[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cabinet for a sewing machine and accessory items, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the cabinet for a sewing machine and accessory items showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the cabinet for a sewing machine and accessory items with the front door open and the sewing machine supporting platform extended;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the cabinet for a sewing machine and accessory items;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the cabinet for a sewing machine and accessory items;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the cabinet for a sewing machine and accessory items.






