[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an operating assembly for a cigarette lighter, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an operating assembly for a cigarette lighter showing my new design, FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, and FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

The lighter housing is shown, in open position, in FIG. 1 for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the invention.

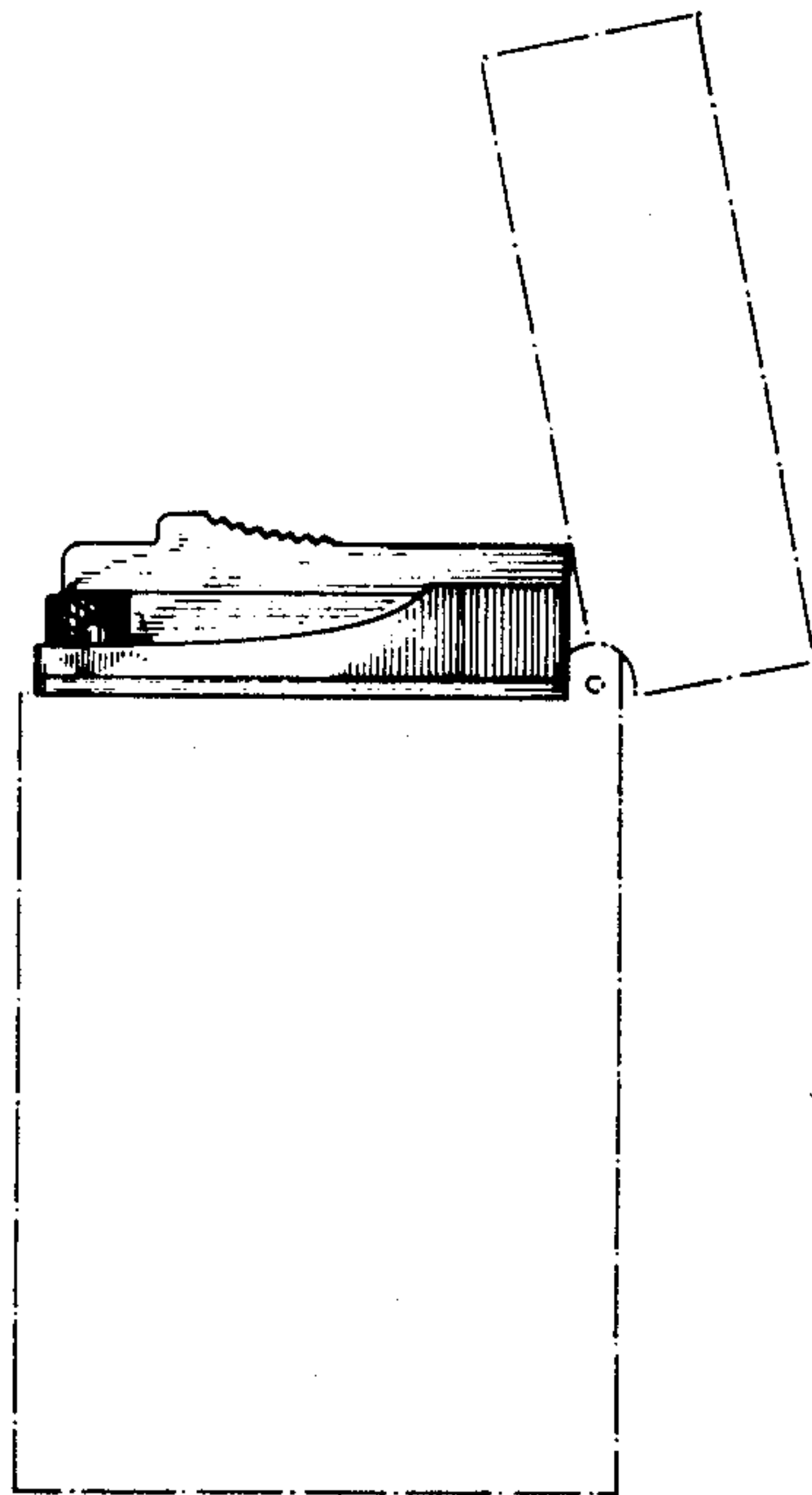

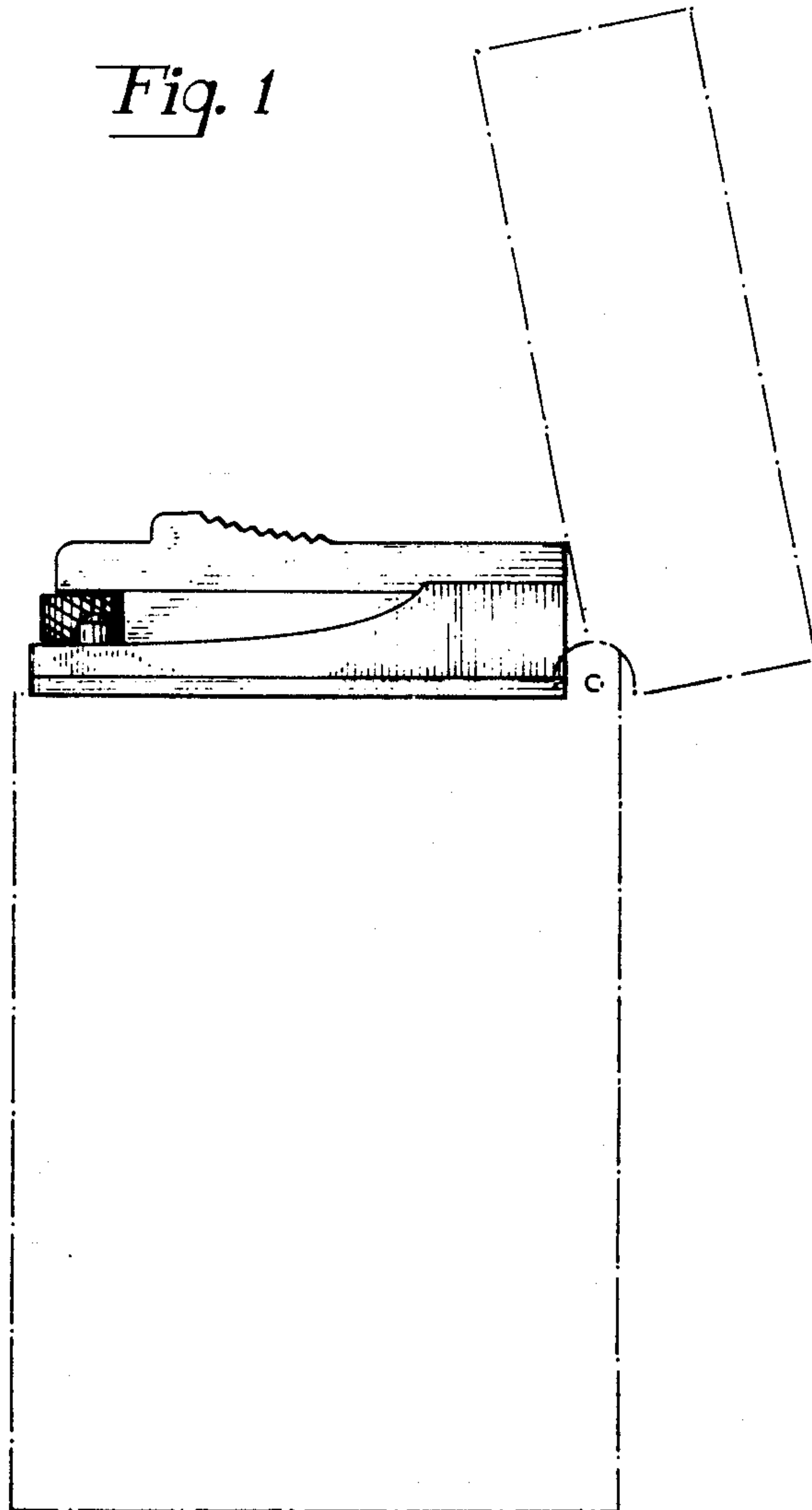

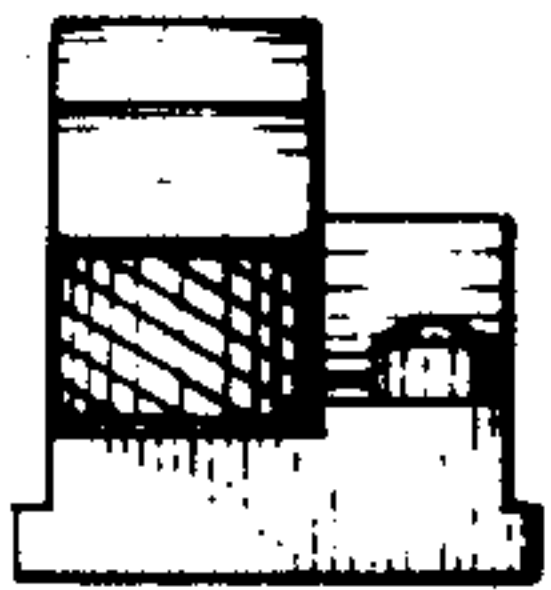

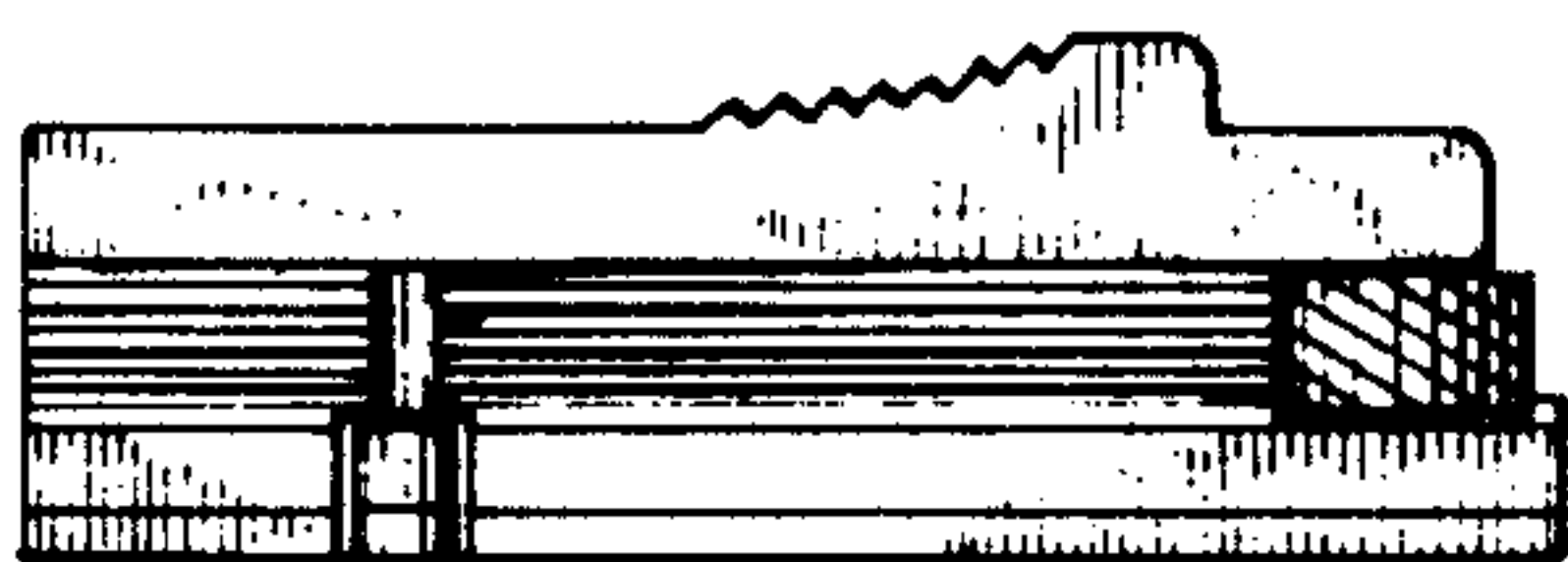
