DESCRIPTION

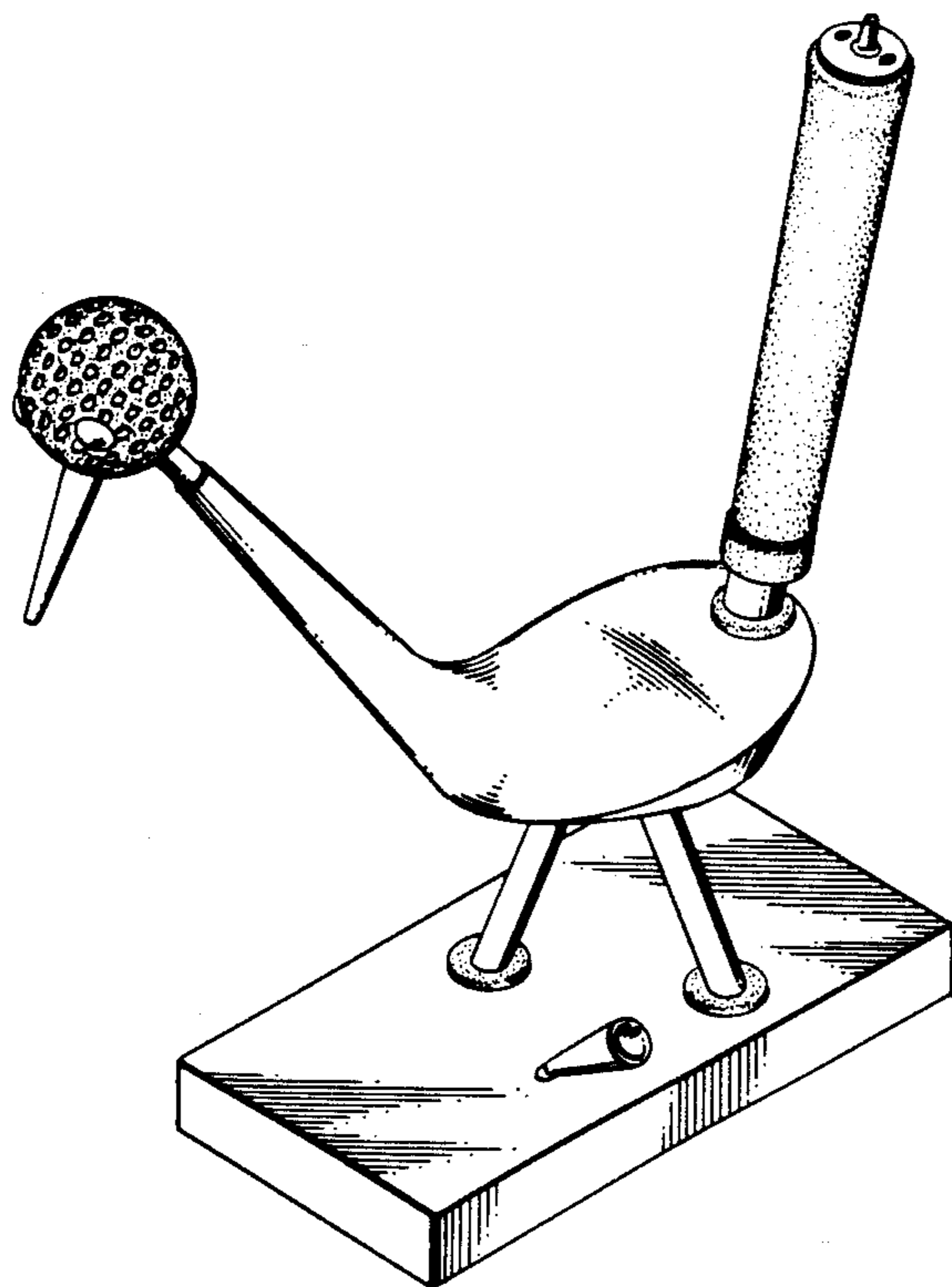

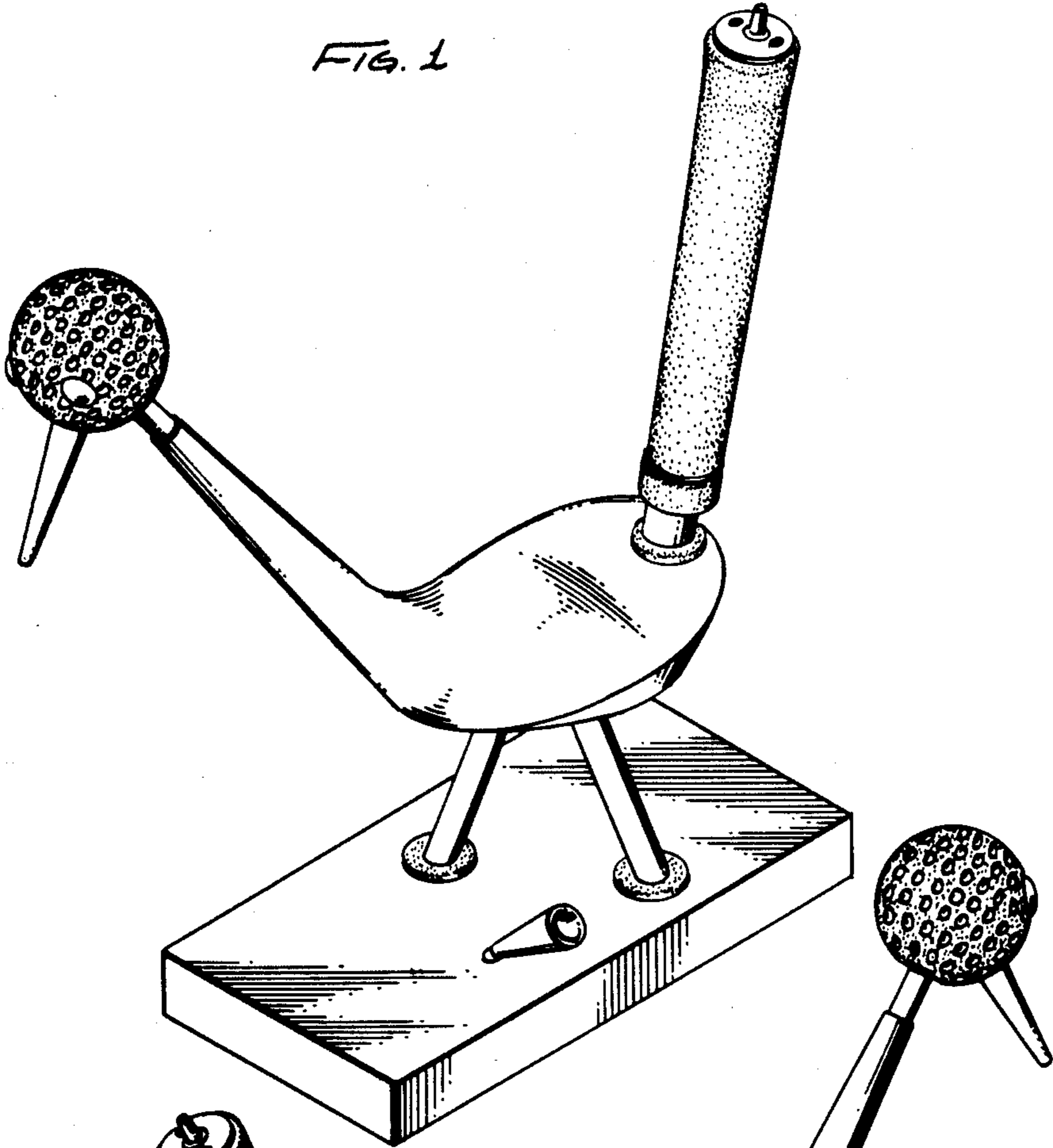

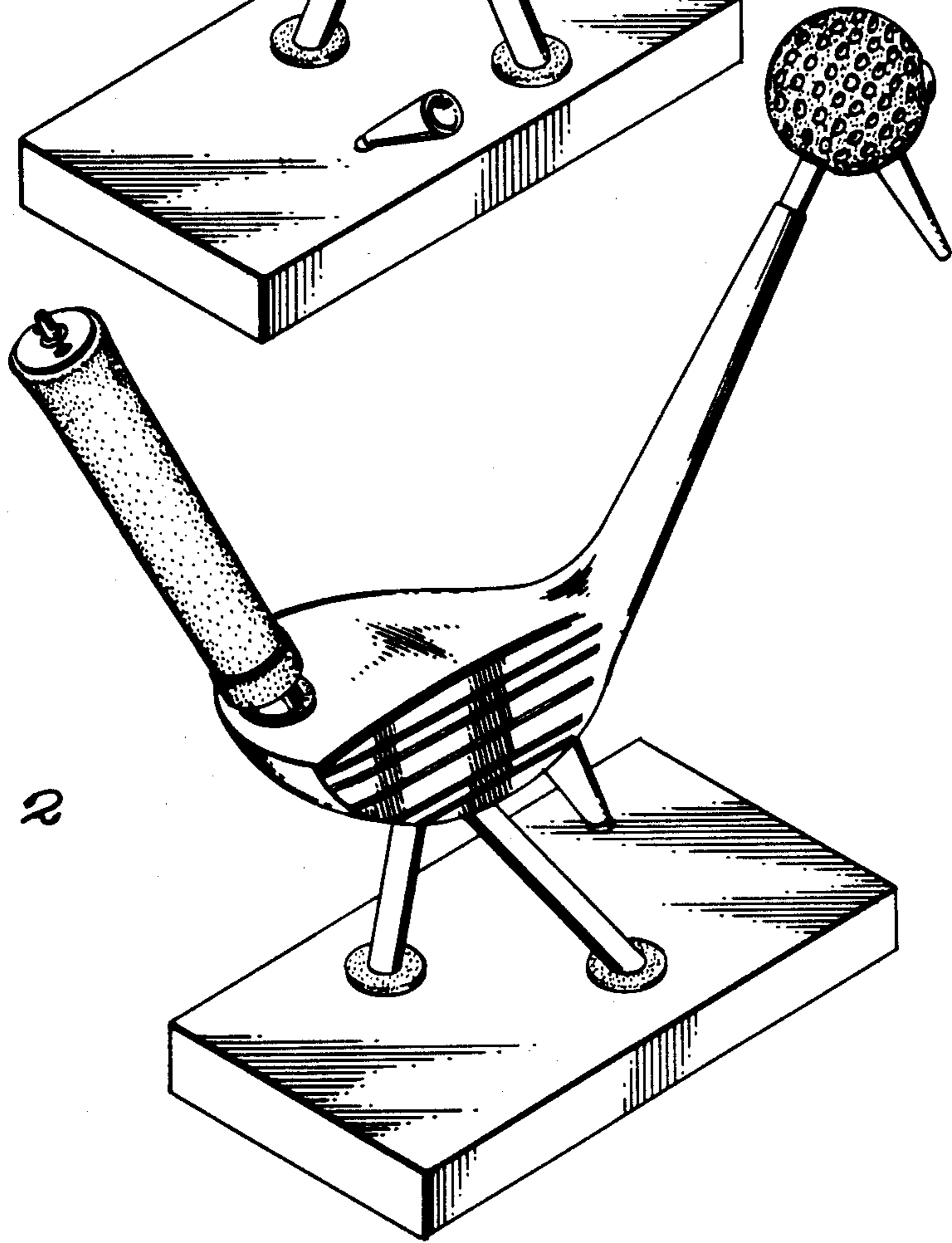

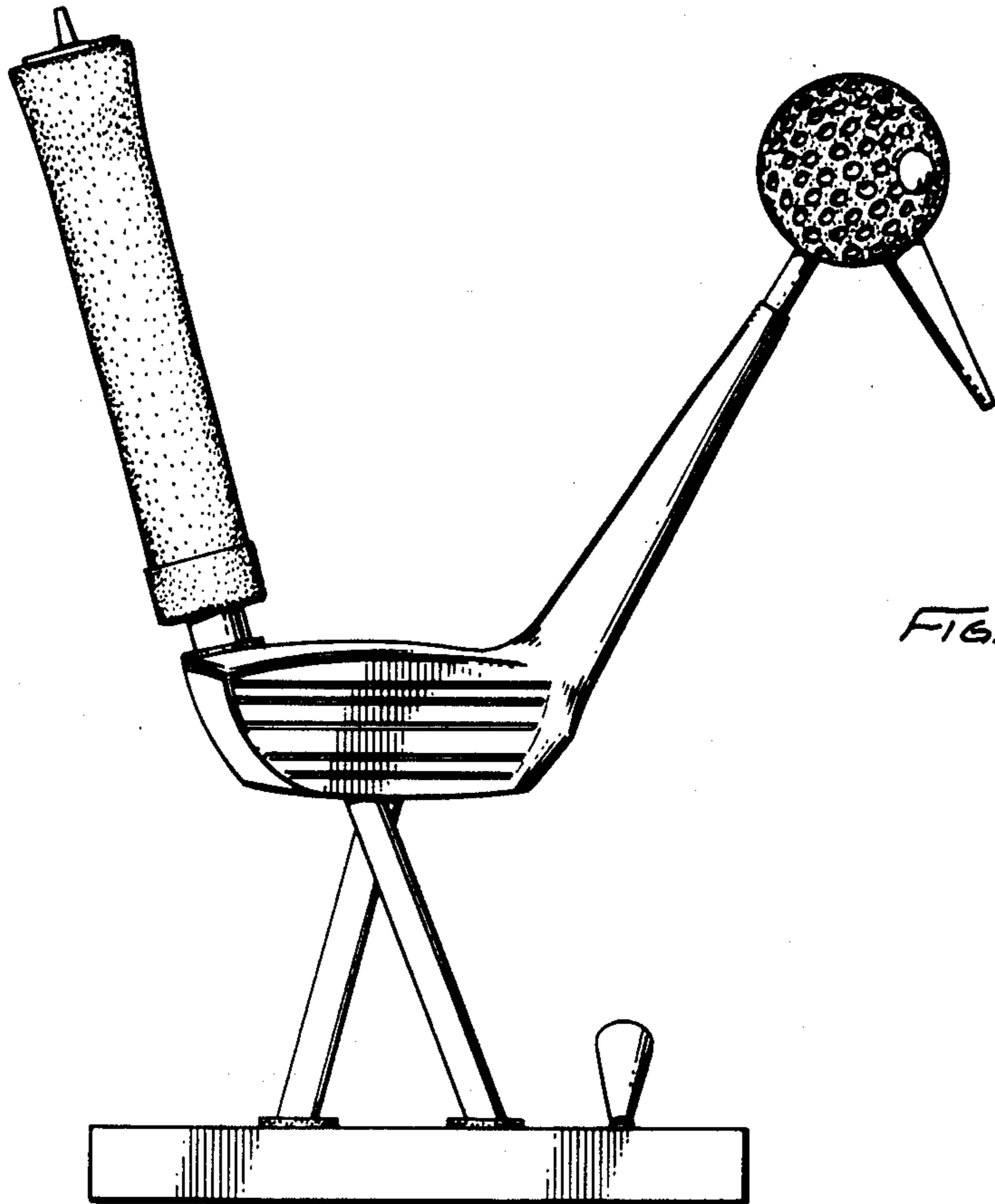
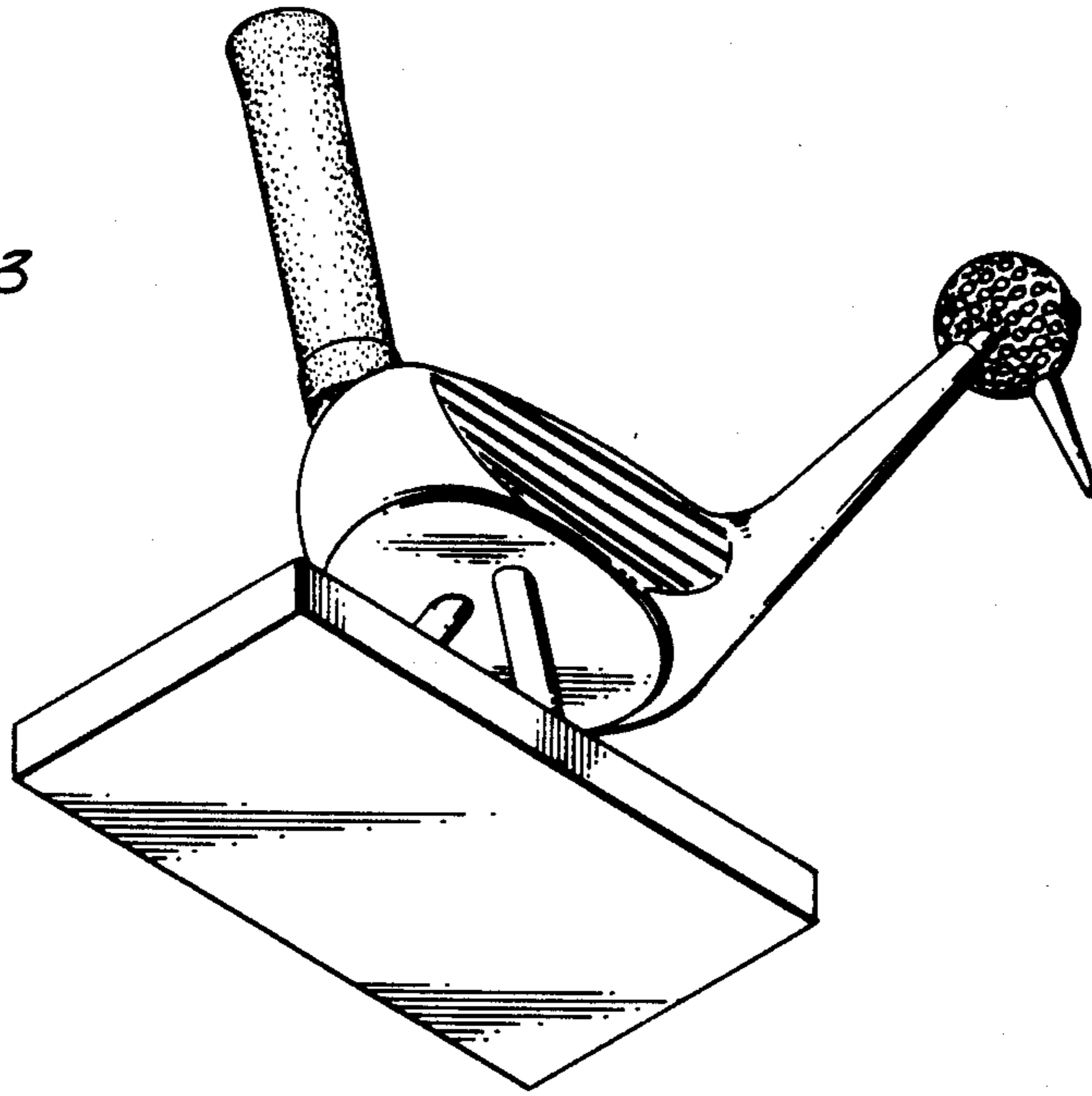

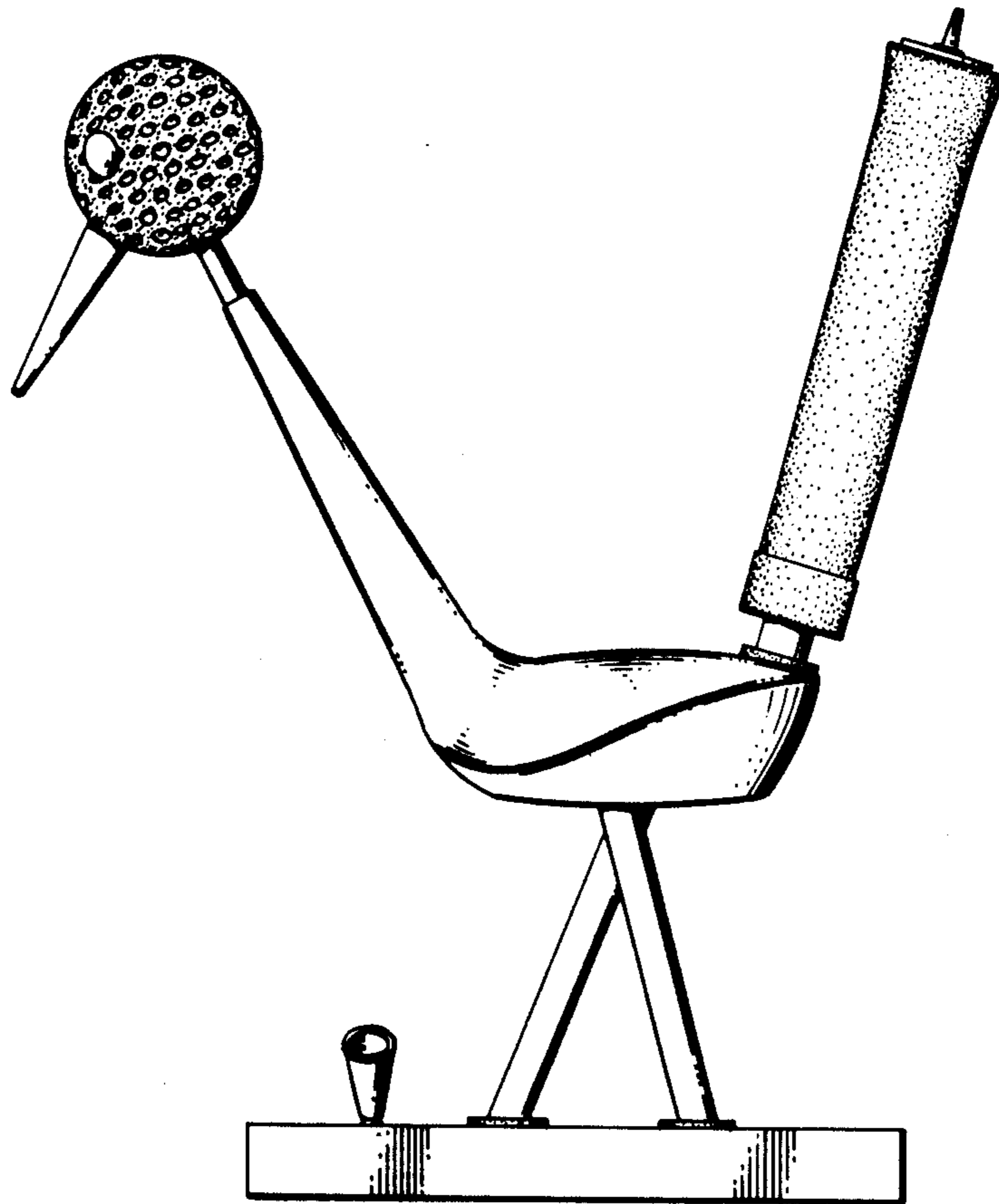
