DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a belt buckle illustrating my new design;

FIG. 4 is an exploded perspective view thereof.

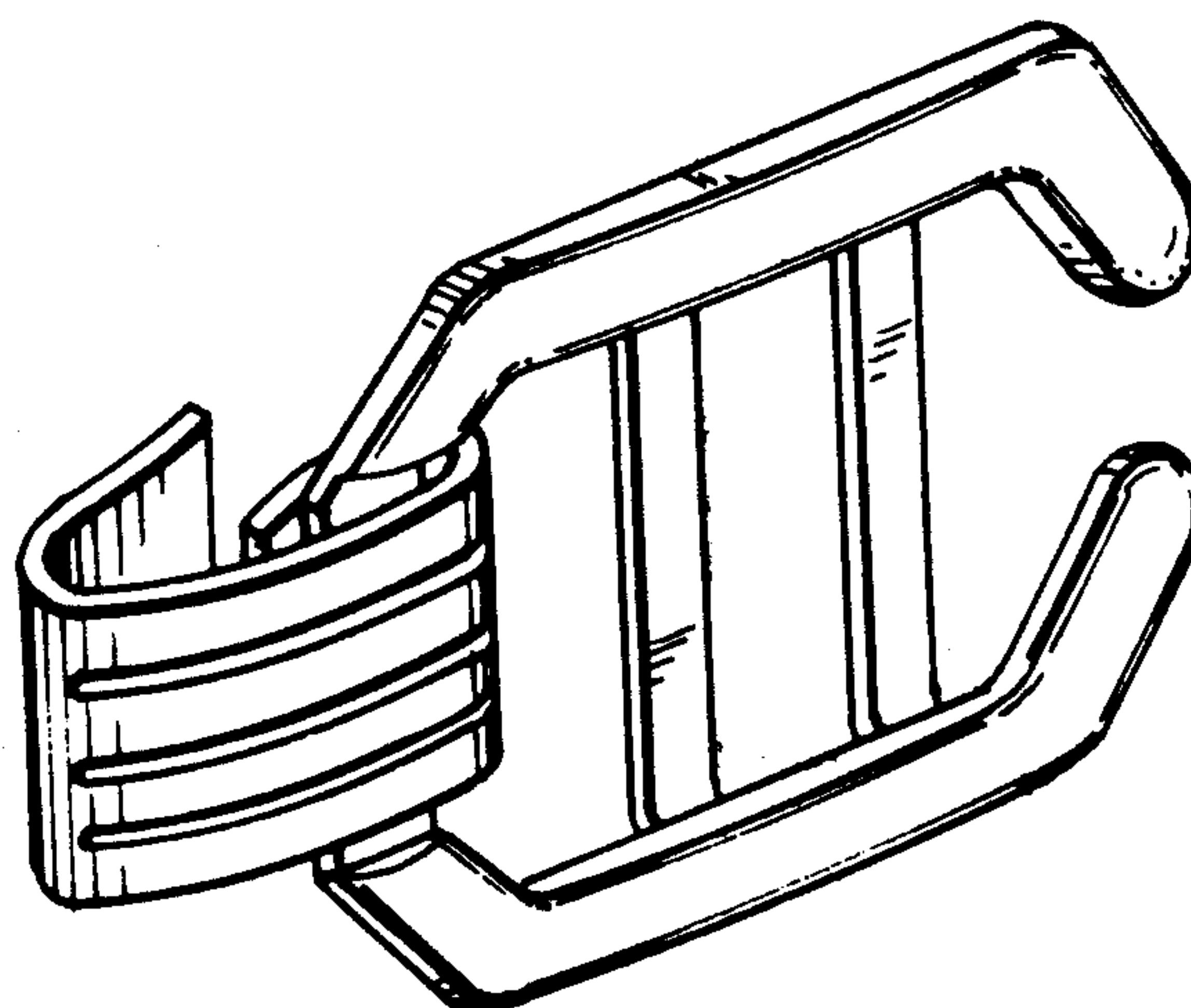
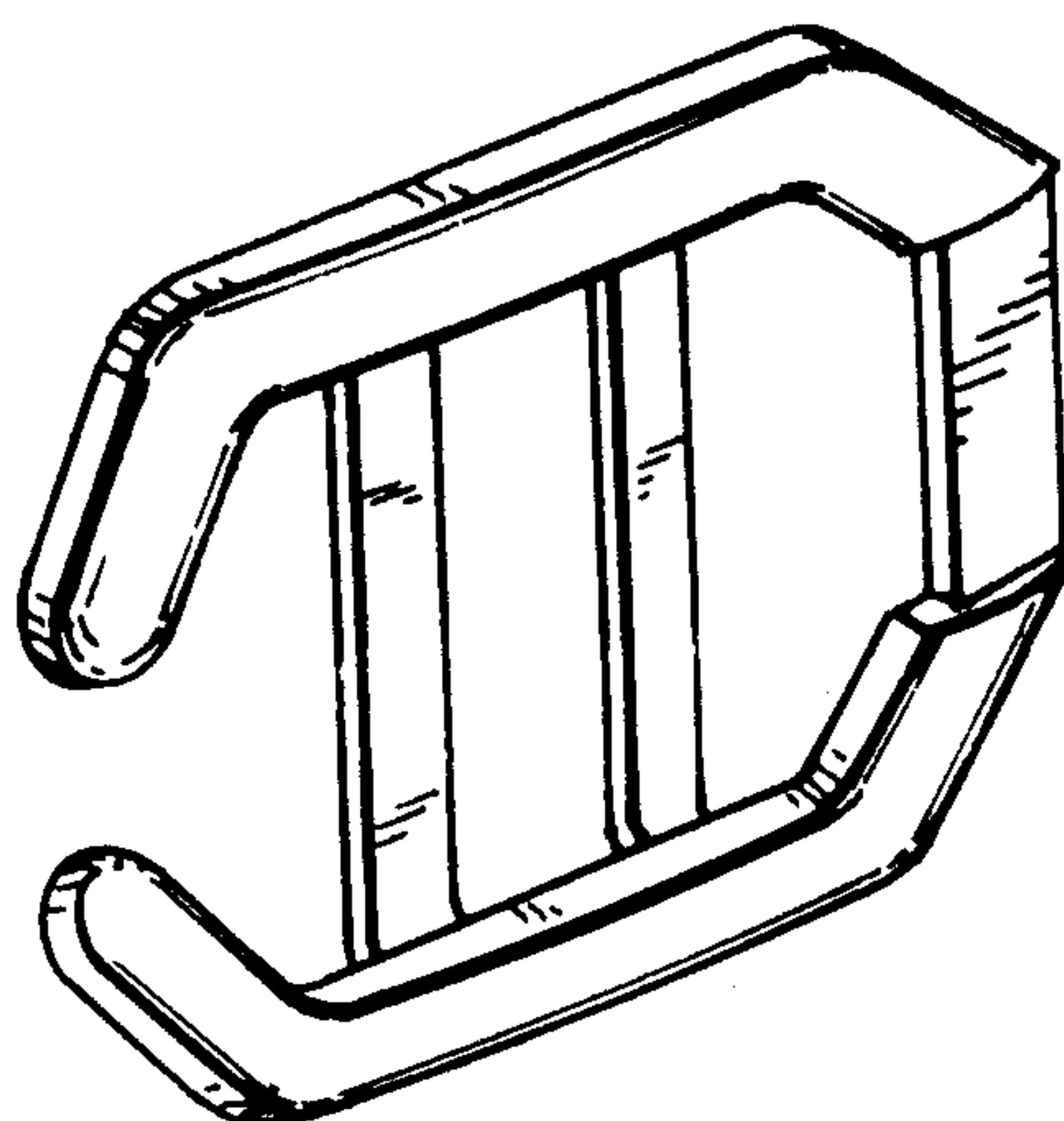

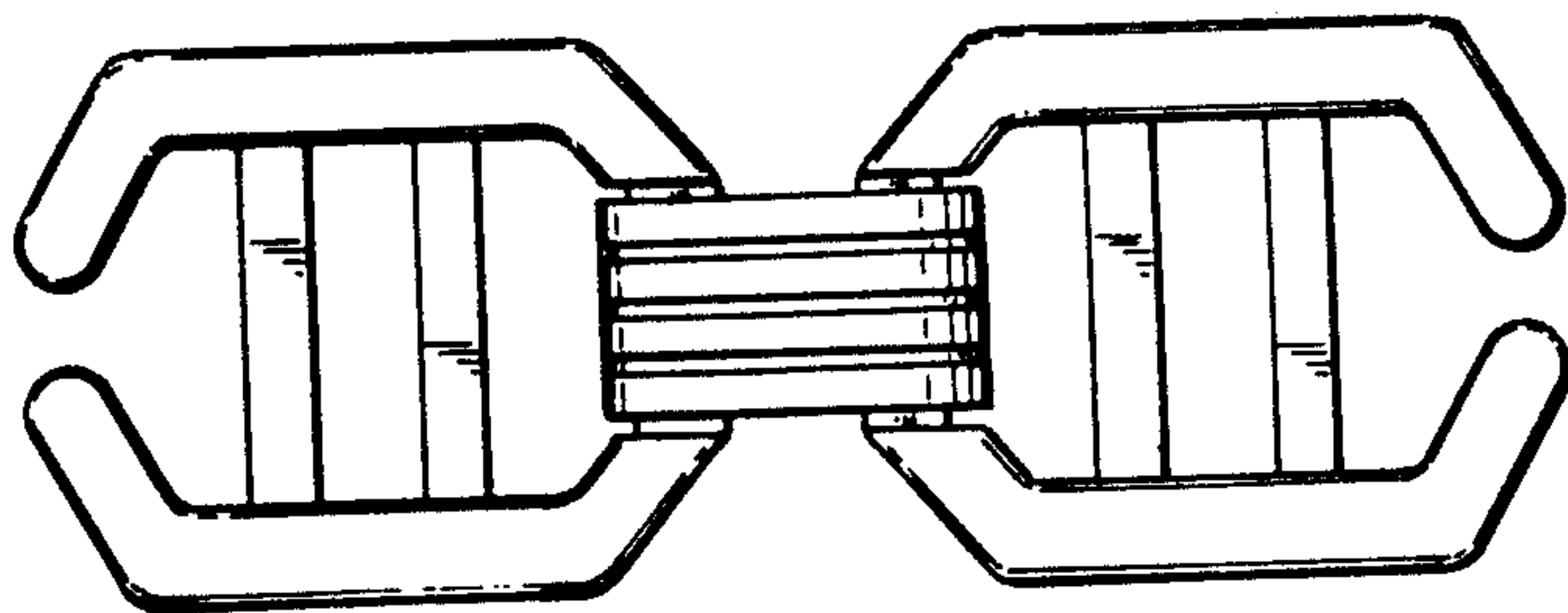
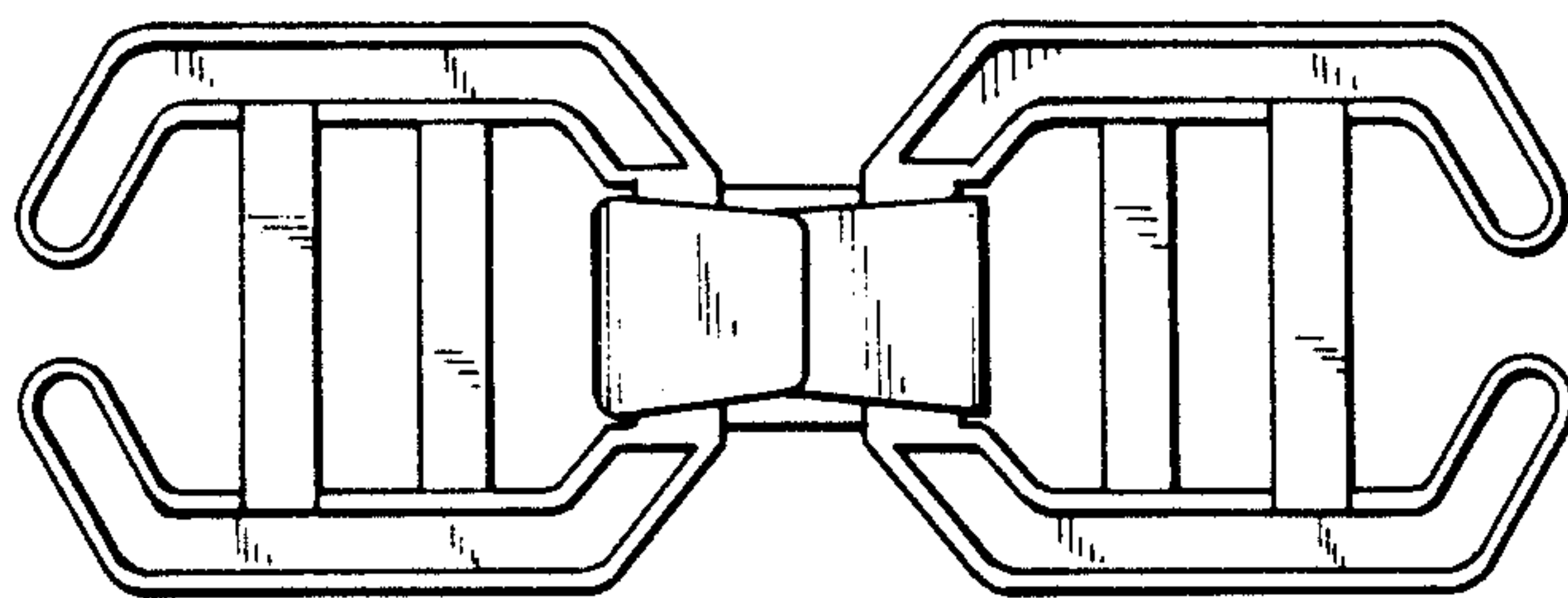
