DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of a starter for small
engines showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a view in front elevation thereof on an en-
larged scale;

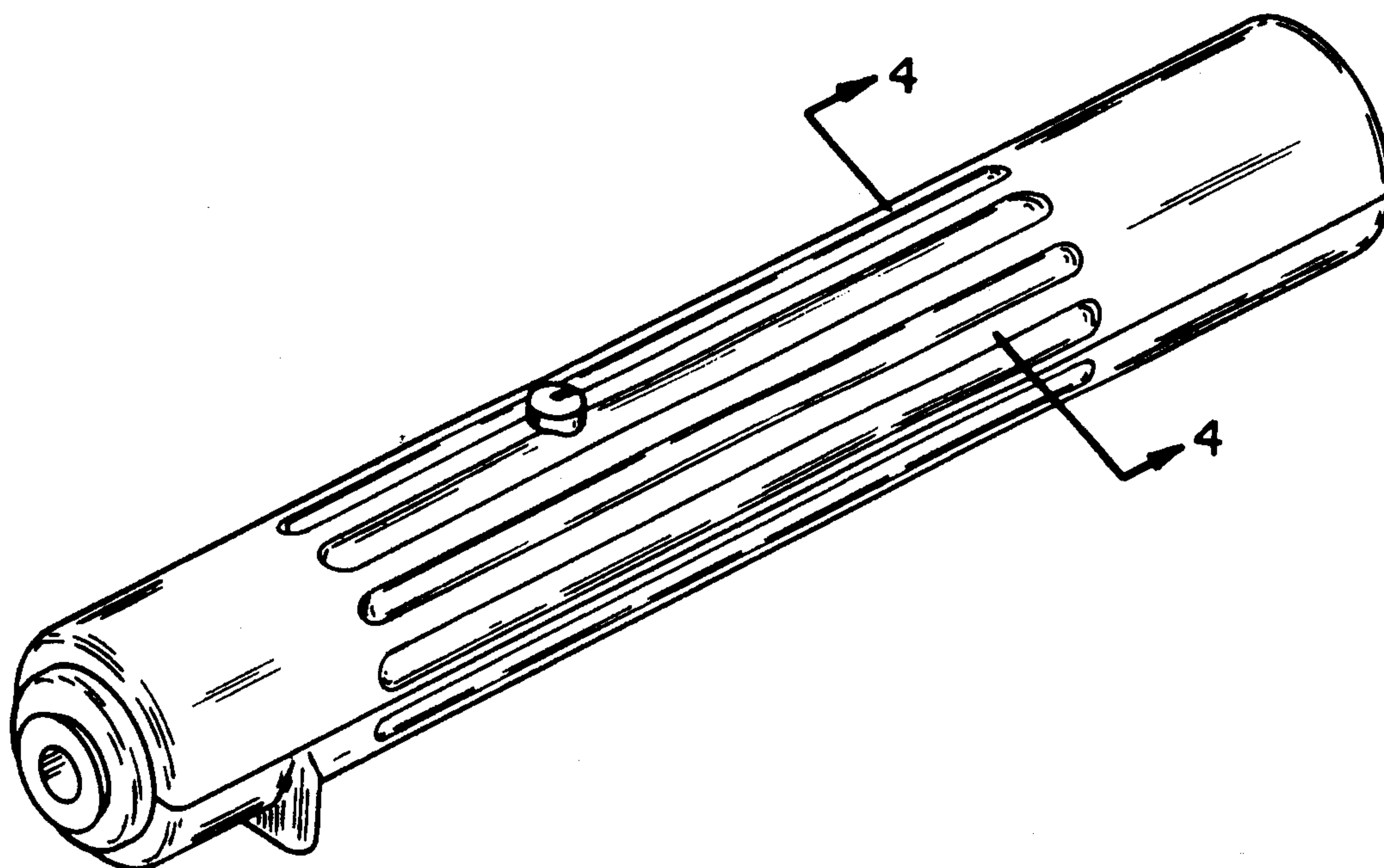
FIG. 3 is a view in rear elevation thereof on an enlarged

scale, the other side view being a mirror image.



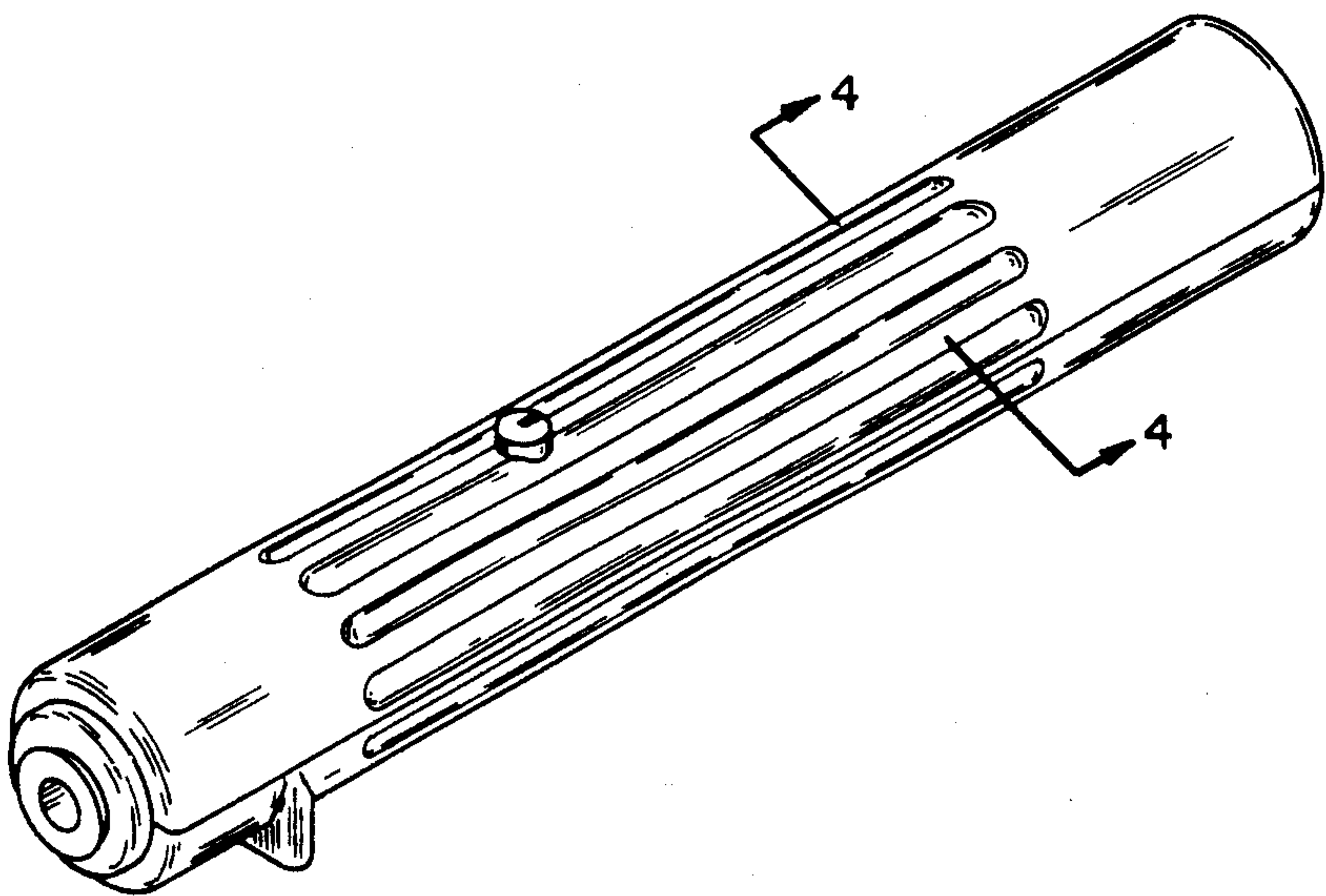

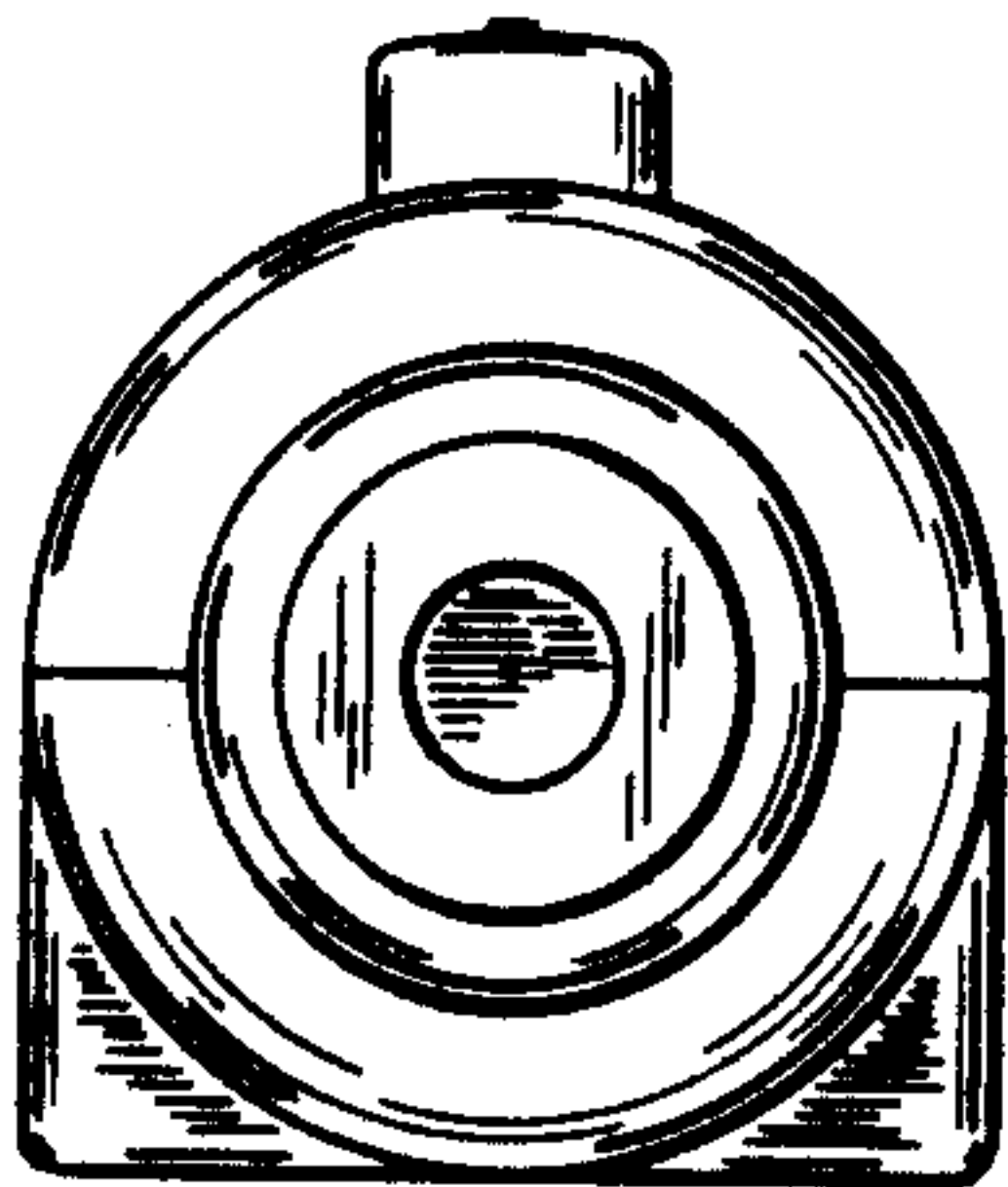

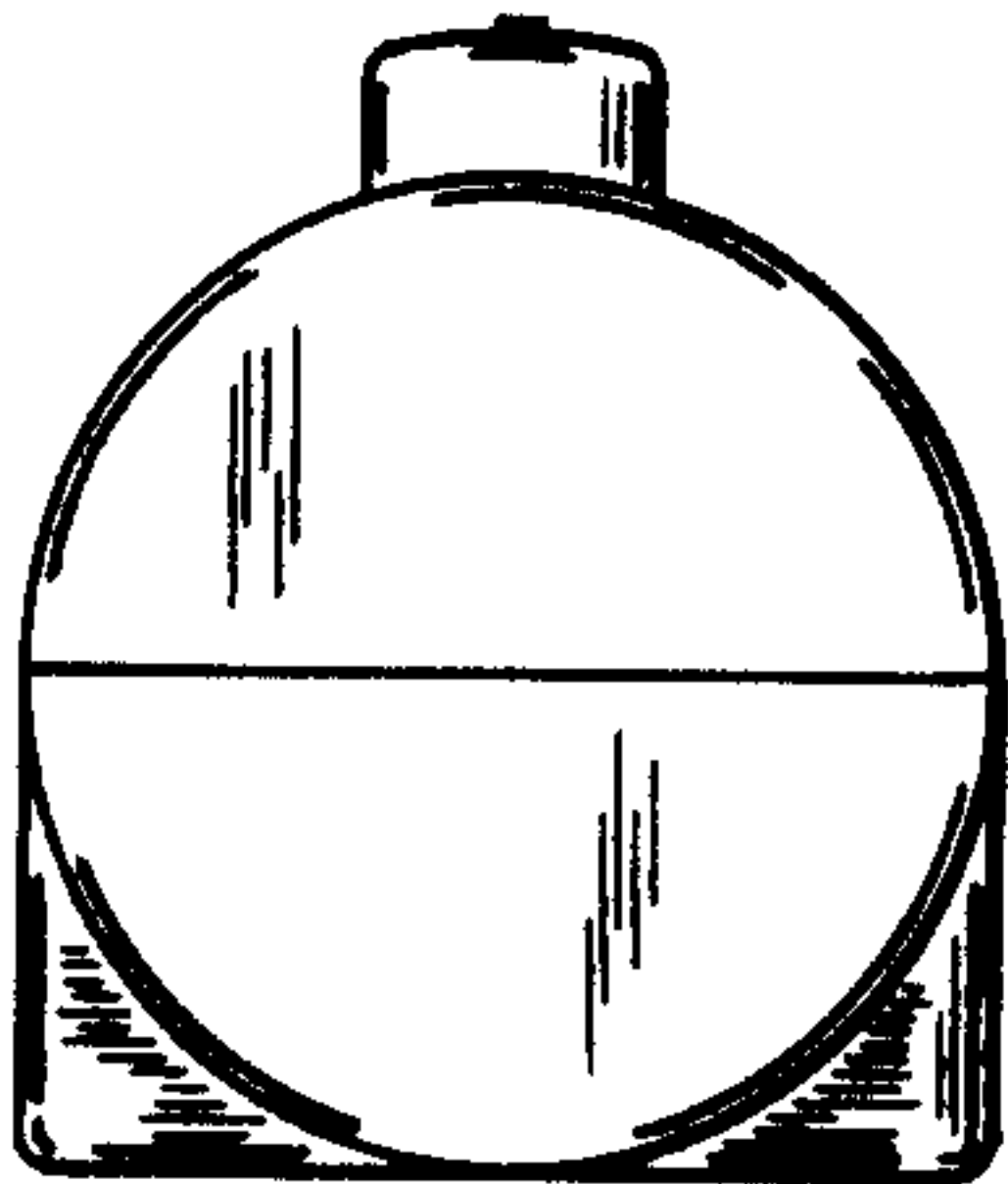

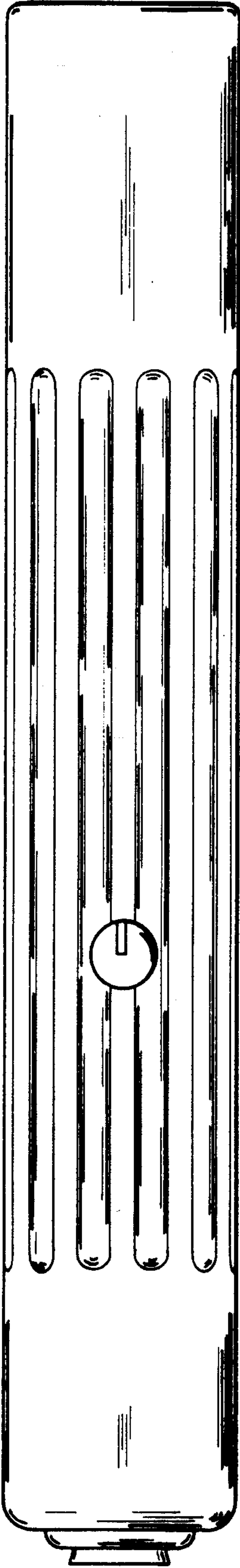

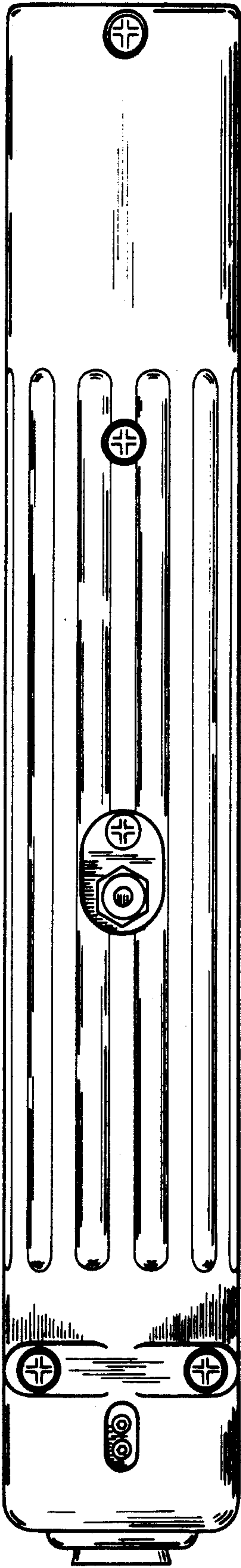

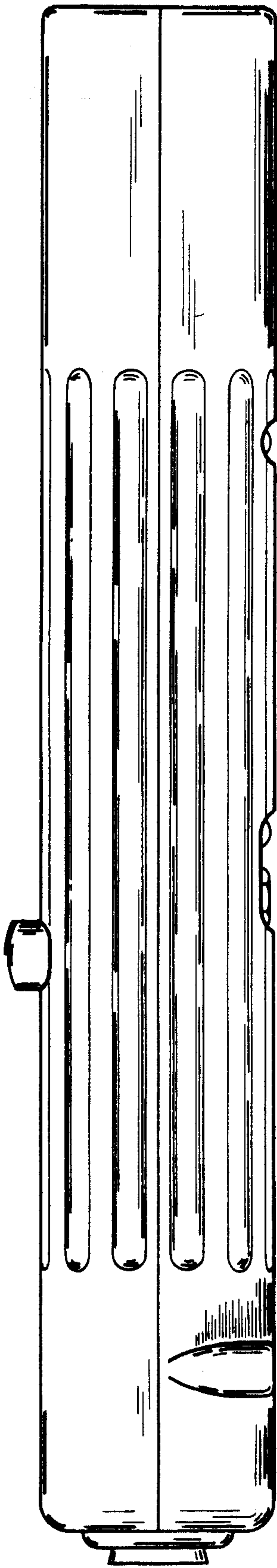
