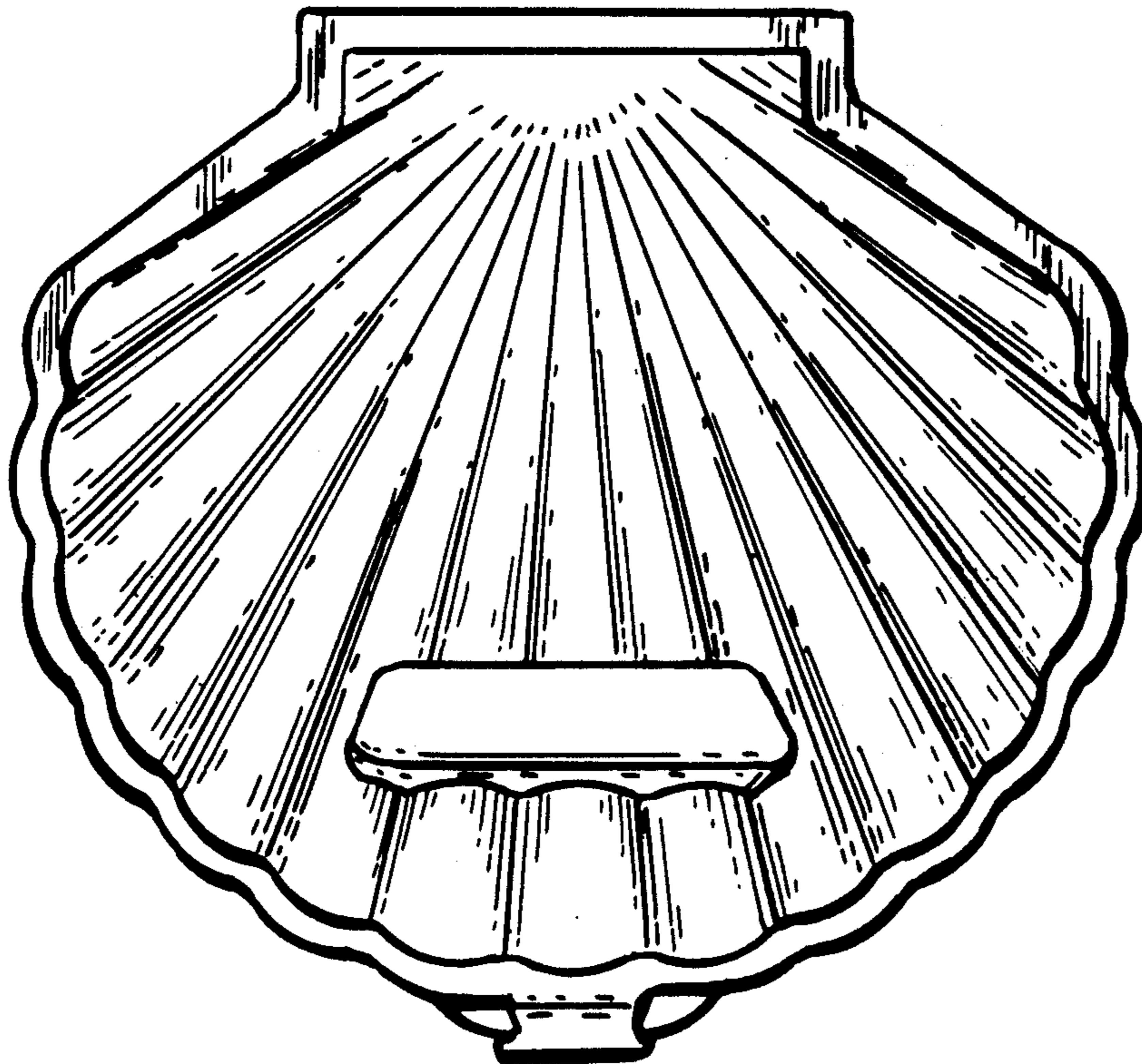

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a takeout food container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a food container showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view looking from the left side of FIG. 2, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a top perspective view in an open position.



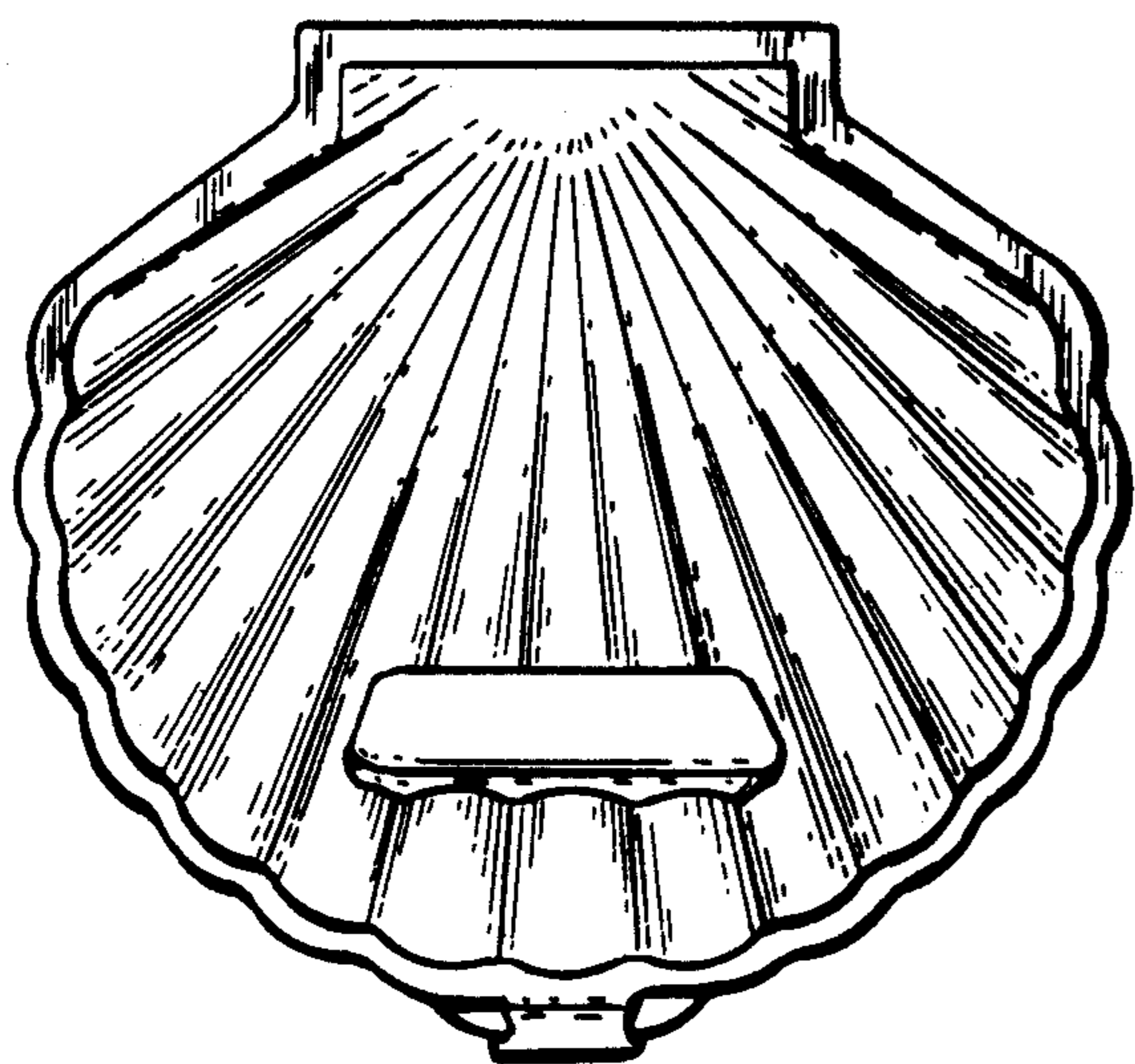

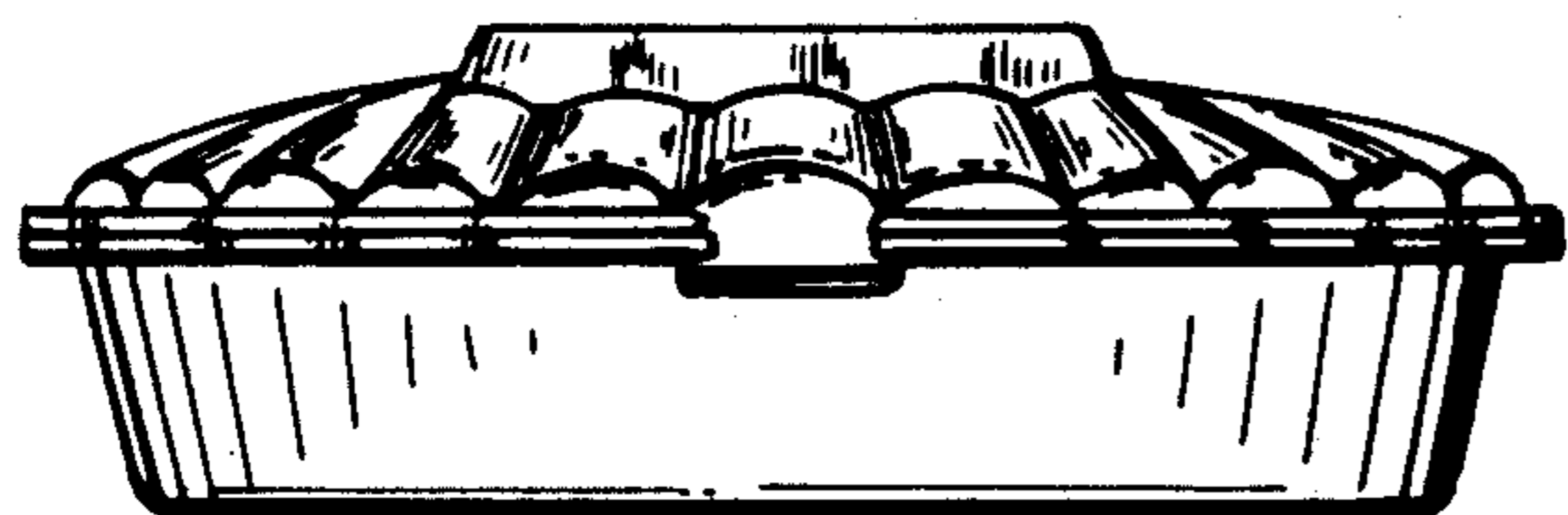

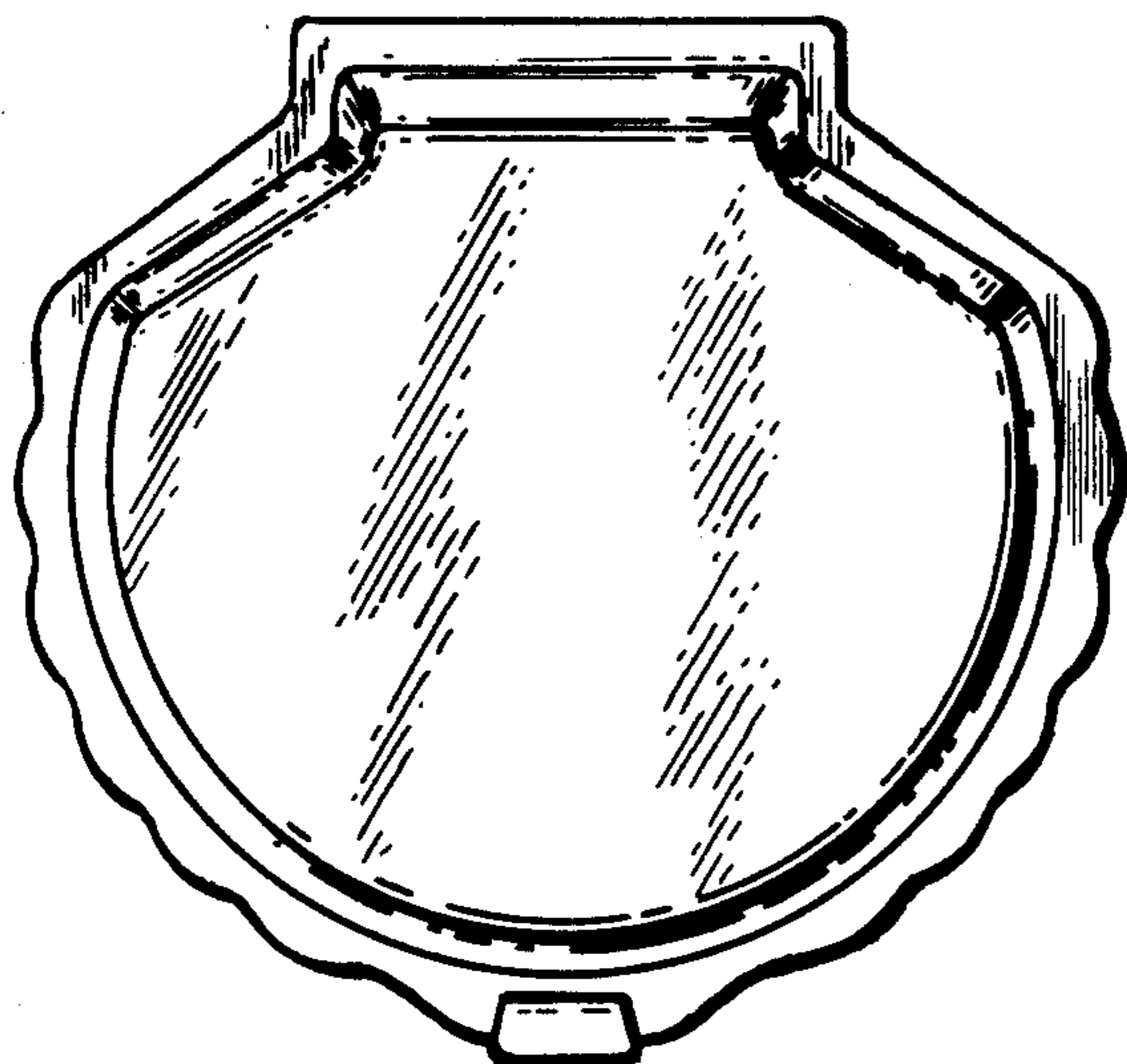

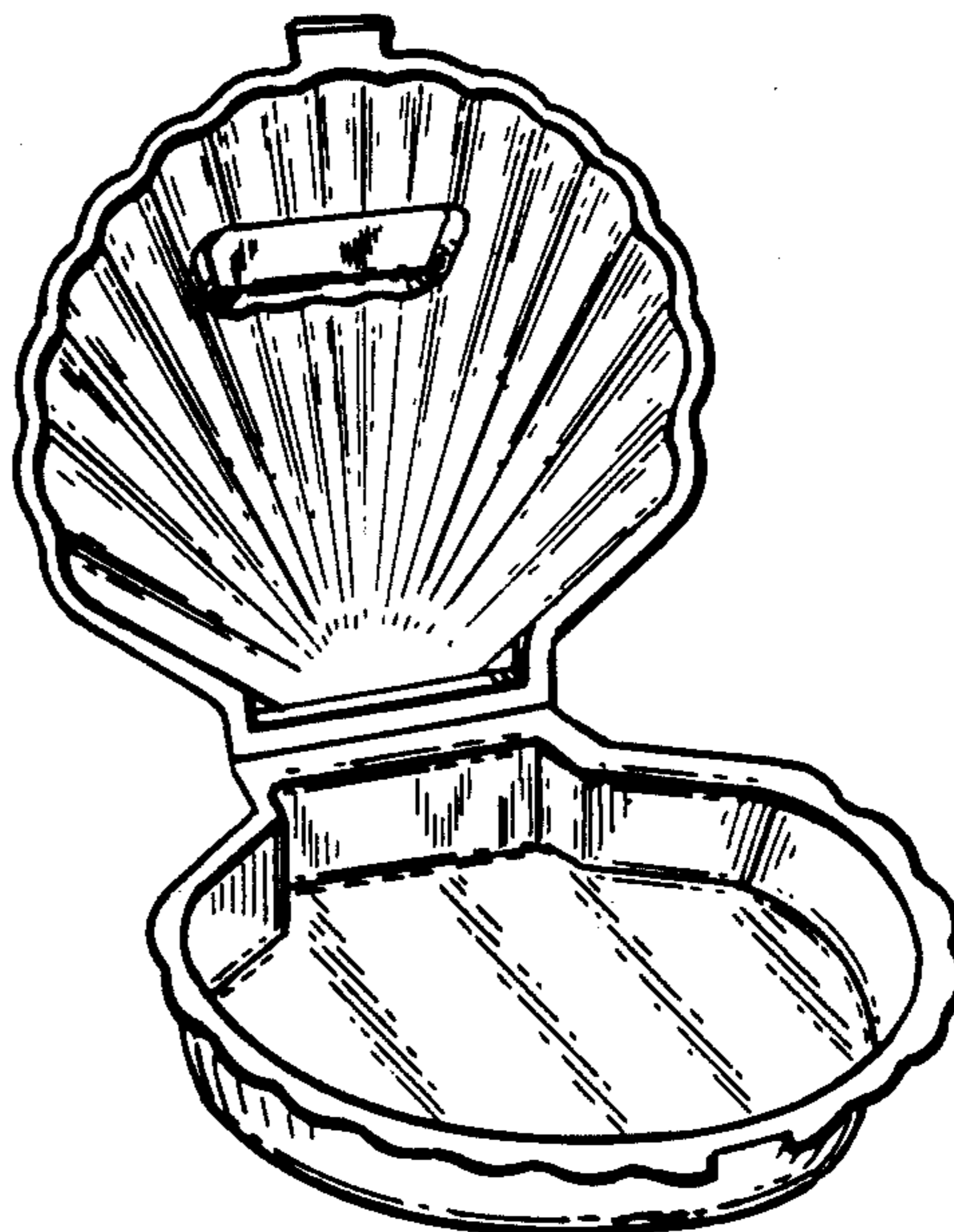
