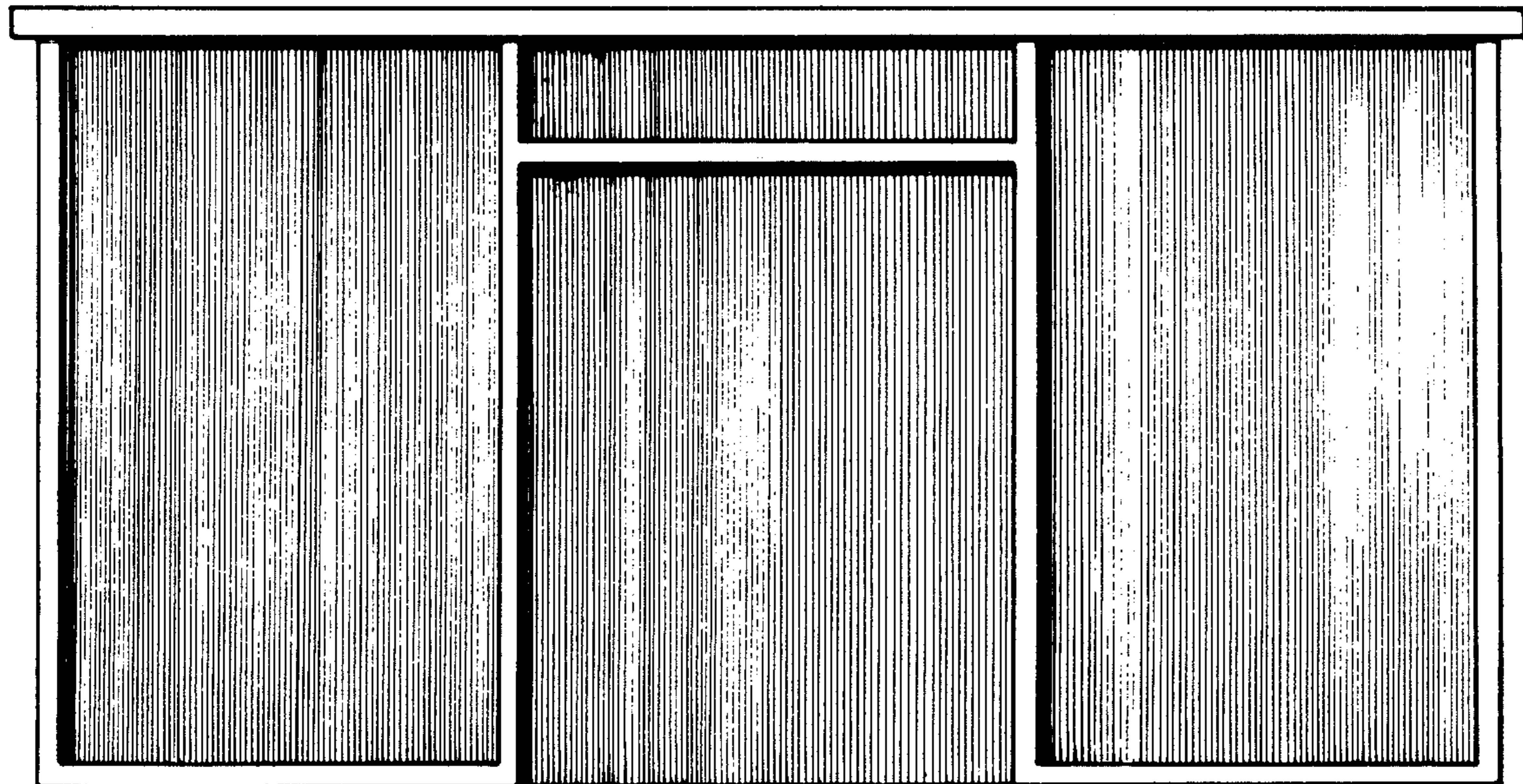

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cabinet for housing stereo components, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a back elevational view of a cabinet for housing stereo components embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof. The side of the cabinet not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 4.



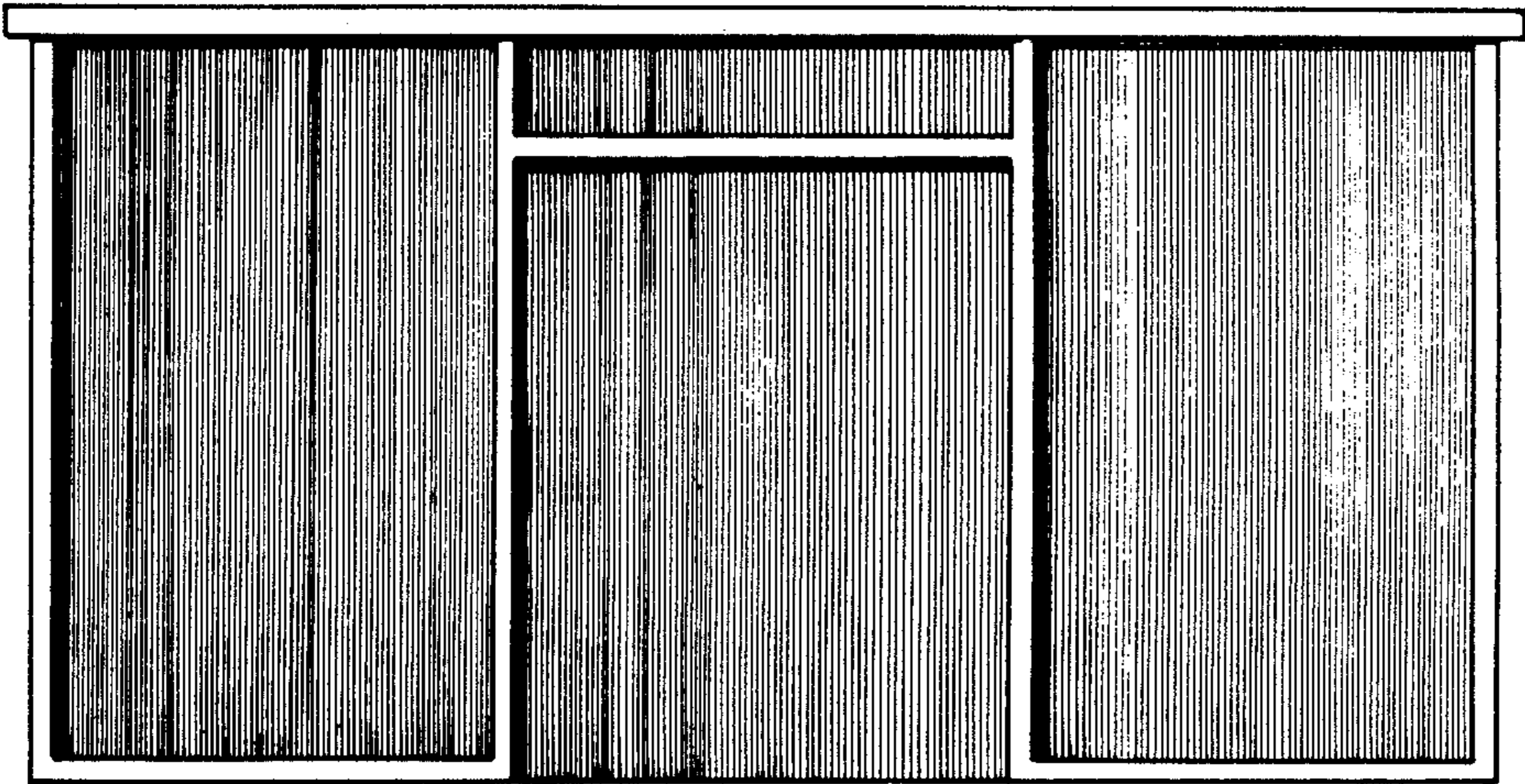

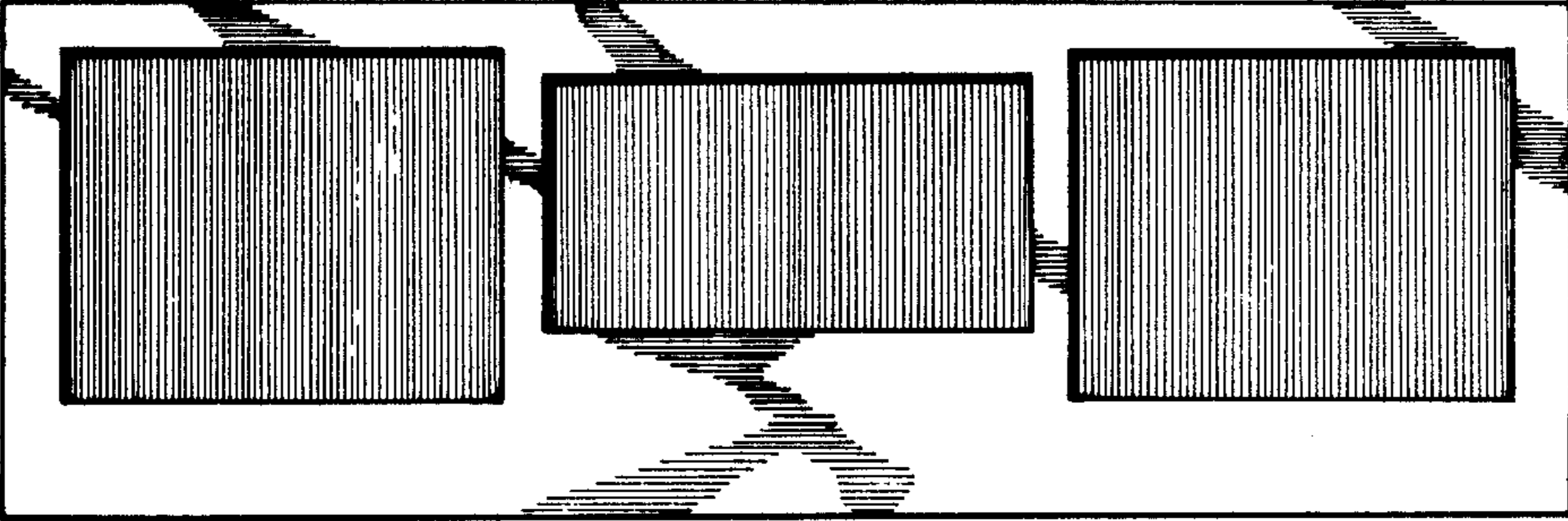

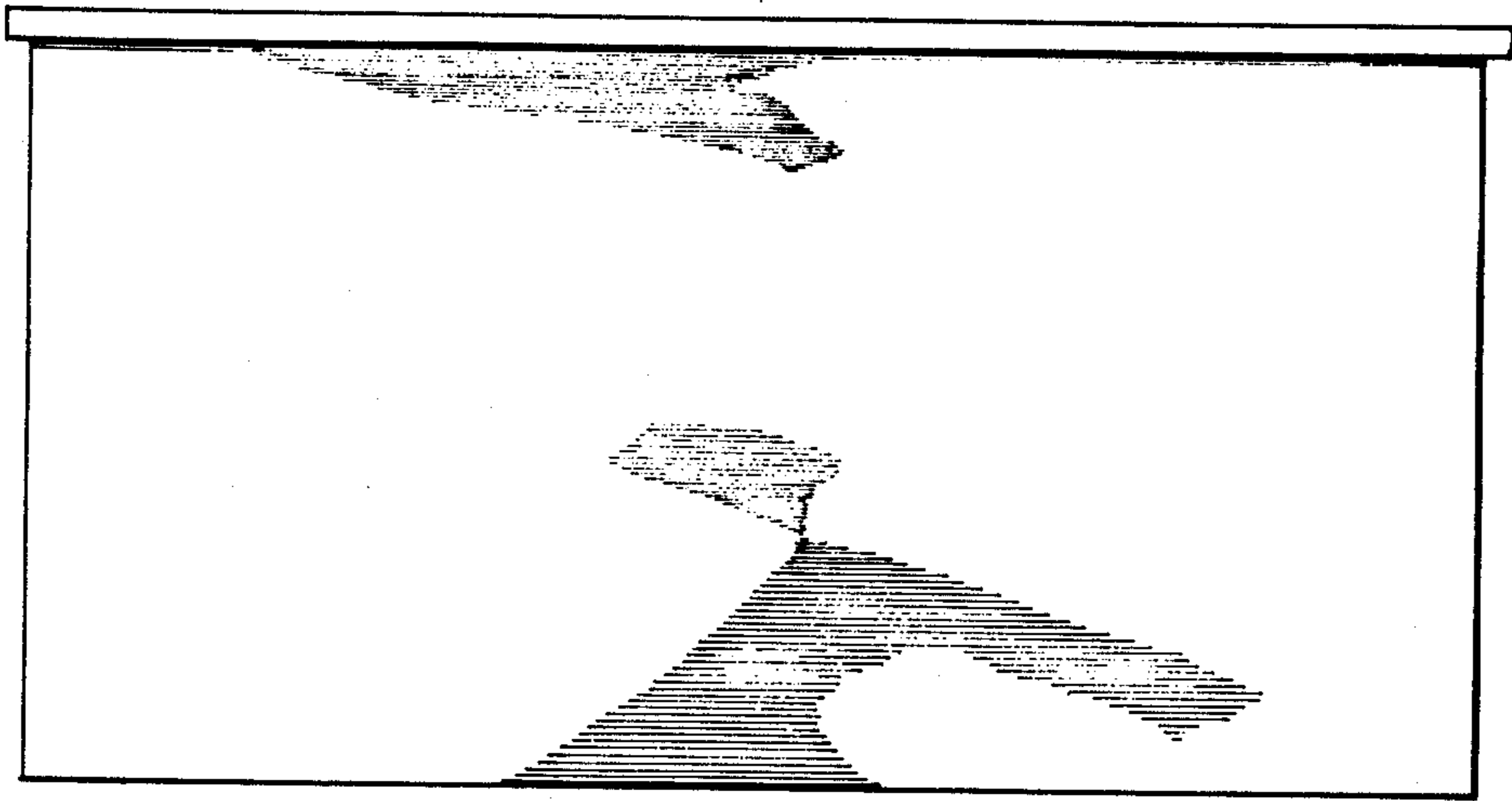

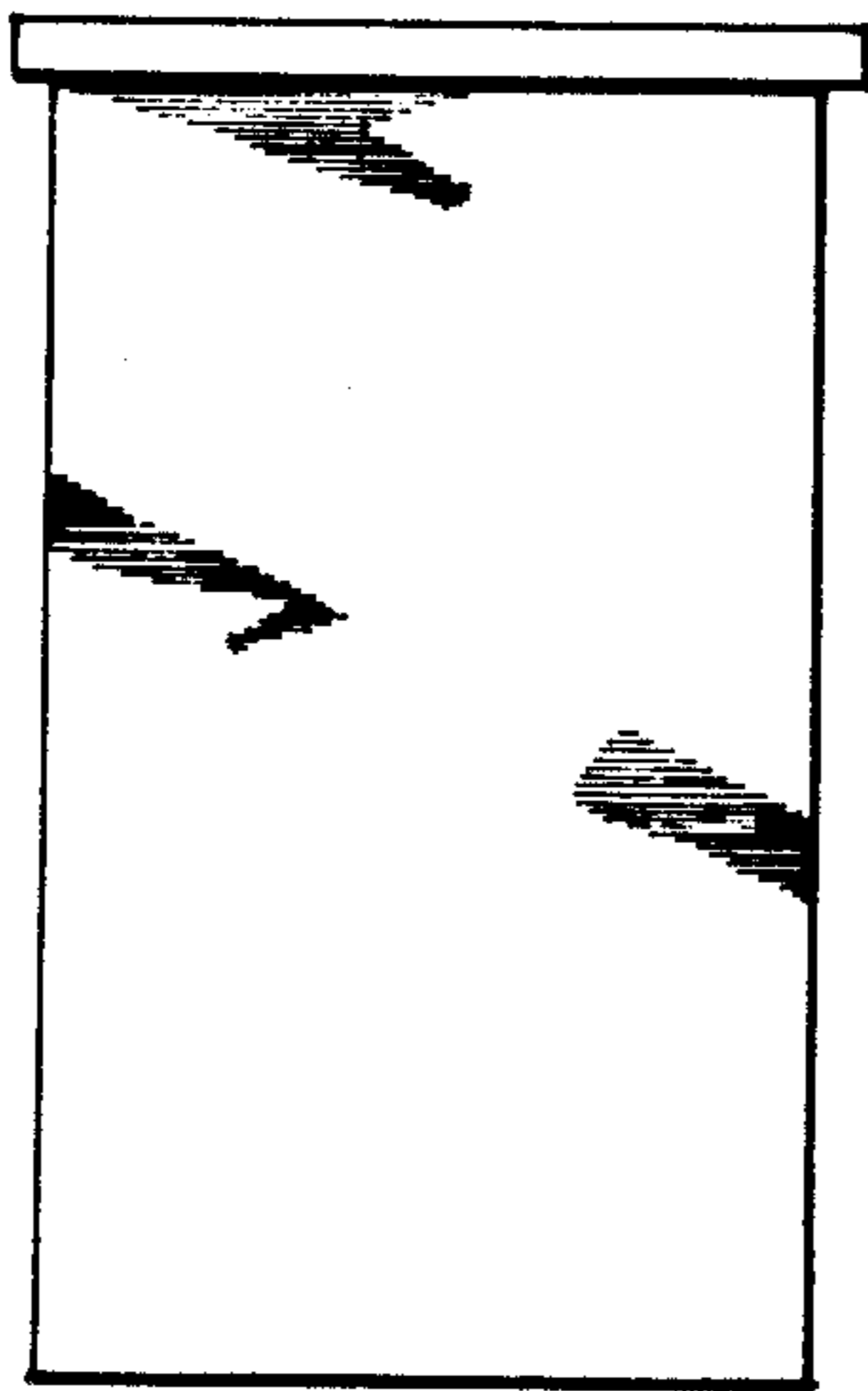
