DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a thermometer
support base showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right
side being a mirror image thereto;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view
a mirror image thereto.

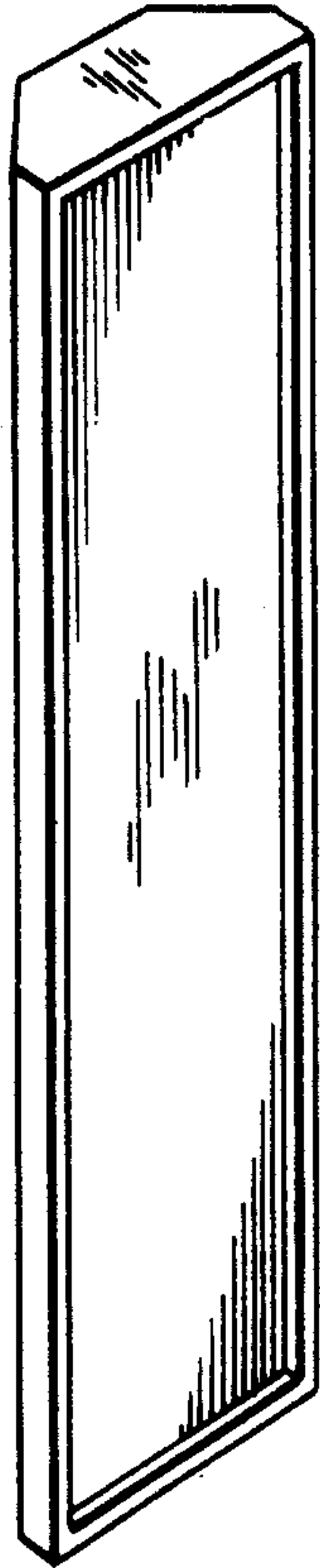

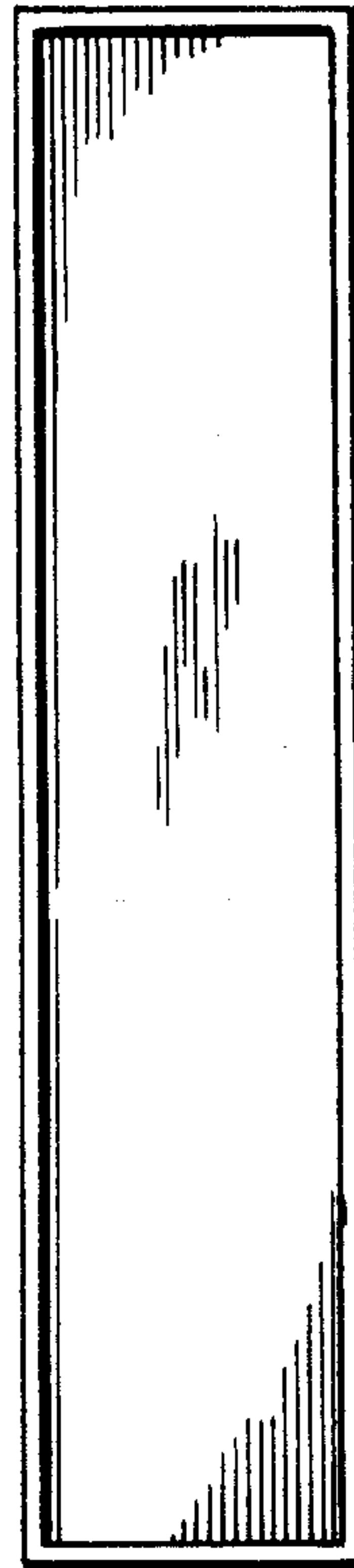

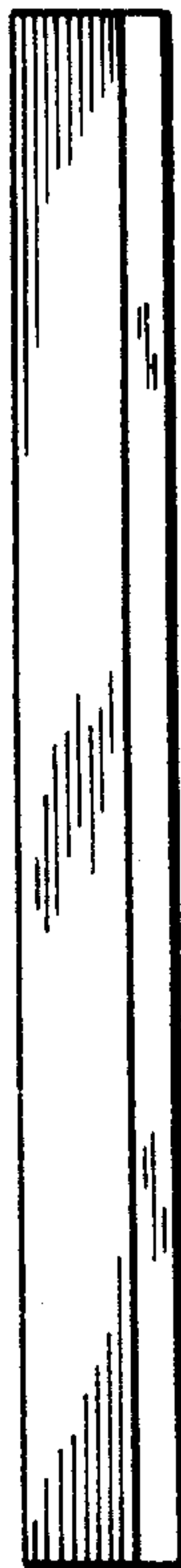

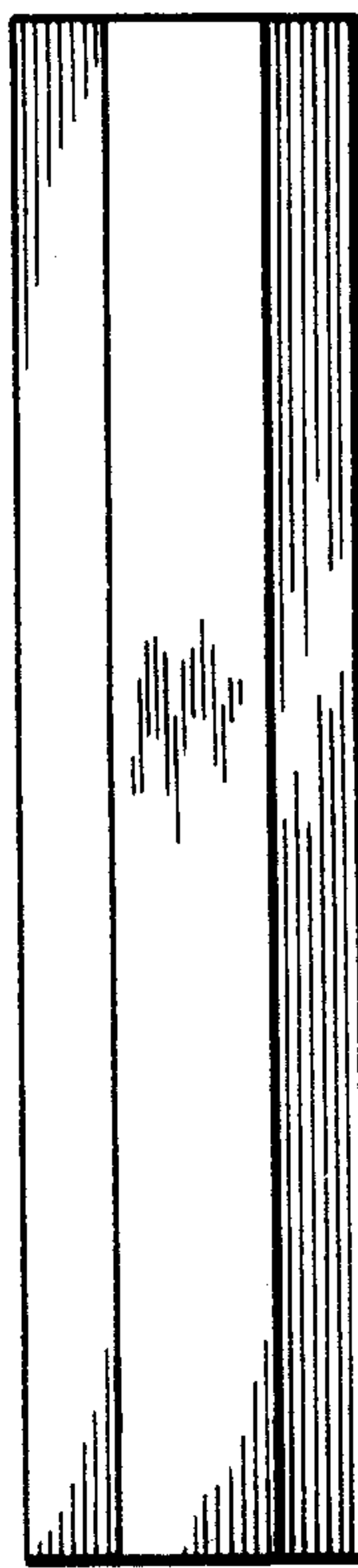
