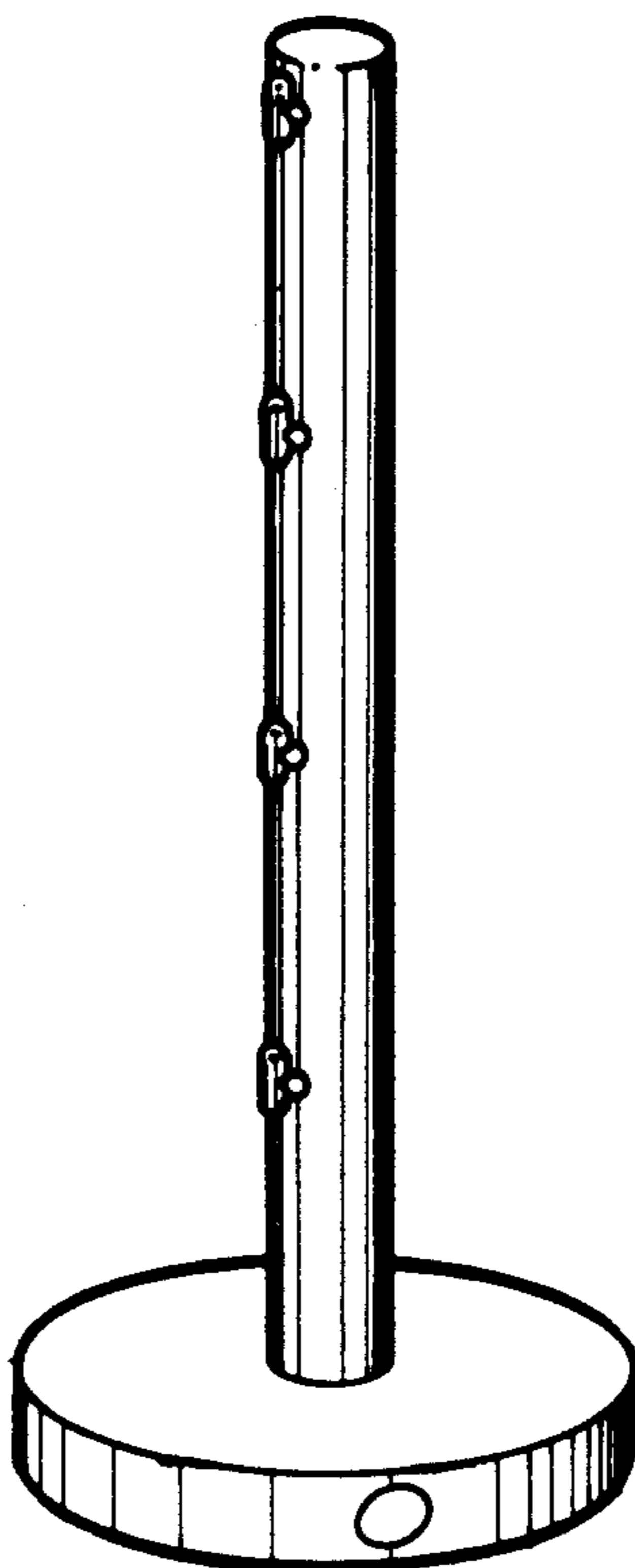

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the portable post of FIG. 1.



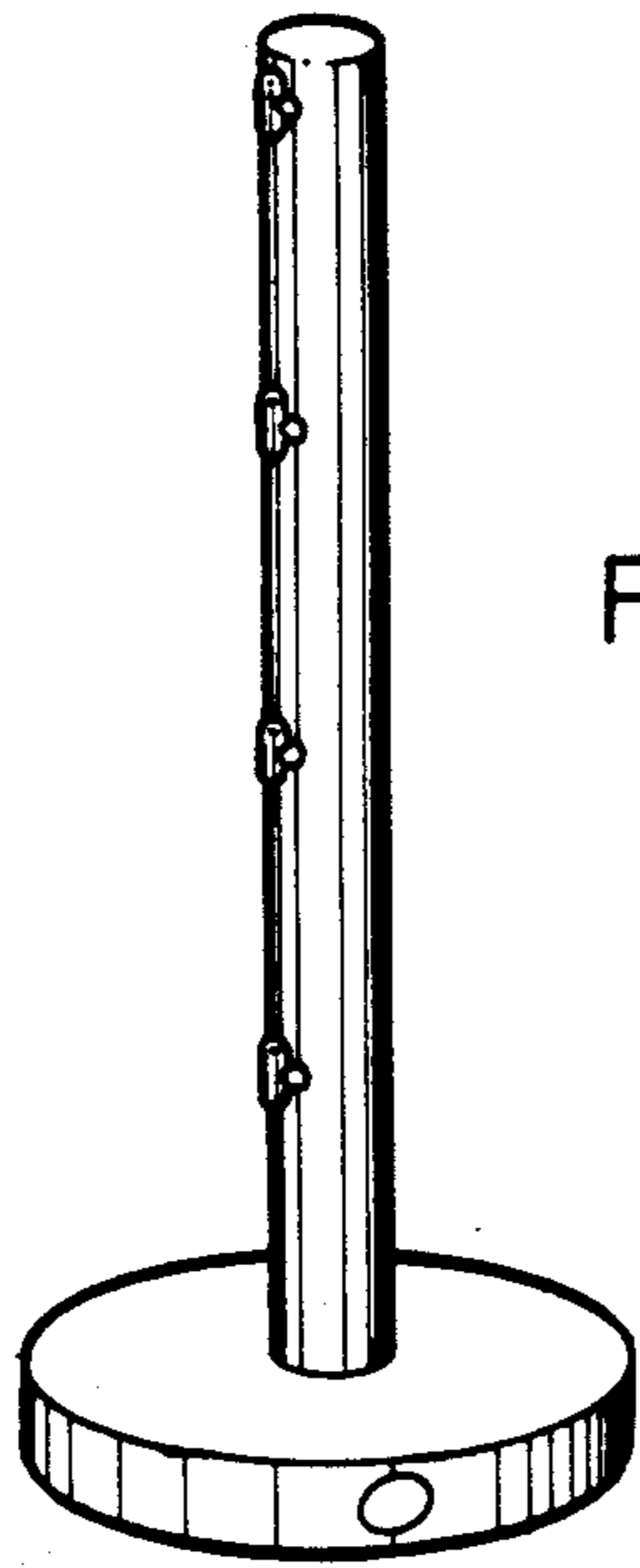

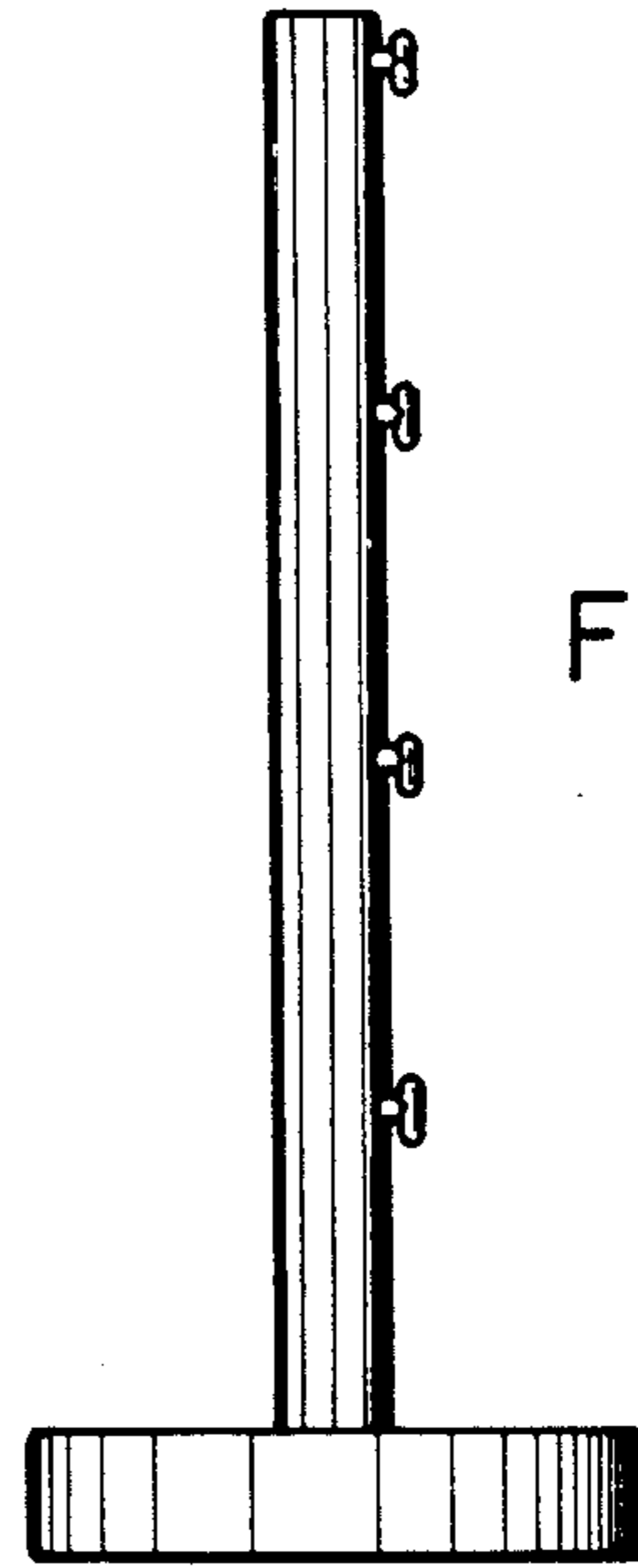

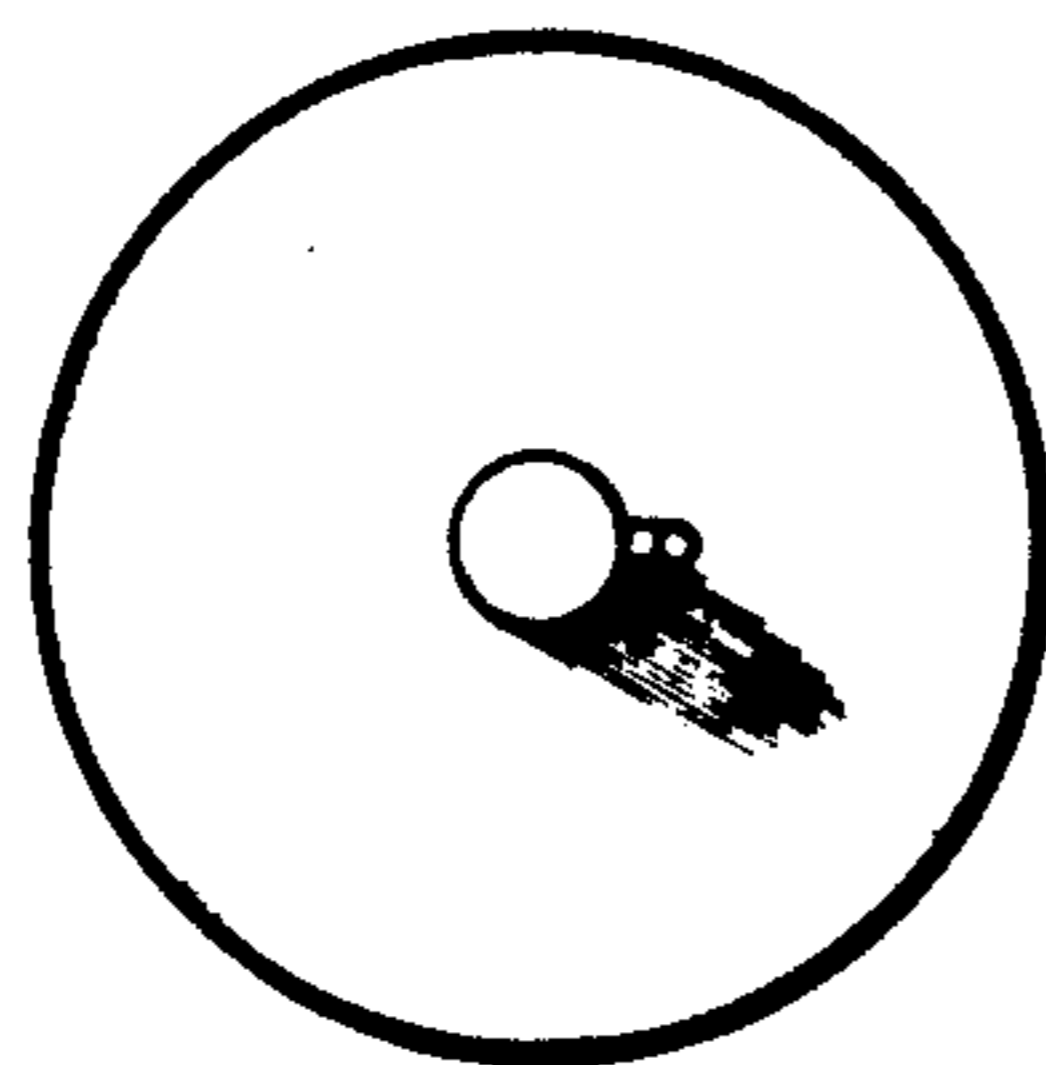

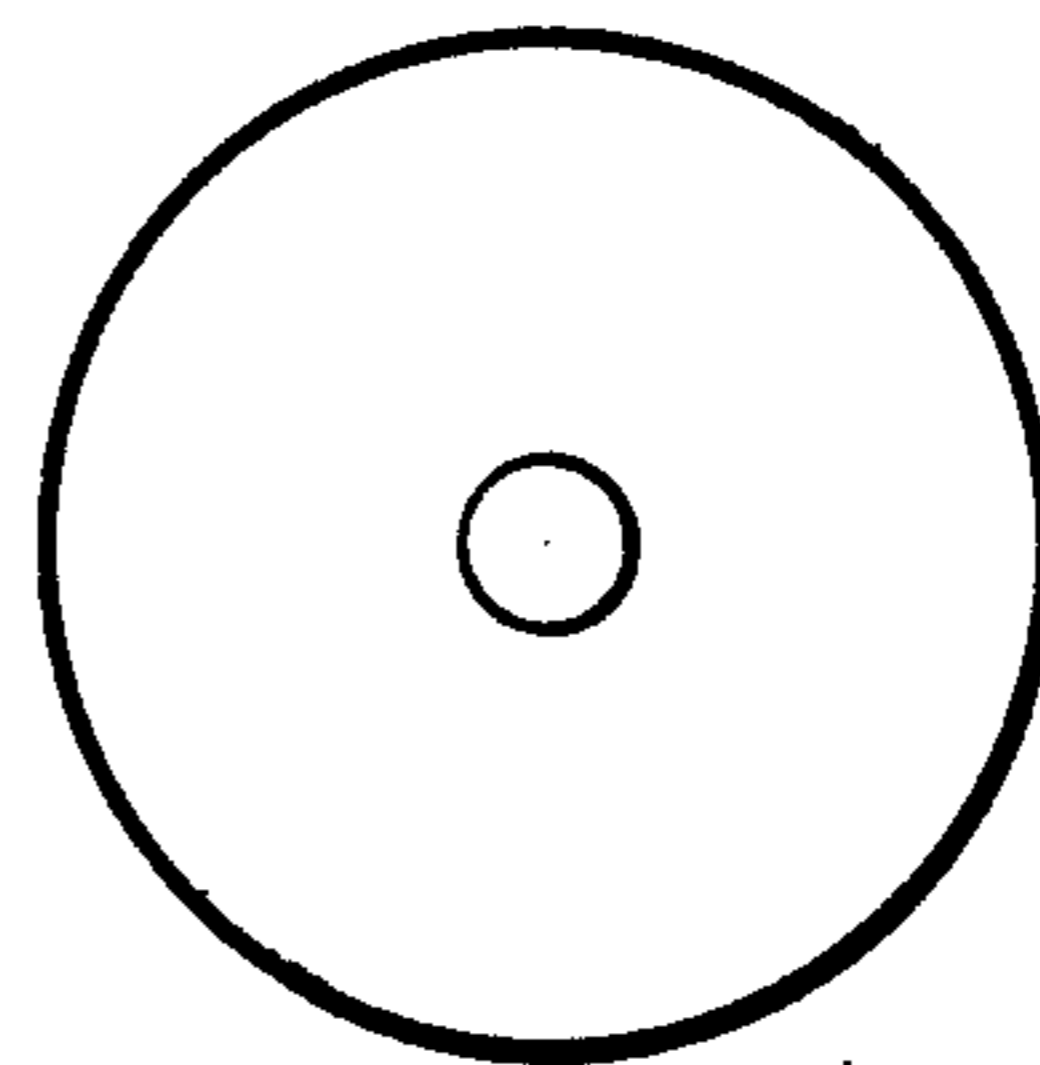
