The ornamental design for a combined display holder package and advertising holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined display package and advertising holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the left side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken in the direction of the arrows on line 7-7 of FIG. 1.

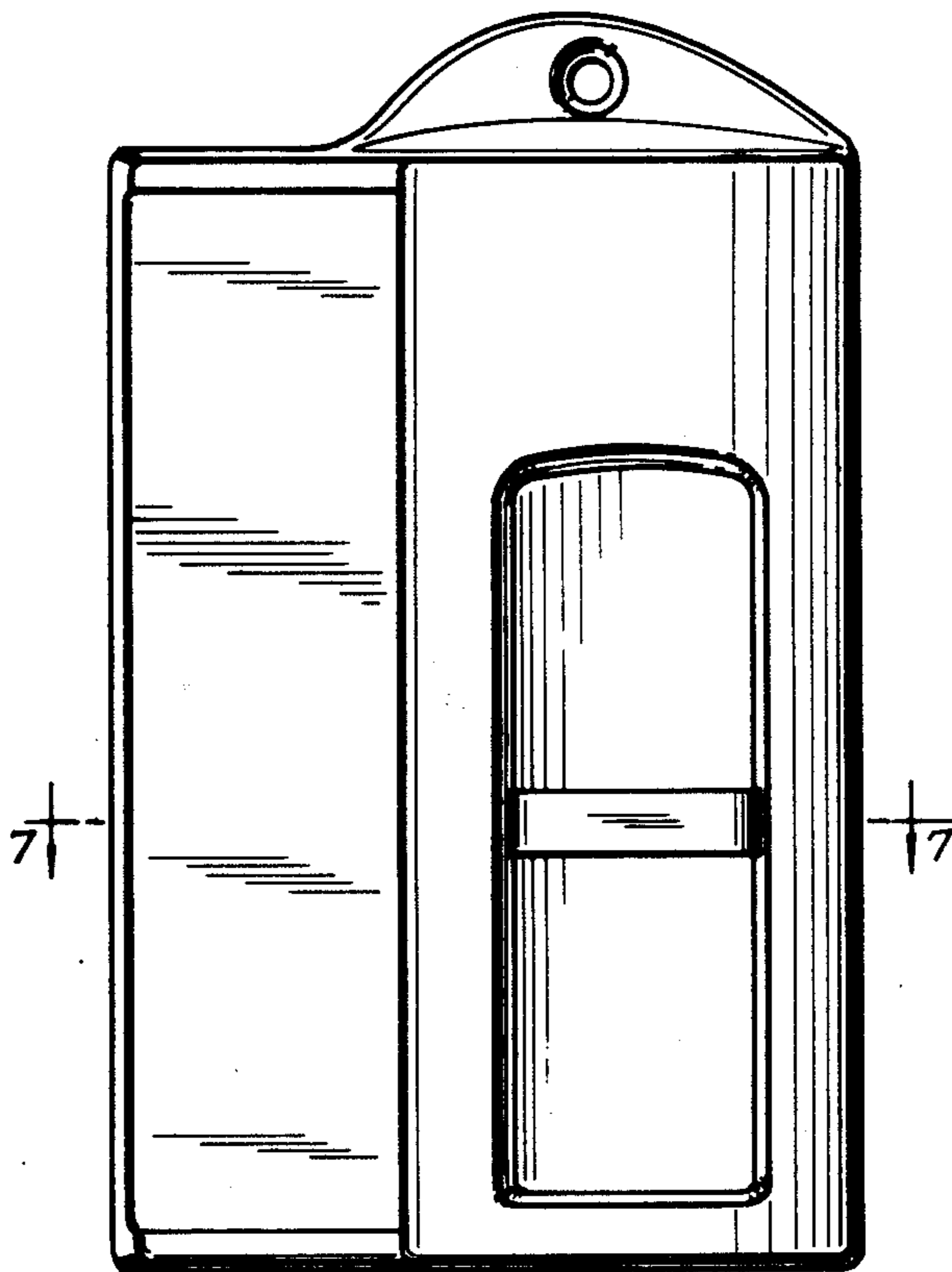

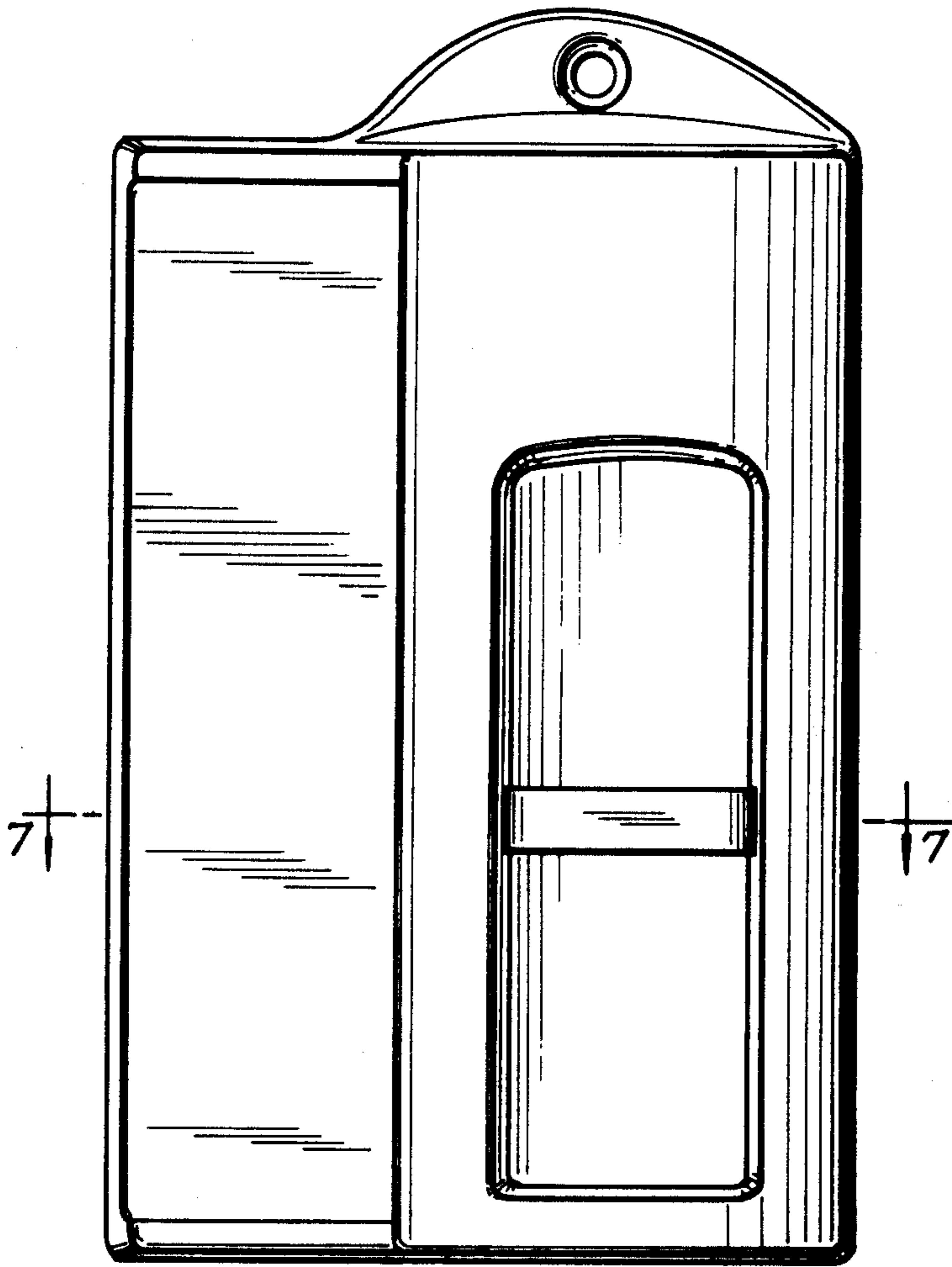

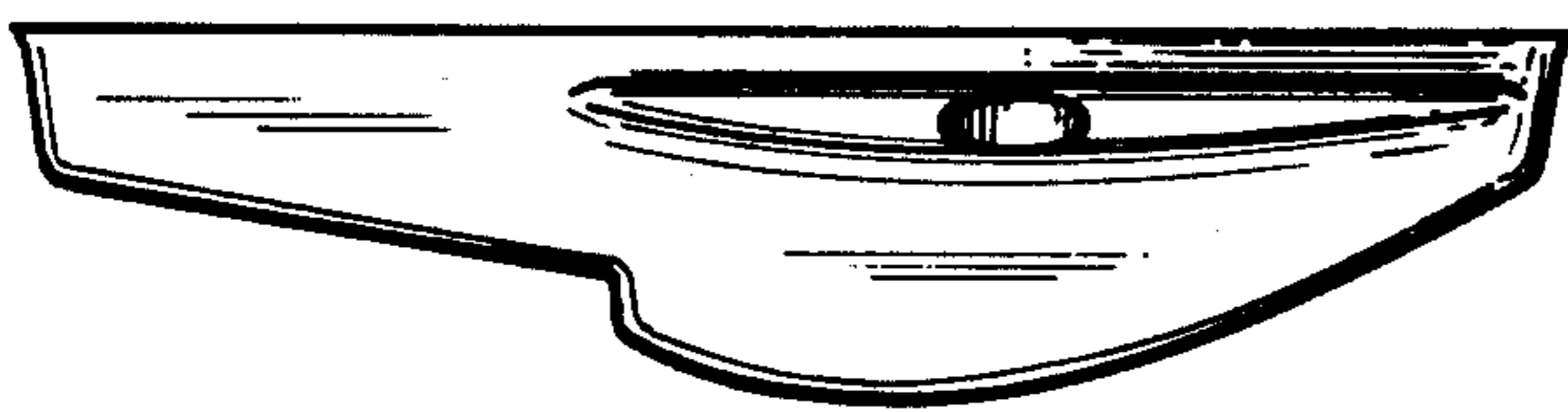

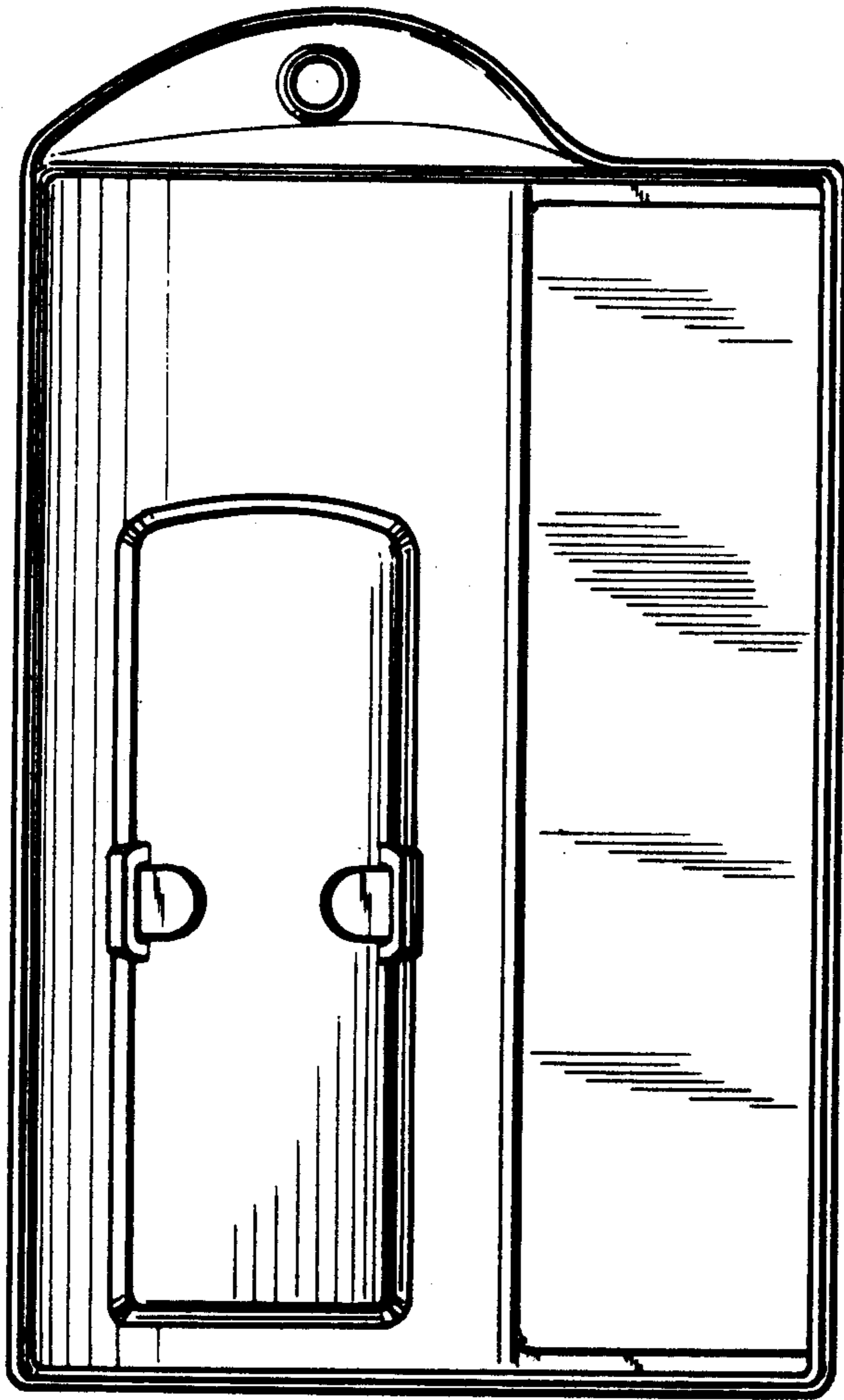

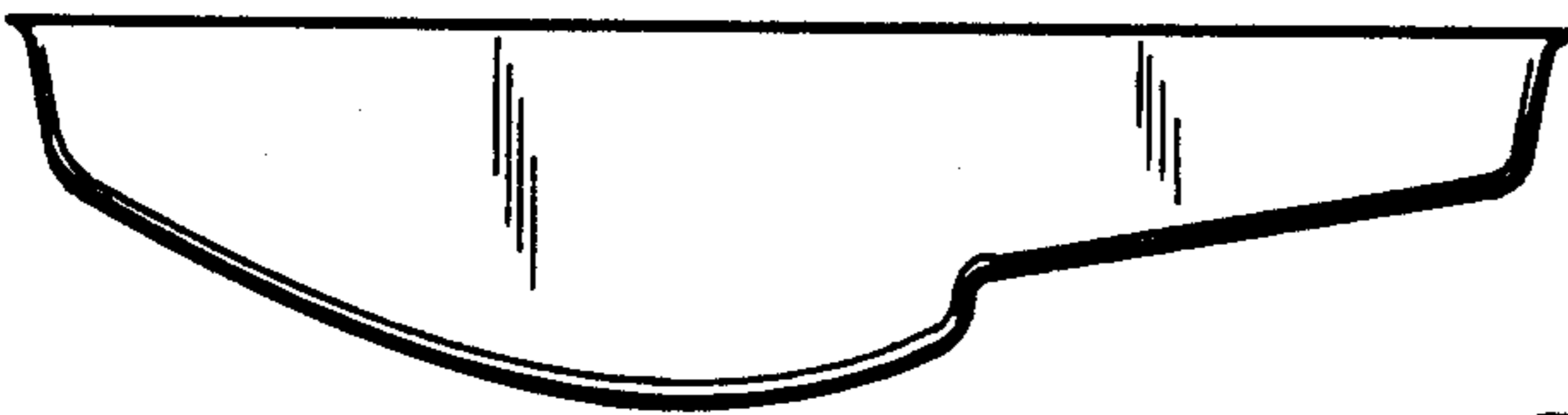
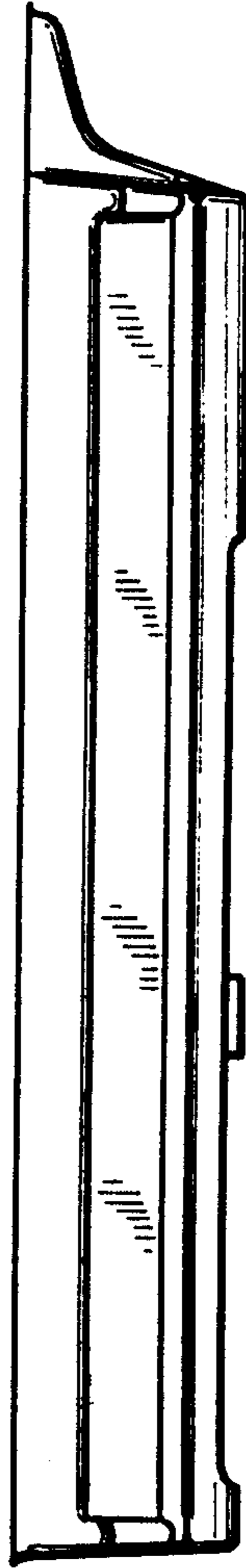
