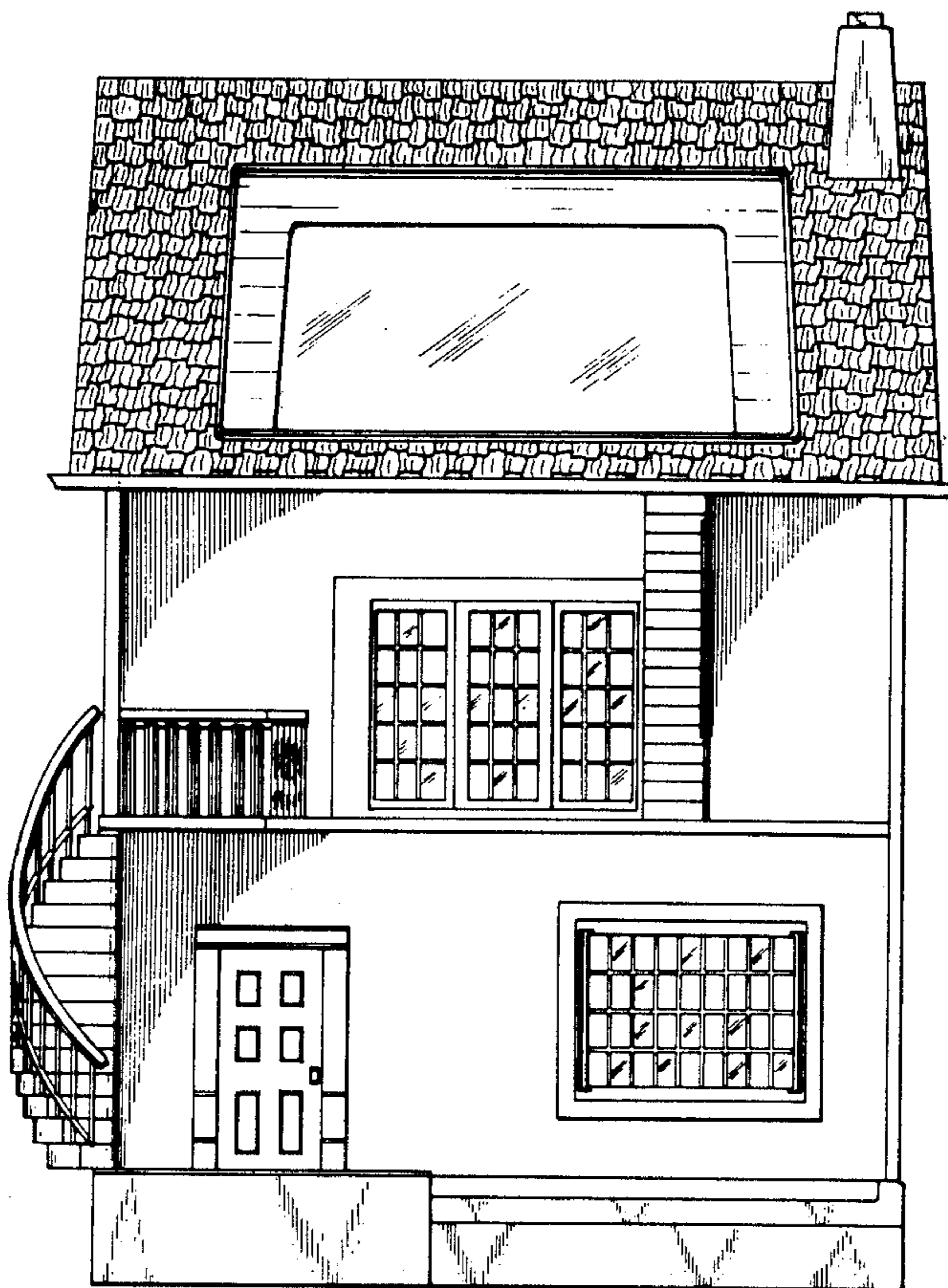

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy doll house, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a toy doll house showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



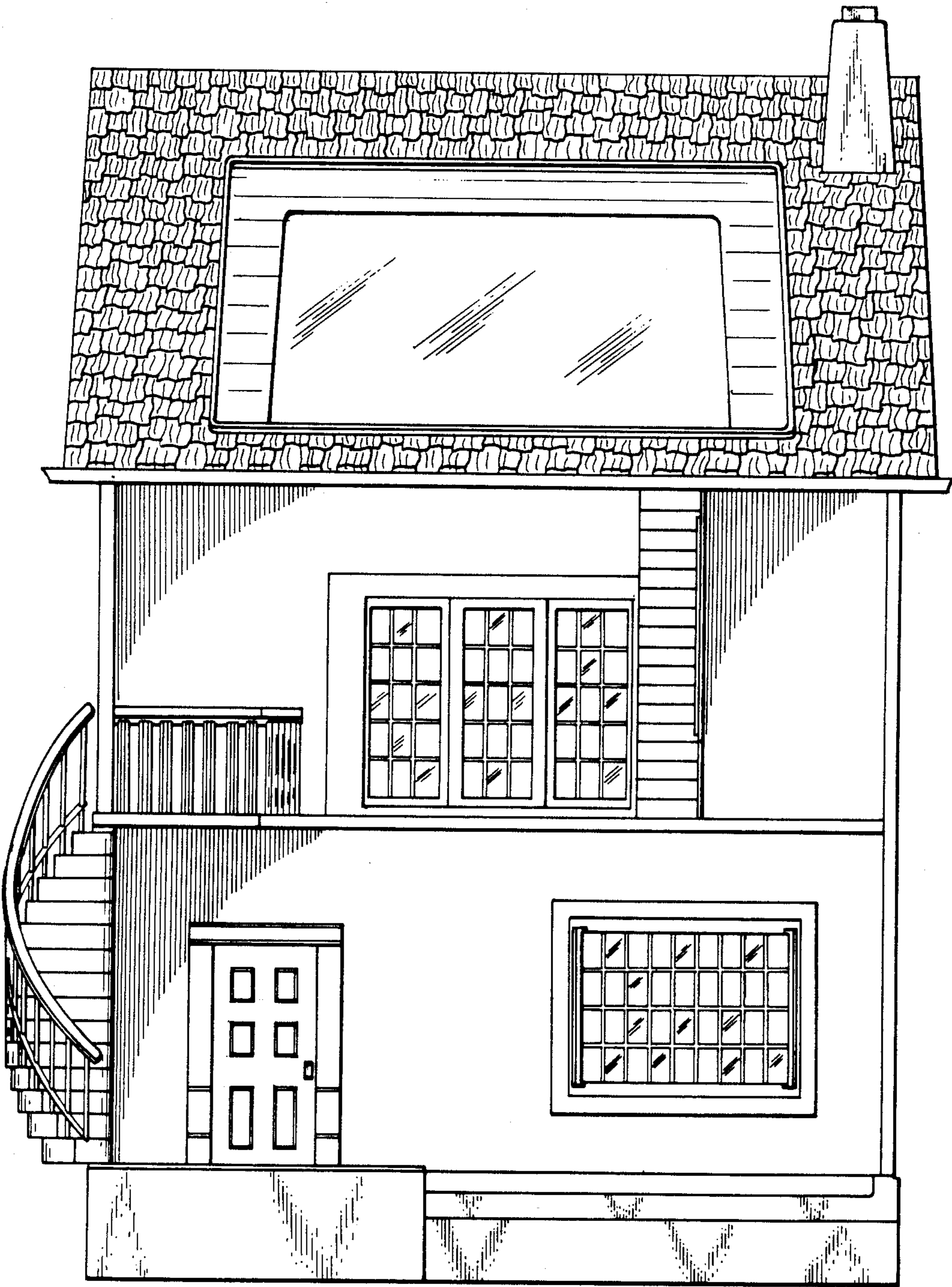

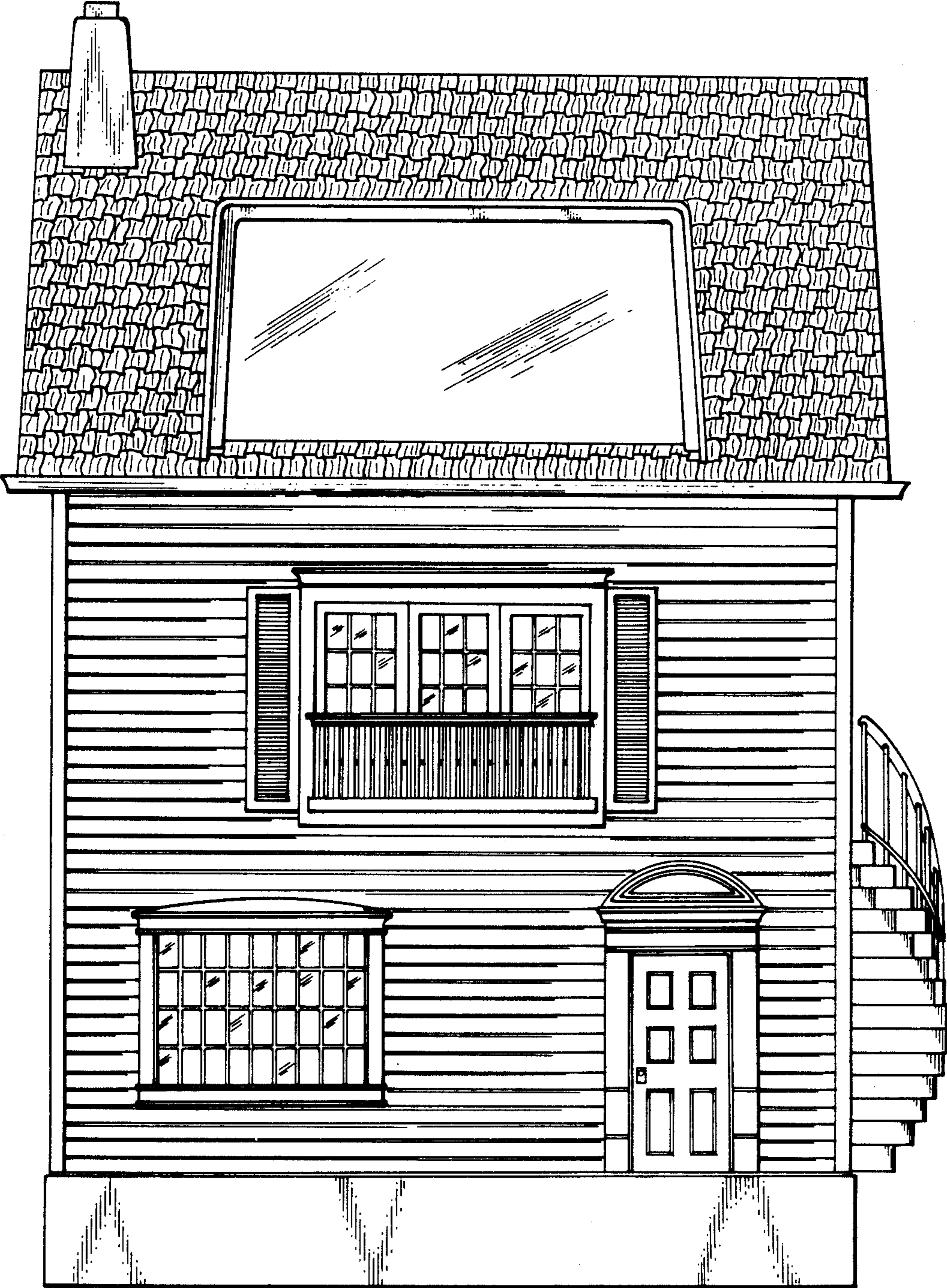

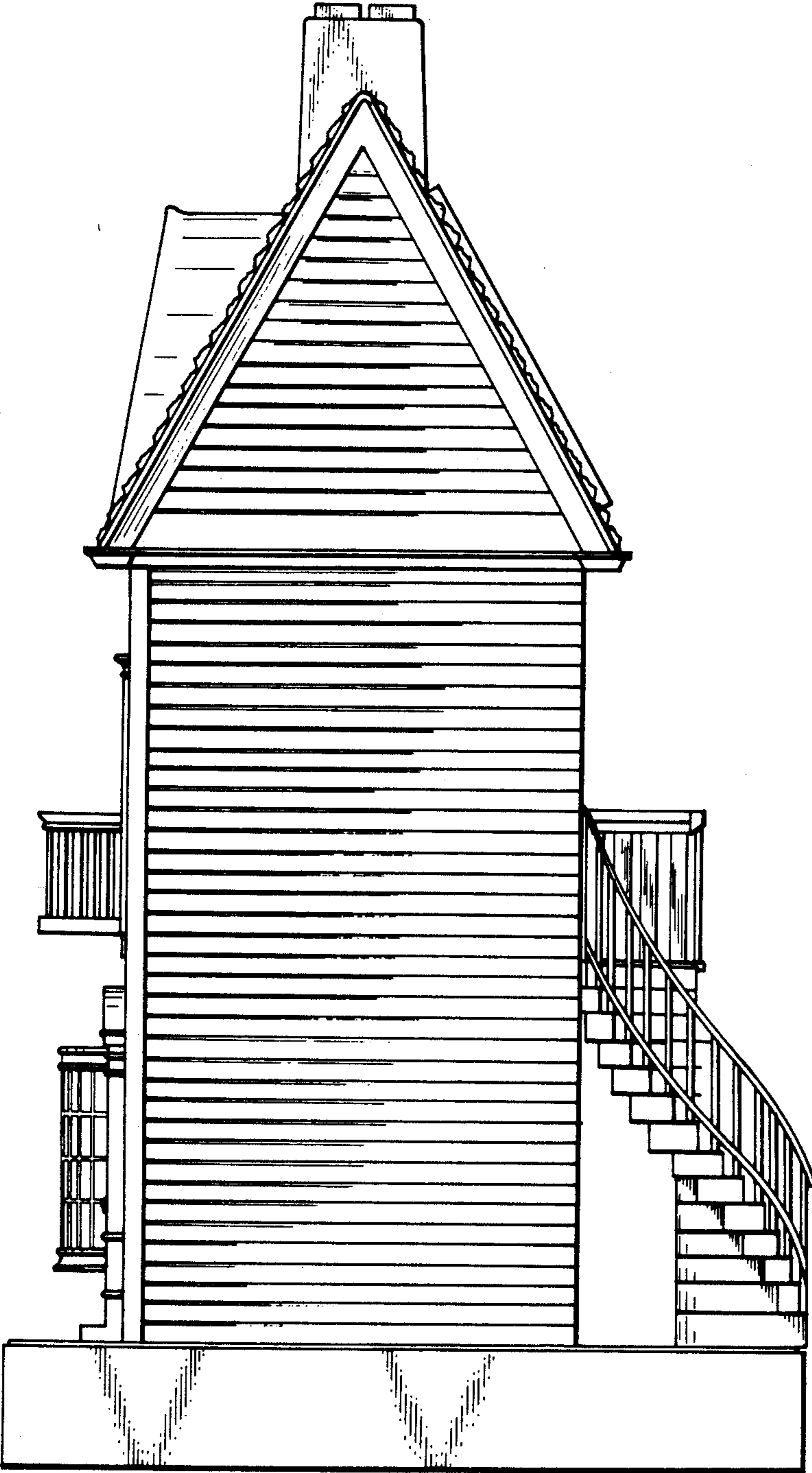

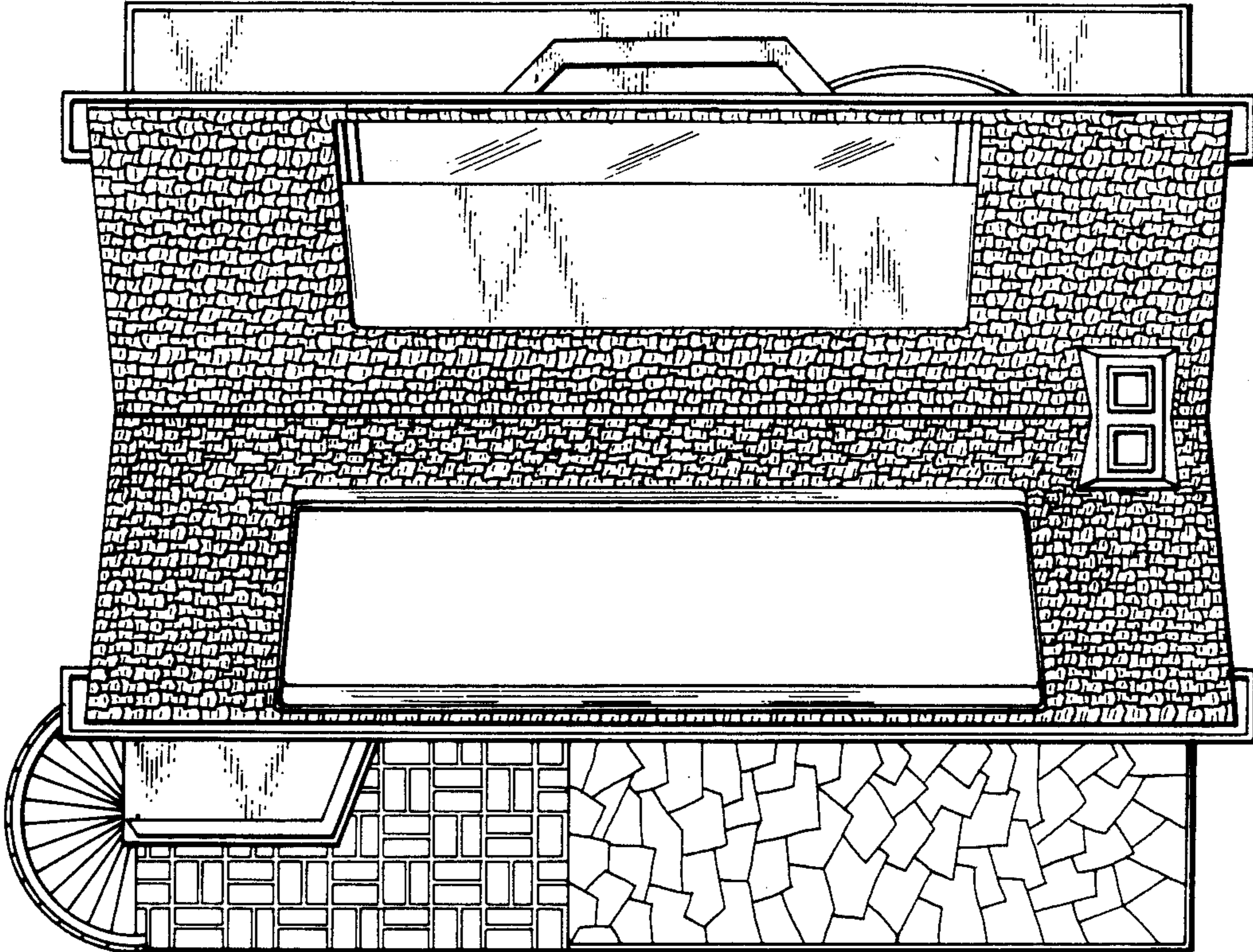

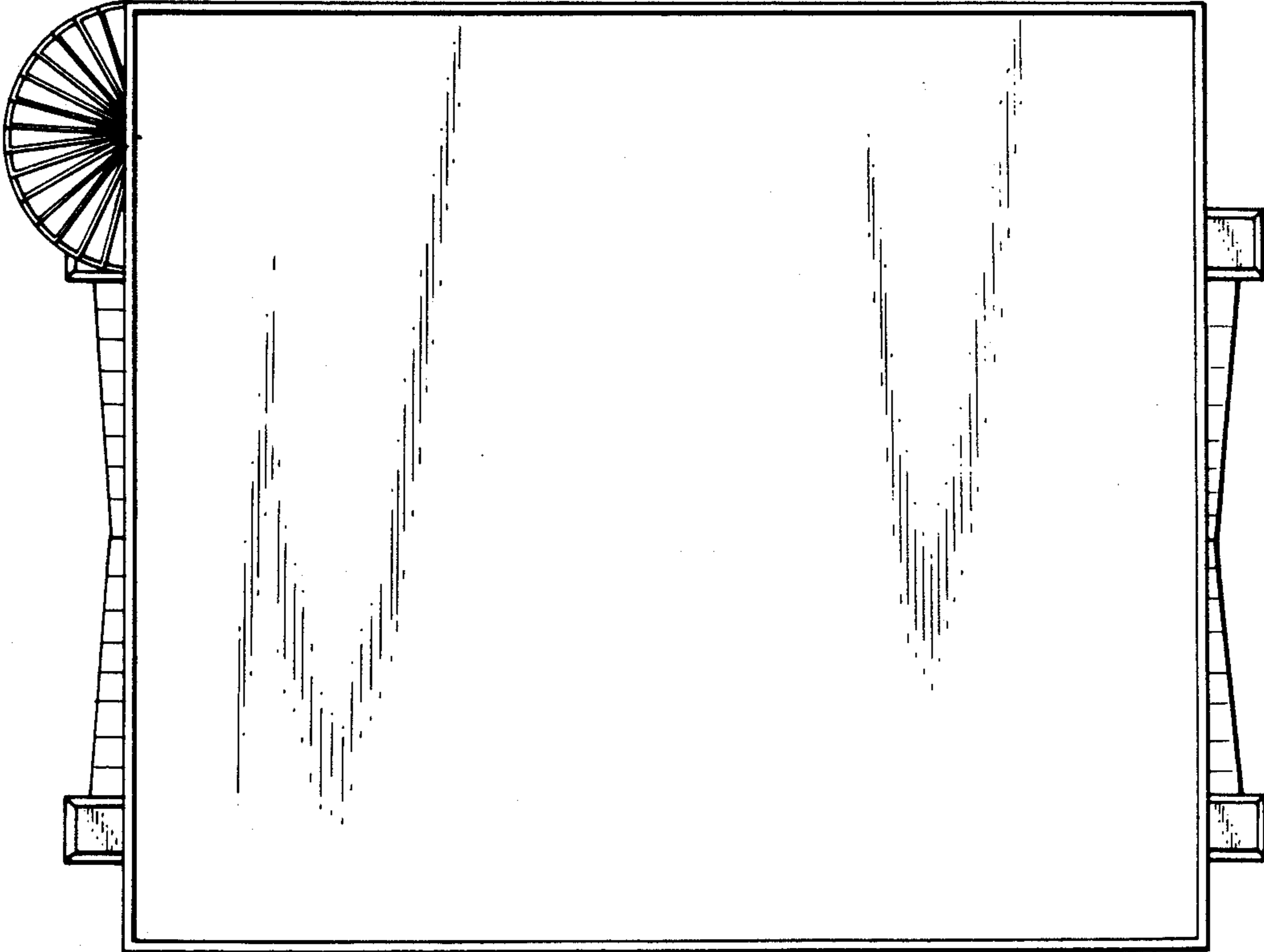
