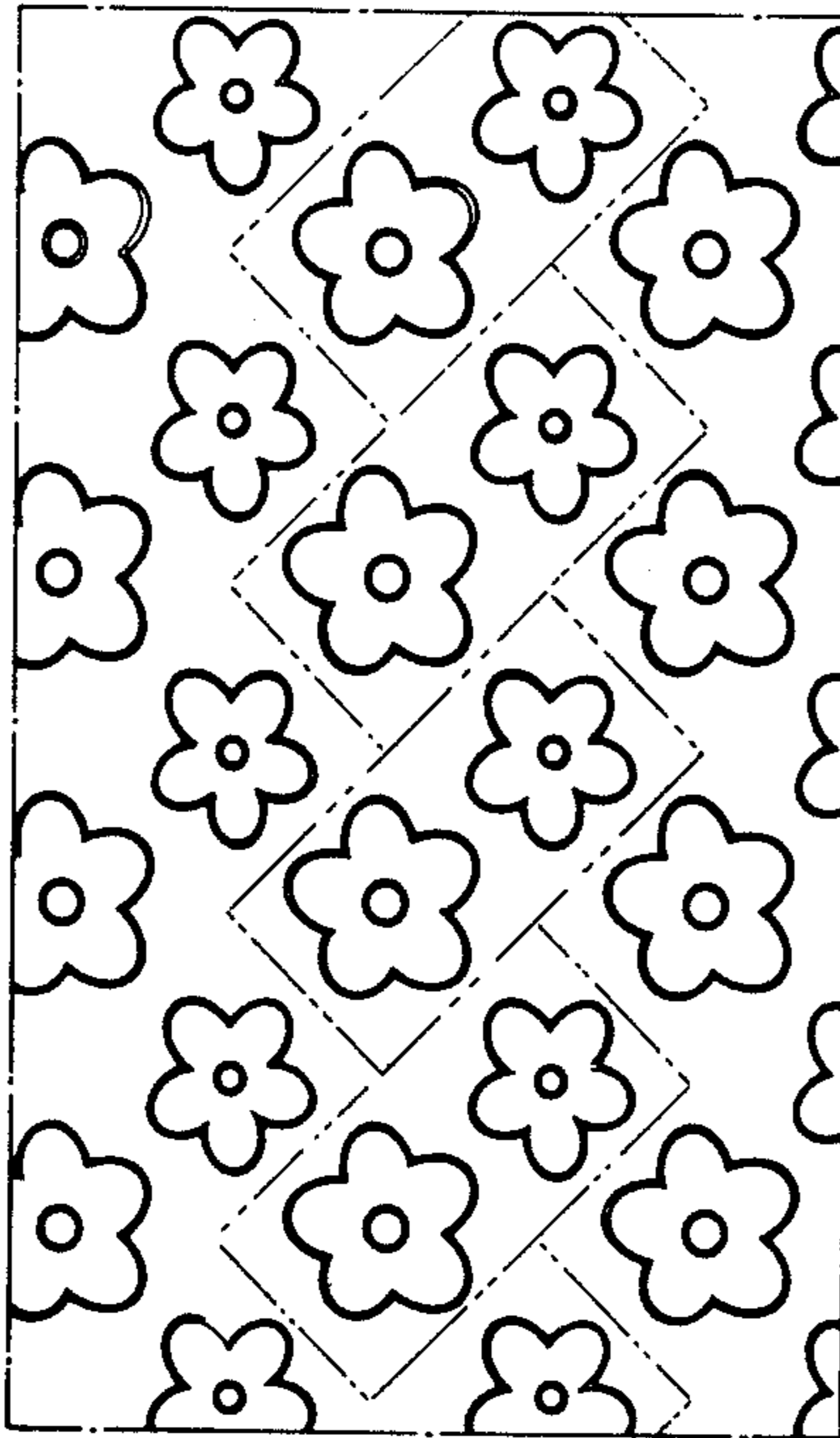

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an embossed patterned sheet of material for sanitary napkins, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an embossed patterned sheet of material for sanitary napkins showing my new design; the unit being marked off in broken lines, which unit is repeated in a regular succession as indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.



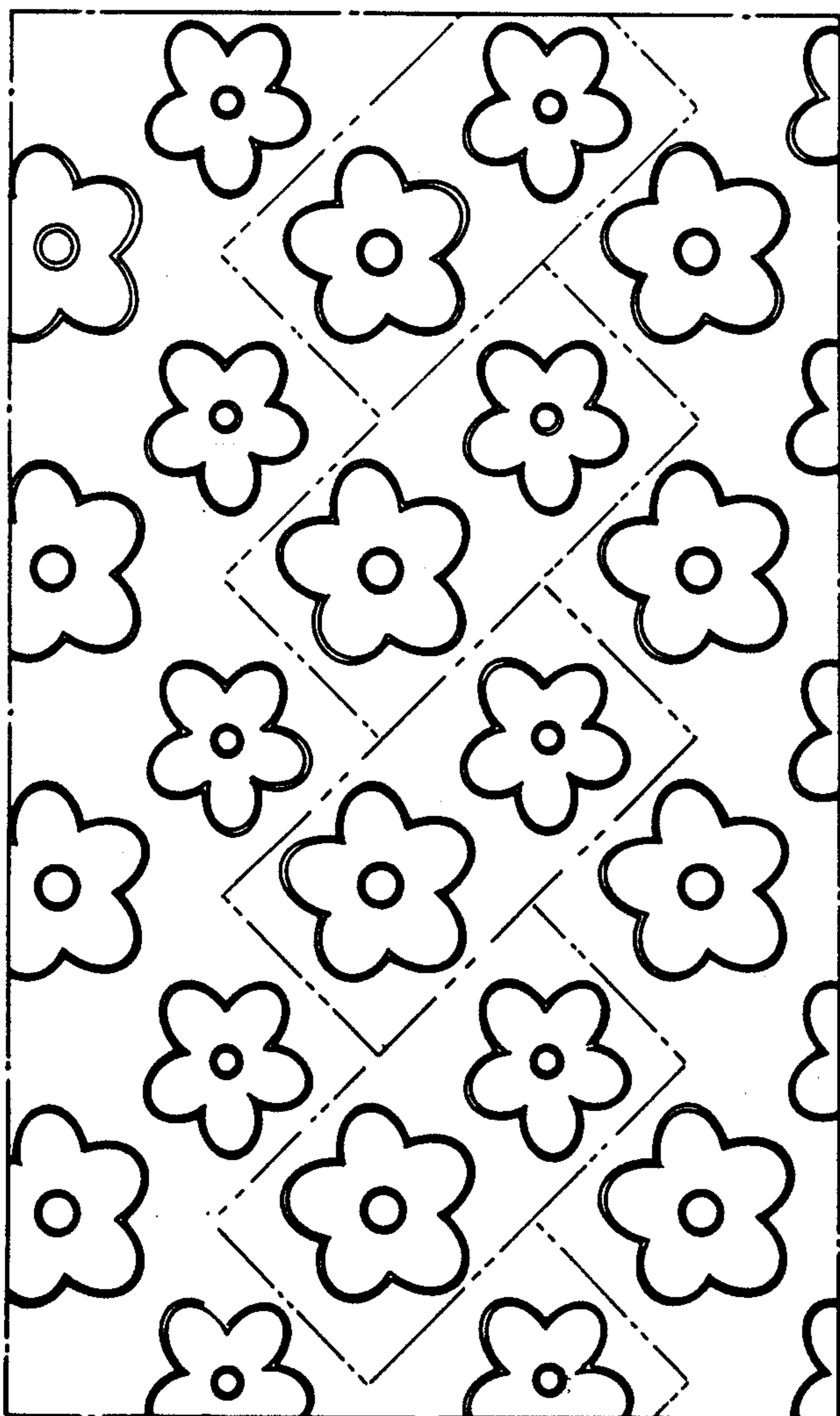
