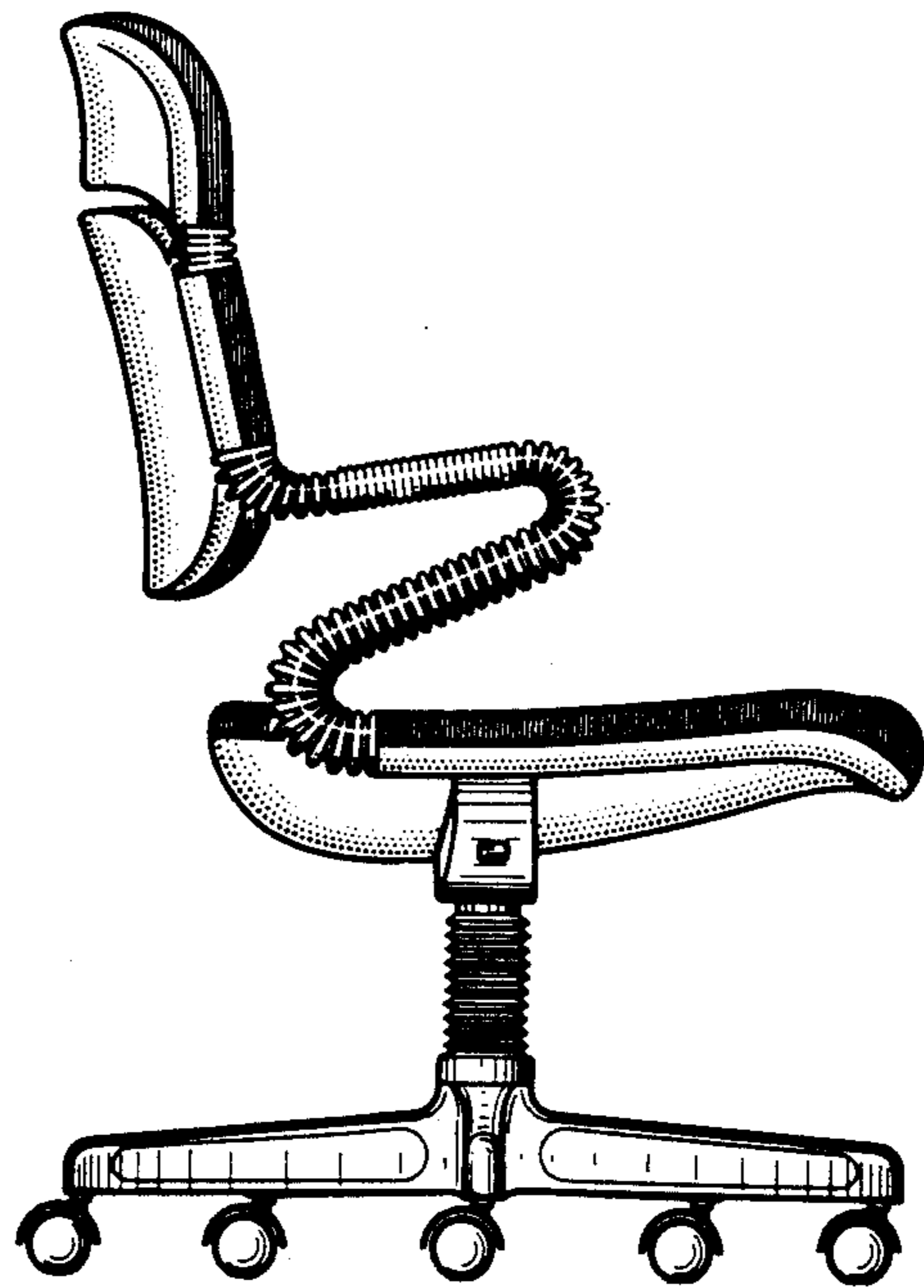

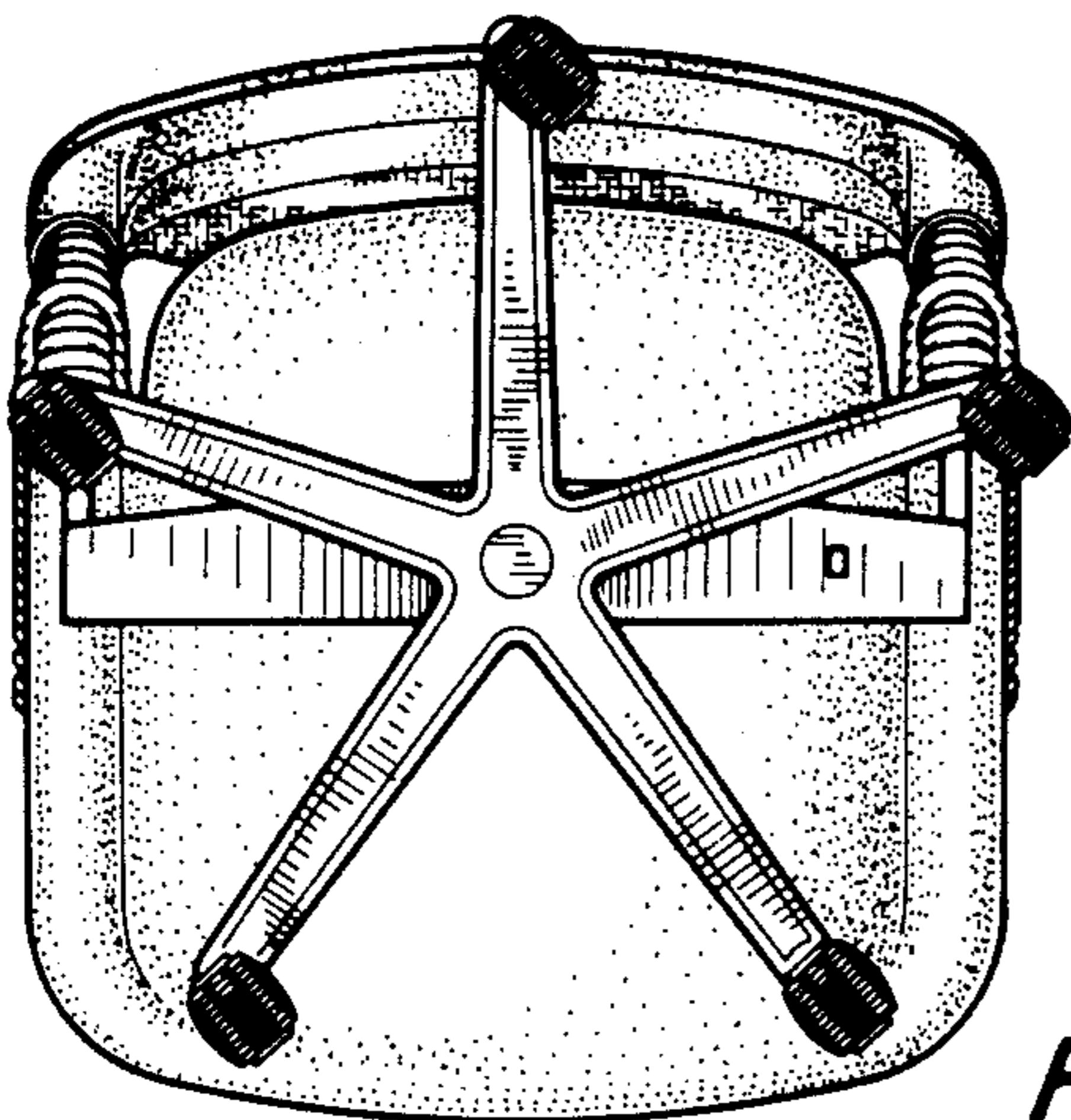
