DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a trivet or the like showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view on an enlarged scale.

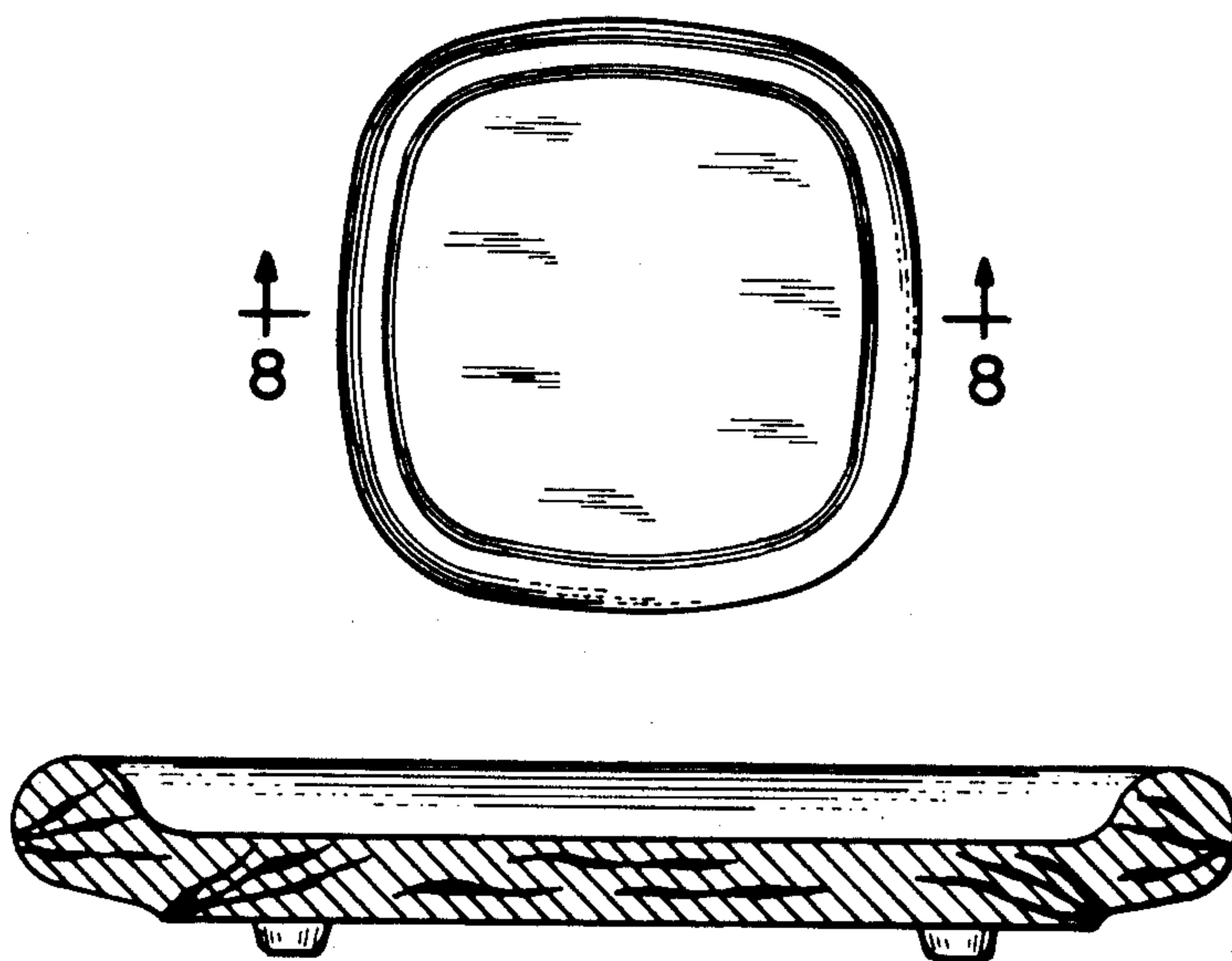
FIG. 4 is an elevational view on an enlarged scale in section taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is an elevational view on an enlarged scale in section taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 5.



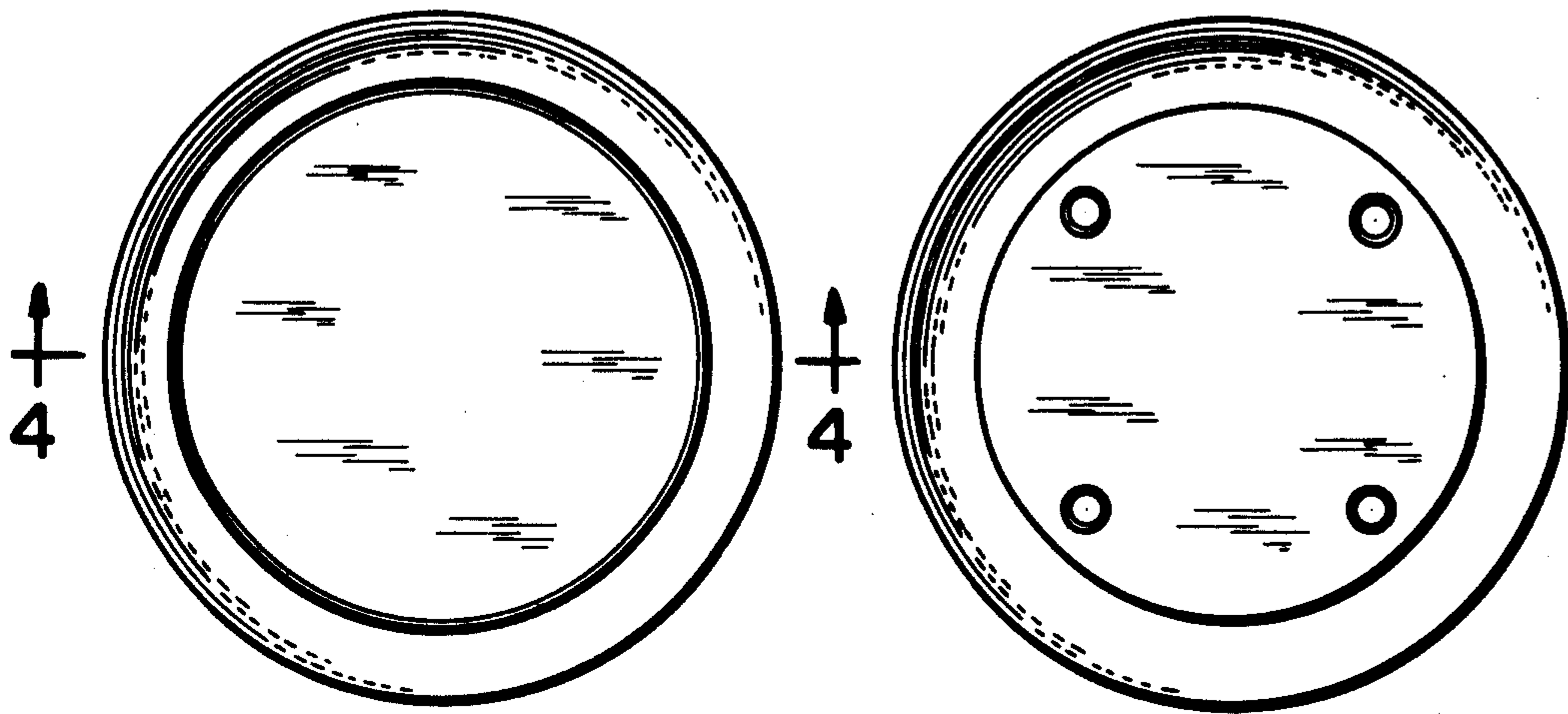

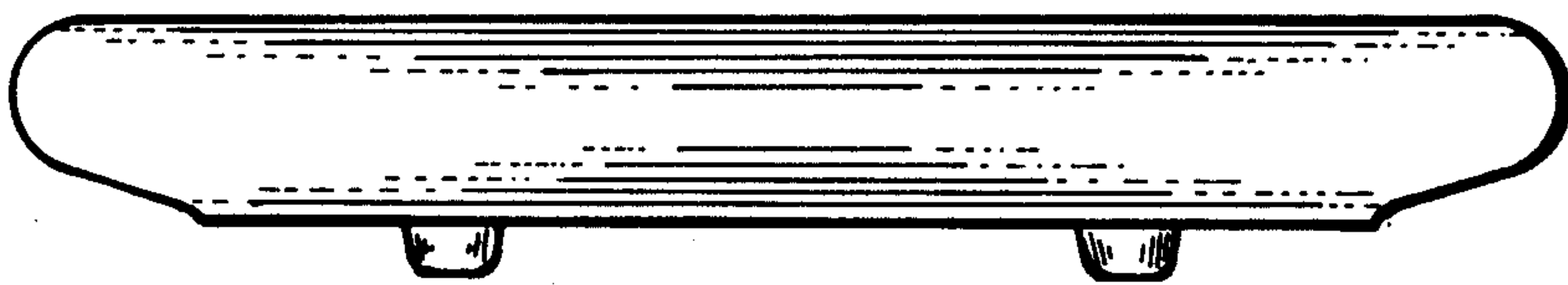

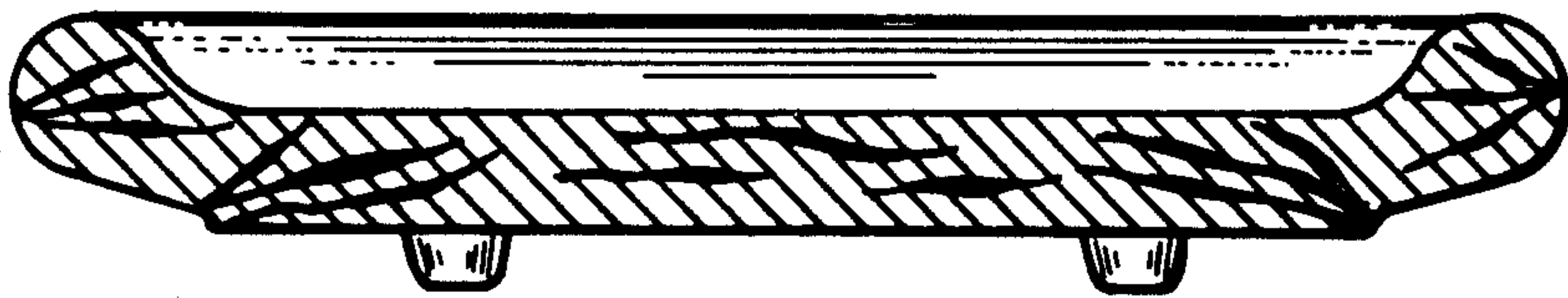

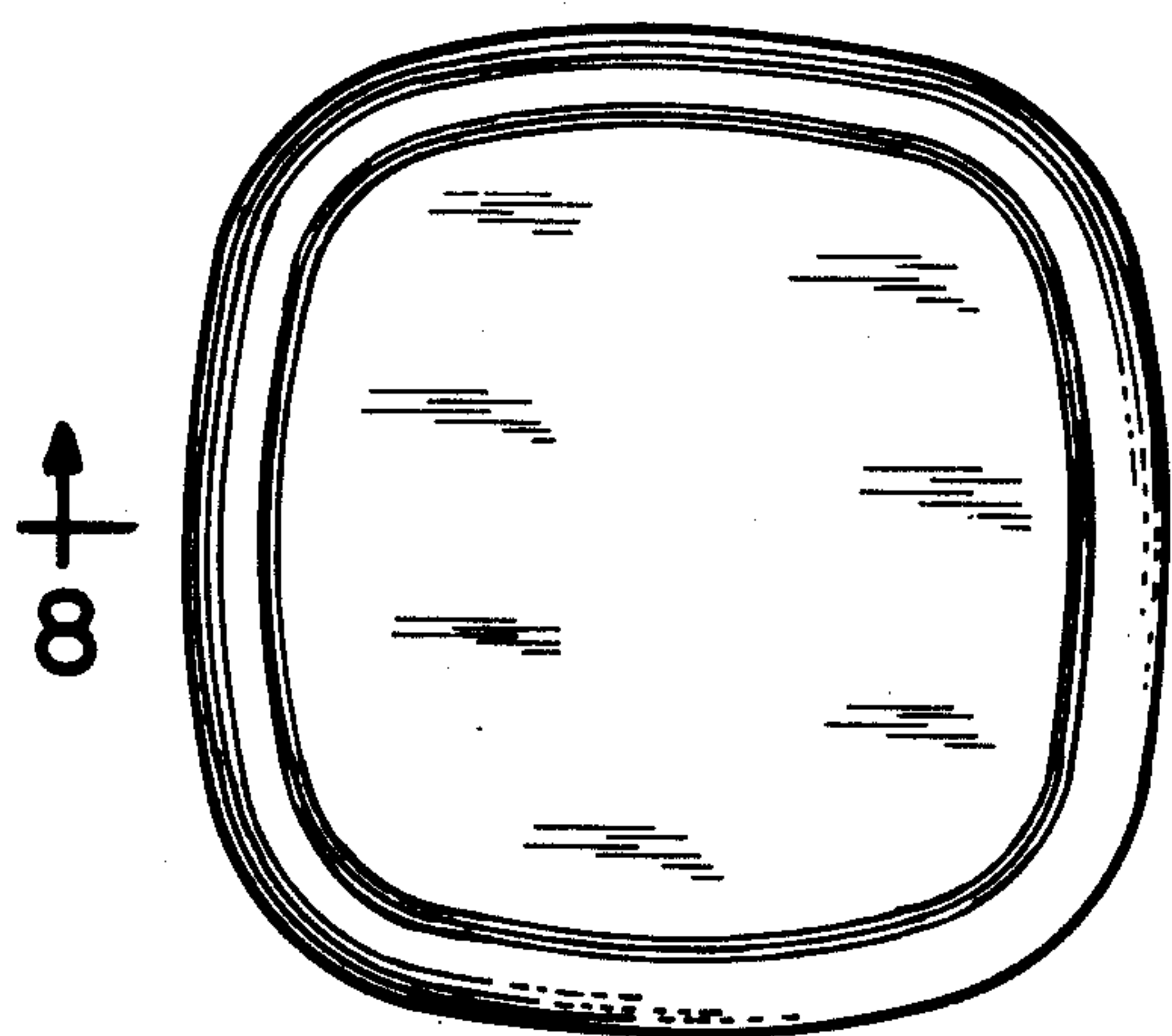

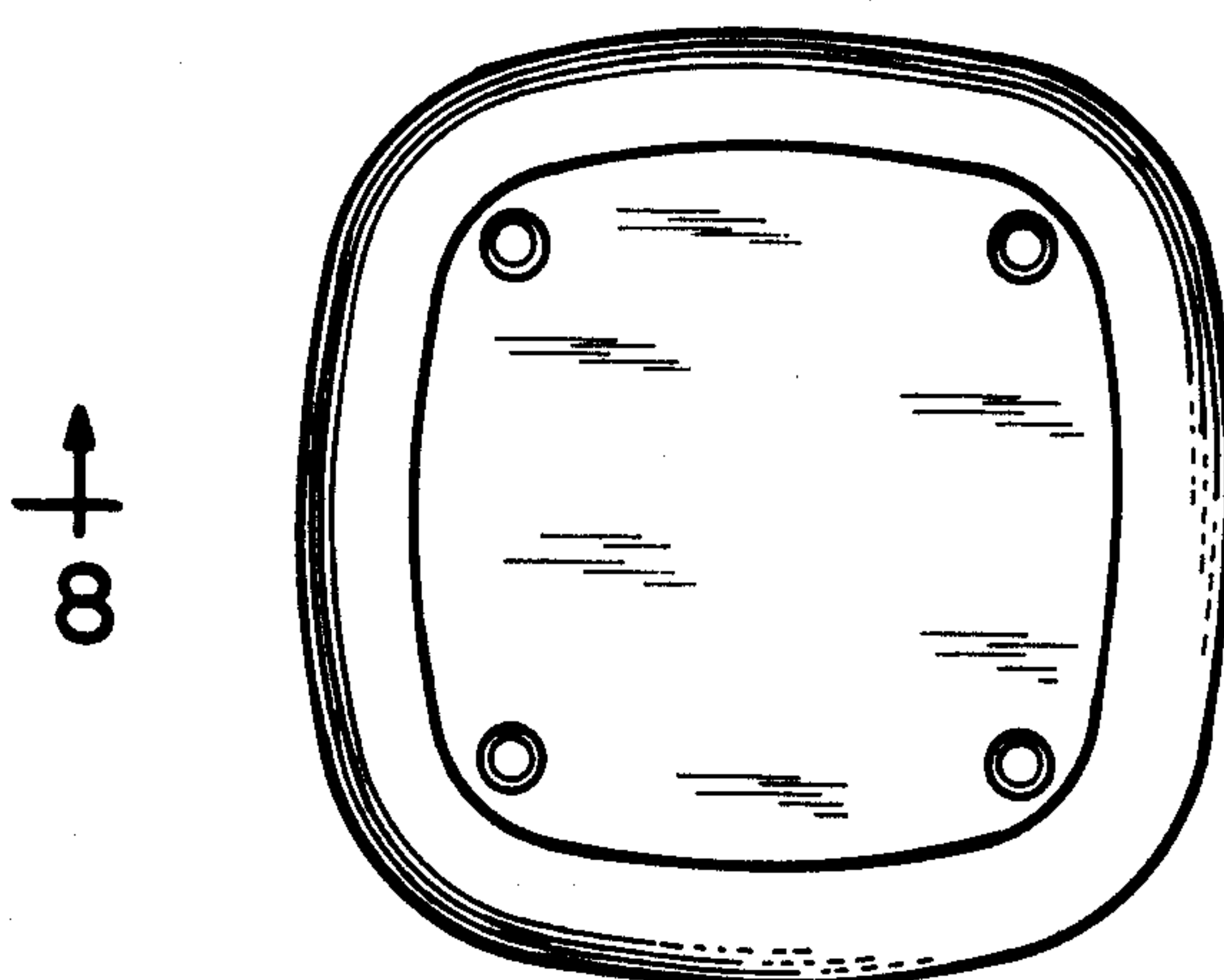

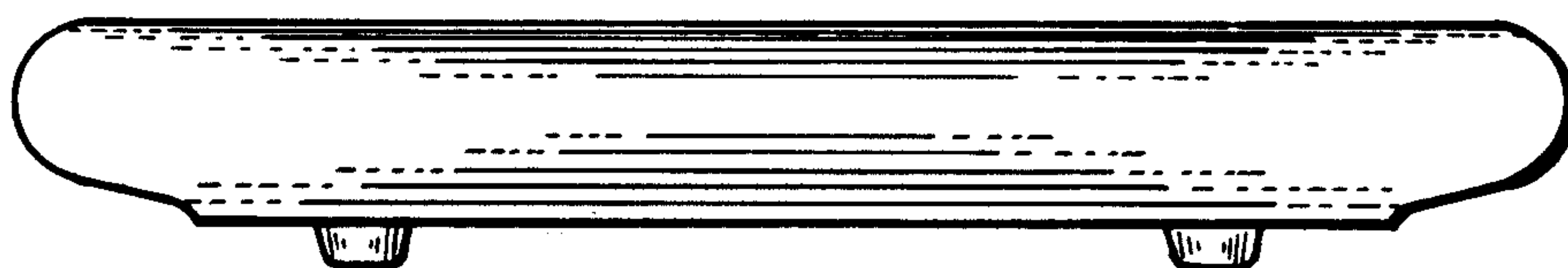

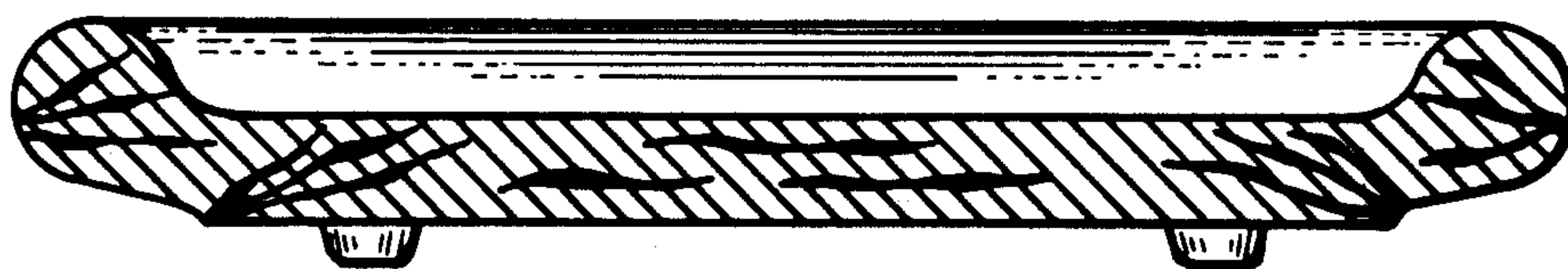
