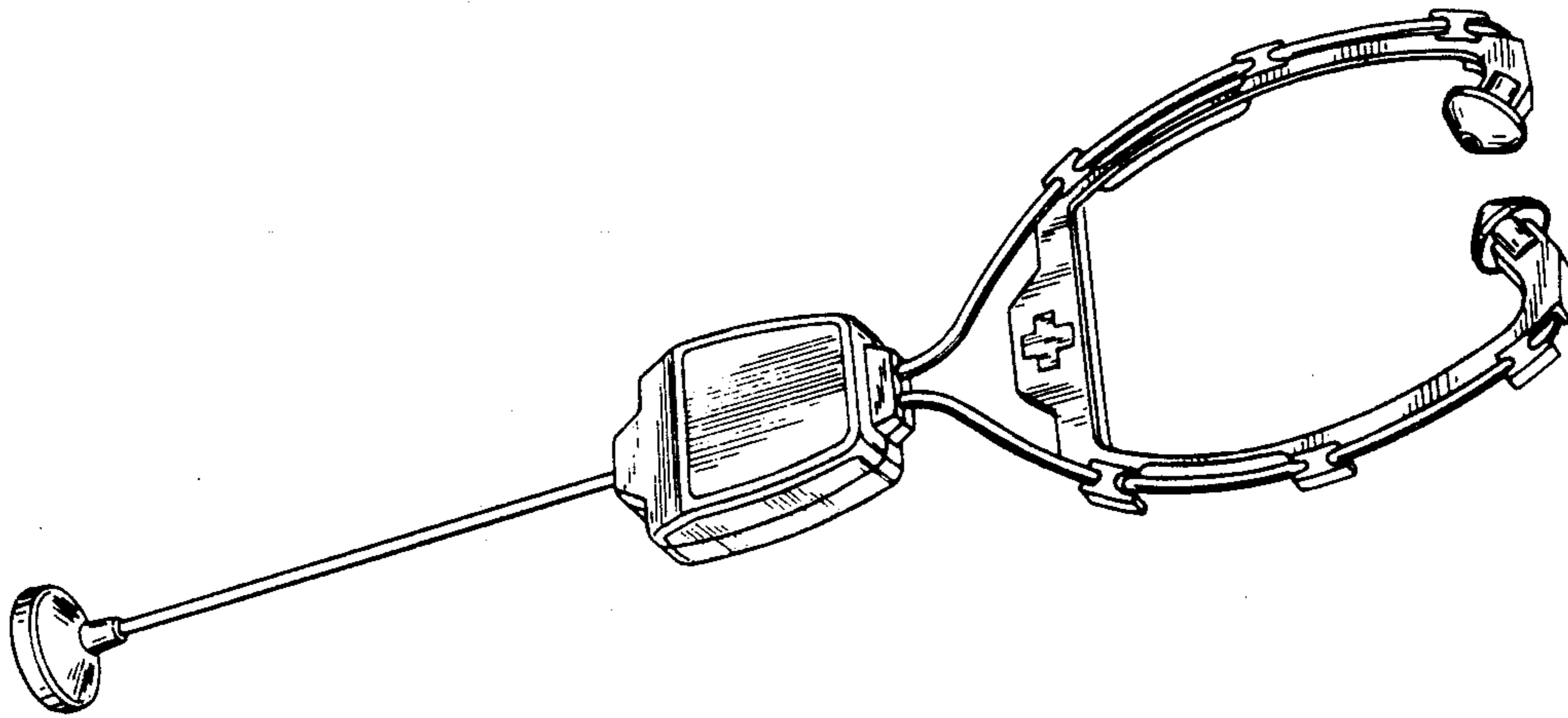

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy stethoscope, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy stethoscope illustrating our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view of the suspended member shown partially in fragment.



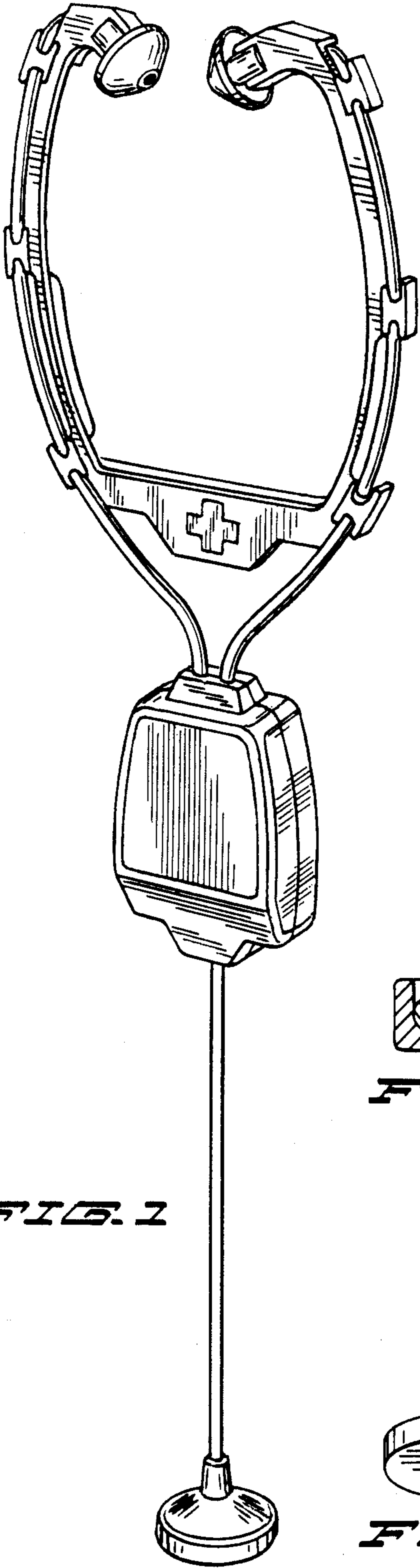

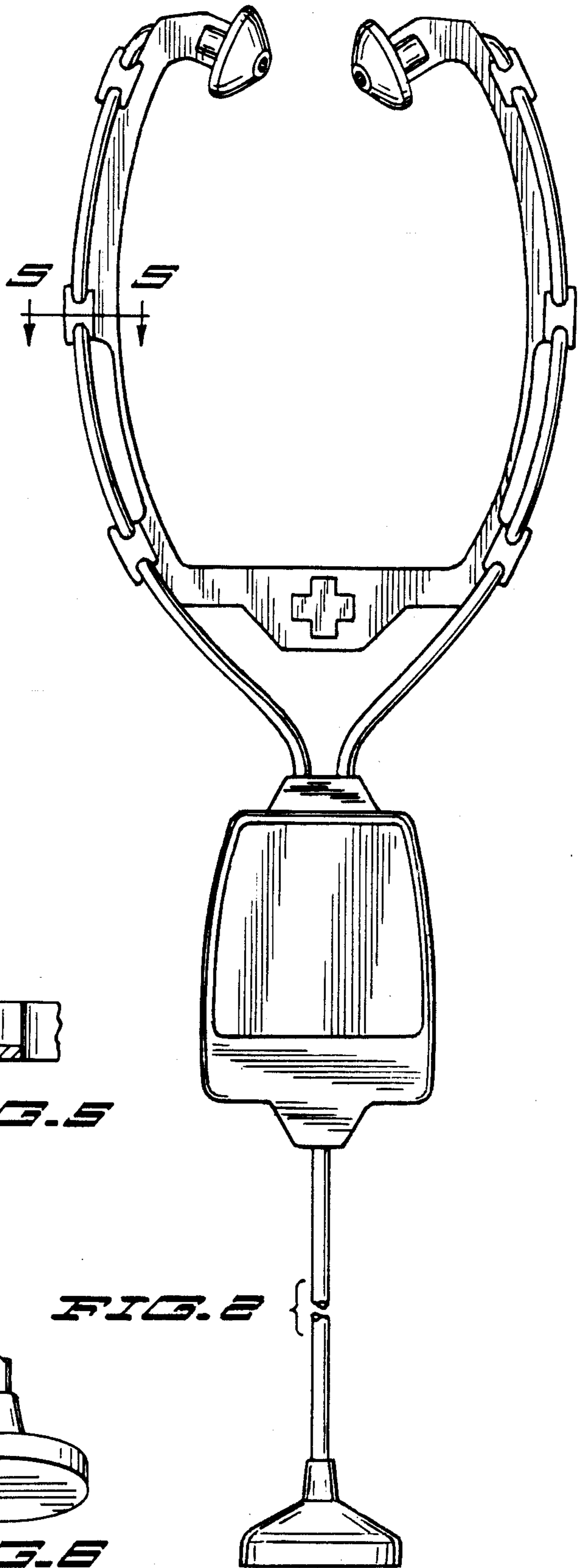

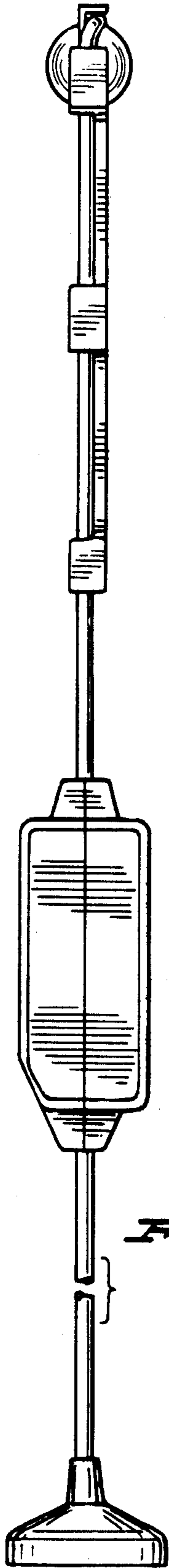

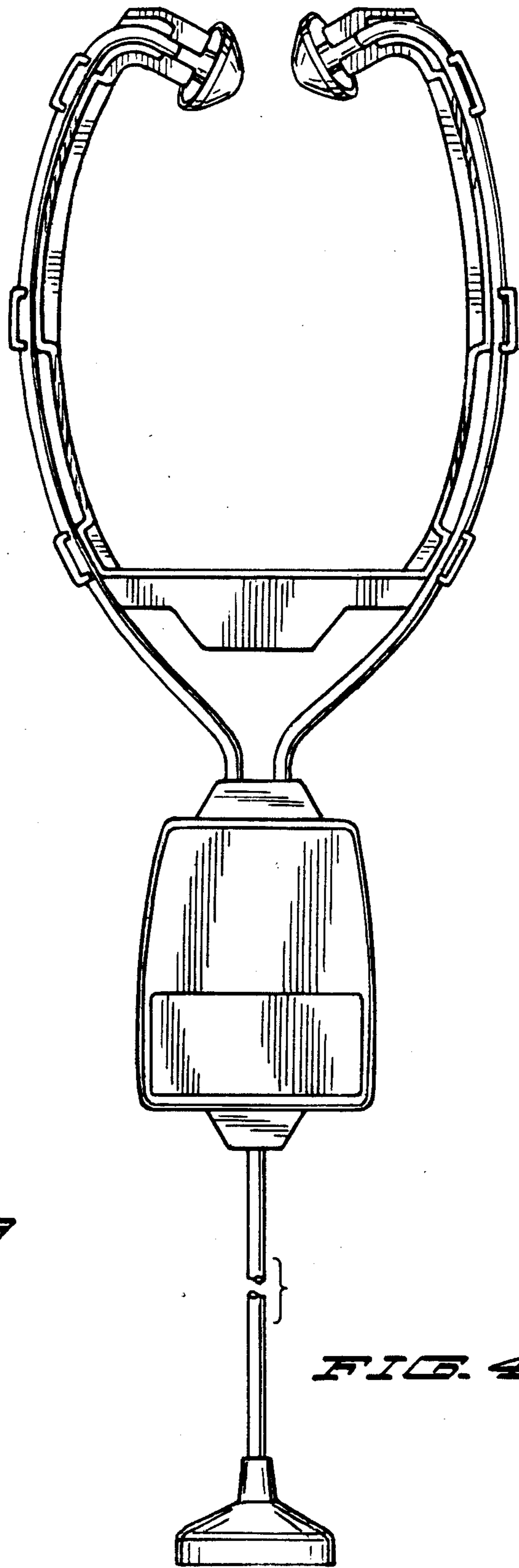
