DESCRIPTION

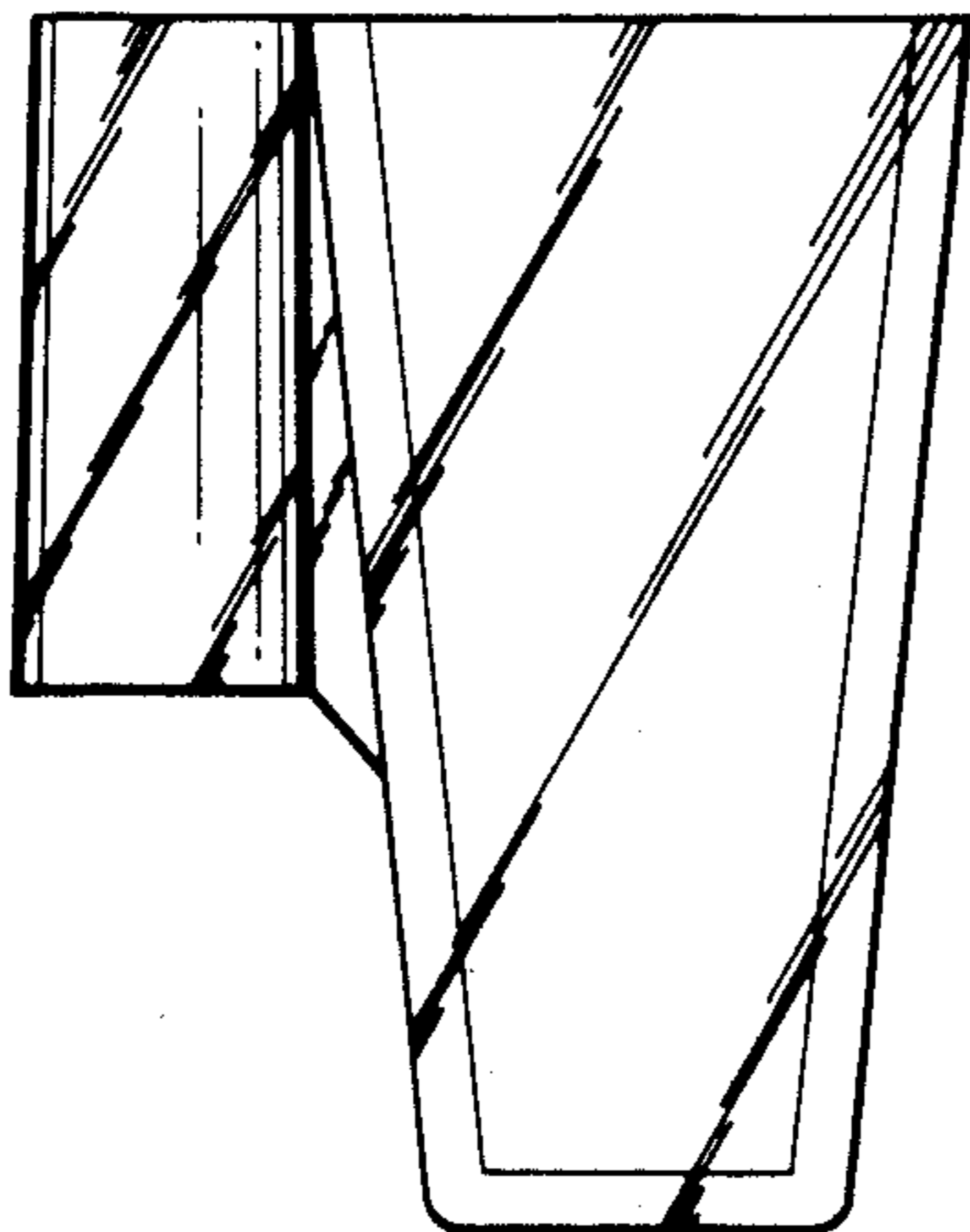

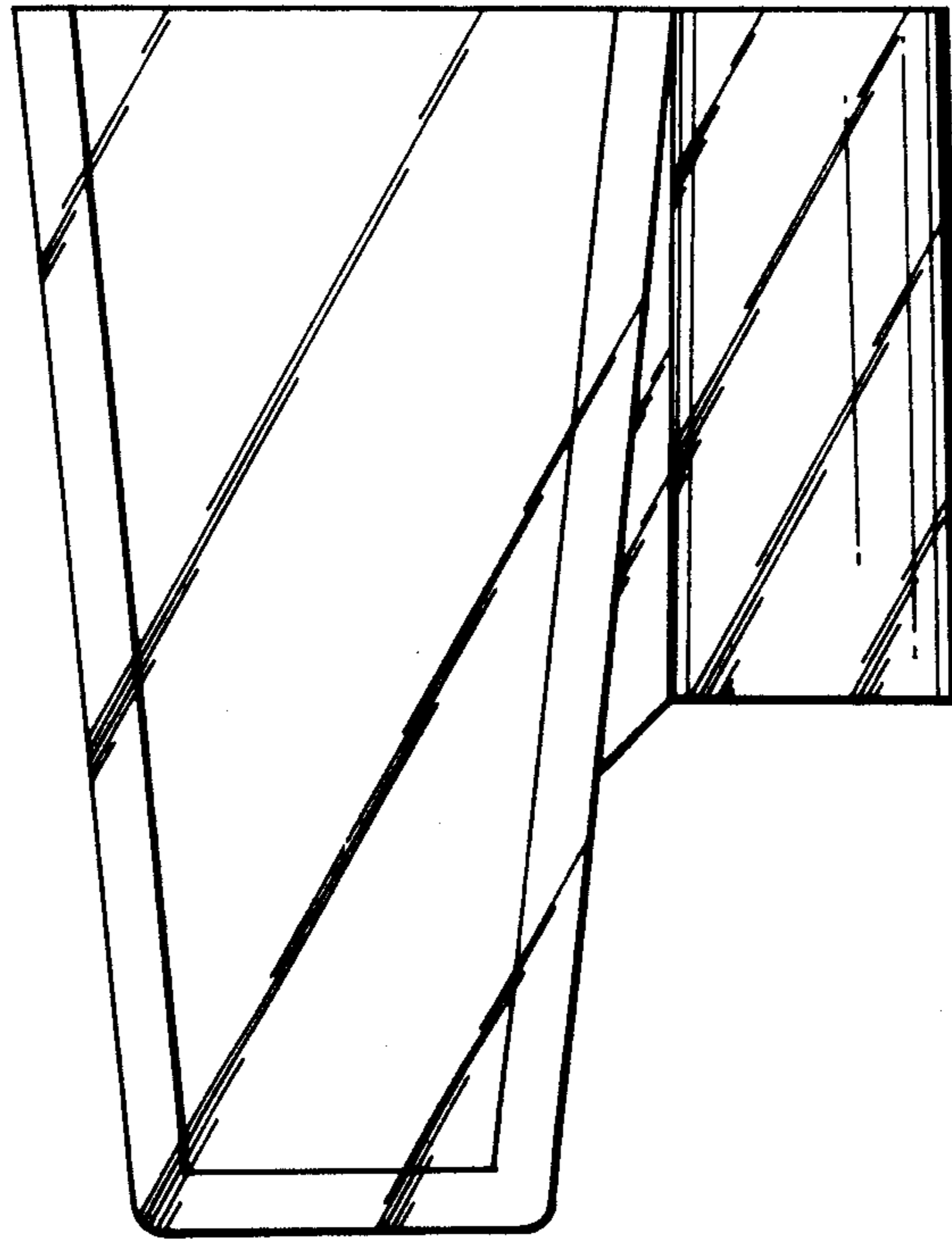

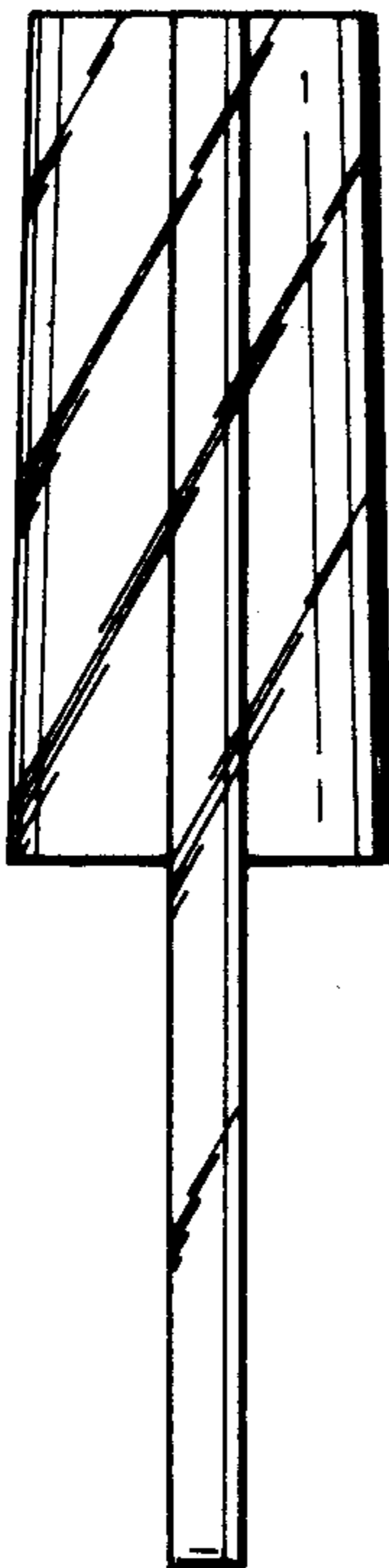
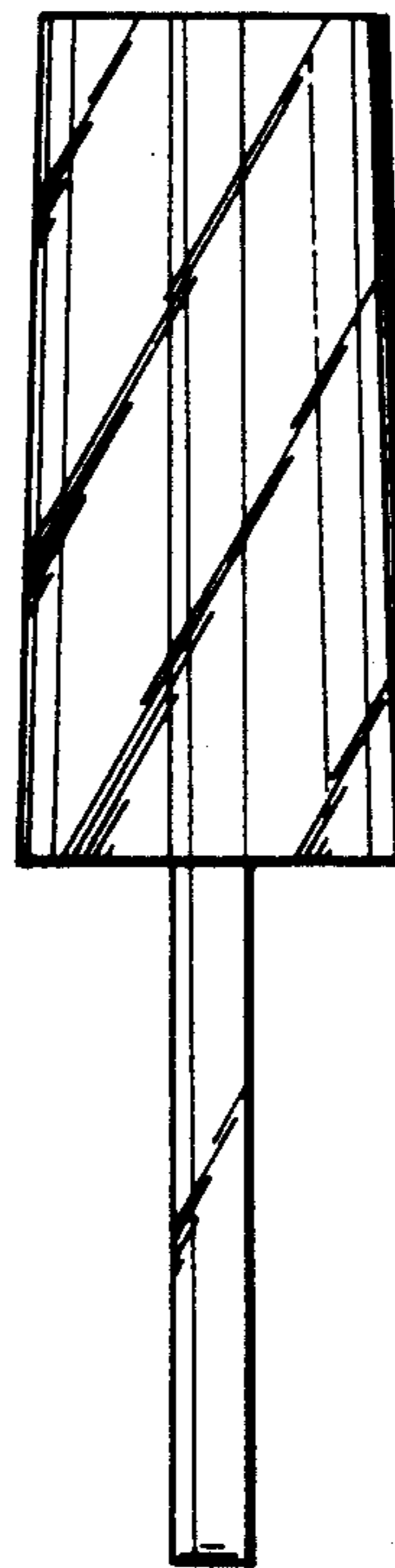

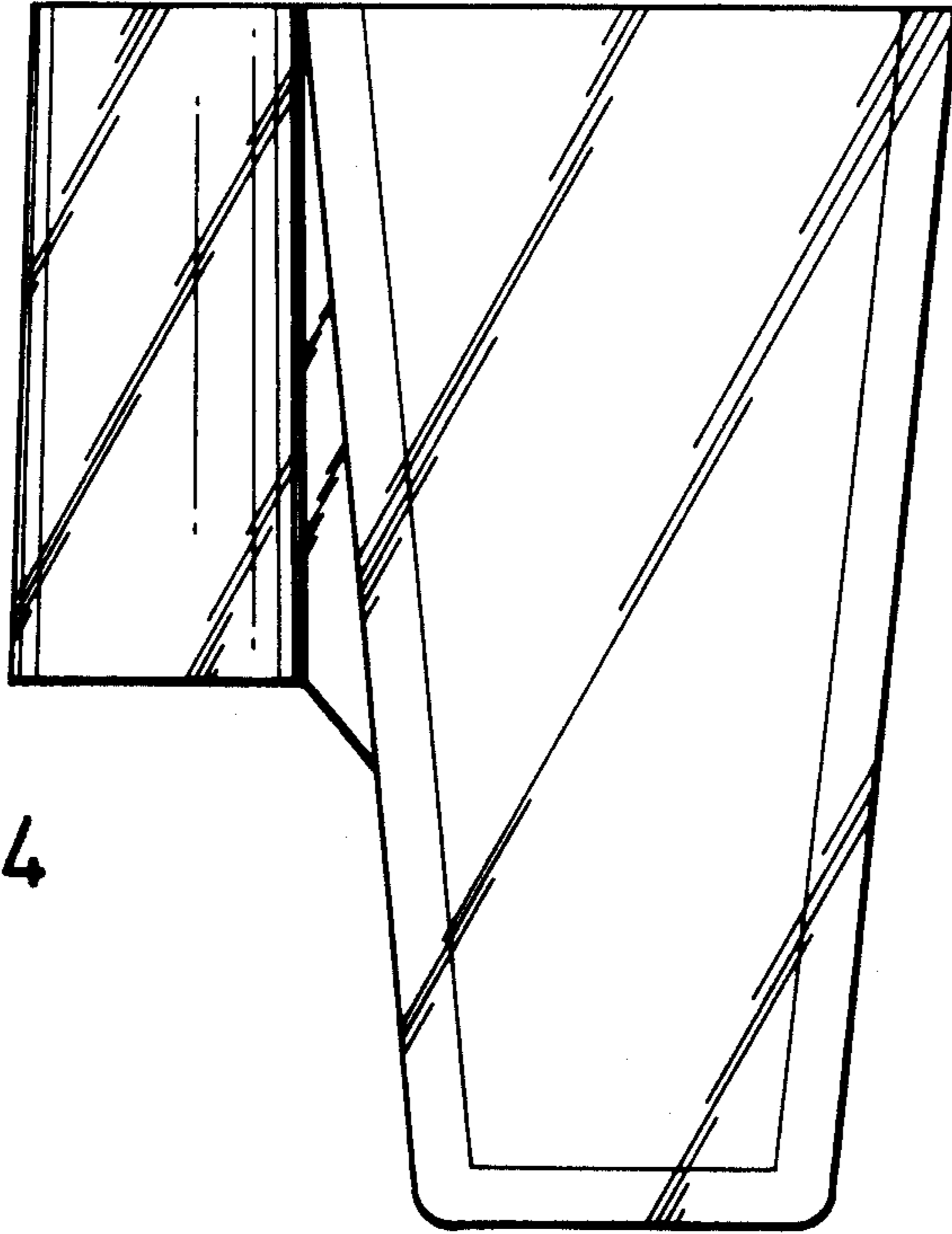

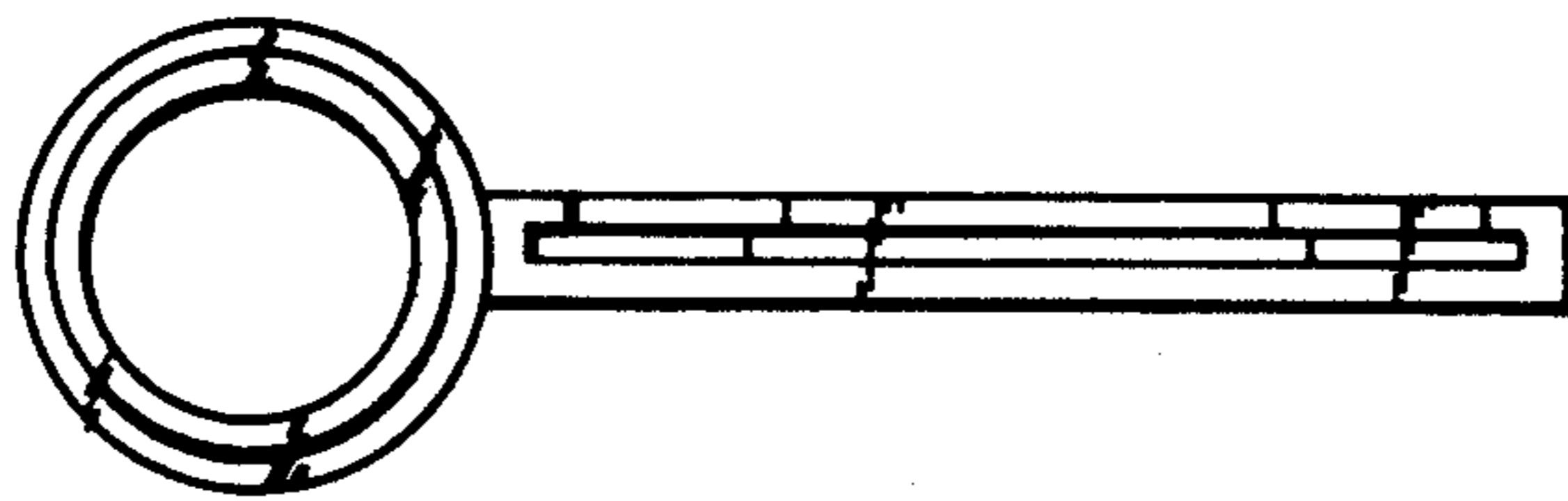
